






Locate Requests for NC February 2024 vs 2023




Locate Requests for NC YTD 2024






Transmissions for NC



- Locates for February '24 was +8.0% higher (226,572) than February '23, (208,813). YTD Locates.
- <u>Transmissions</u> for February '24 was +6.2% higher (1,229,200) than February '23, (1,157,238). YTD Locates.
- Burke County: Had a total of 934 tickets for the month, Morganton and Valdese having the most.
- <u>Caldwell County:</u> Had a total of 817 tickets for the month, Granite Falls and Lenoir having the most.
- <u>Damage Reported for February 2024</u>: Burke County <u>3</u>; Caldwell County <u>4</u>; Grand Total: <u>1,117</u>. Mecklenburg <u>160</u> & Wake <u>152</u> Counites has the highest number of damages.
