



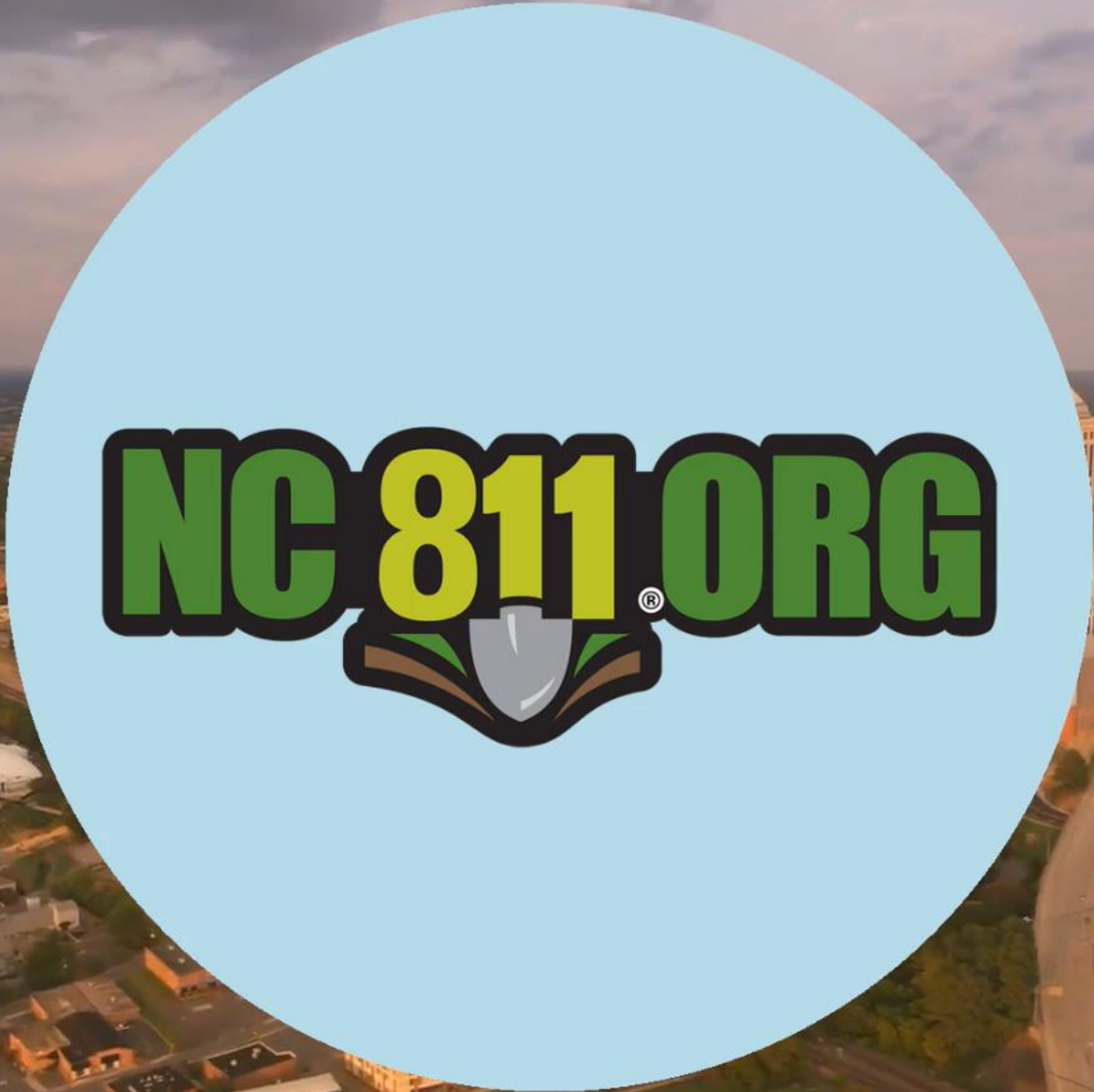

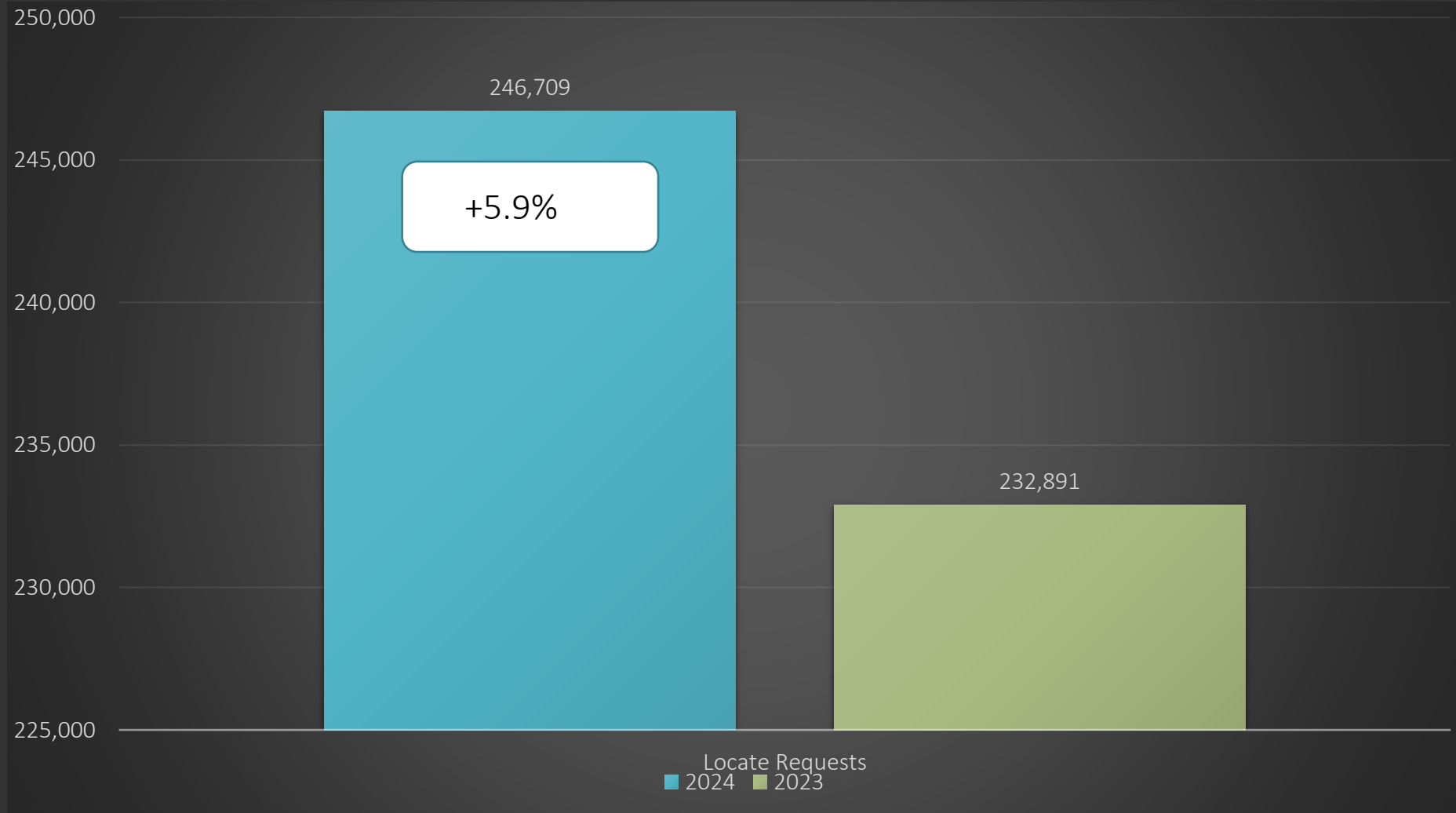

Locate Requests for NC - May 2024 vs 2023

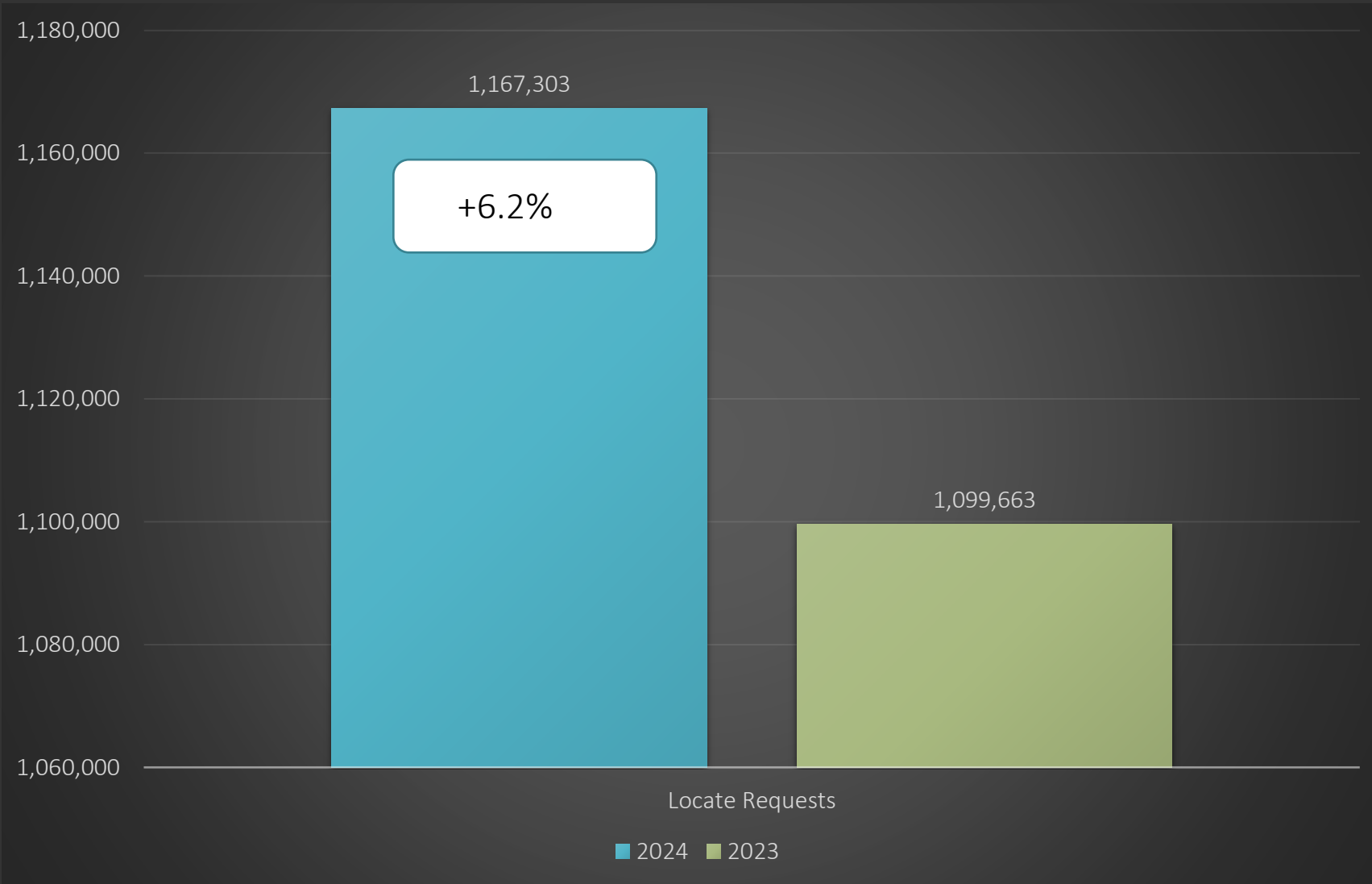


MTD May 2024 – 246,709 / 2023 – 232,891=(5.9%)

Updates for March 2024 – (79,139) = 32.1% of volume / April 31% = -1.1% (Increase the month before)

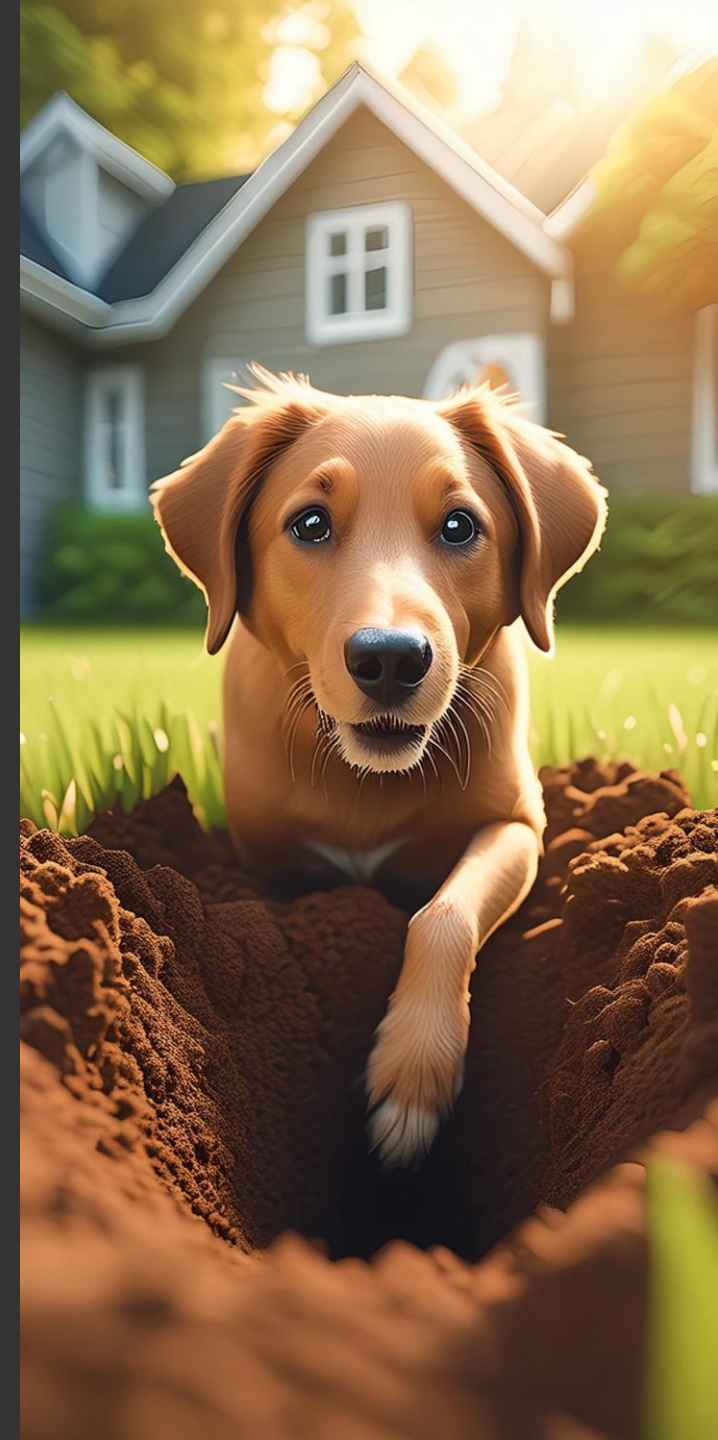
Locate Requests for NC - YTD



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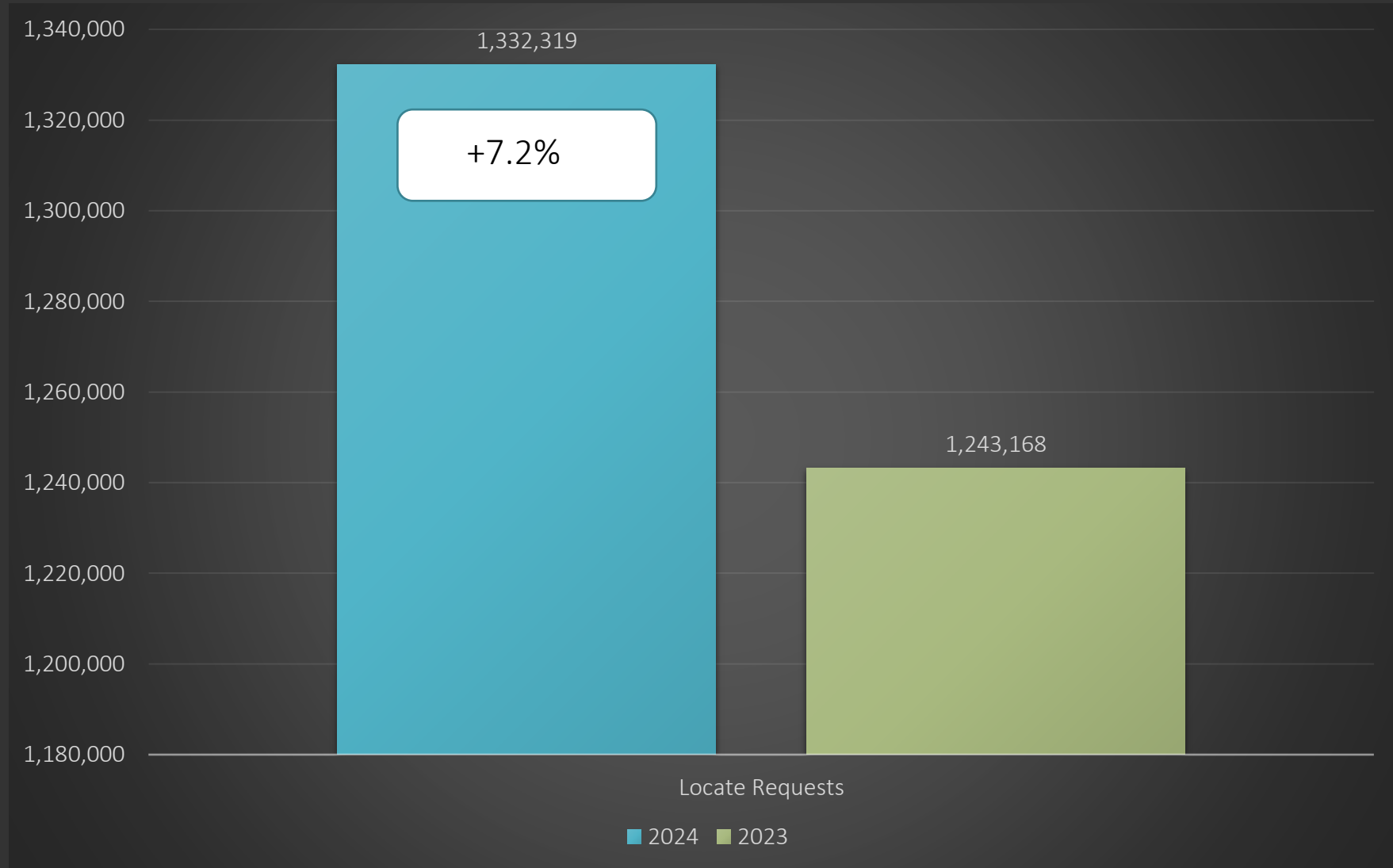
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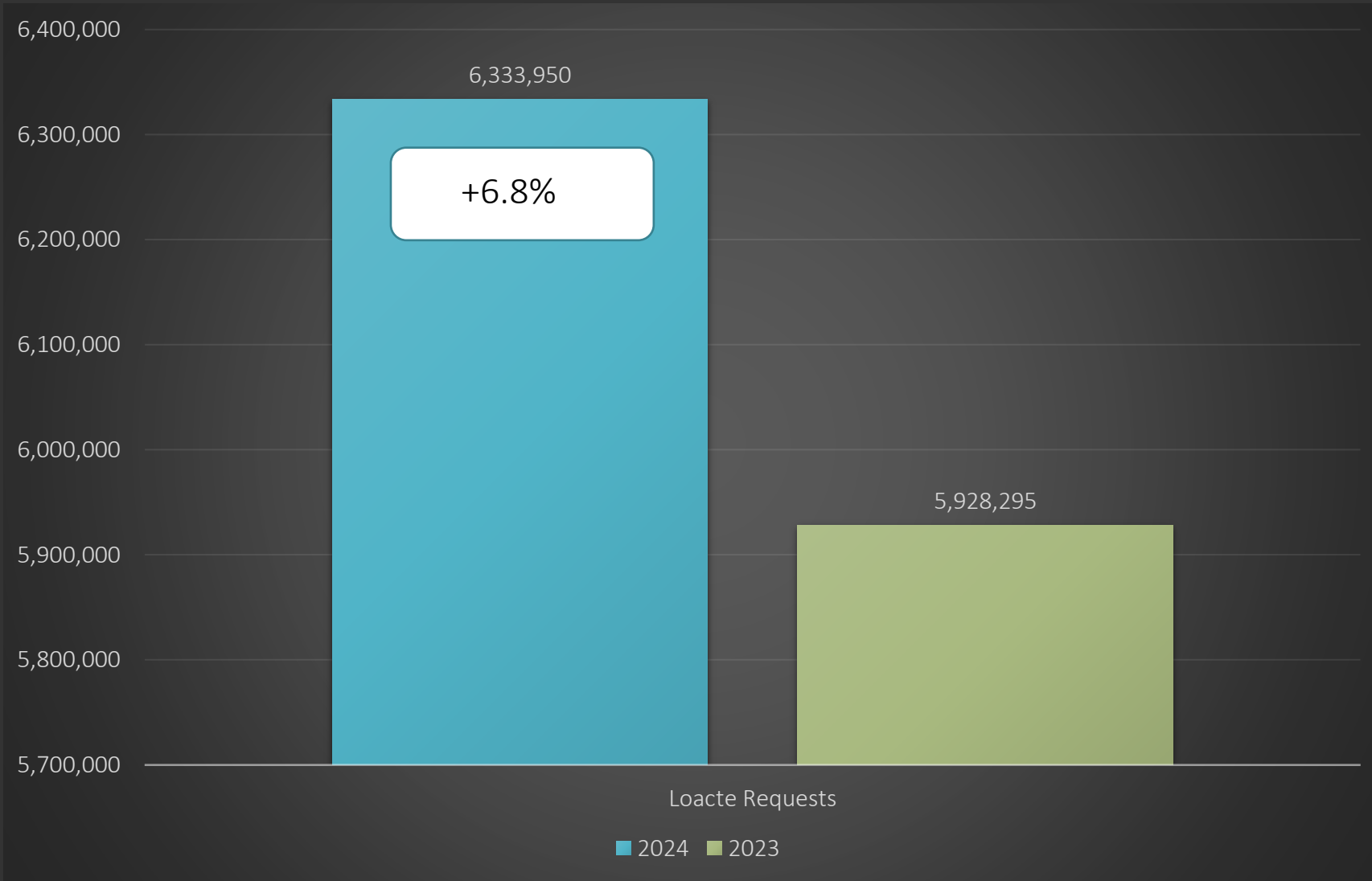
Transmissions for NC - May 24 vs 23

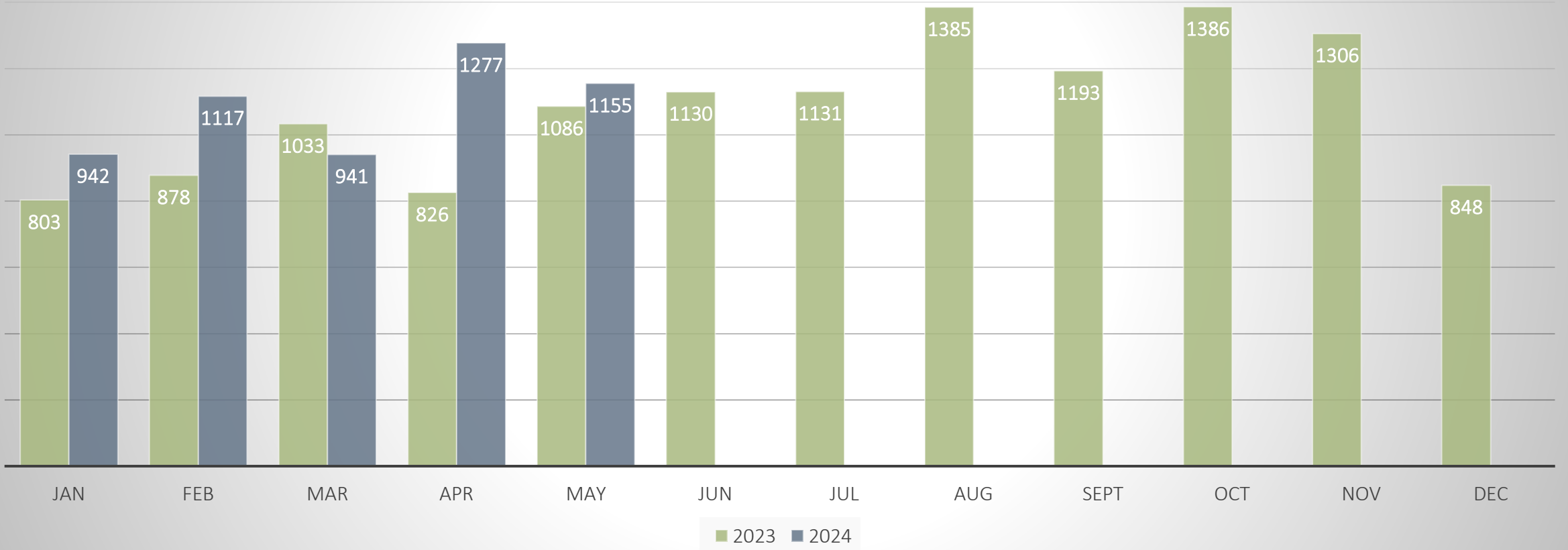

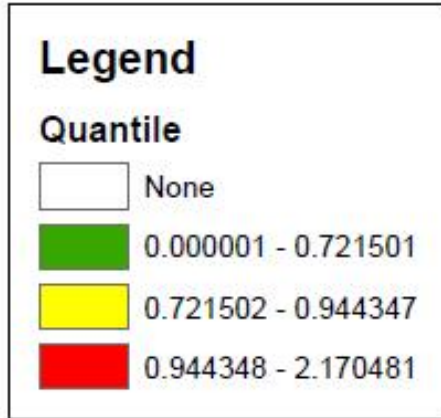
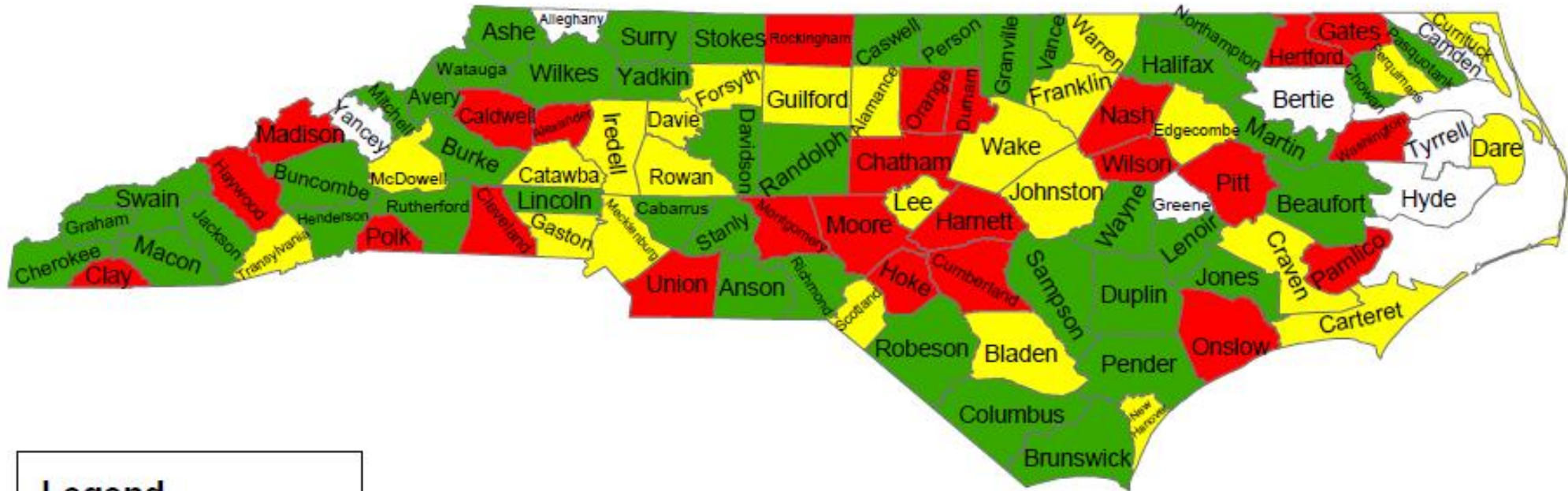

Meeting opened by Chair, David Burr

PeeDee covers seven counties. If you call 811 and the number is busy, call the 1-800 number, or use SAT. What happens if you don't call? You could damage utilities, prevent emergency services from being notified. You could damage your own utility or knock out an entire neighborhood. Cable Hound – Phillip Perkins is retiring in August. 811 does not perform locates. Positive response comes out from the utility. What information do you need to perform a locate? Make sure you have the information available when you call or use SAT. Spectrum will be on a lot of poles. PeeDee is working on a lot of pole replacements. Some in Anson, Richmond, & Union. Lot of poultry farm growth. Work in Peachland on Hwy 218 going from single phase to three phase.

NCDOT – Some concerns with encroachments being done correctly. Union County getting a lot of roundabout work. Lot of road work coming to Union. Lot of resurfacing in Anson & Union.

Utility Partners – always available with services. Glad to be of assistance to anyone. Locating, soft digs, core boring.
