<u>Beryl Cook – Burke County Water System</u>: Still installing new water taps for folks in our area.


<u>Vermeer All Roads</u>: New to our organization. They are suppliers of varies types of equipment used in construction situations. WELCOME!






AUG 2023 vs 2022







YTD 2023 vs 2022






Transmissions for NC



Damages in North Carolina 2022 vs 2023




