# HOT WEATHER TIPS

- Encourage workers to wear sunscreen and use other protections from direct sunlight

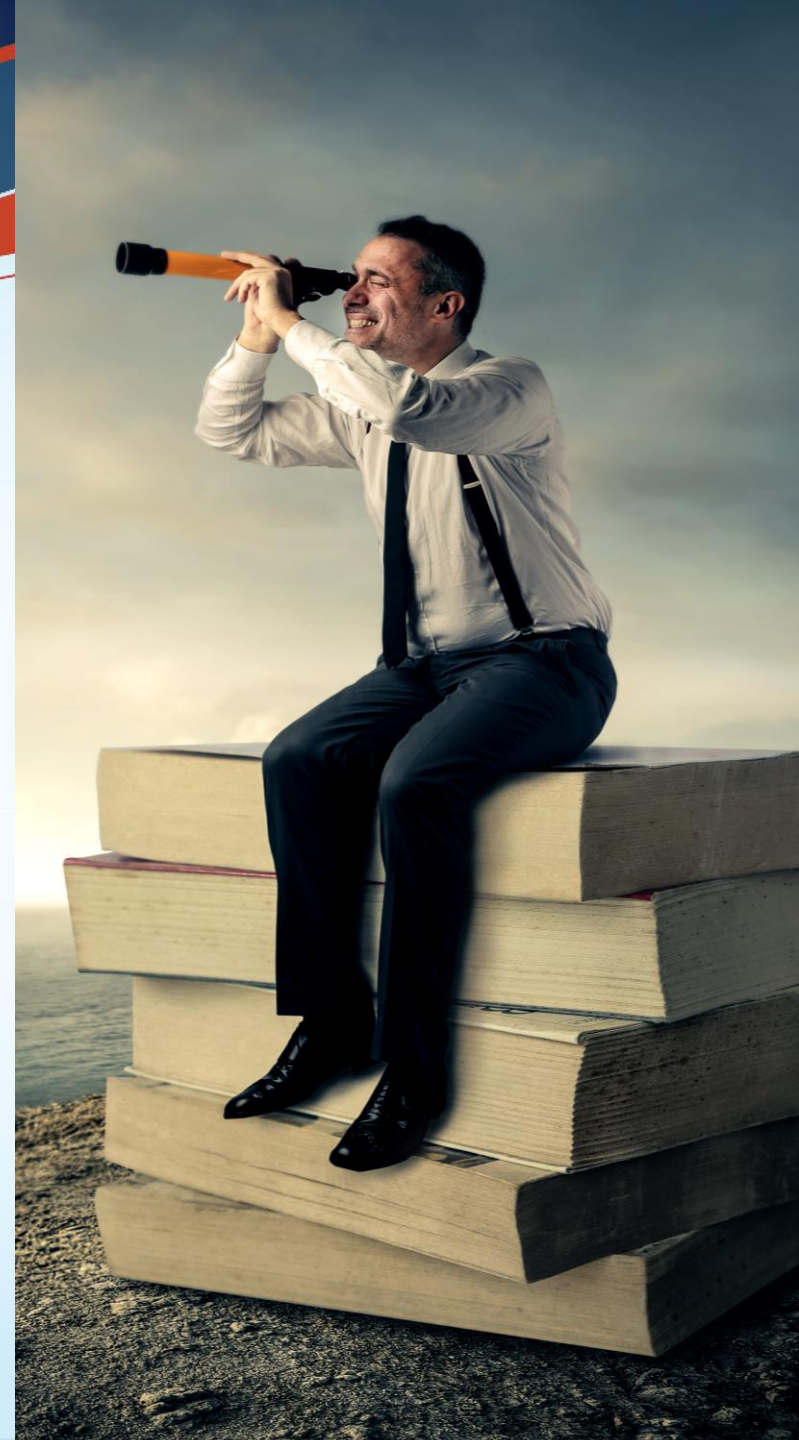

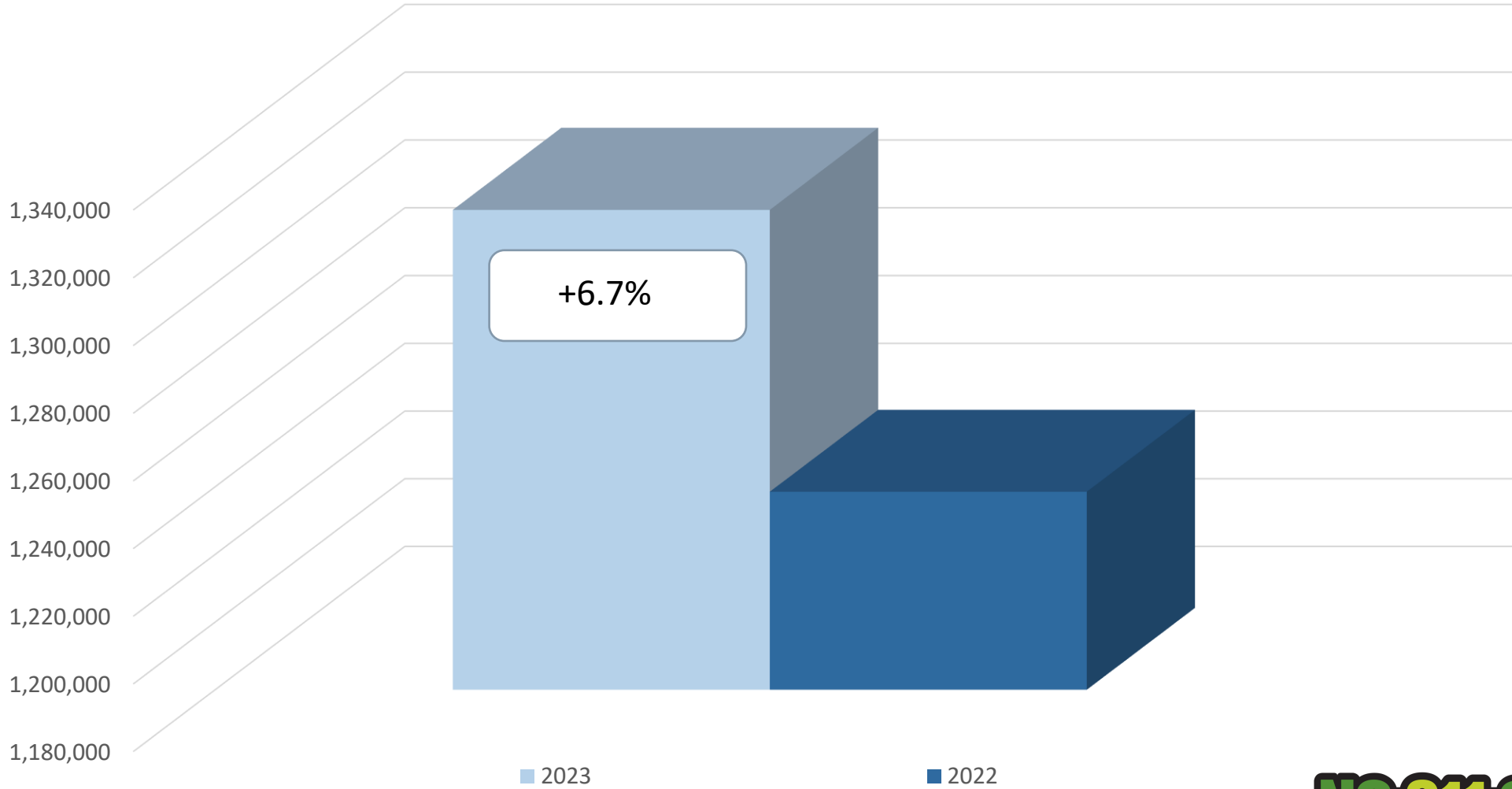

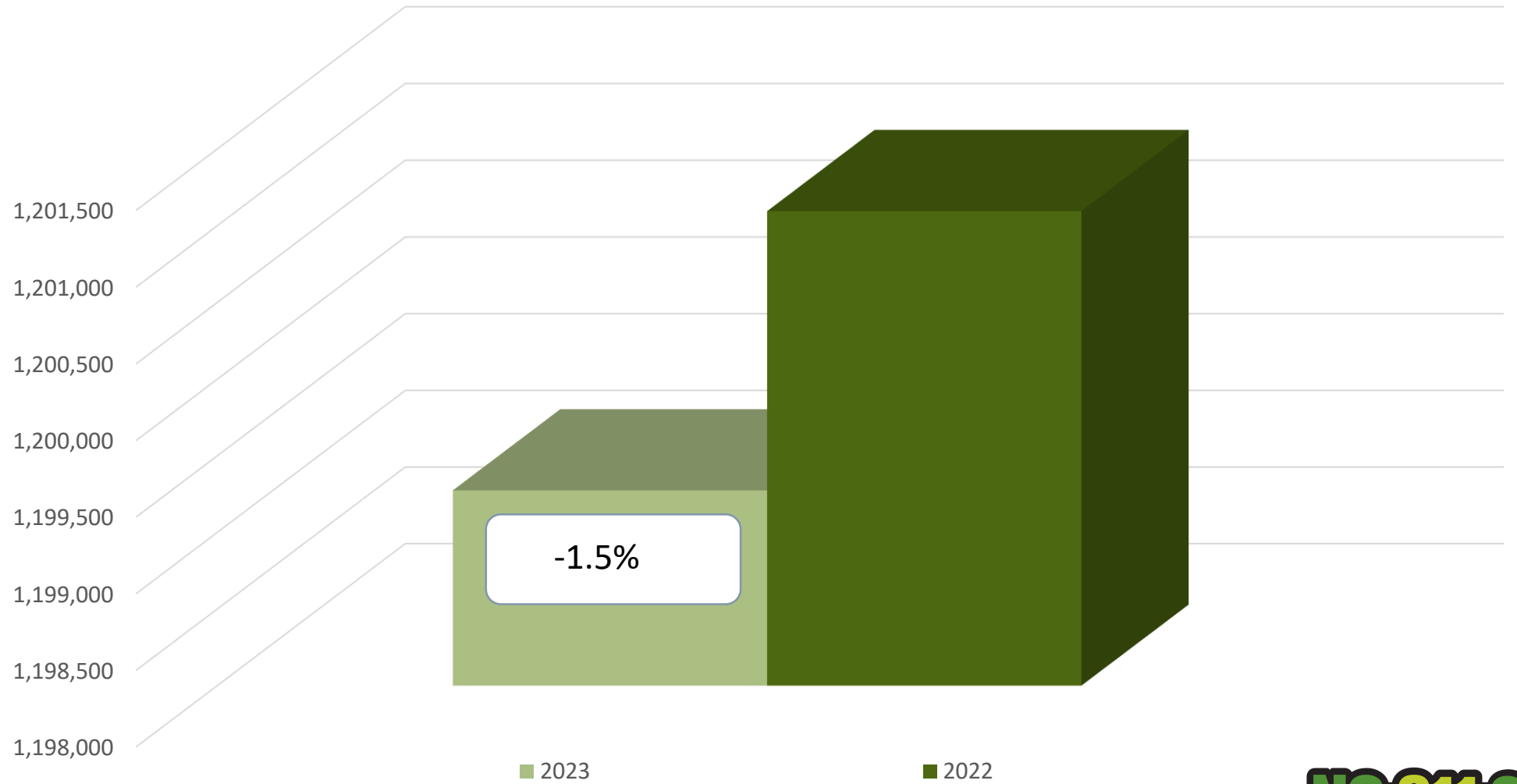
# YTD 2023 vs 2022





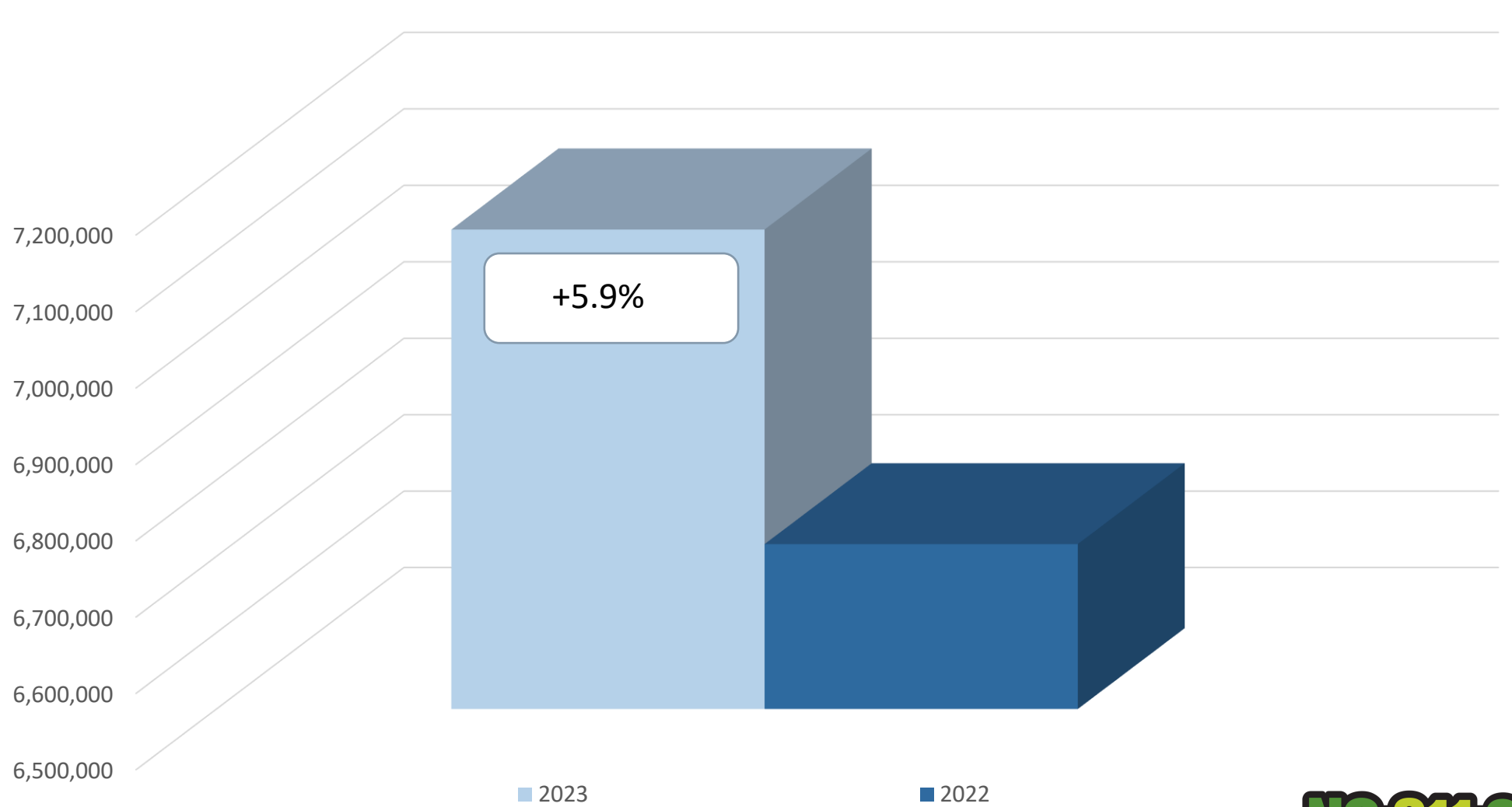

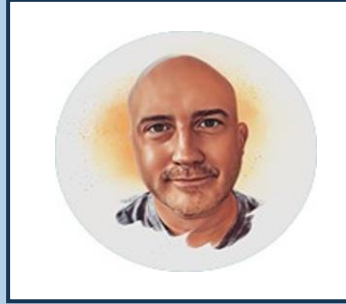
