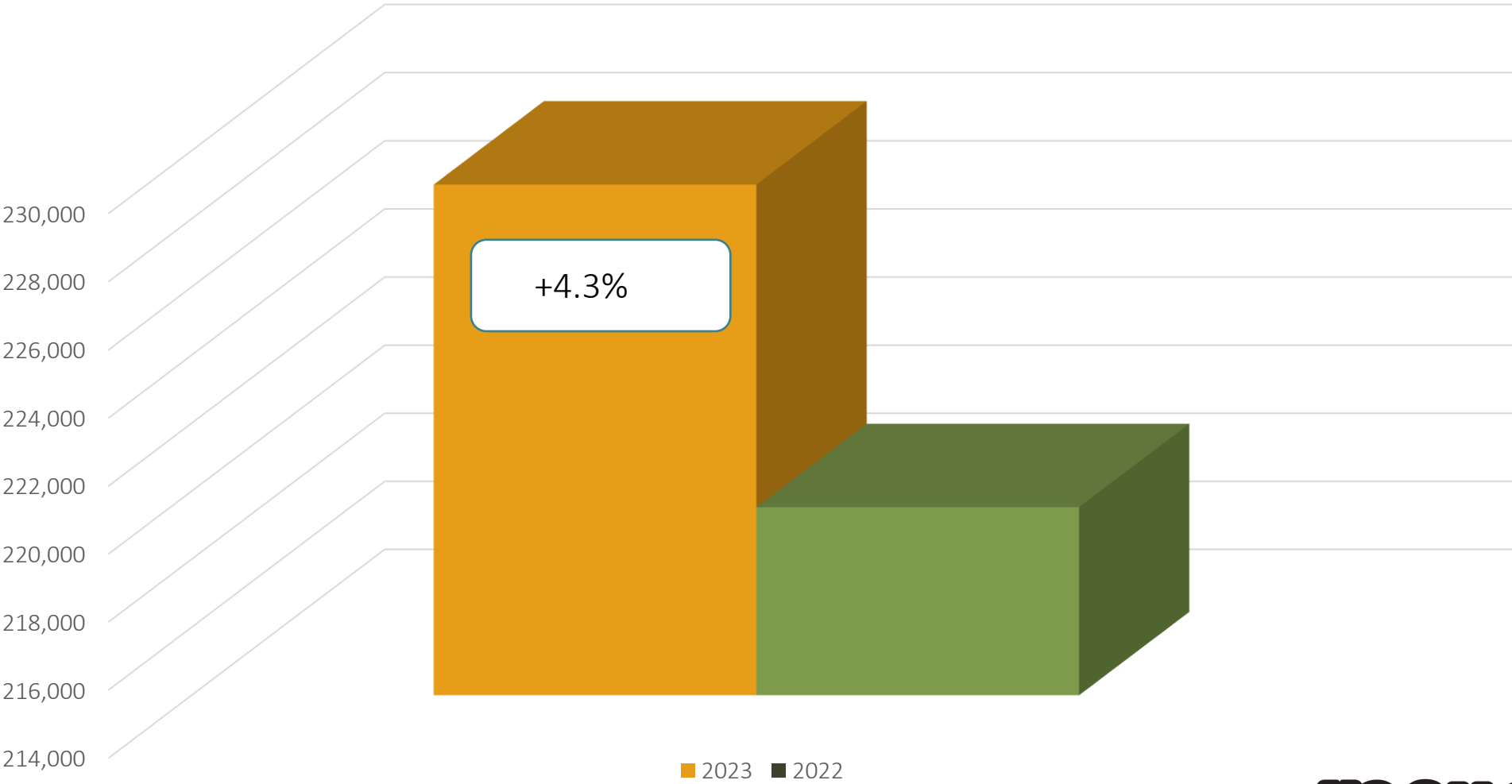

SEPT 2023 vs 2022

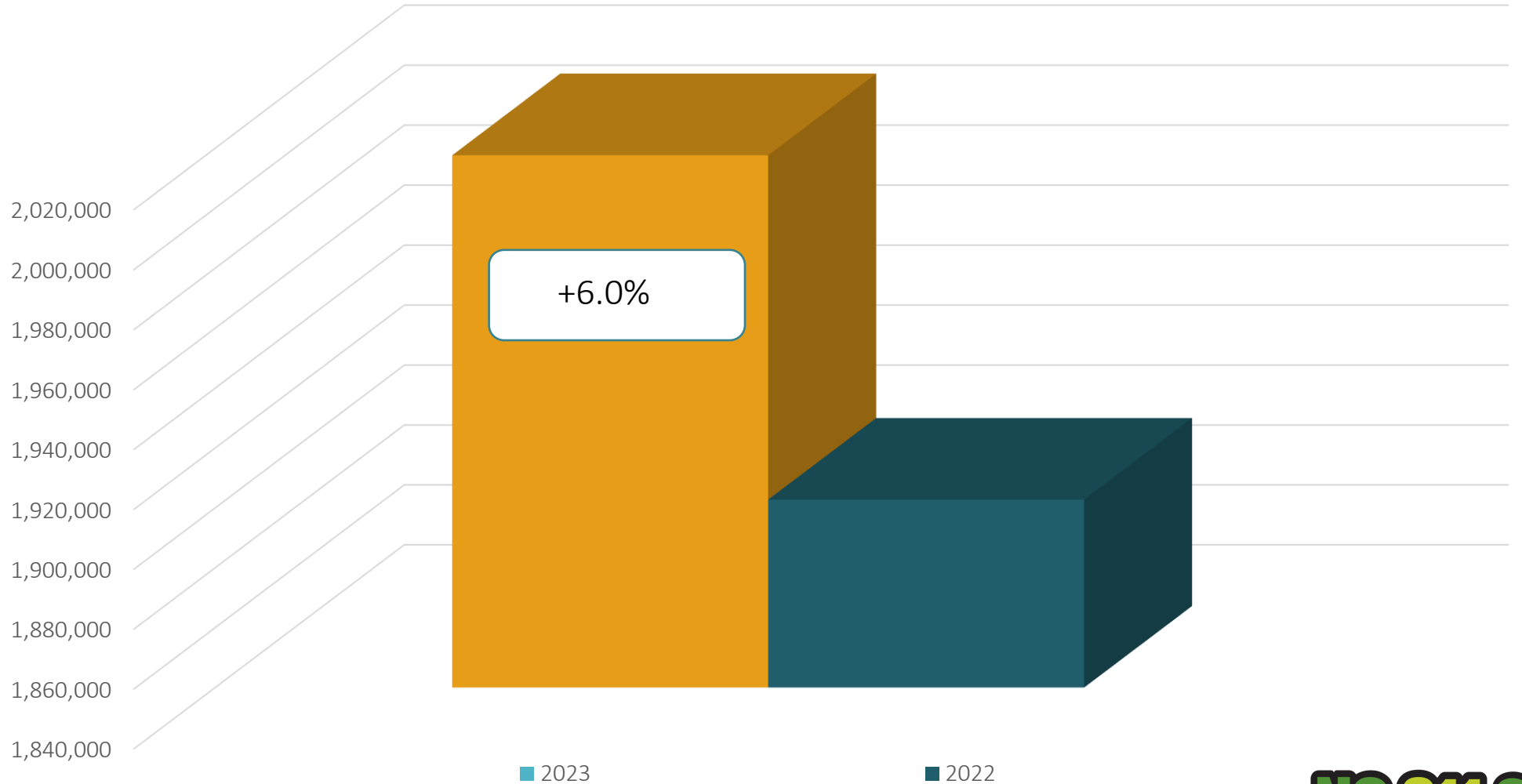


MTD September 2023 – 229,003 / 2022 - 219,532= +4.3%

Updates for Sept 2023 – (66,923) = 29.2% of volume / August 30.% = -.8% (Decrease the month before)



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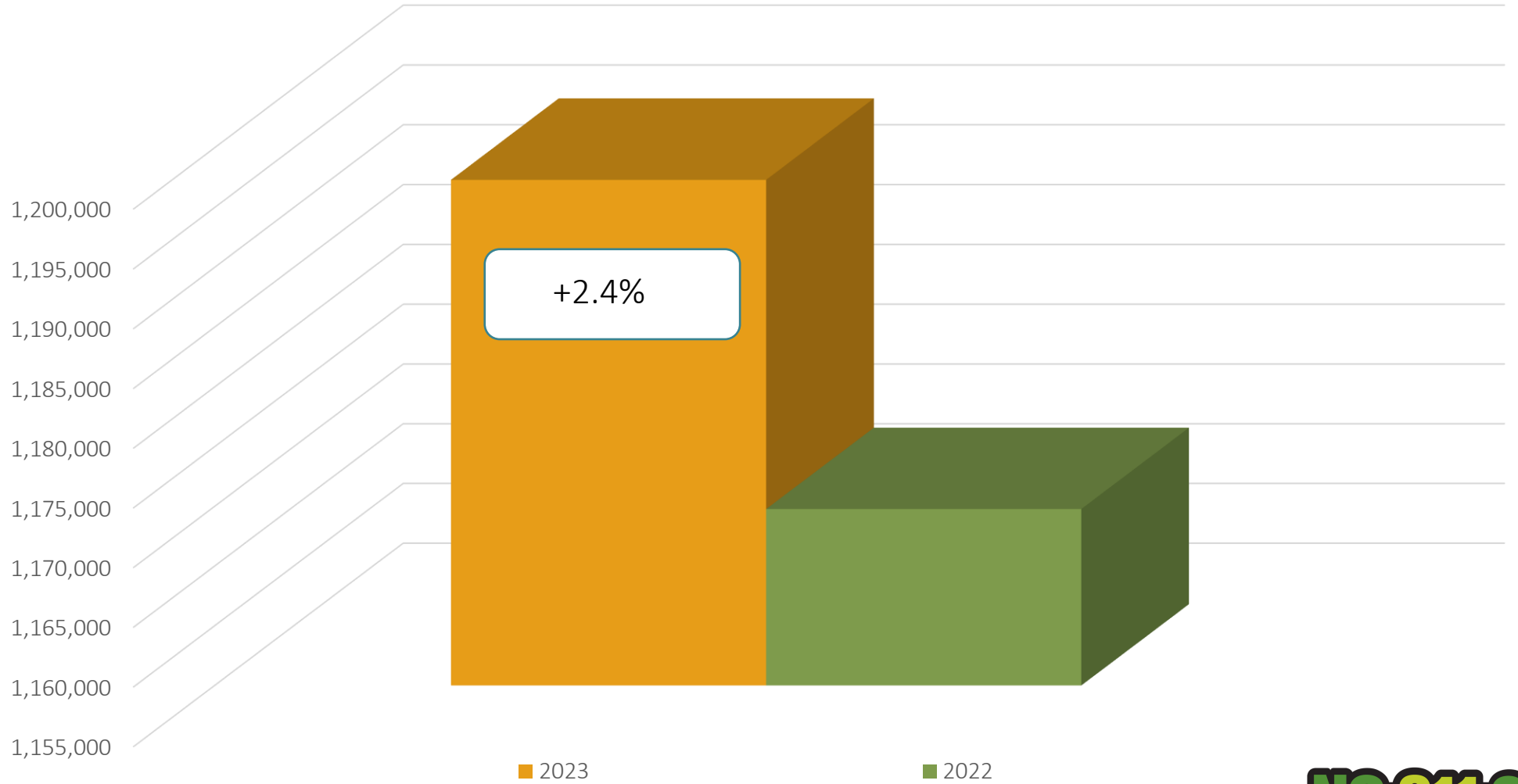
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Transmissions for NC

SEPT 2023 vs 2022

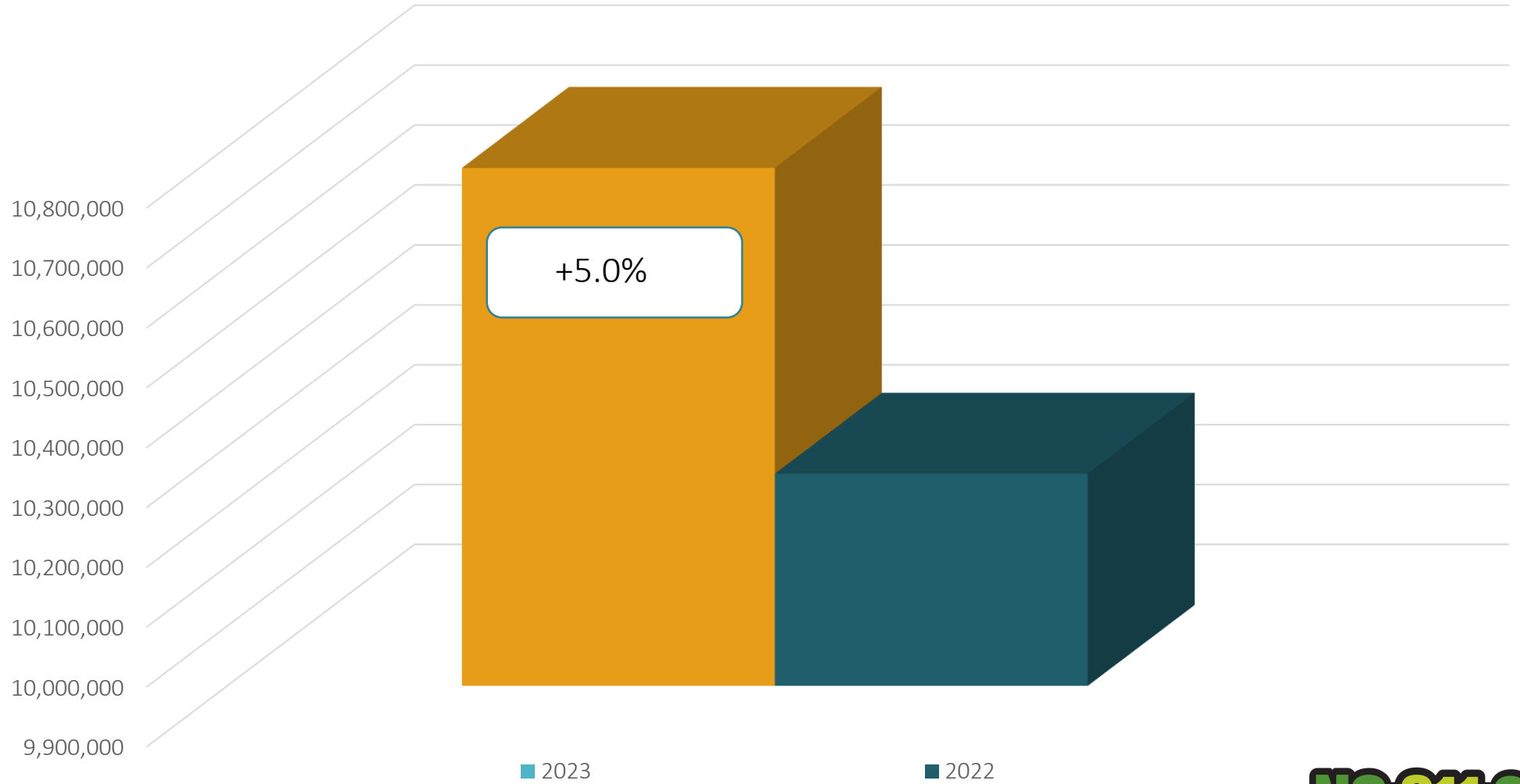


Transmissions MTD 2023 – 1,197,317 / 2022 – 1,169,779 = +2.4%

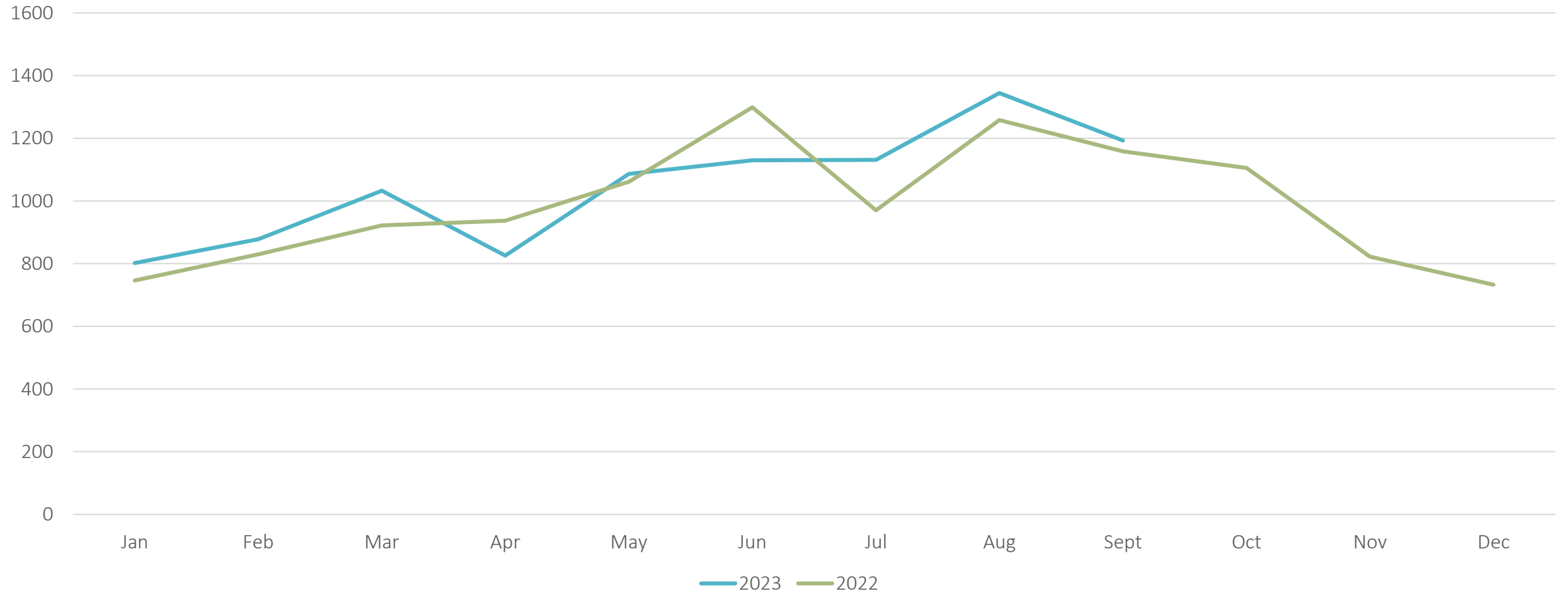

Leo spoke about the benefits of attending local UCC meetings. Meeting utility operators, excavators, and locators. Names and numbers of people who might be able to assist.

USIC – Please be sure to include USIC in pre-construction meetings. That will help them to make sure they have enough staffing to assist with additional marking. Busy doing a lot a marking for pole replacements for Duke Energy. Multiple jobs at one time on sites. Be sure to specify what you need done and where. If you do not need the entire property, be sure to narrow down your area. That allows utility to get the marking done more quickly. Inefficiencies all across the board.

Please be sure to include point of contact on locate requests and make it the person in the field who knows about the project. Don't call in what you don't need or can't work.

City of Concord – Business as usual. No new projects at this time.

Chris McCandless – getting some additional calls about “private” property not being marked. Some of what is called in as private would actually be marked by utility operators.

Google – They will be sure to white line or inform subcontractors about white lining. Scope always helps when marking.
