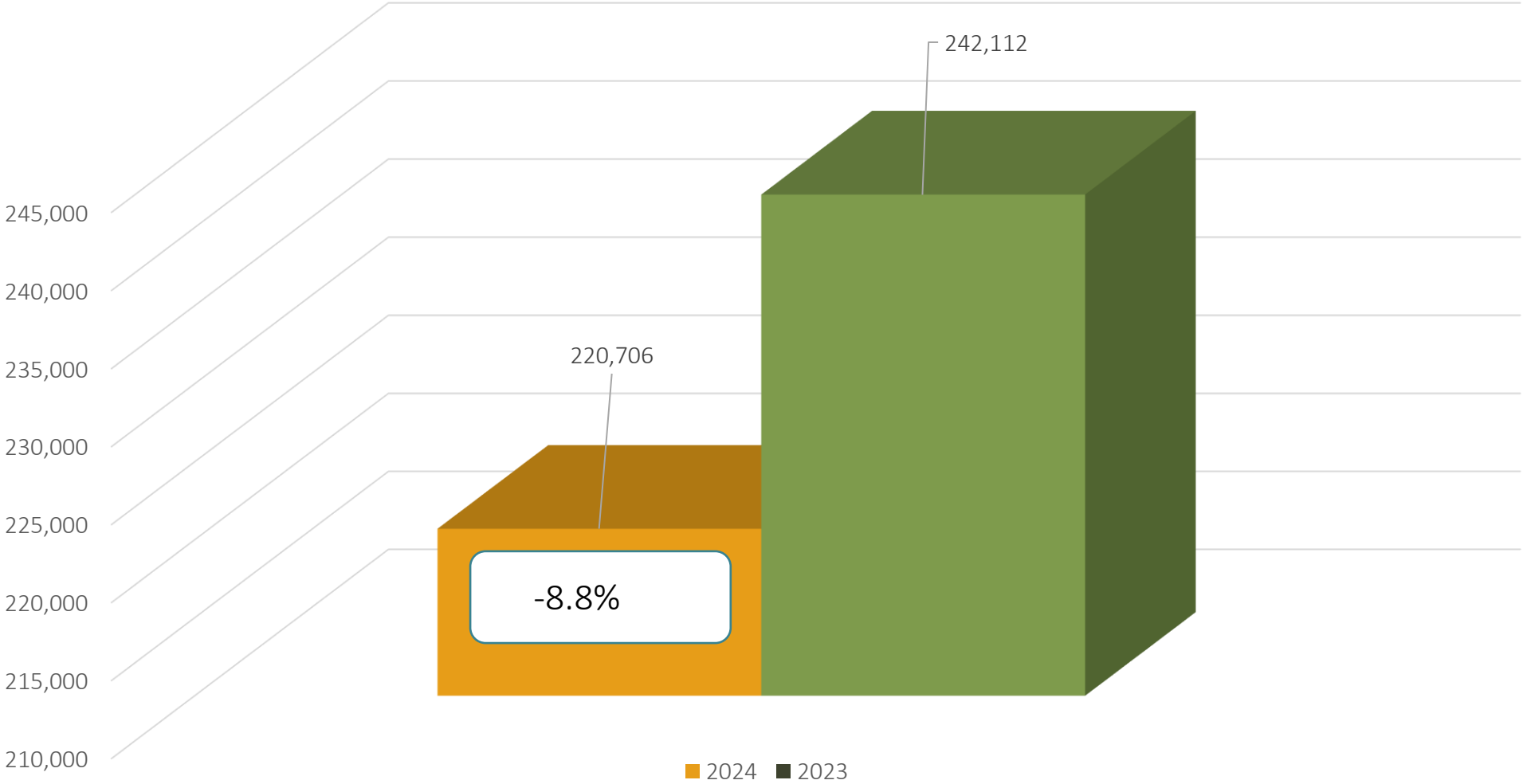

March 2024 vs 2023

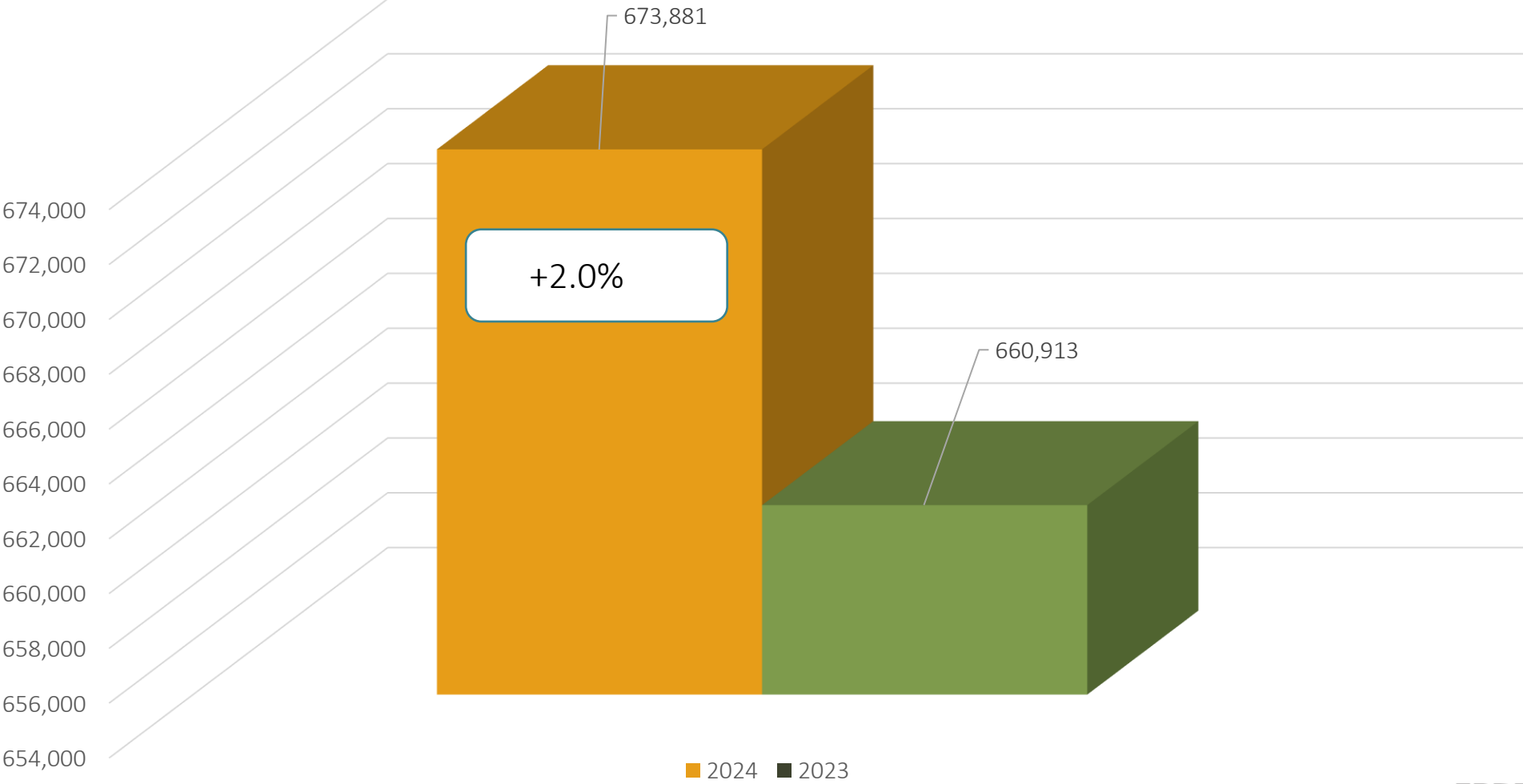


MTD March 2024 – 220,706 / 2023 – 242,112 = (-8.8%)
YTD 2024 – 673,881 / 2023 – 660,913 = +2.0 %
Updates for March 2024 – (67,301) = 30.5% of volume / February 30.4% = -.1% (Decrease the month before)

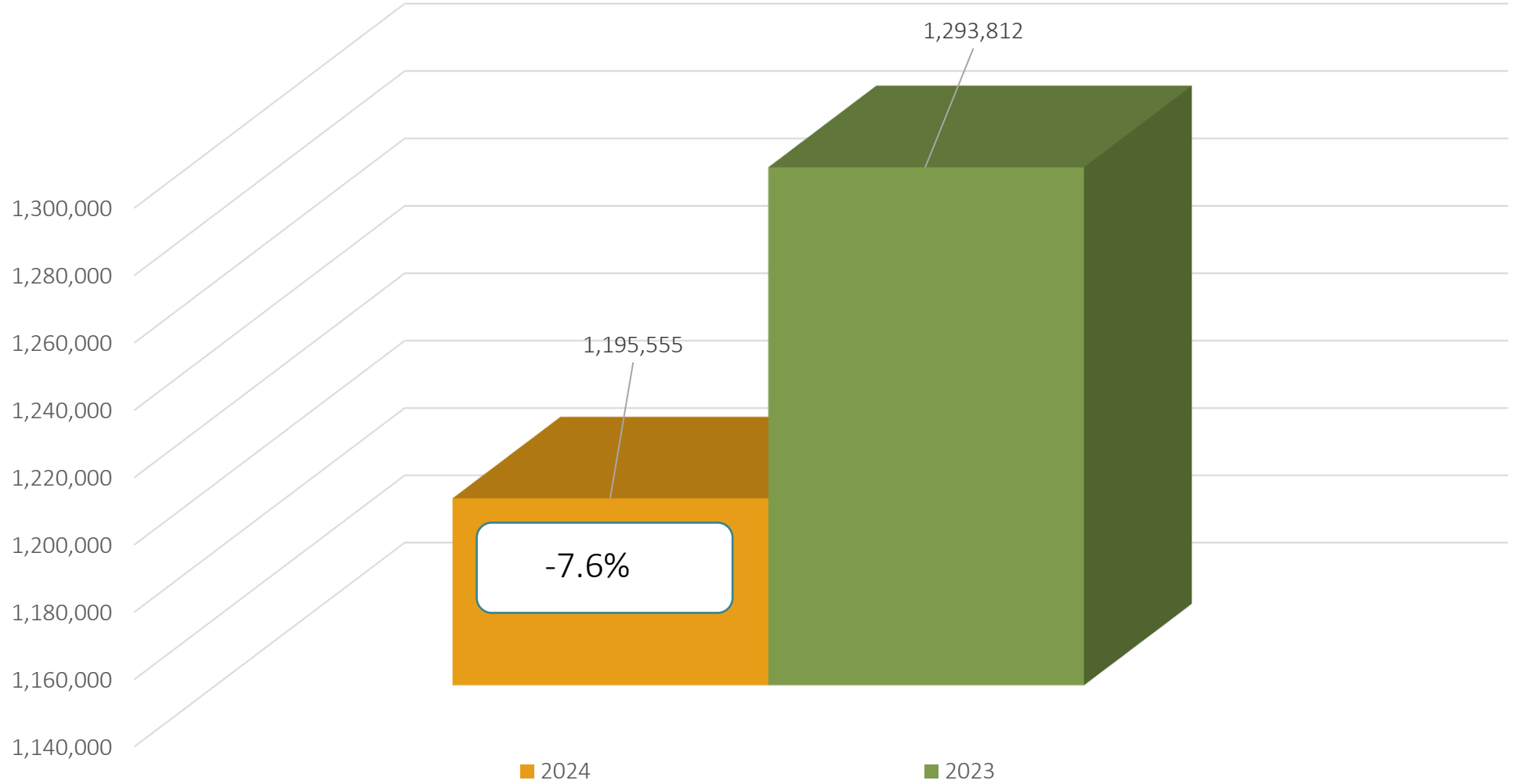


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Transmissions for NC

March 2024 vs 2023

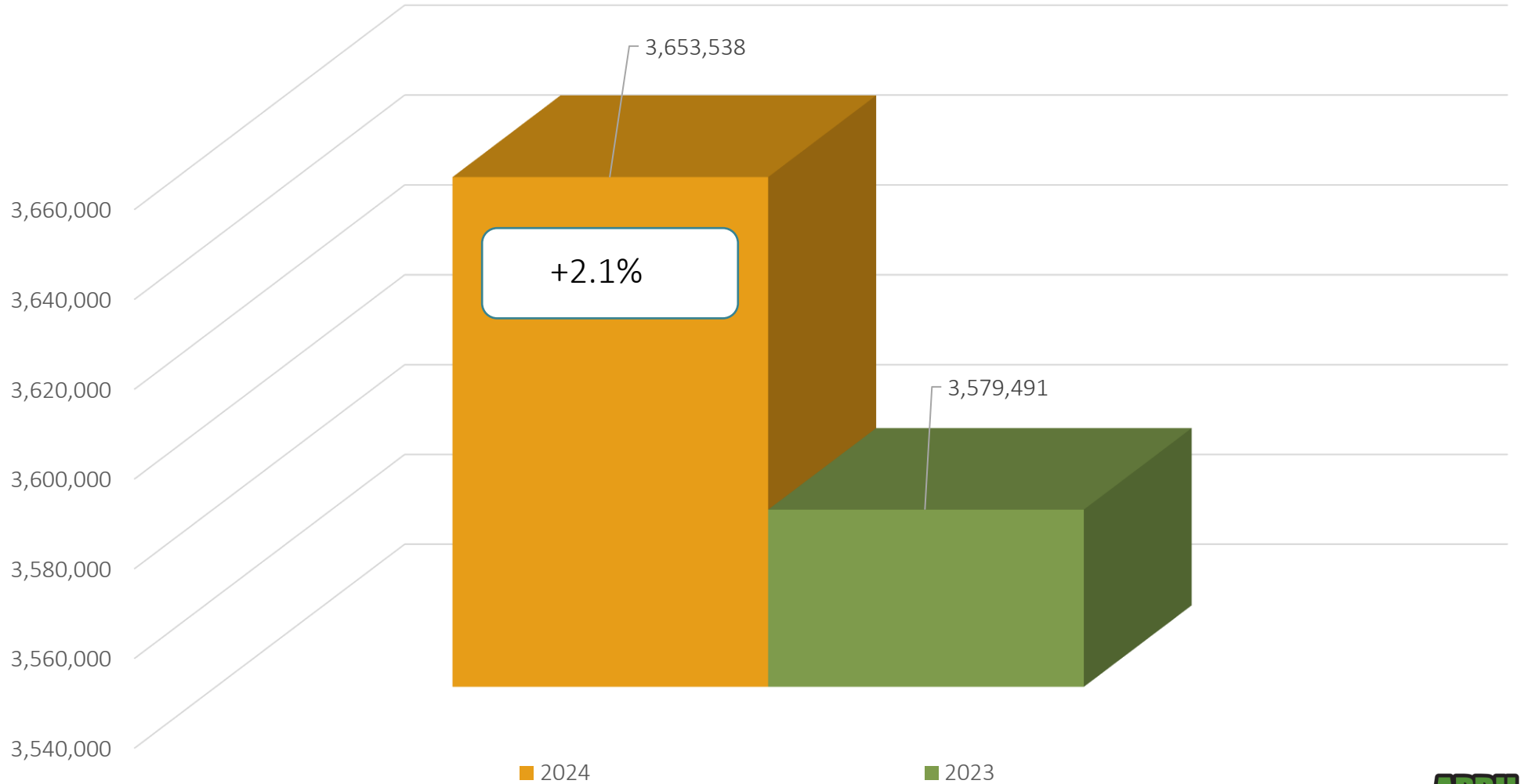
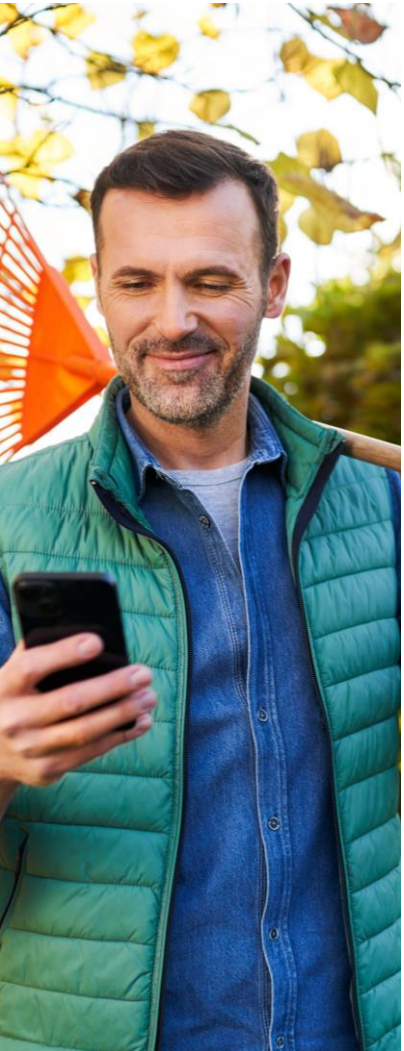


Transmissions MTD 2024– 1,195,555 / 2023 – 1,293,812= (-7.6%)

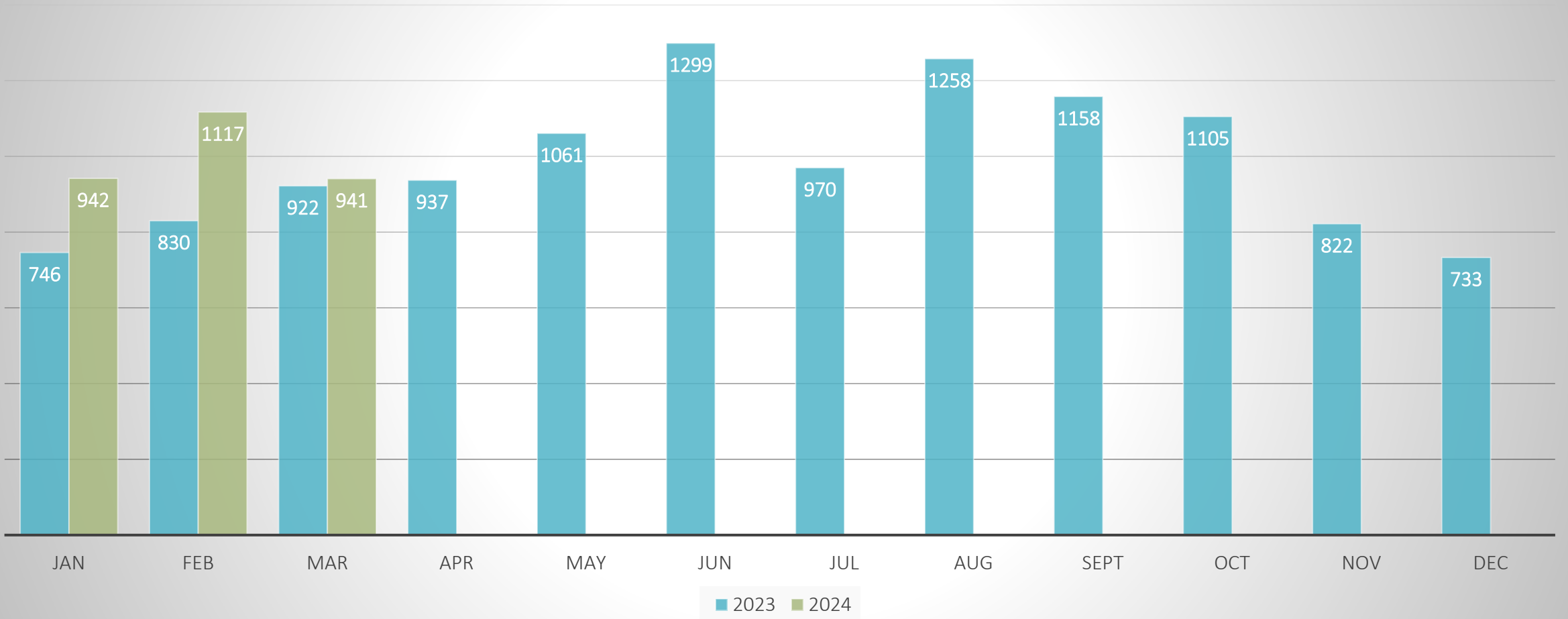

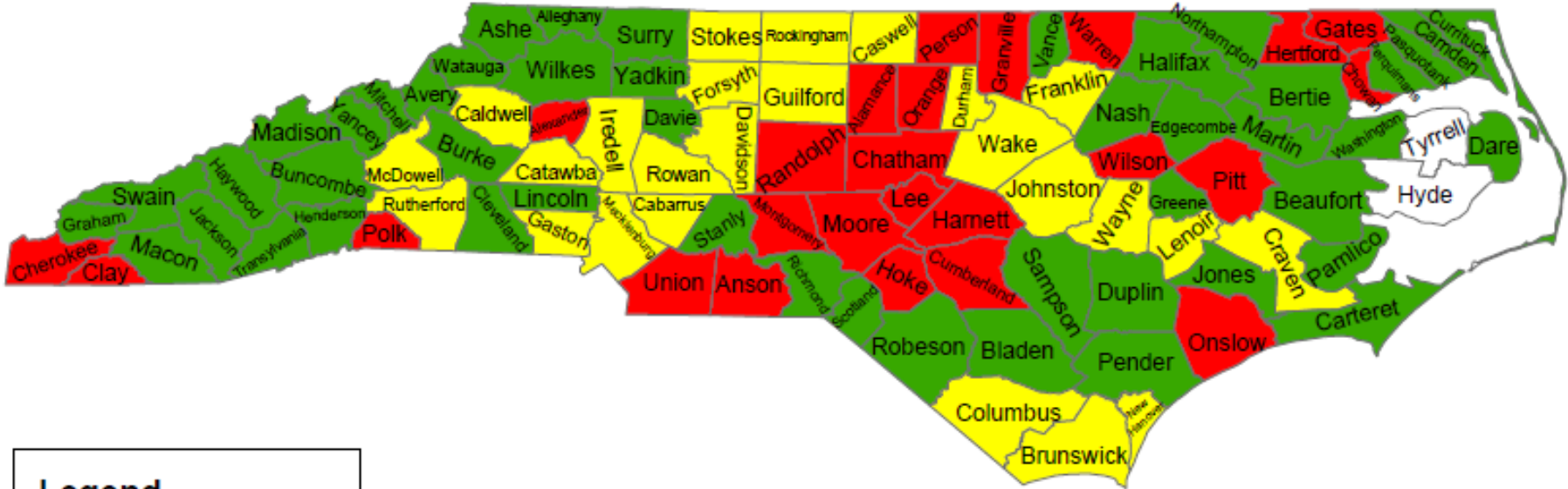


Damages in North Carolina 2024 vs 2023

March 2024



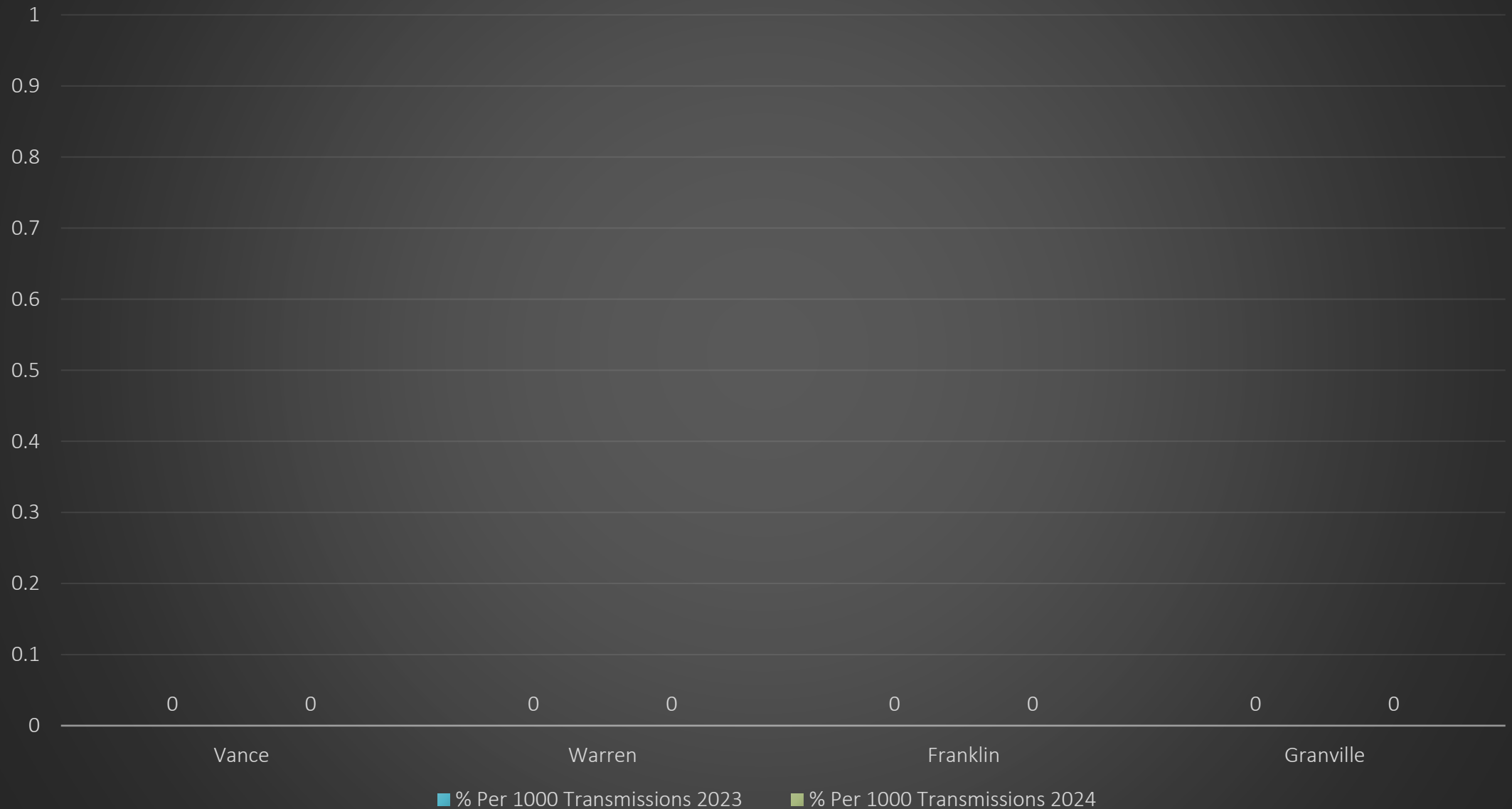

Self introductions

NC811 presentation given by Tami Groves

Dominion –very busy. Lot of construction. Next phase of 150 is moving. Google is coming to Iredell Co. Brian is working with the fire department to poss regulate ticket volume to keep a handle on it. One Duke project –on 21 down ramp Young Street to bridge at 150. Doing a great job. Still need to do station for Williams Pipeline. About one month away. Ran 230 services last month and still 120 behind. Three months behind on moving pipe. Talbert to Hwy 21 two months behind on this project. Let date on 8/1. Stafford subdivision. Along Faith Road –hard to grid system. Can't enter tickets via RTE. They have to be called in.

Roddi Long Grading –staying busy. Getting ready to do a project for Dominion.

Town of Mooresville –general business. No new large projects. Mill Village wrapping up. Wiggins Pump Station finishing up.

Iredell Water – Replace 8” main with 12” on Harmony. Working developments. Several more coming anywhere from 300- 1200 homes. Hwy 21 project put off until 2025. Ft Dobbs/Shinnville Road development. They will do water. Troutman will do sewer. Don't try to repair services. Report to Iredell Water.

Williams Pipeline – They are slammed. 12 ongoing developments in varying stages. Have to be onsite when they are crossed. No exceptions. Mears is working a project to Williams. Working on anomalies. Moving toward Rowan Co next. Lot of work in Mecklenburg Co. Google has crossed a few in Mecklenburg and done better job.

Next meeting at the Town of Troutman, Thursday, May 2nd. Also keep in mind the damage prevention breakfast/luncheon.
