

SEPT 2023 vs 2022




MTD September 2023 – 229,003 / 2022 - 219,532= +4.3%

Updates for Sept 2023 – (66,923) = 29.2% of volume / August 30.% = -.8% (Decrease the month before)



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

SEPT 2023 vs 2022




Transmissions MTD 2023 – 1,213,716 / 2022 – 1,169,779 = +3.8%

UPDATE YOUR LOCATE


Update Lite allows excavators to update a locate request.
