HOT WEATHER TIPS

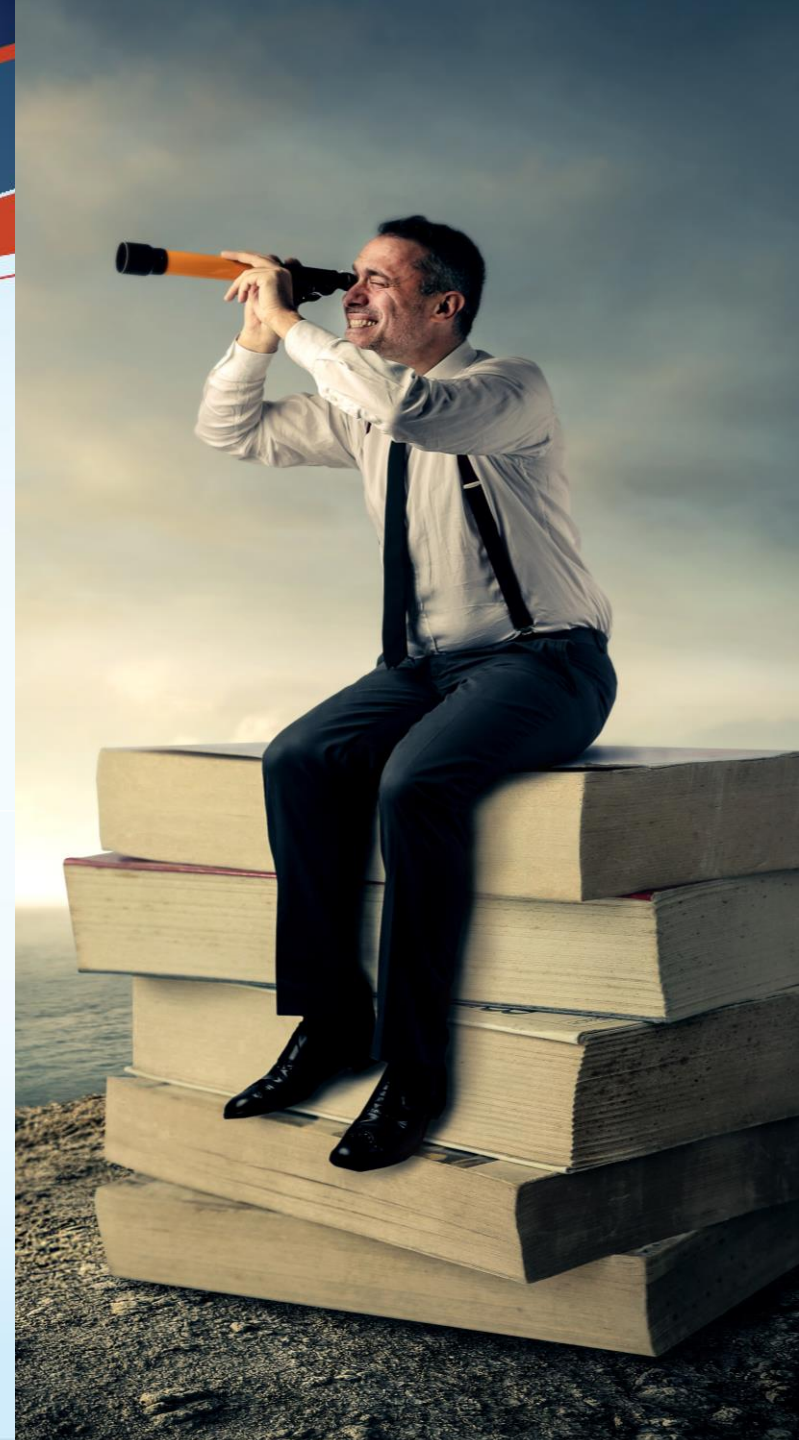
- Alert workers to the heat index anticipated for the day and identify each precaution in place at the work site to reduce the risk of heat-related illness

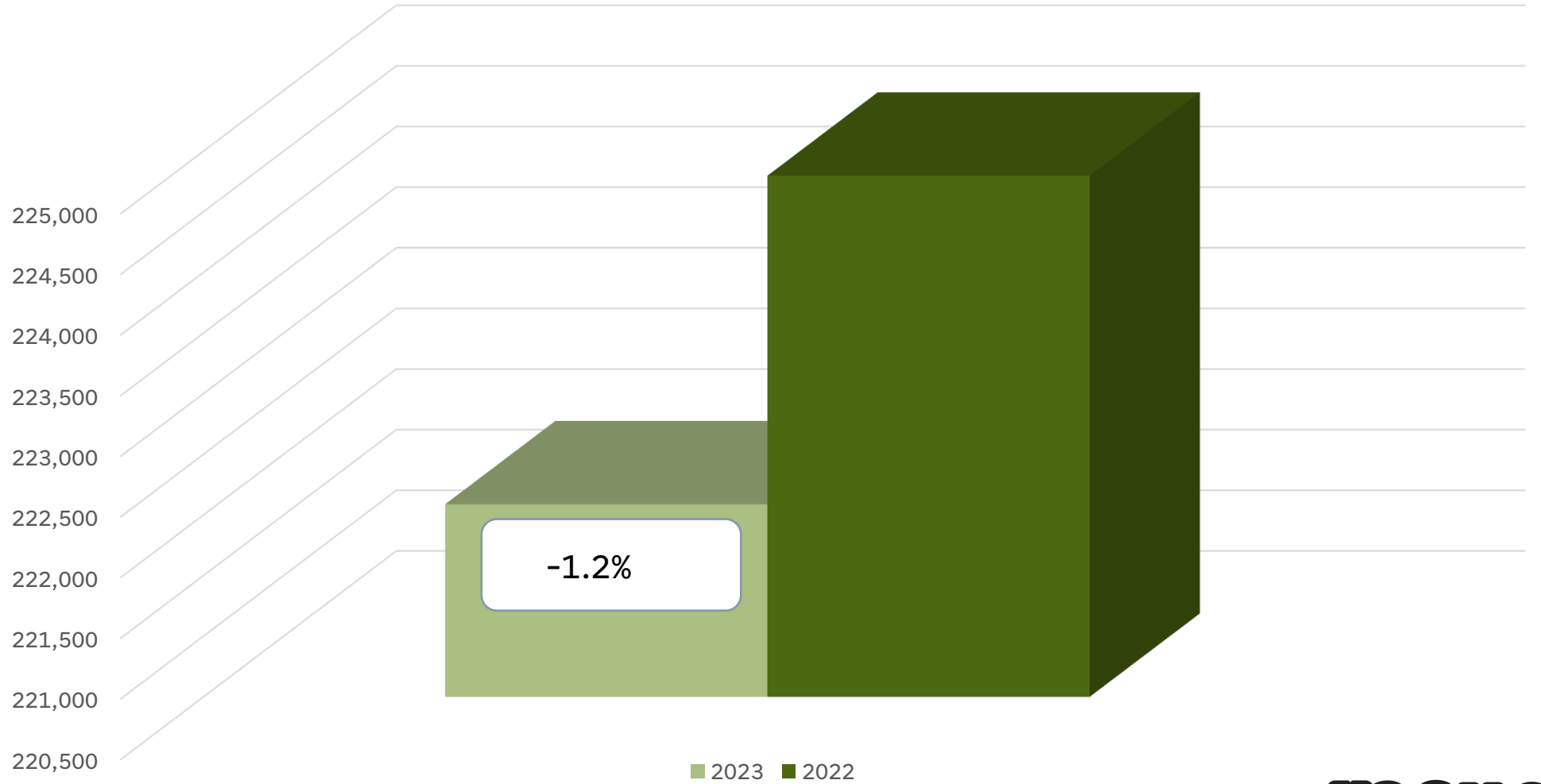

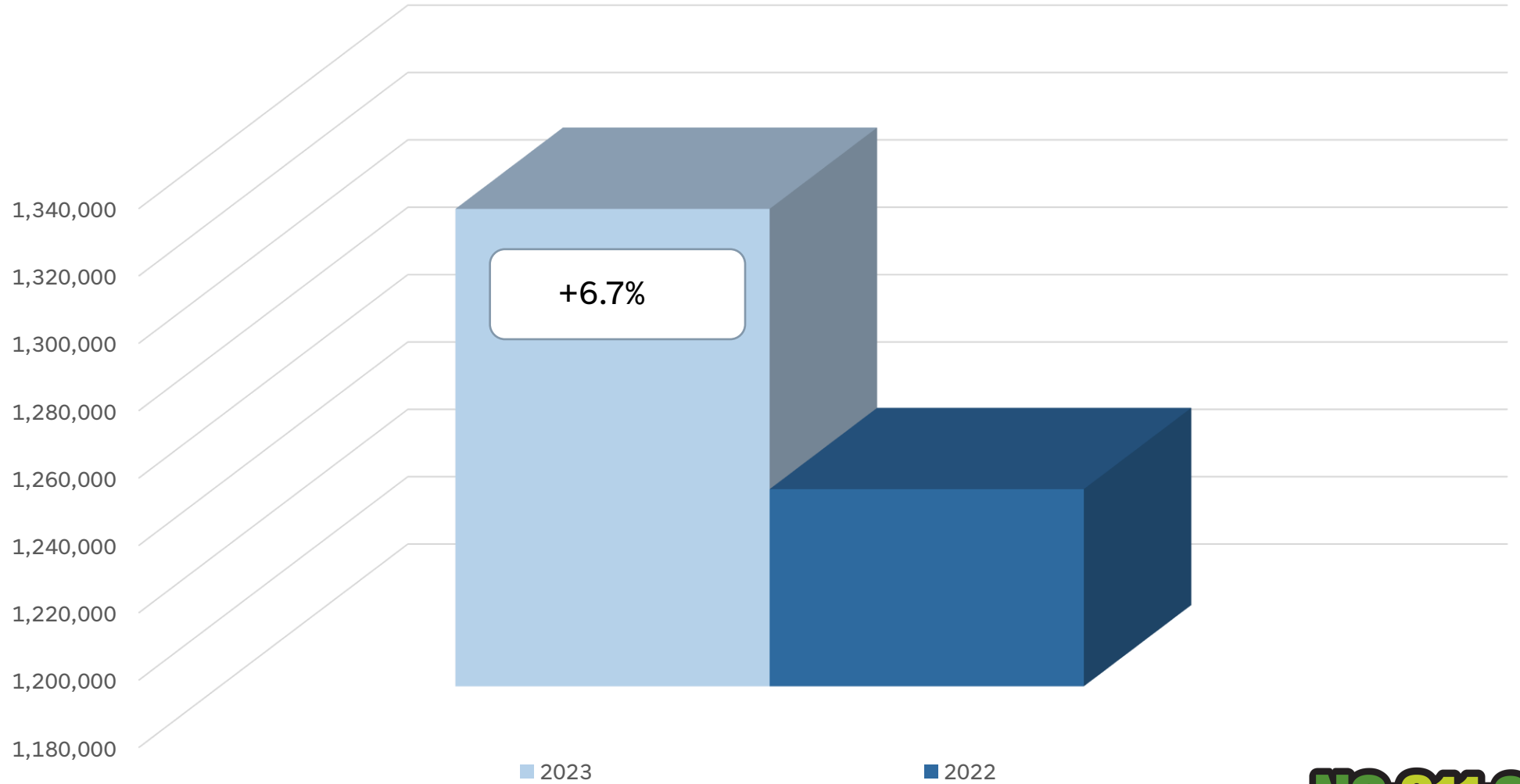
Locate Requests for NC

JUNE 2023 vs 2022



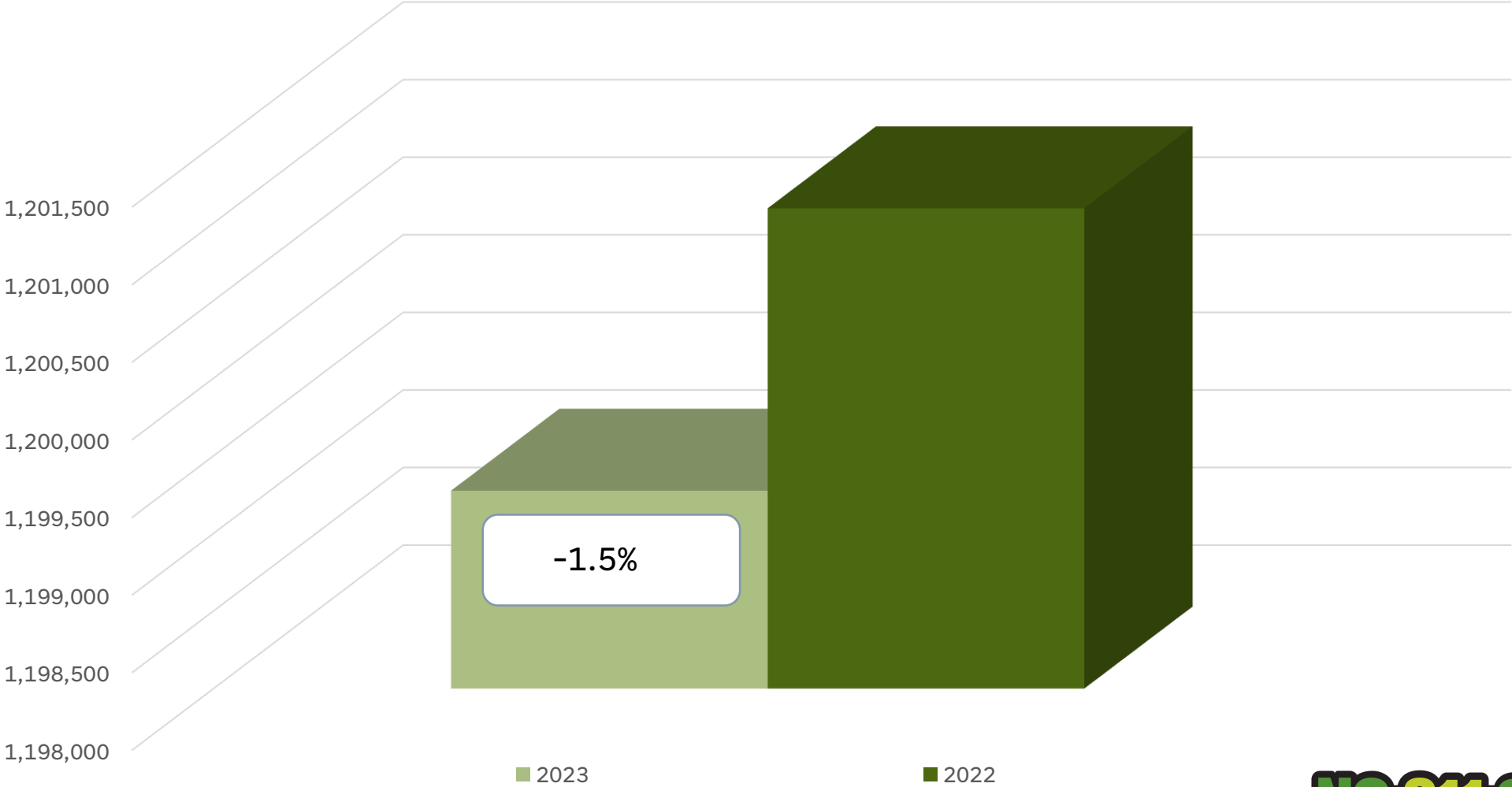
Locate Requests for NC

YTD 2023 vs 2022



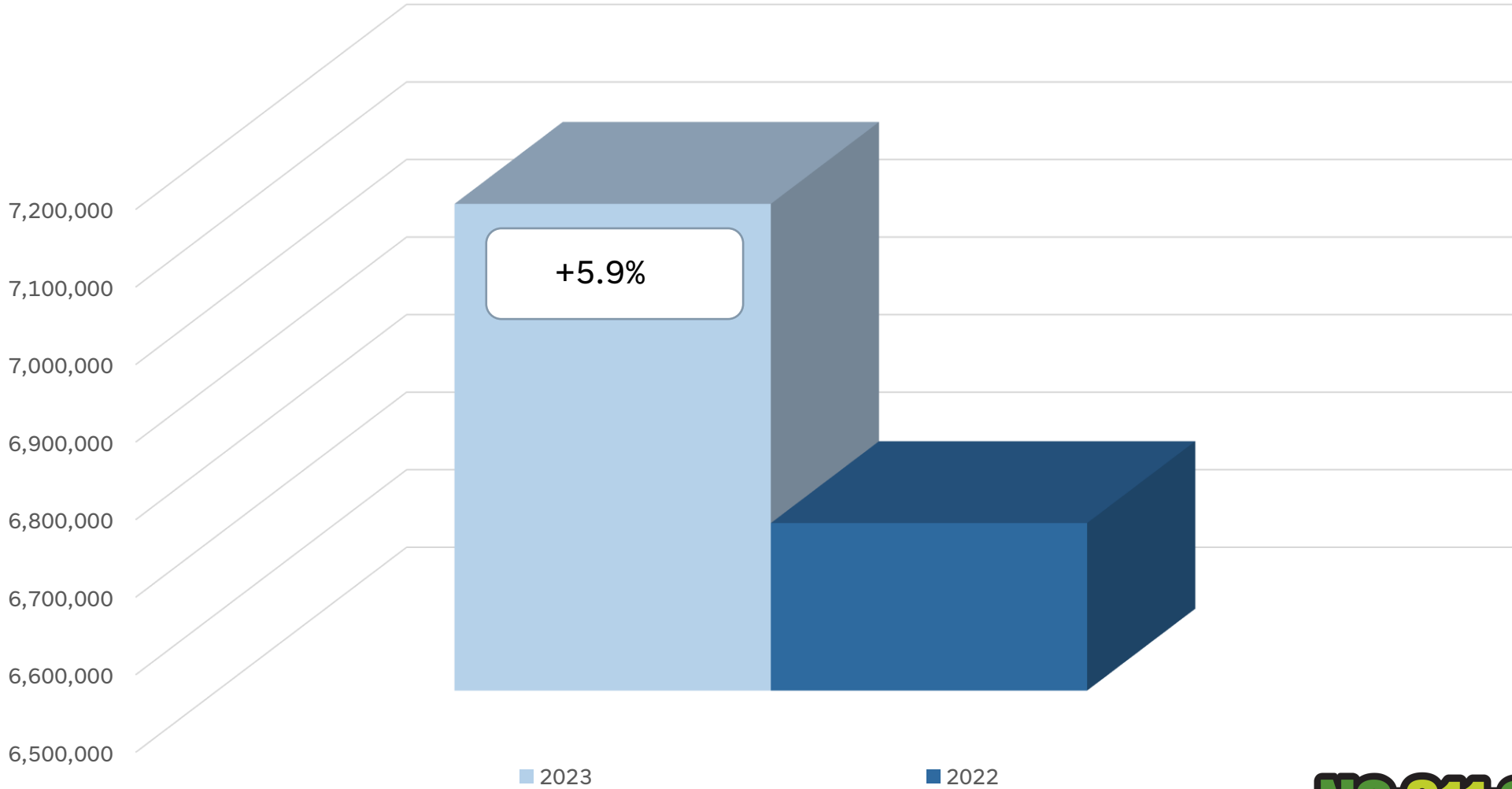
Transmissions for NC

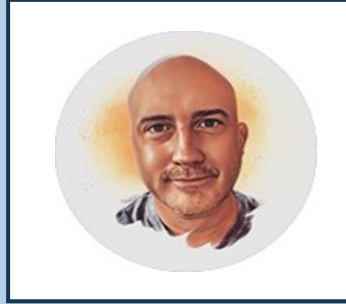
