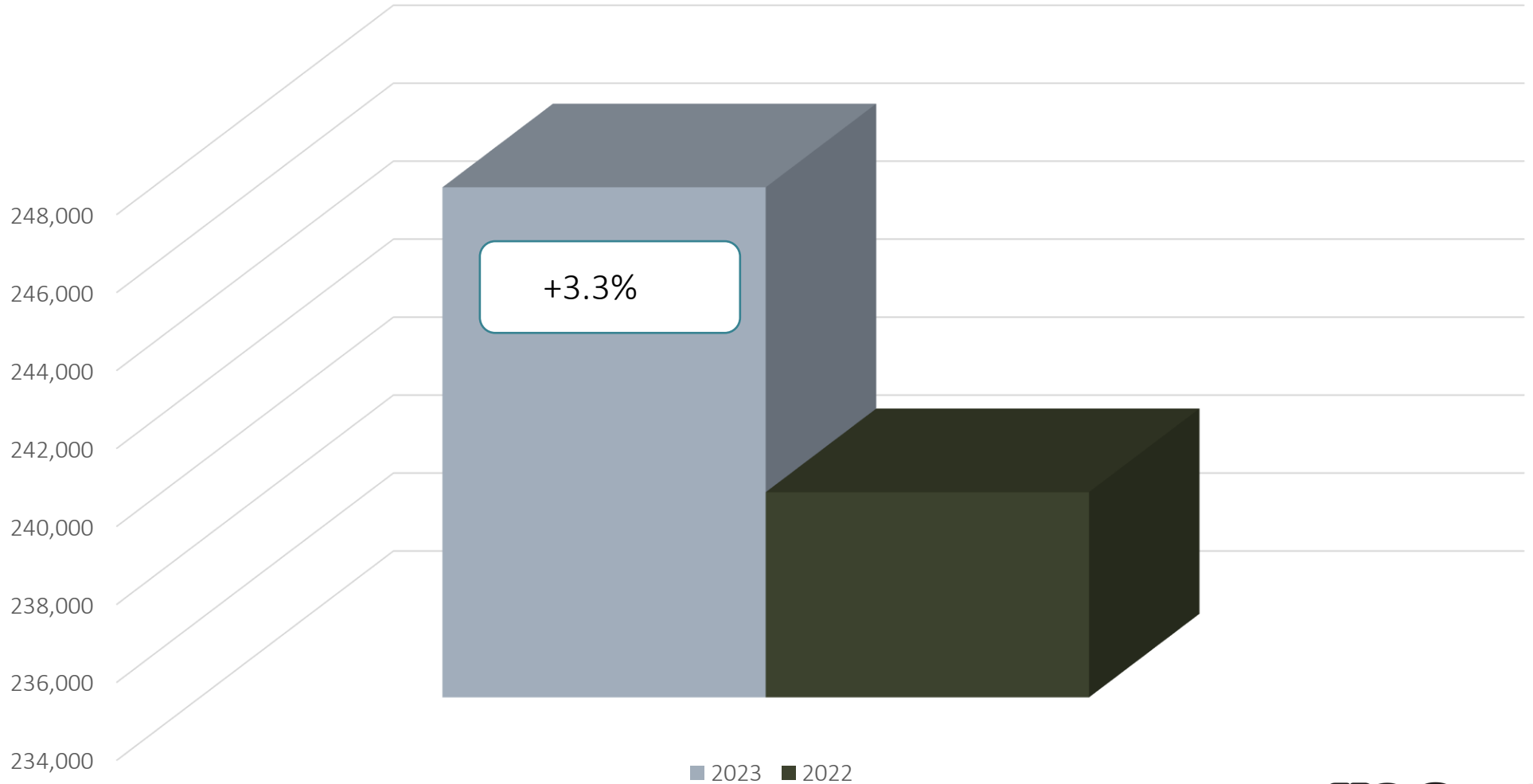

MTD August 2023 – 247,083 / 2022 – 239,263 = +3.3%

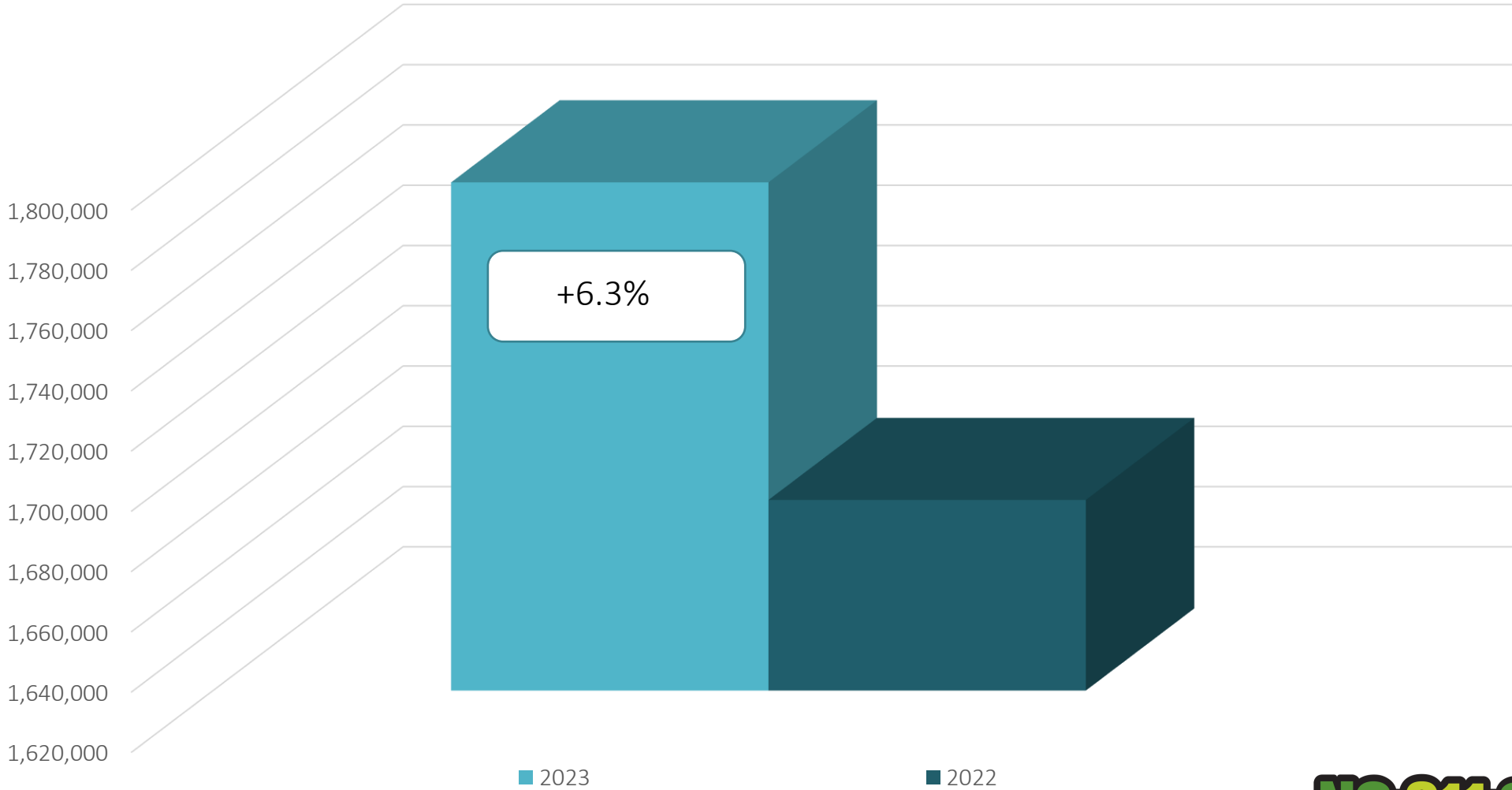
YTD 2023 – 1,788,620 / 2022 – 1,683,240 = +6.3 %

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YTD 2023 vs 2022

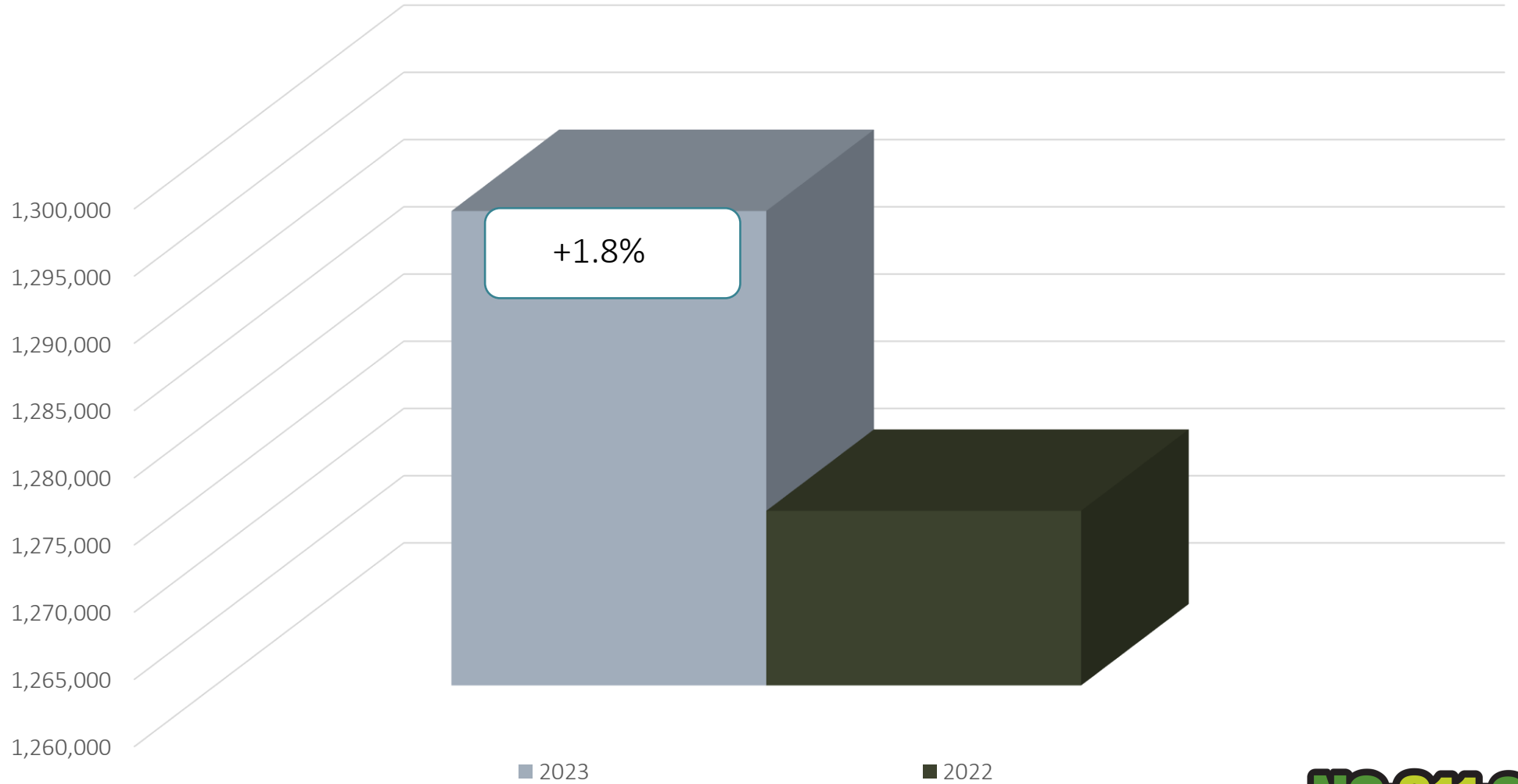


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Transmissions for NC

AUG 2023 vs 2022

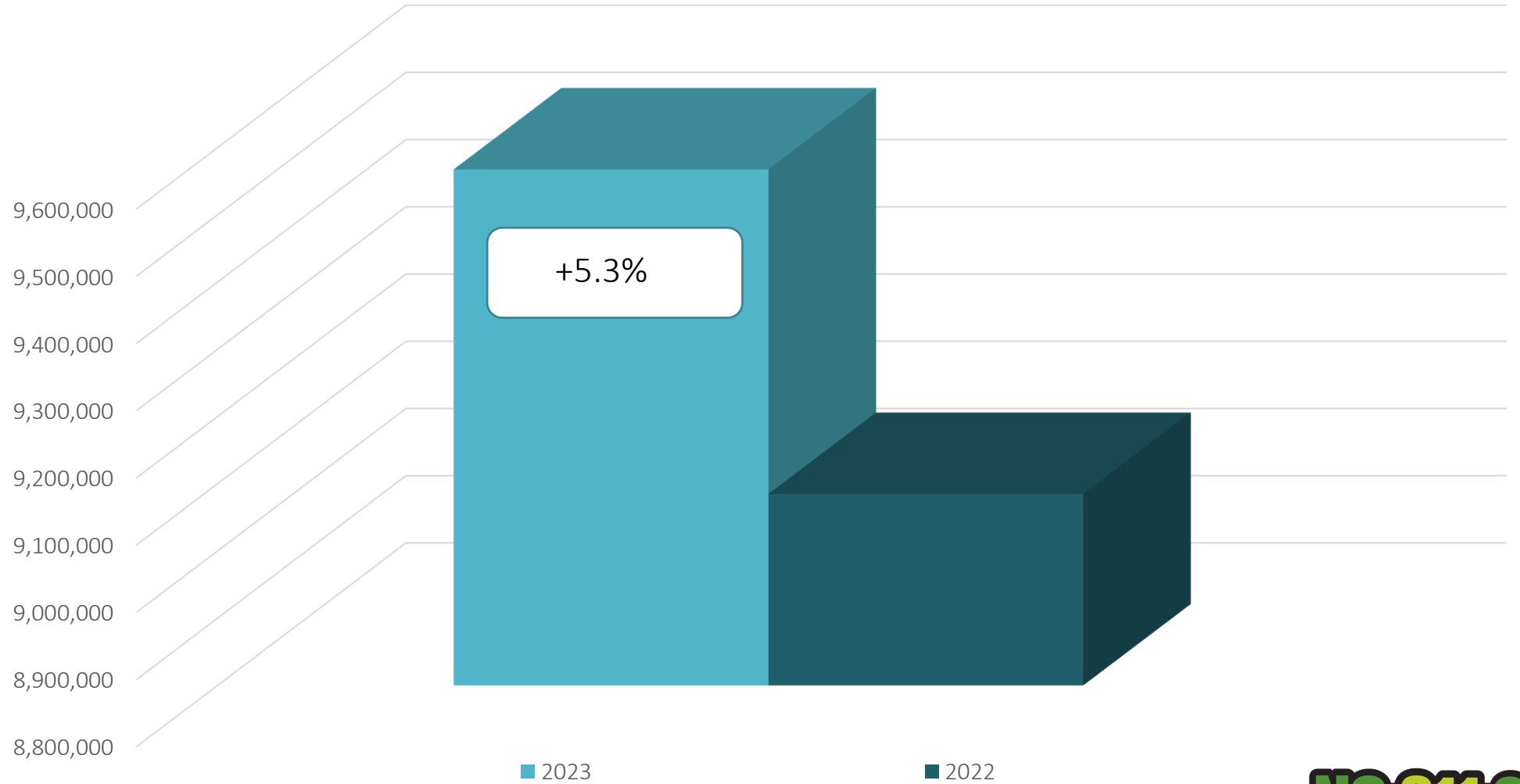


Transmissions MTD 2023 – 1,295,285 / 2022 – 1,272,985 = +1.8%

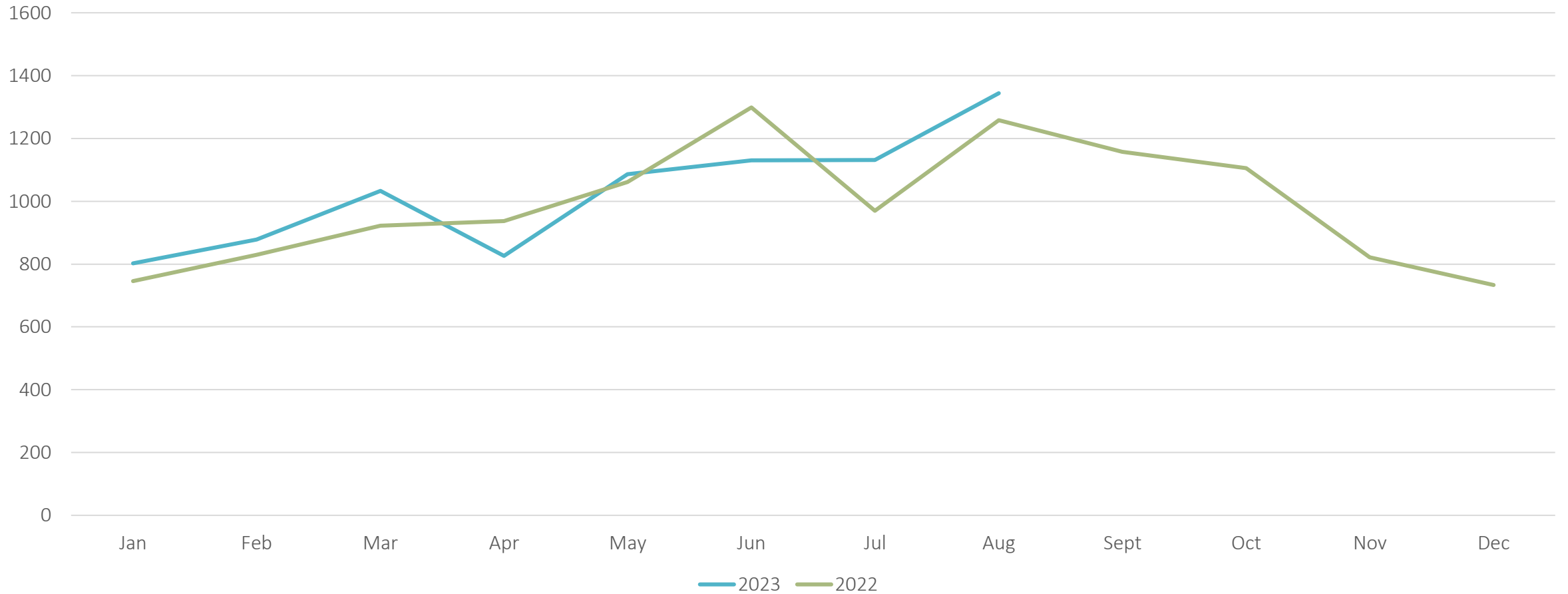

V. July Narrative

- Tami Stout, NC811- Provided information on locate ticket increases in Davidson County and across the state. Locate ticket submittals are up 6.3% across the state year to date.

- Joint NC/SC UCC will be held on April 30th – May 3rd, 2024 in Charleston, SC

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VI. New Business

- Caleb Freidenbach asked about Pipe Plus Training (Onsite if possible). Tami said she would be happy to provide the training in person. The training last approximately 2.5 hours in person and a test will be at the end.

VII. Round Table Reports

- **NCDOT** – Turning Lane installation project getting ready to start at Nucor on E US Hwy 64
- **Surry Telephone** – Contractors for Surry Telephone will begin installation of new main line via open trench and HDD in the areas of Odell Owen Rd / W Old Hwy 64 and Happy Hill Road/ Rowe Rd areas.
- **Piedmont Natural Gas** – They will begin soon installing new gas main along S Union Grove Rd for a new 400 home subdivision.
- **Davidson County Sewer** – Will be starting a sewer project in the near future from I85 @ 64 E; heading E on Hwy 64 toward Thomasville.
- **Lexington Sewer/ Water** – Normal; business as usual.
- **Lexington Stormwater** – Storm drain replacement along Chestnut St; also at W 3rd St @ N State St.
- **Lexington Natural Gas** – New main installation along W 2nd St (between N State St and Salem St – Work will take place at night due to traffic.
-New Gas main installation along Roy Lopp Rd (Popeye Ln to 966 Roy Lopp Rd)
