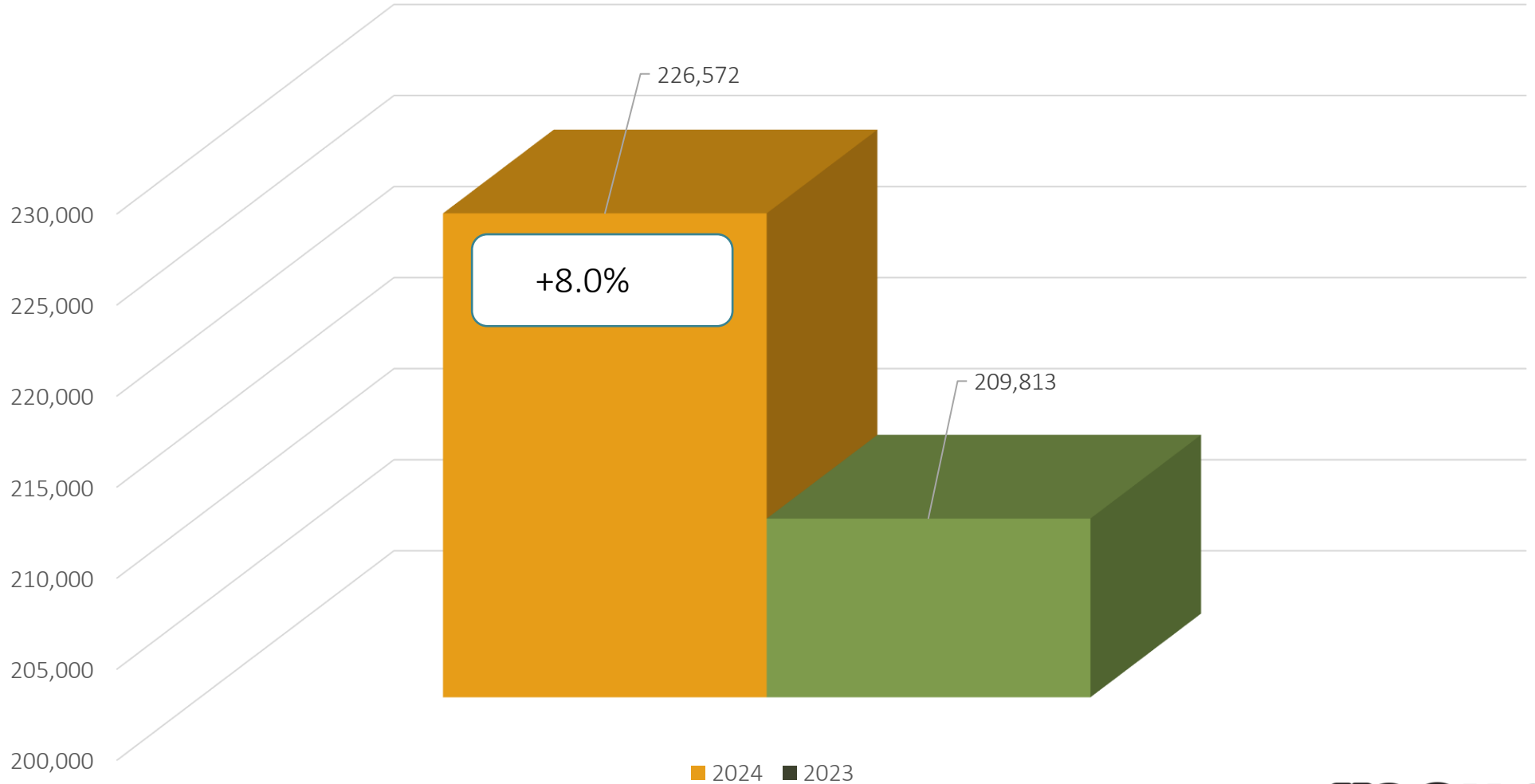
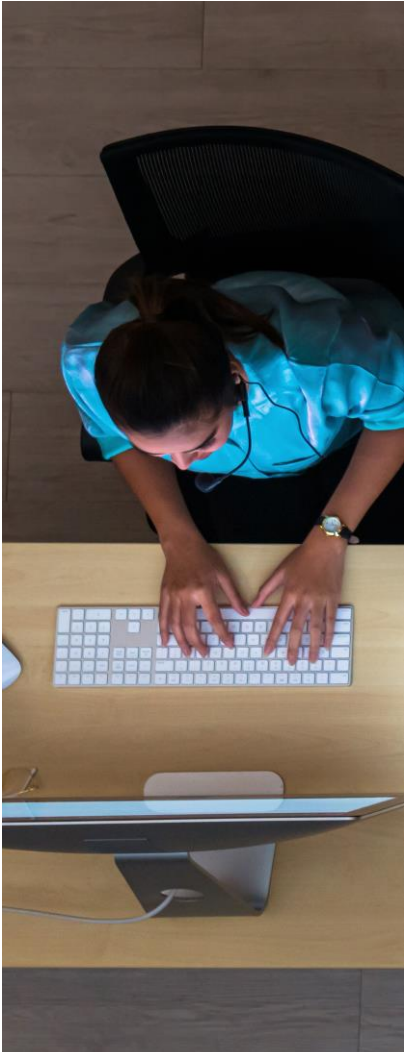

MTD February 2024 – 226,572 / 2023 – 209,813 = +8%

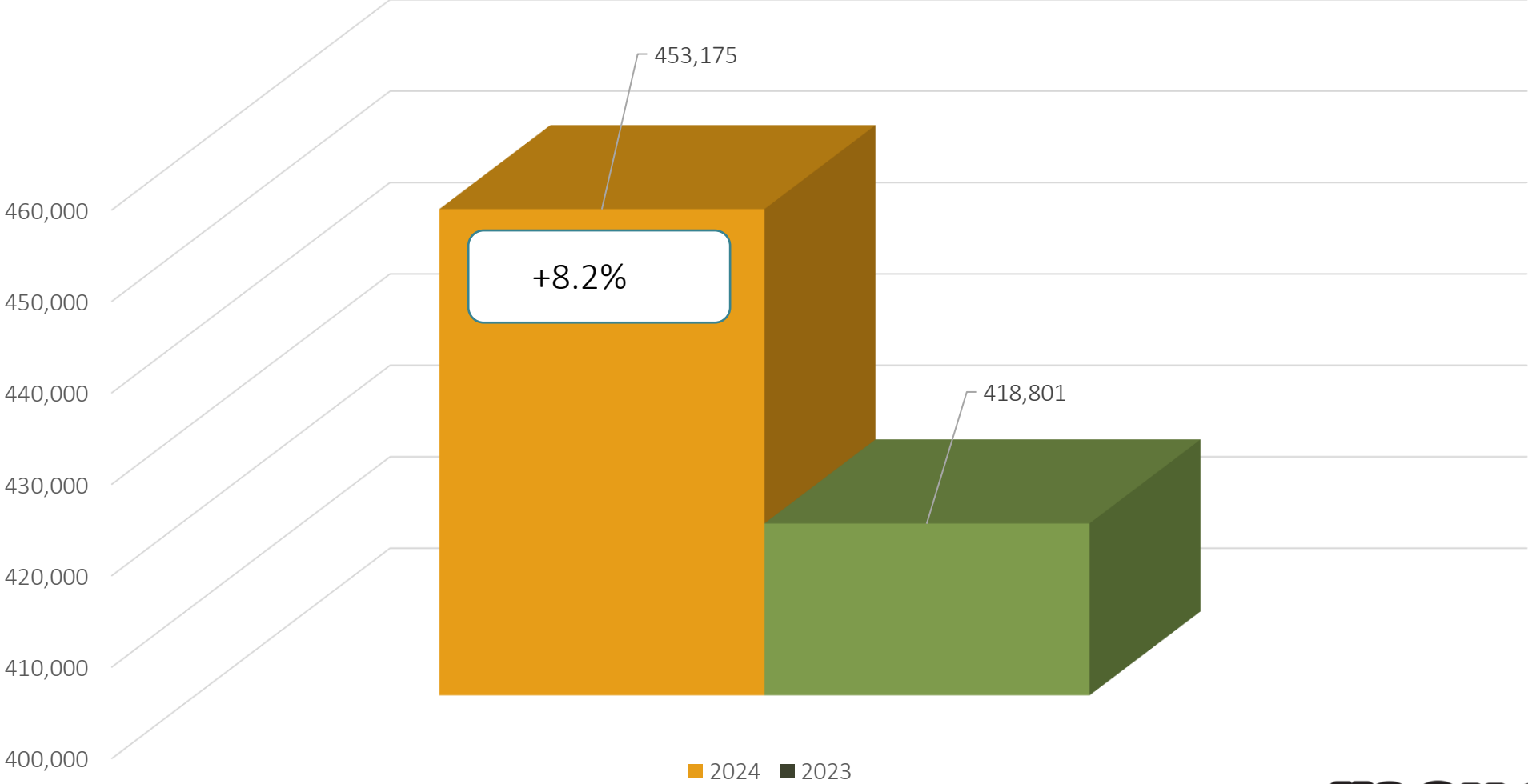
YTD 2024 – 453,175 / 2023 – 418,801 = +8.2 %

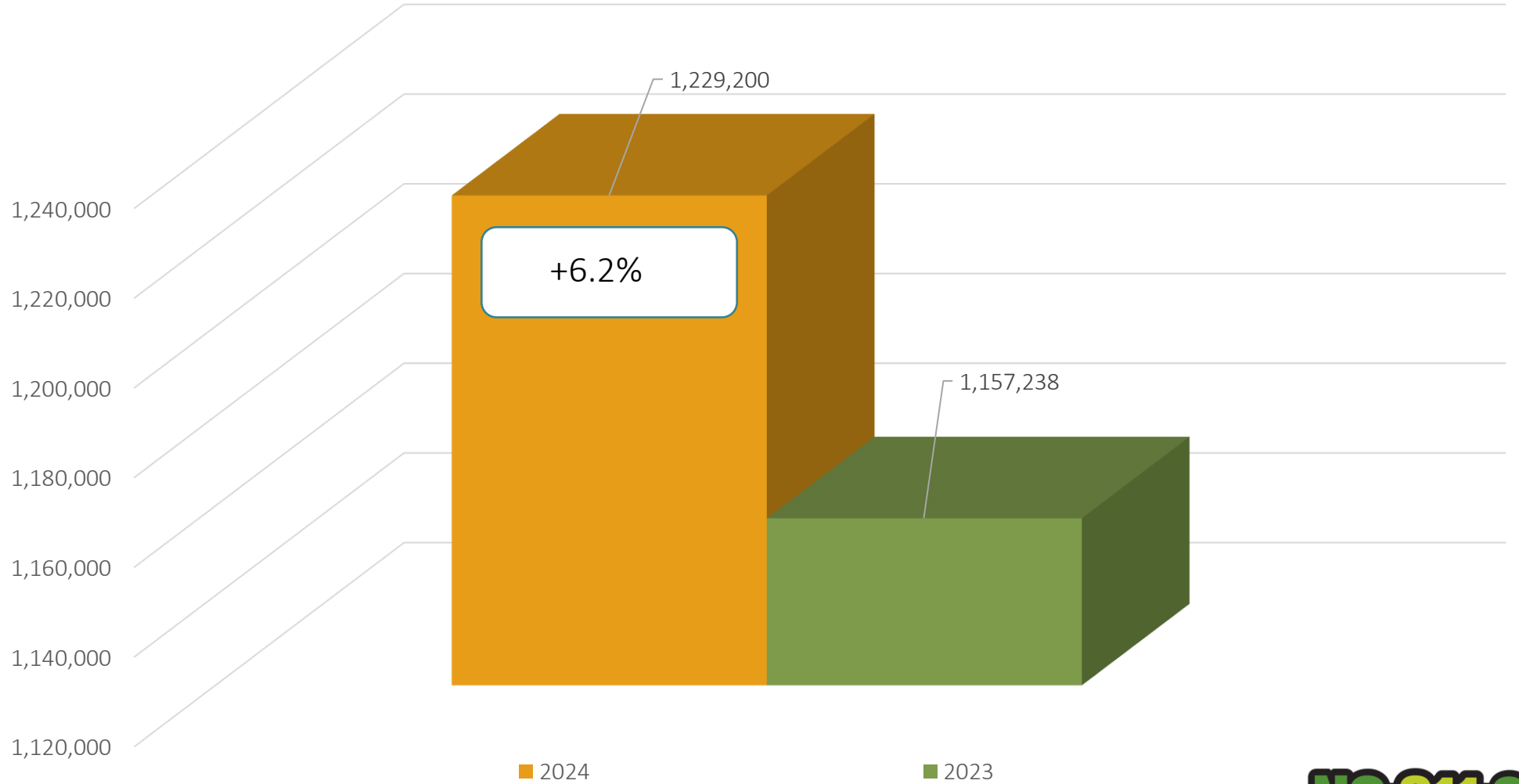
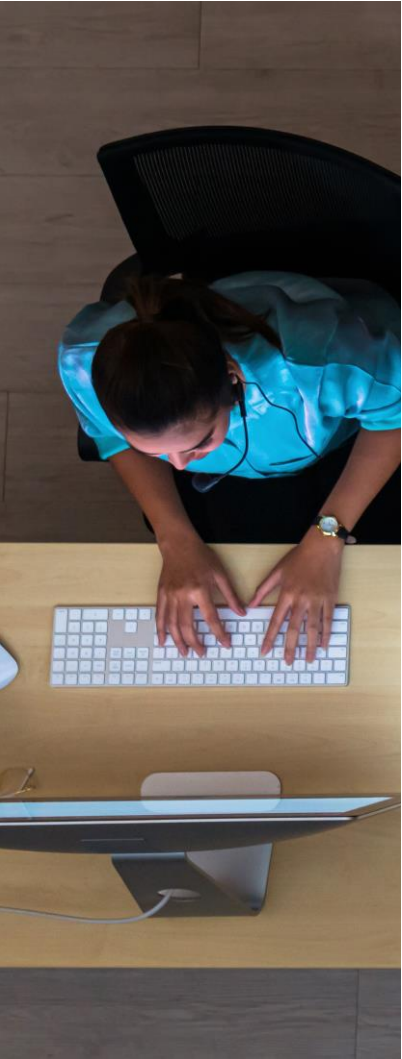


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Transmissions for NC

February 2024 vs 2023

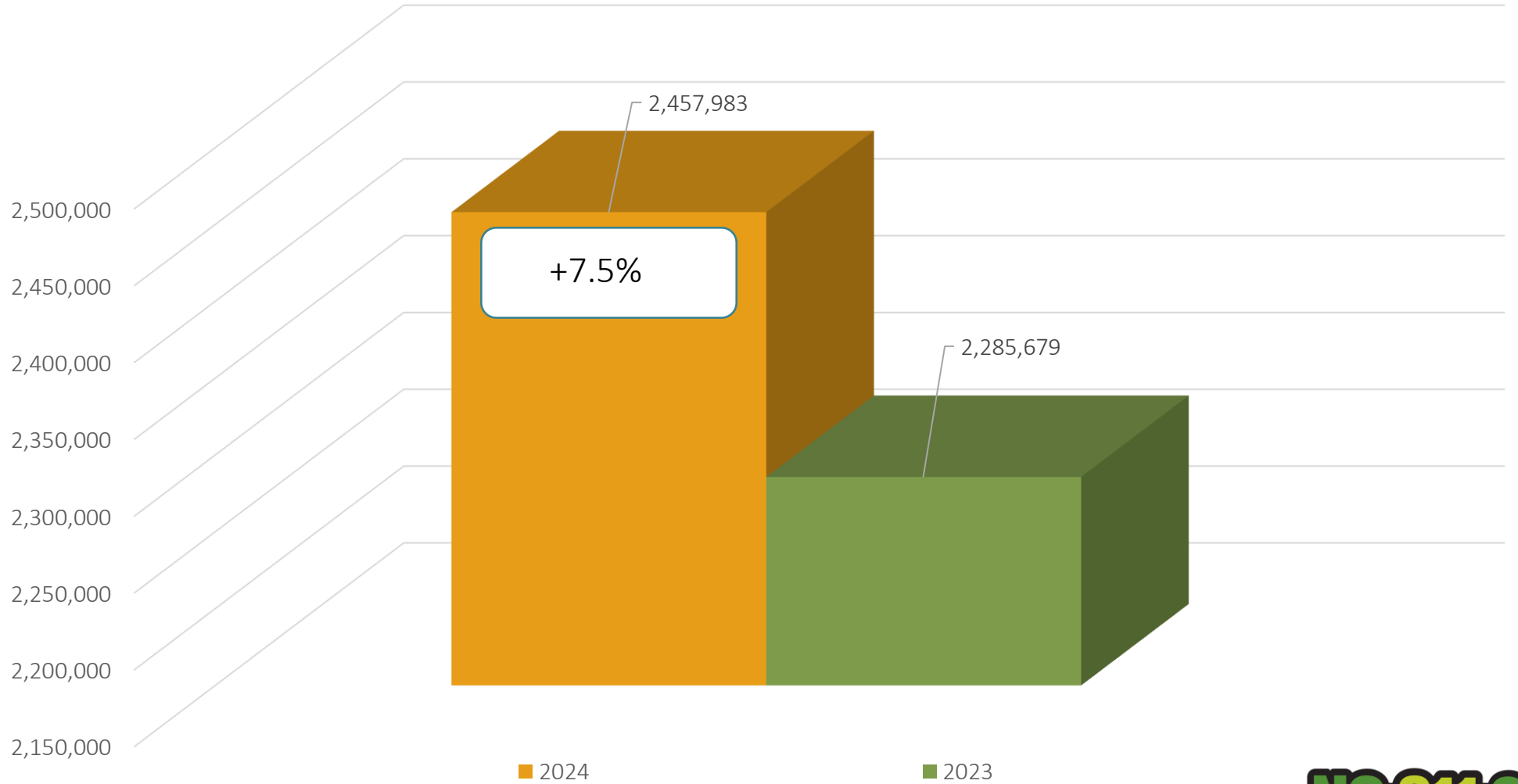
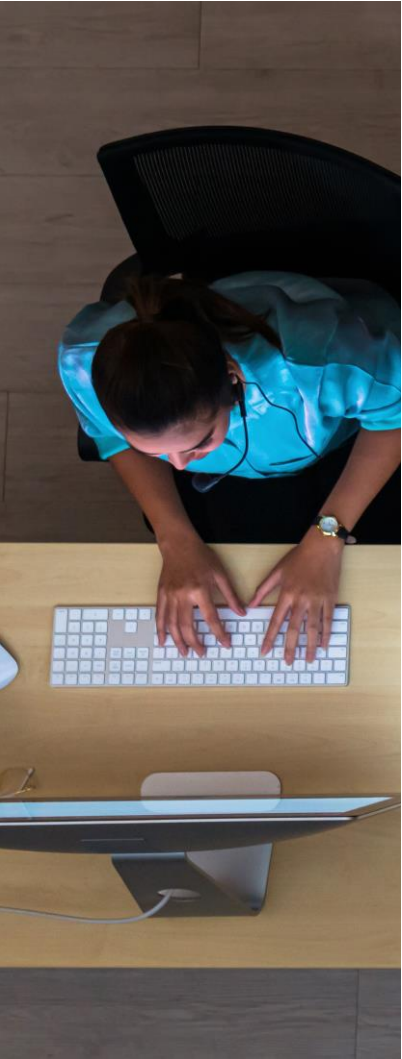


Transmissions MTD 2024– 1,229,200 / 2023 – 1,157,238= +6.2%

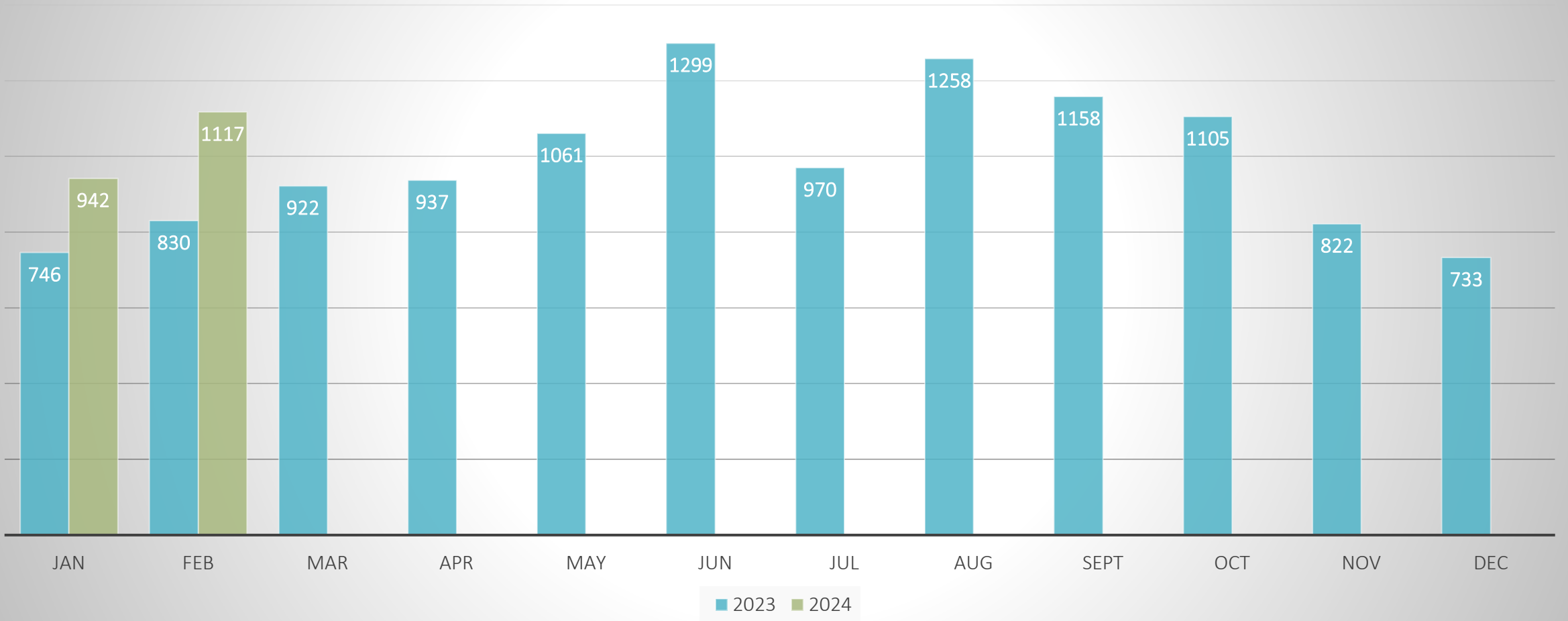

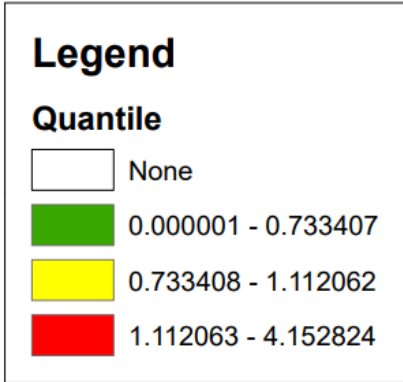
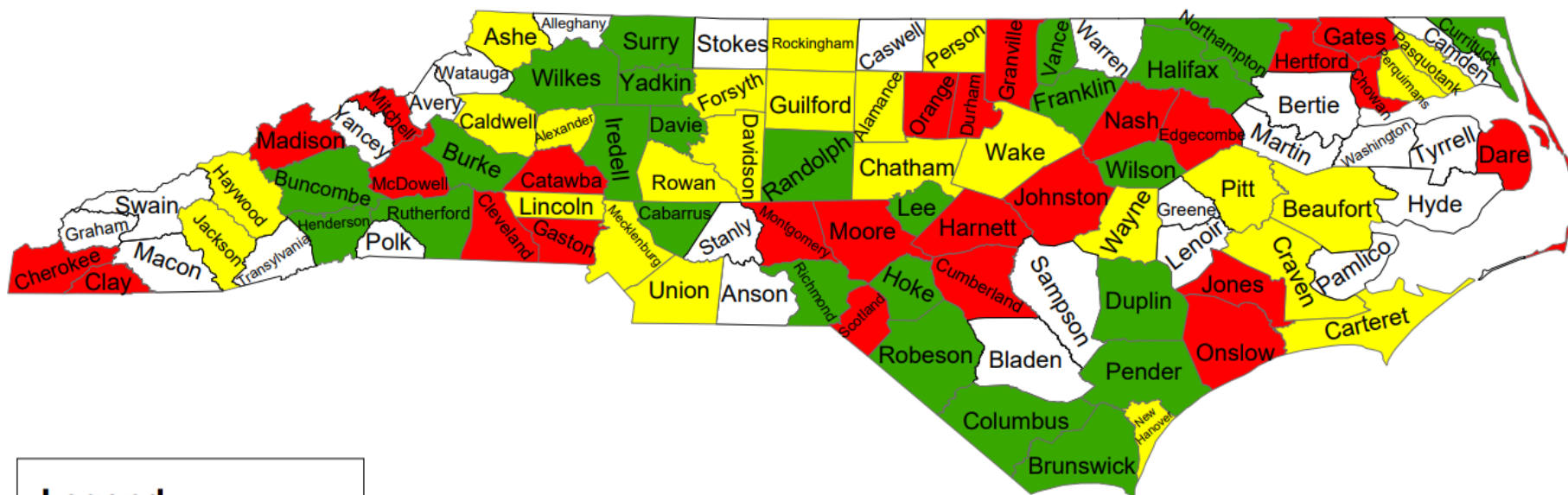

Level One Safety done by Chris Anthony

Safety – Work zone safety hit hard right now. We think about driving, but also in the area where you are physically working. Gas locator – looking for tracer wire, used a shovel and pulled back some dirt, also pulled back a used needle. Using gloves is being stressed – use tool as well. As the weather gets warmer, snakes are out. Spiders. Bees. Keep your head on a swivel. If you are allergic, be sure to have epi pen on you.
