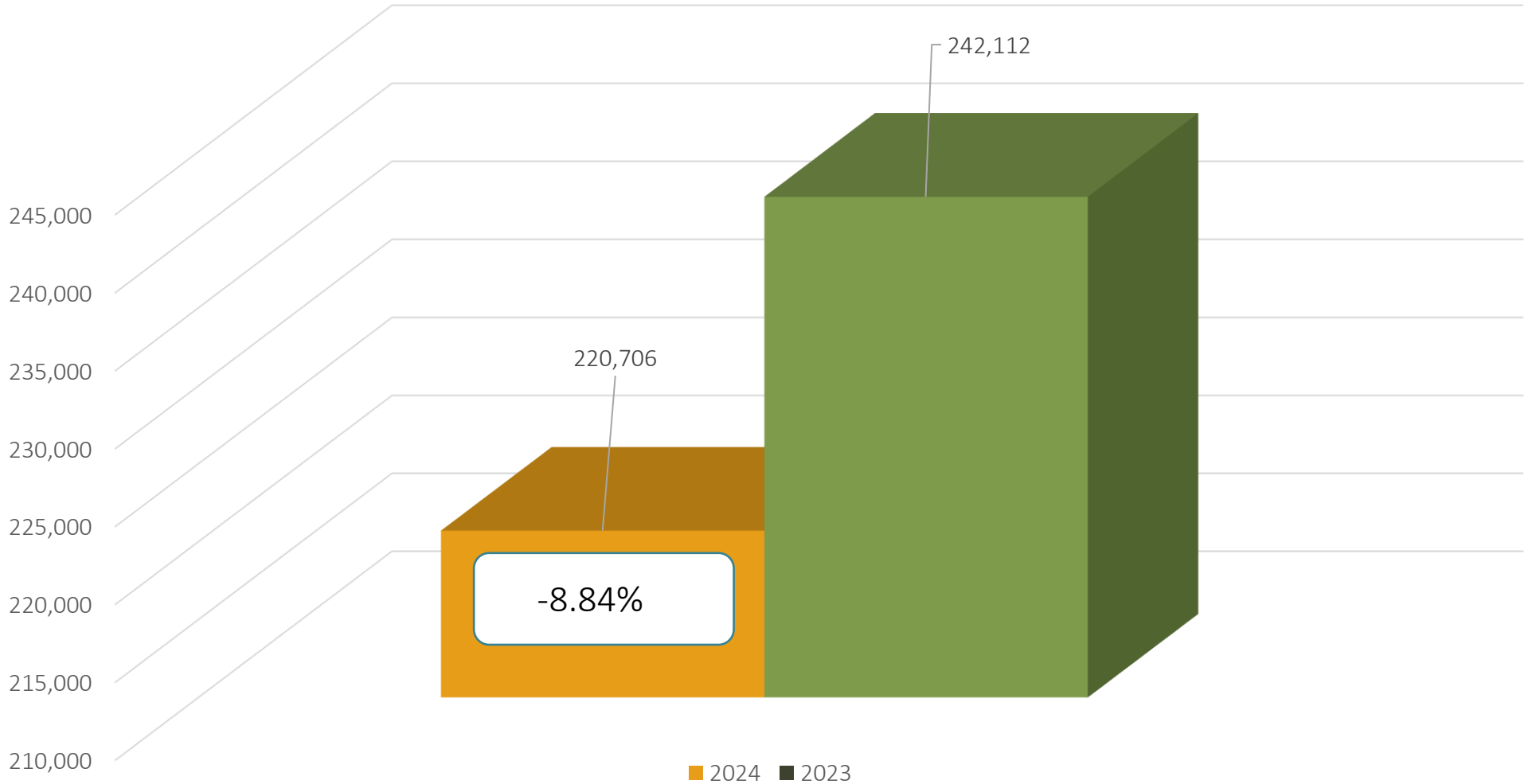

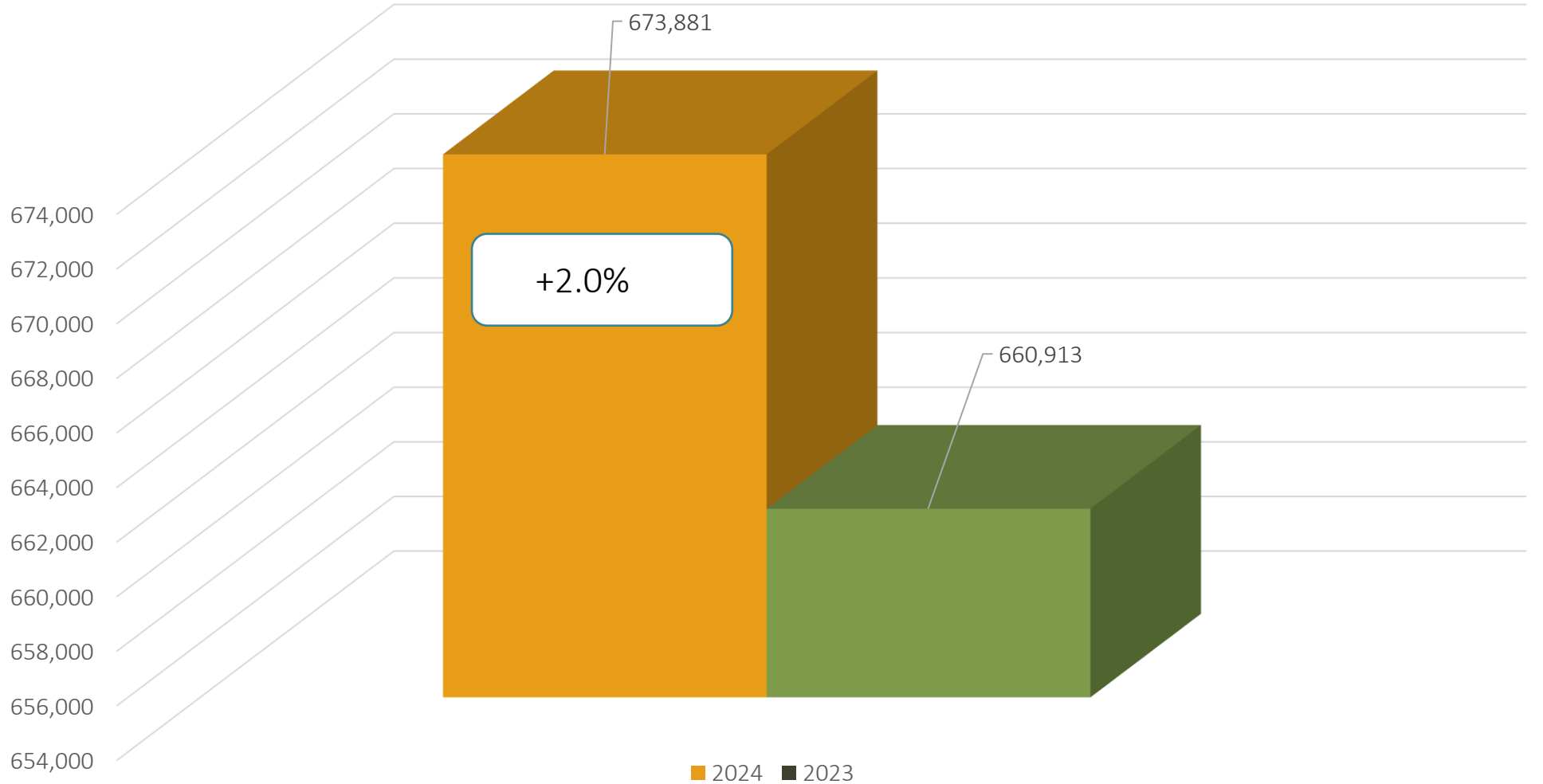

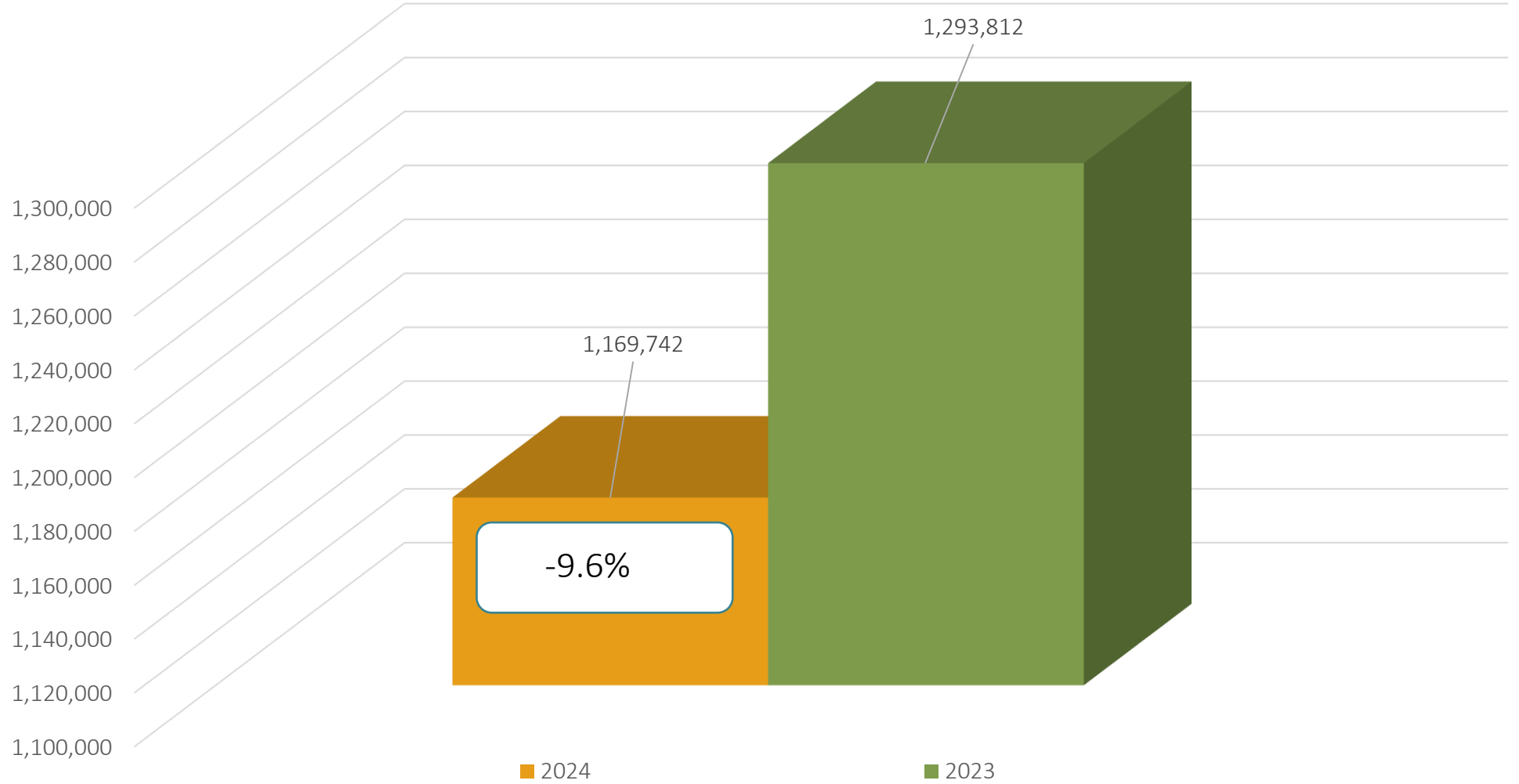

March 2024 vs 2023

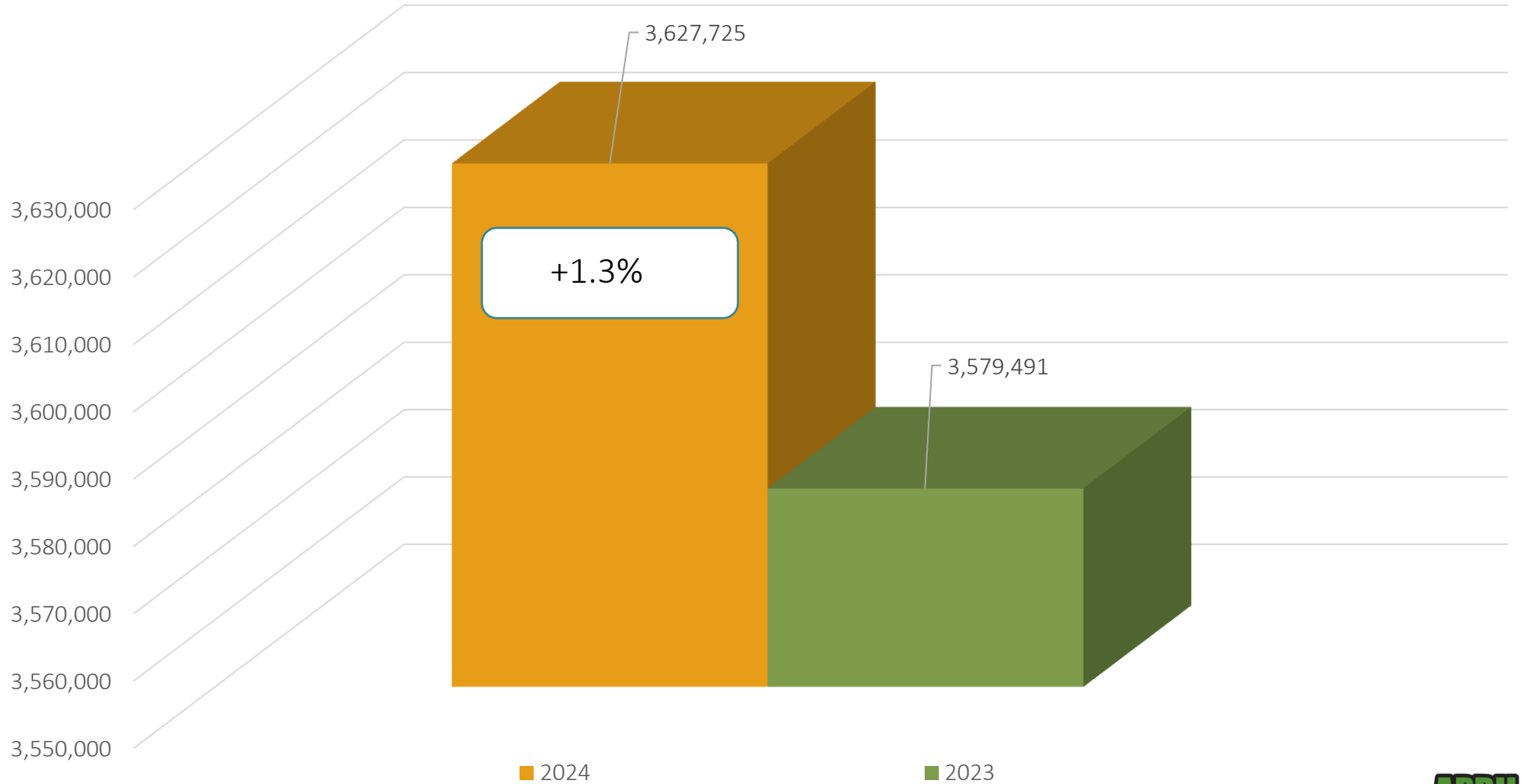
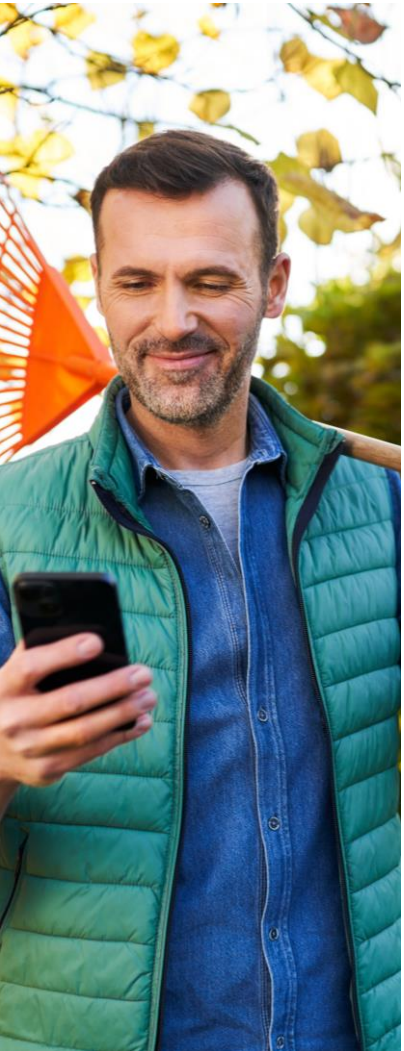

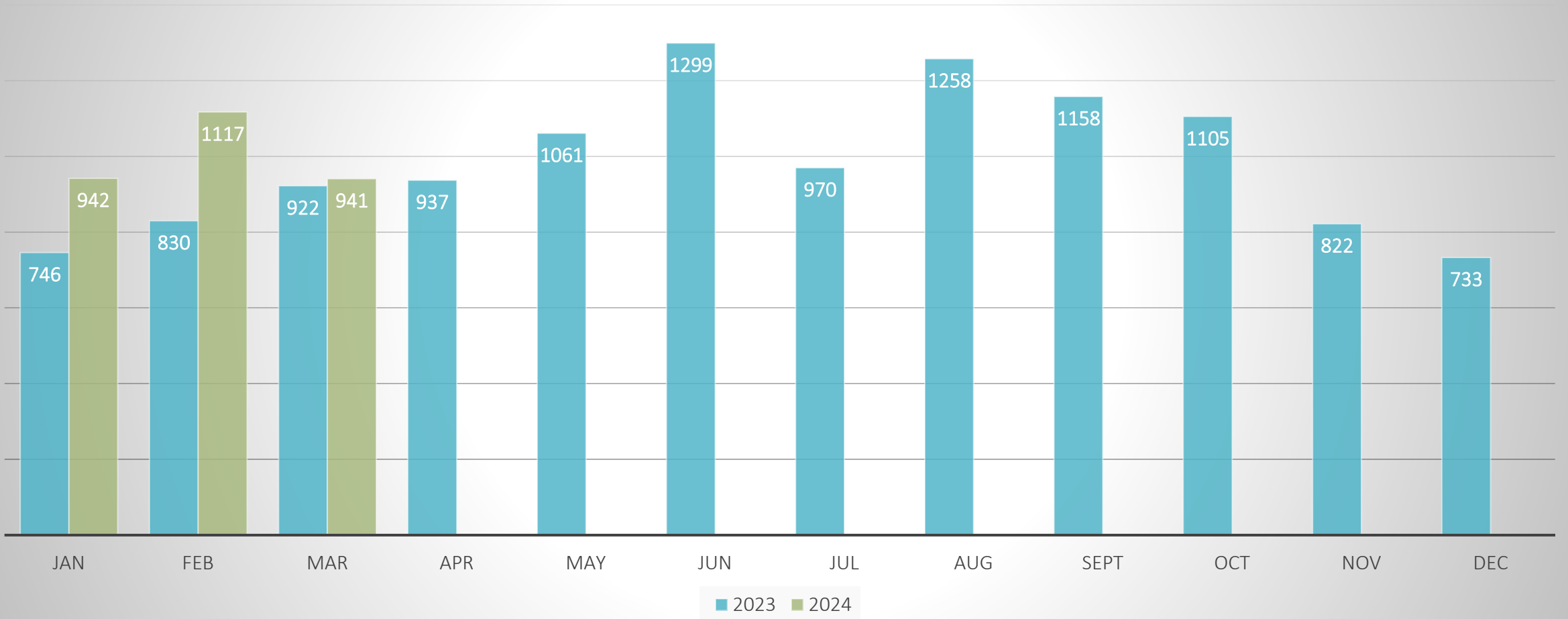
