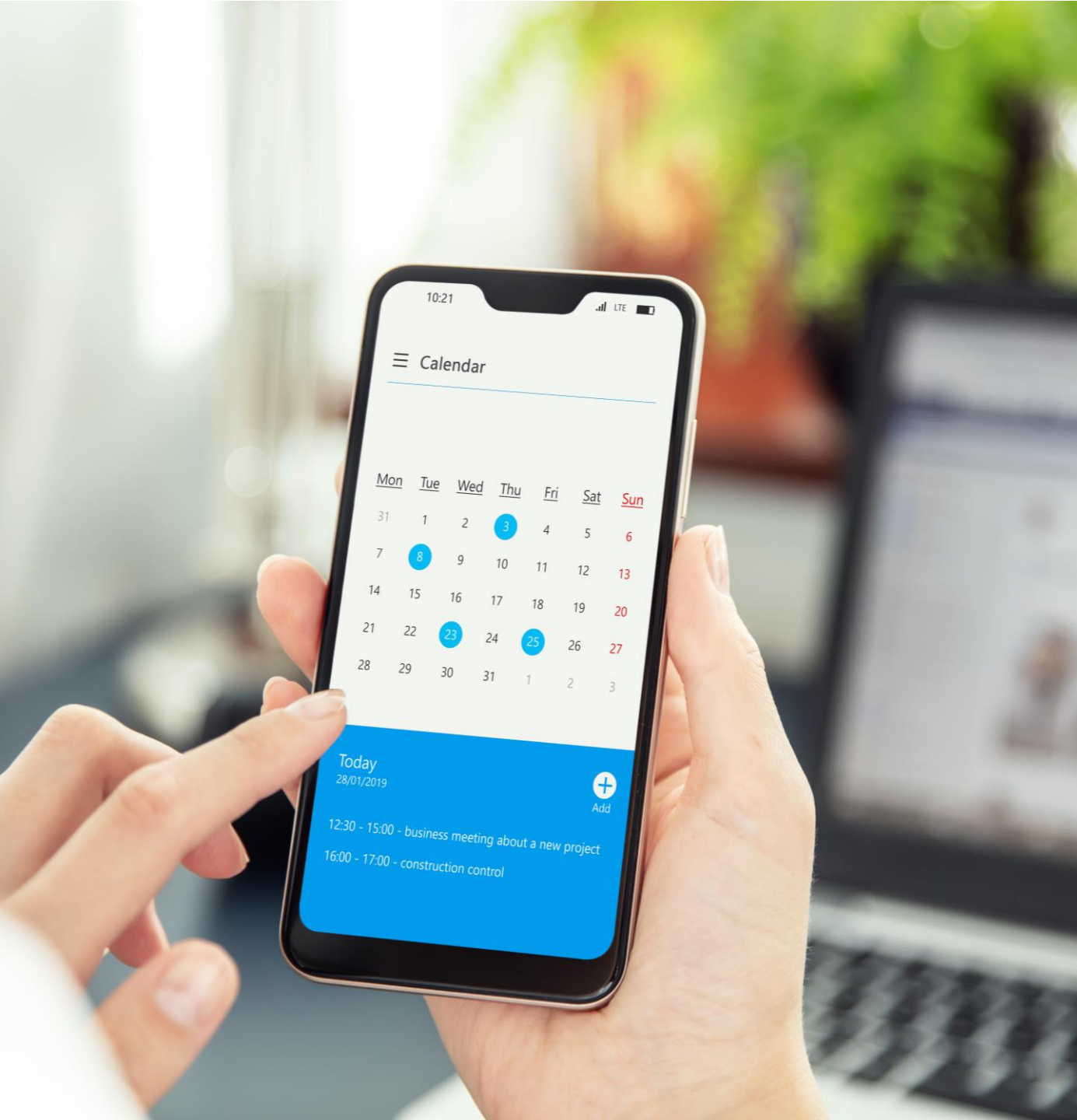

TIP OF THE MONTH

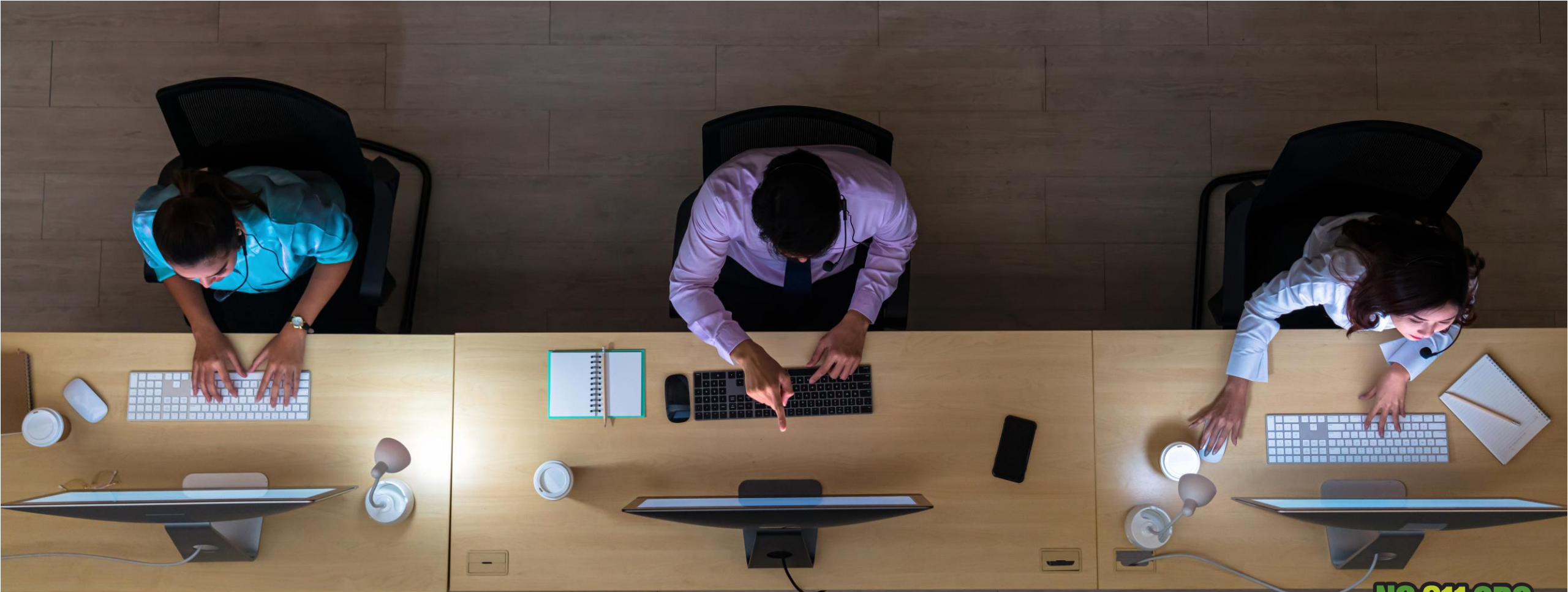
A ticket number does not equal a valid ticket!
