- Currently waiting on final signatures to set NTP (Anticipated September). Contract awarded to Trader Construction. All original locations the City bid for the base bid will be performed.

Elm Street

- Brightspeeds sub (Lamberts) is slated to begin efforts as soon as possible to finish pole transfers and remove old poles.

Atlantic Ave Lot B

- All work complete.

Cedar Ln Stormwater Improvements

- Postponed until further notice.

Oxford Rd. & Rock Springs Bridge Replacement

- Being designed by HTNB and project design-construction handling by NCDOT.
- City will be used as liaisons with the bridges turning over to the city once completed for maintenance.
- Webb White is HTNB Utility Coordinator.

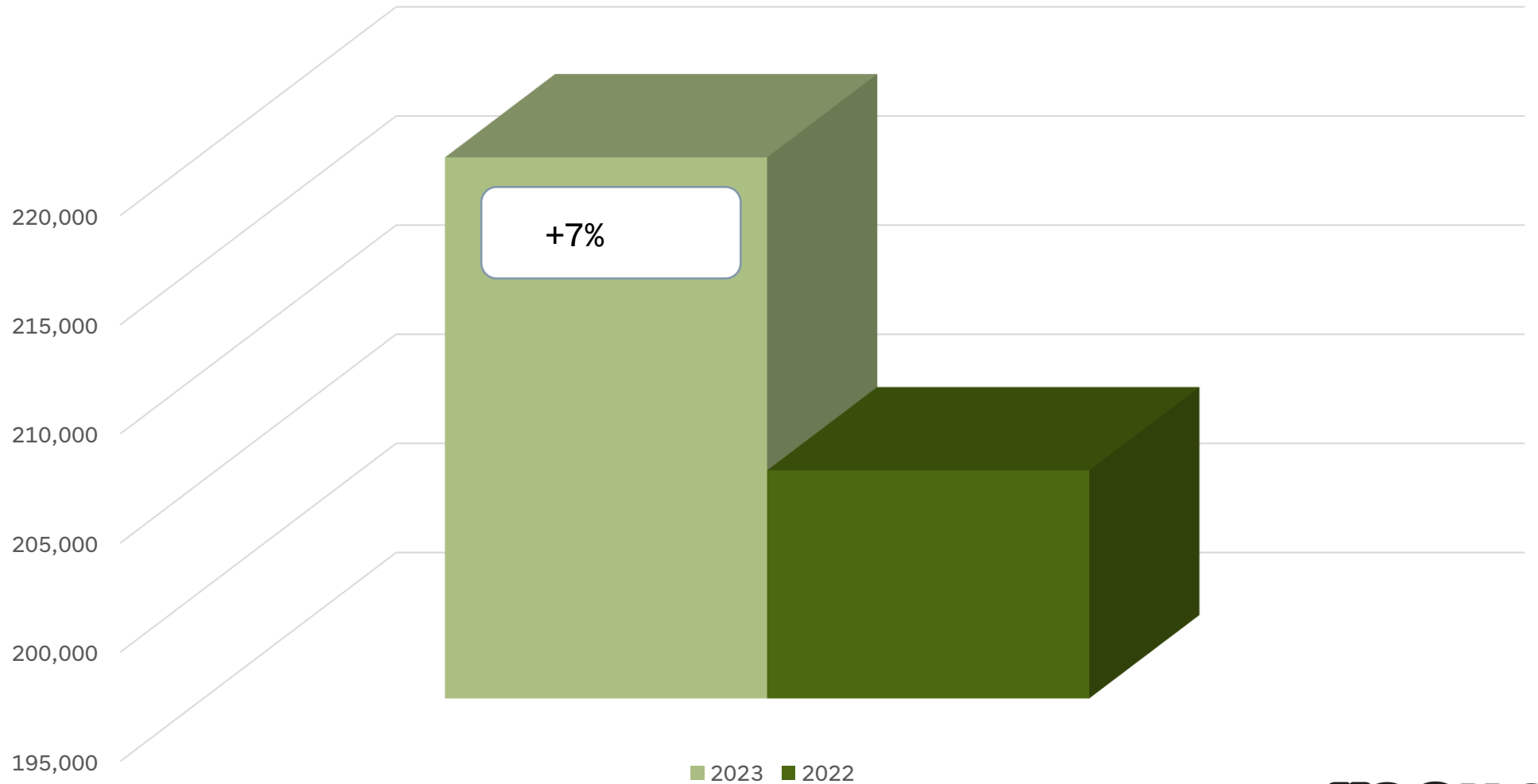

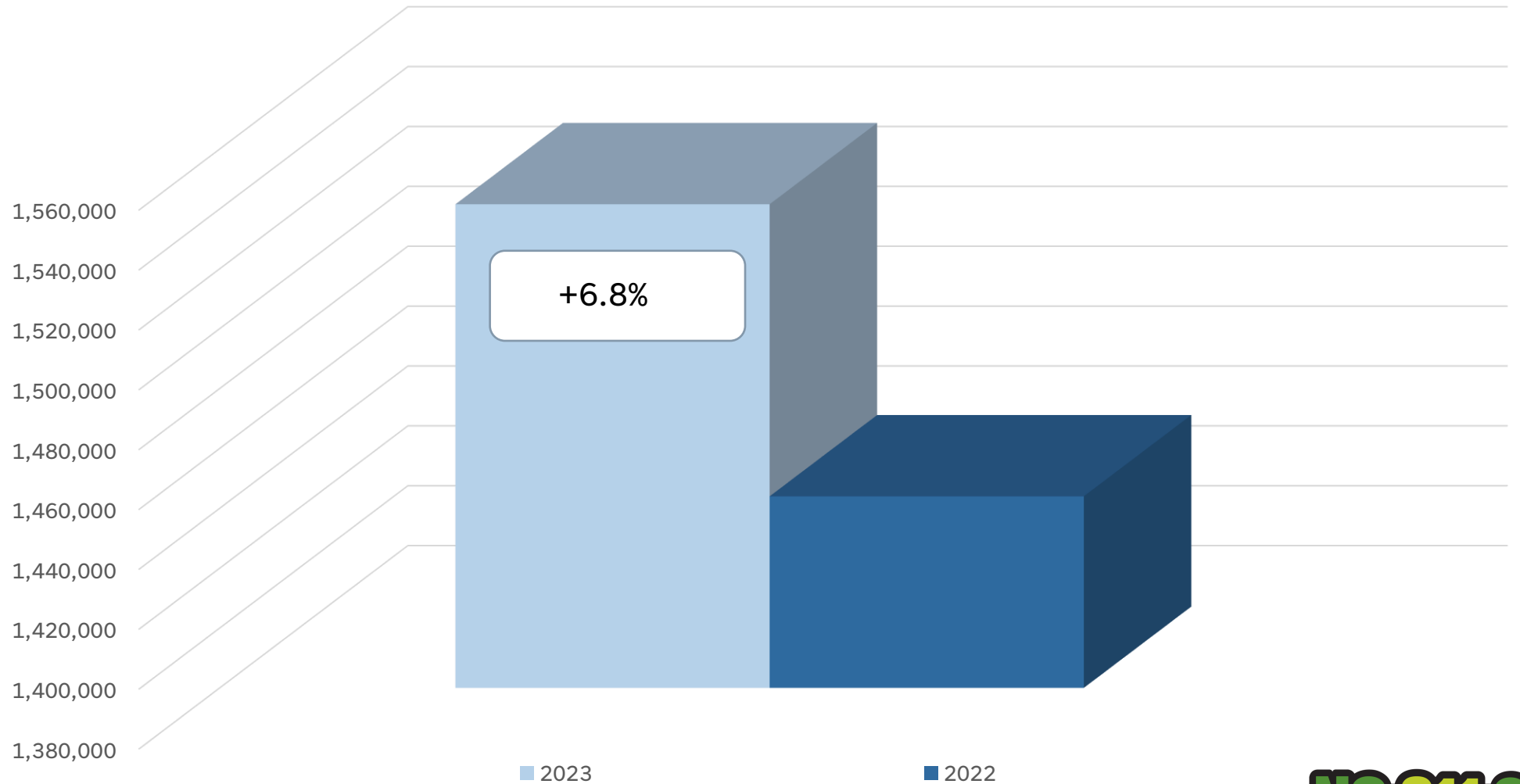
Locate Requests for NC

JULY 2023 vs 2022



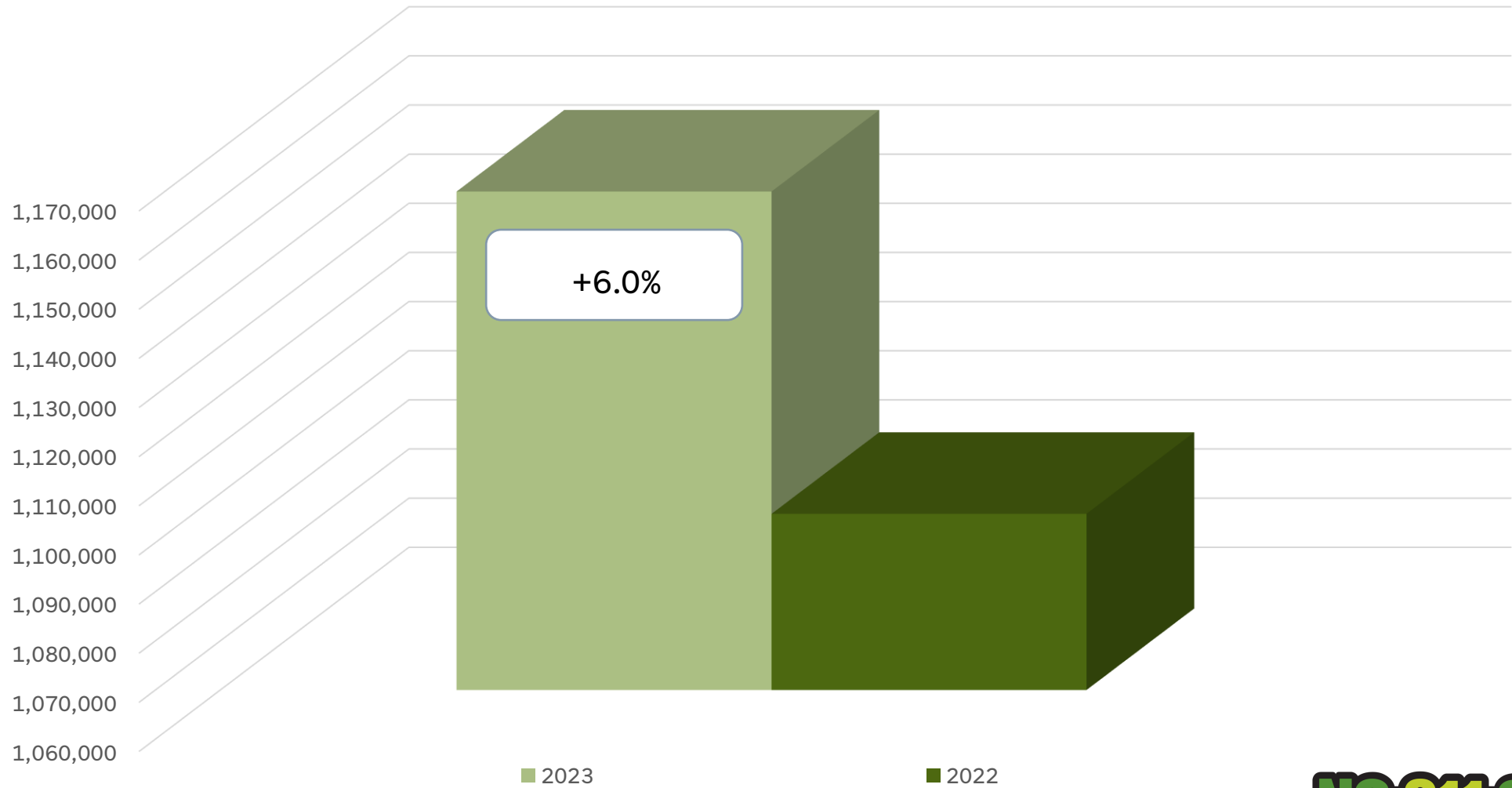

YTD 2023 vs 2022



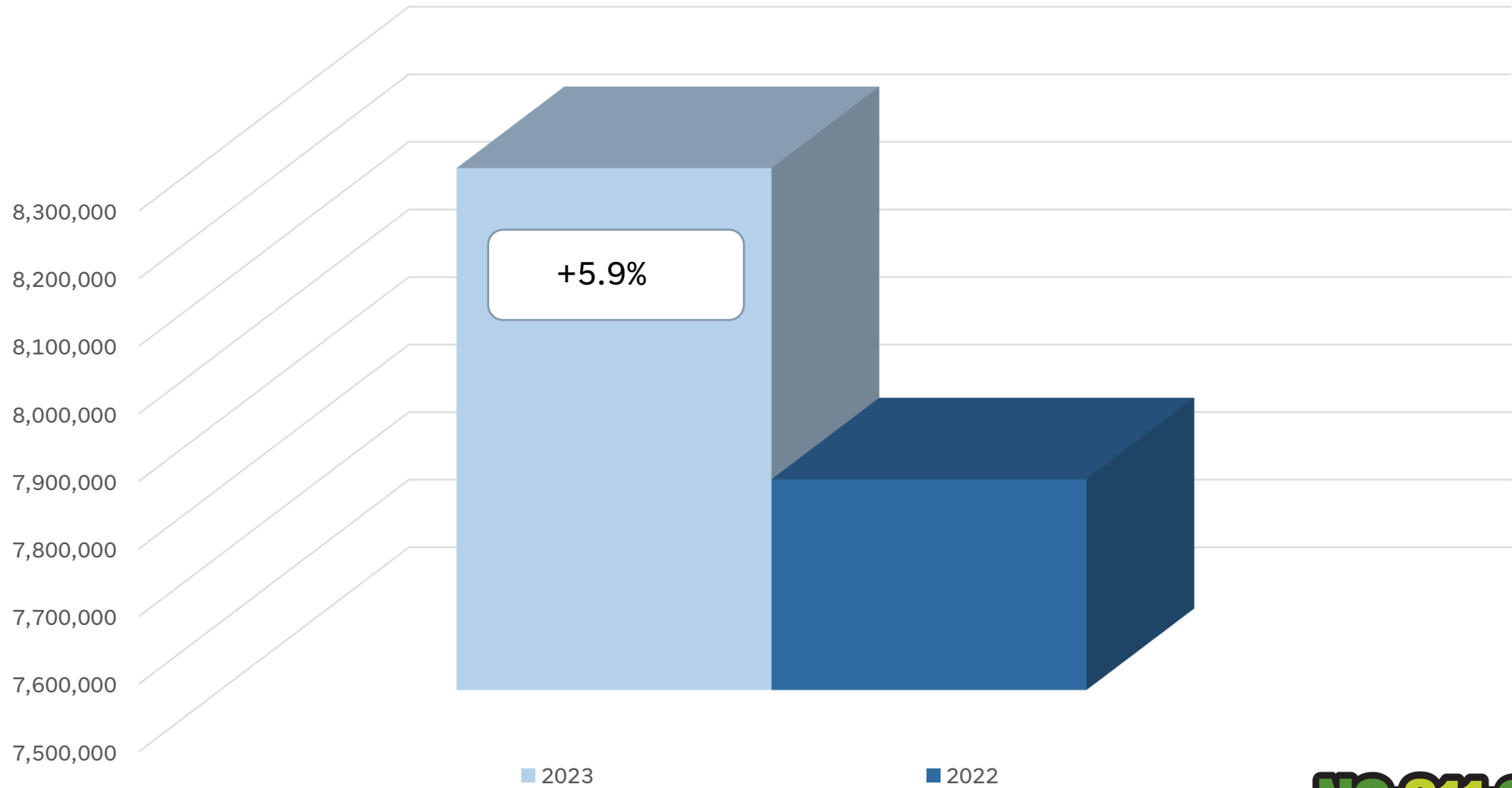
Transmissions for NC

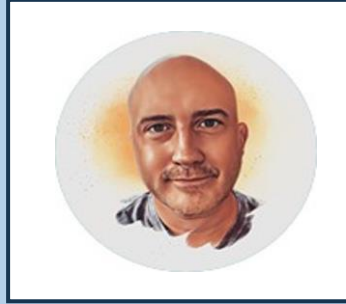

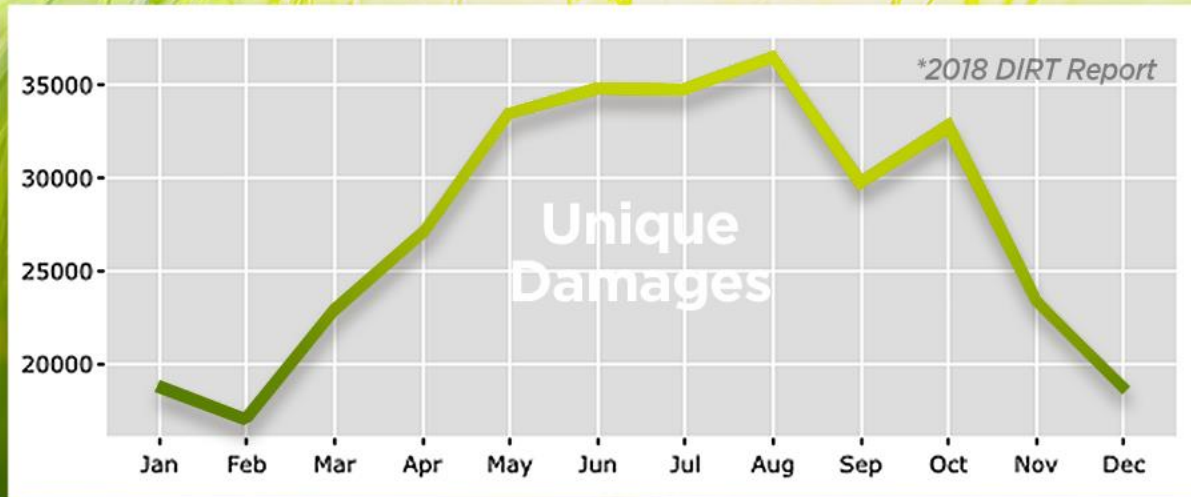
