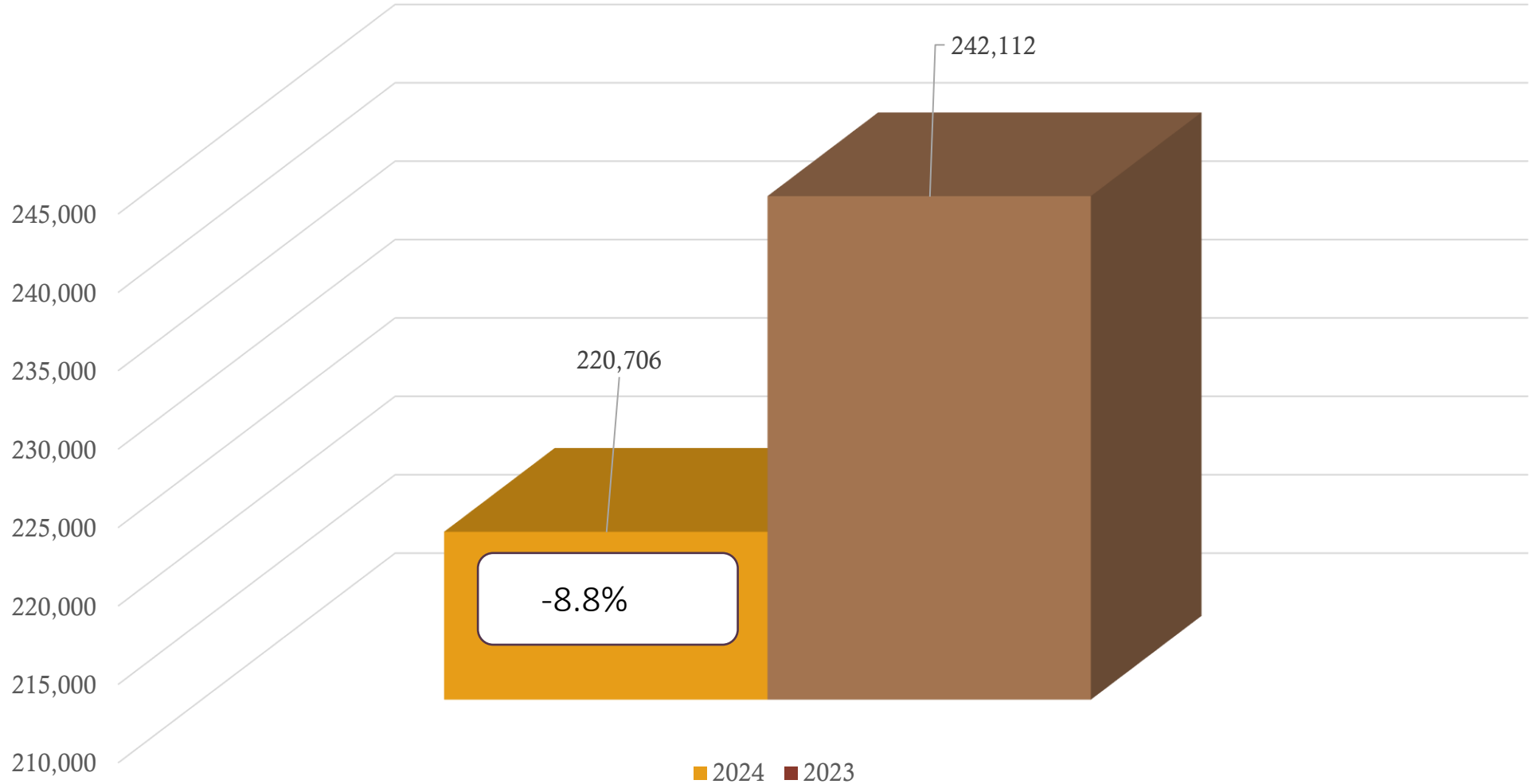

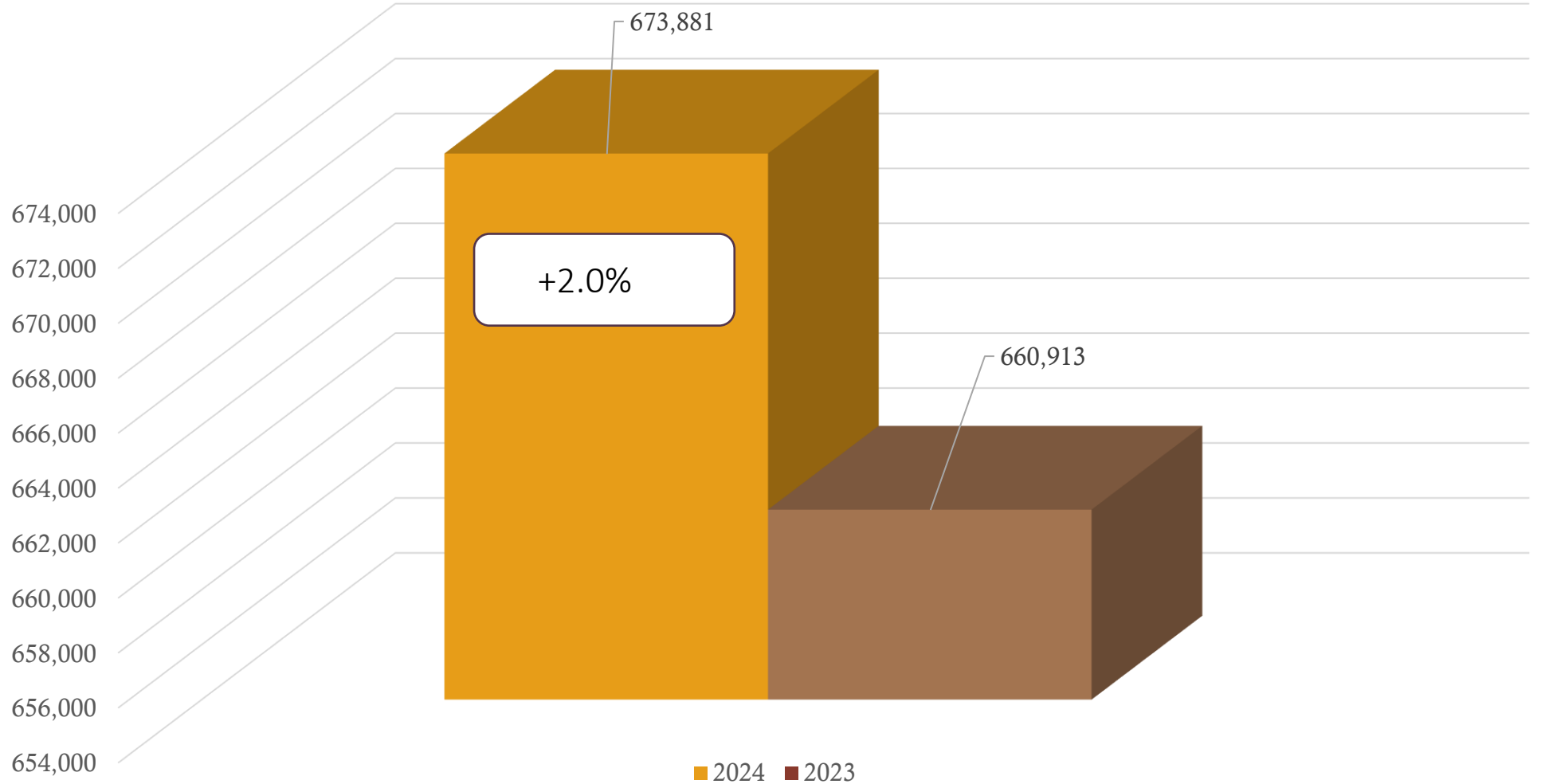

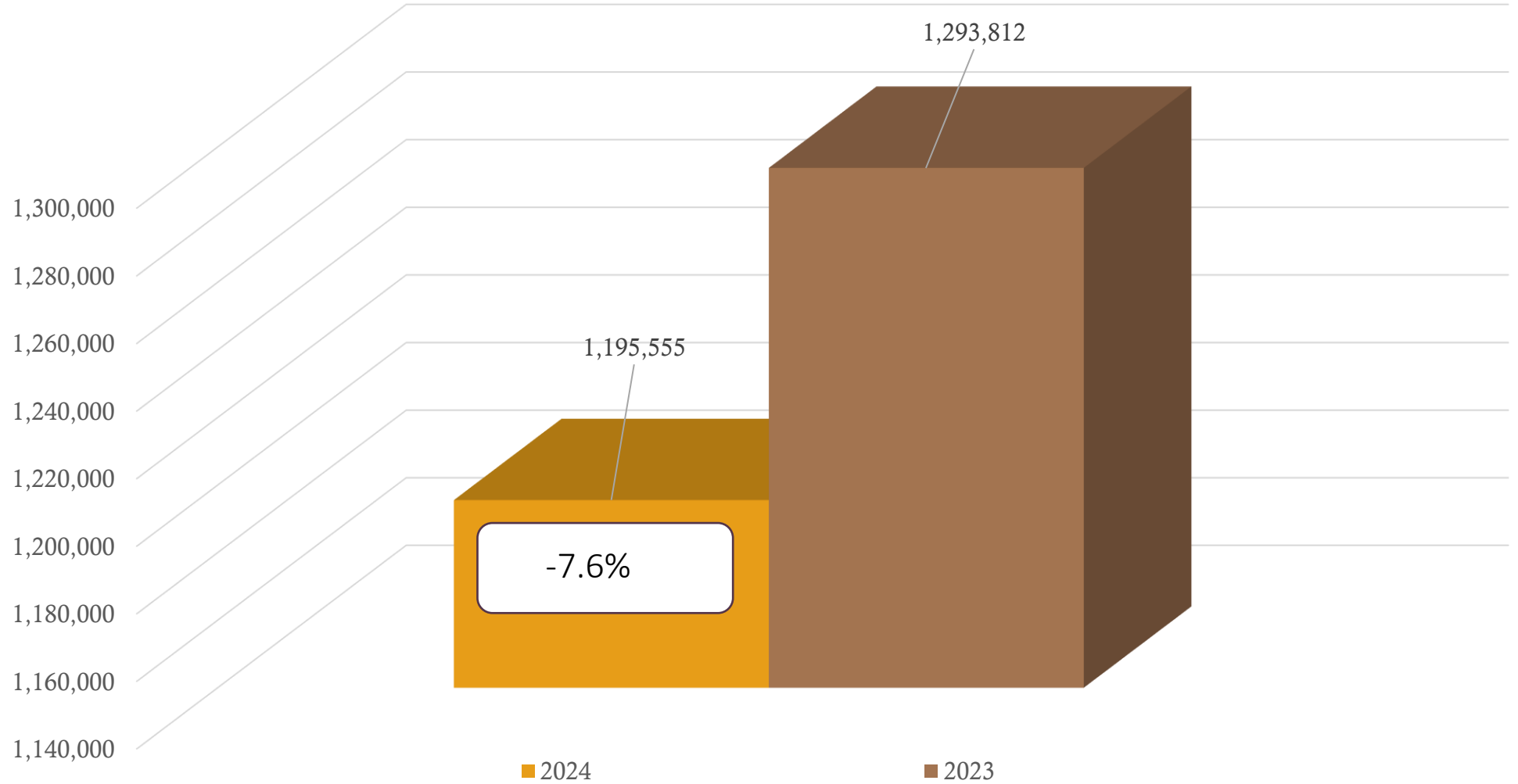

March 2024 vs 2023

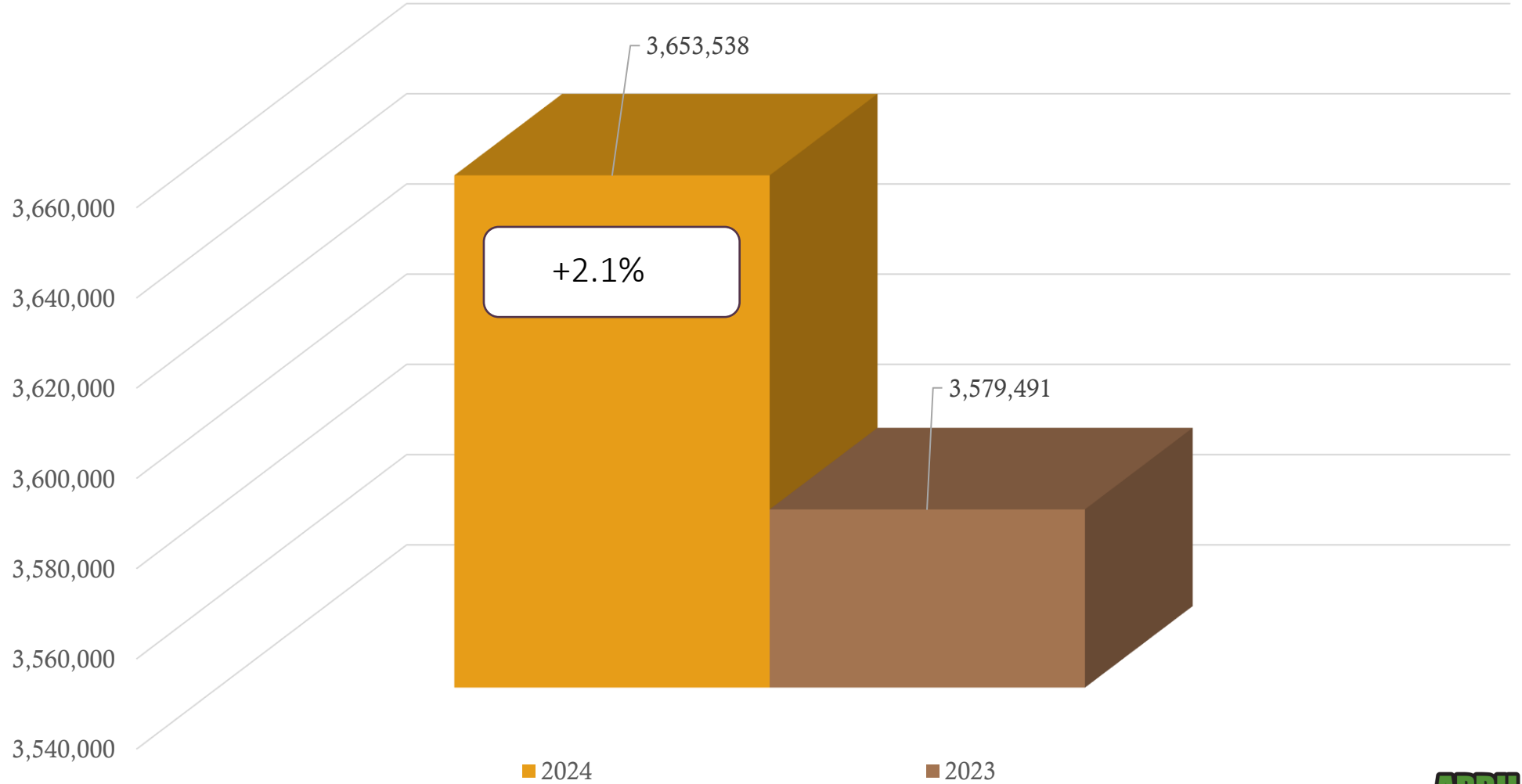
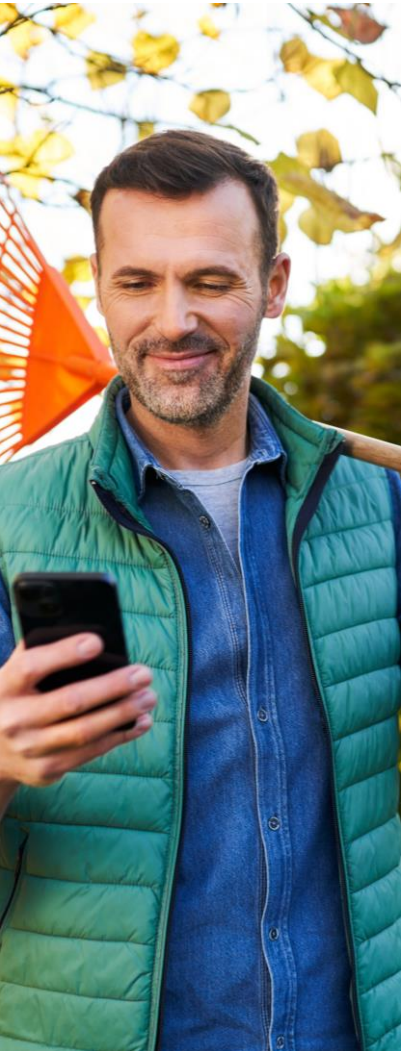

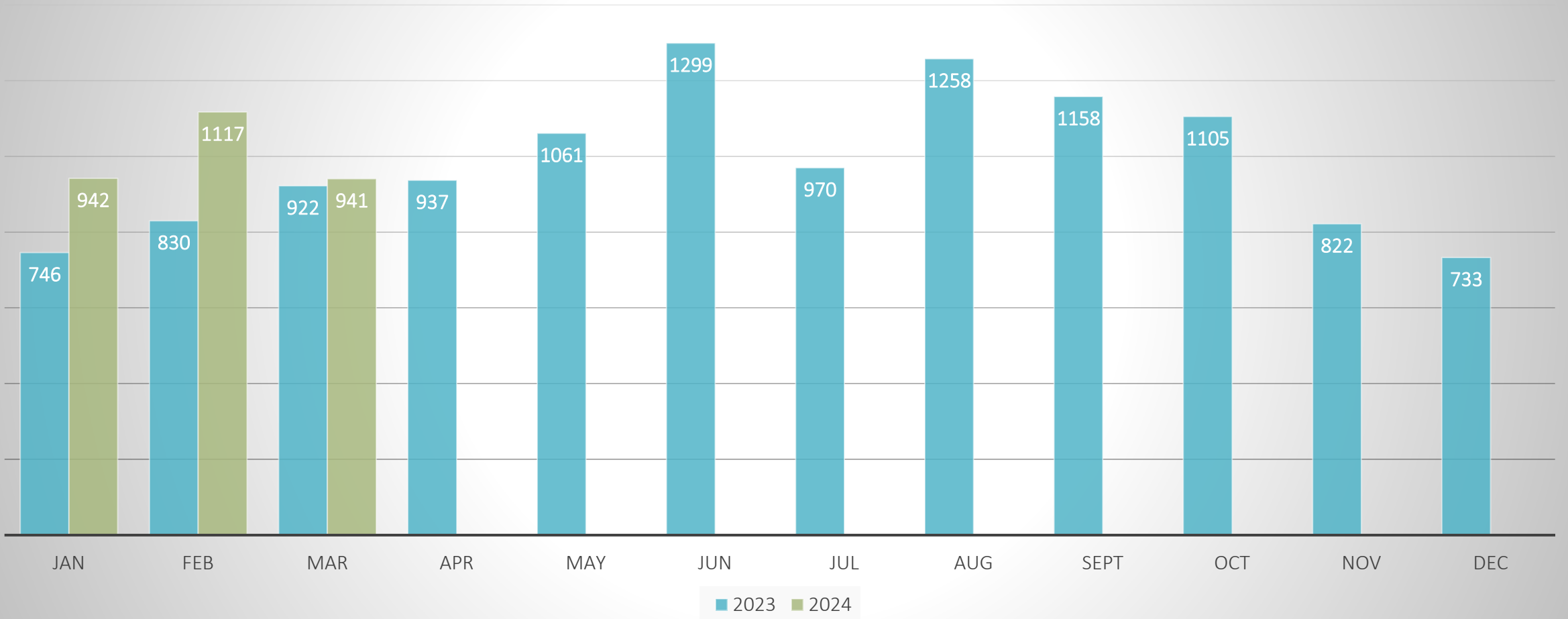

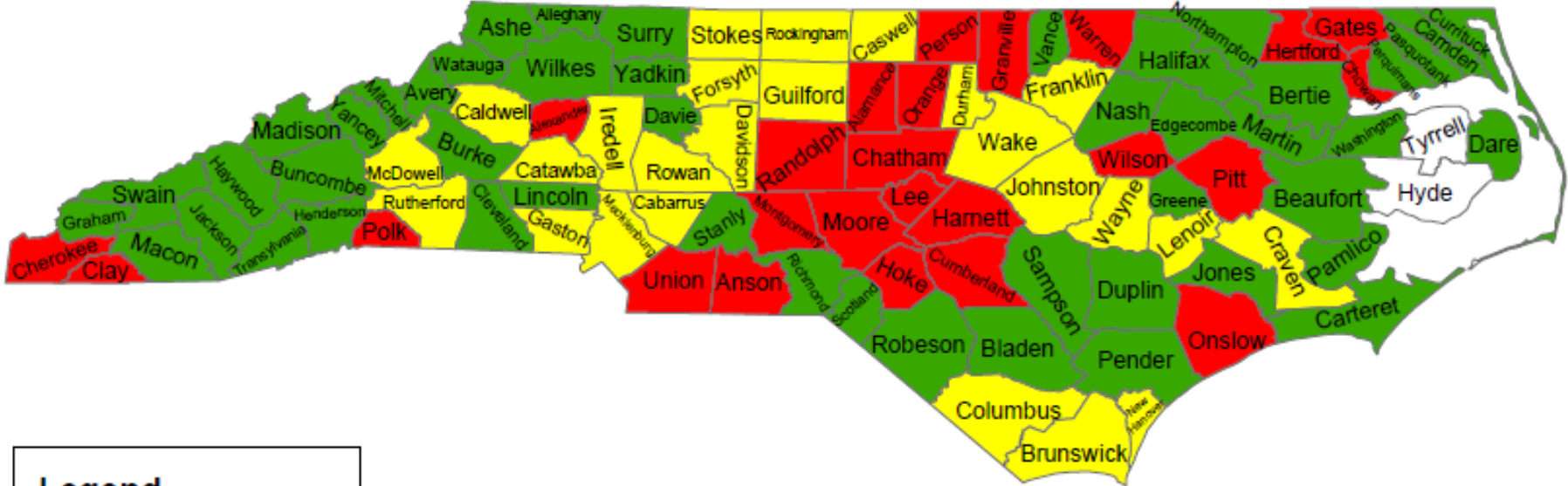


Damages in North Carolina 2024 vs 2023
