# HOT WEATHER TIPS


- Alert workers to the heat index anticipated for the day and identify each precaution in place at the work site to reduce the risk of heat-related illness




# Locate Requests for NC

## JUNE 2023 vs 2022





## YTD 2023 vs 2022




