





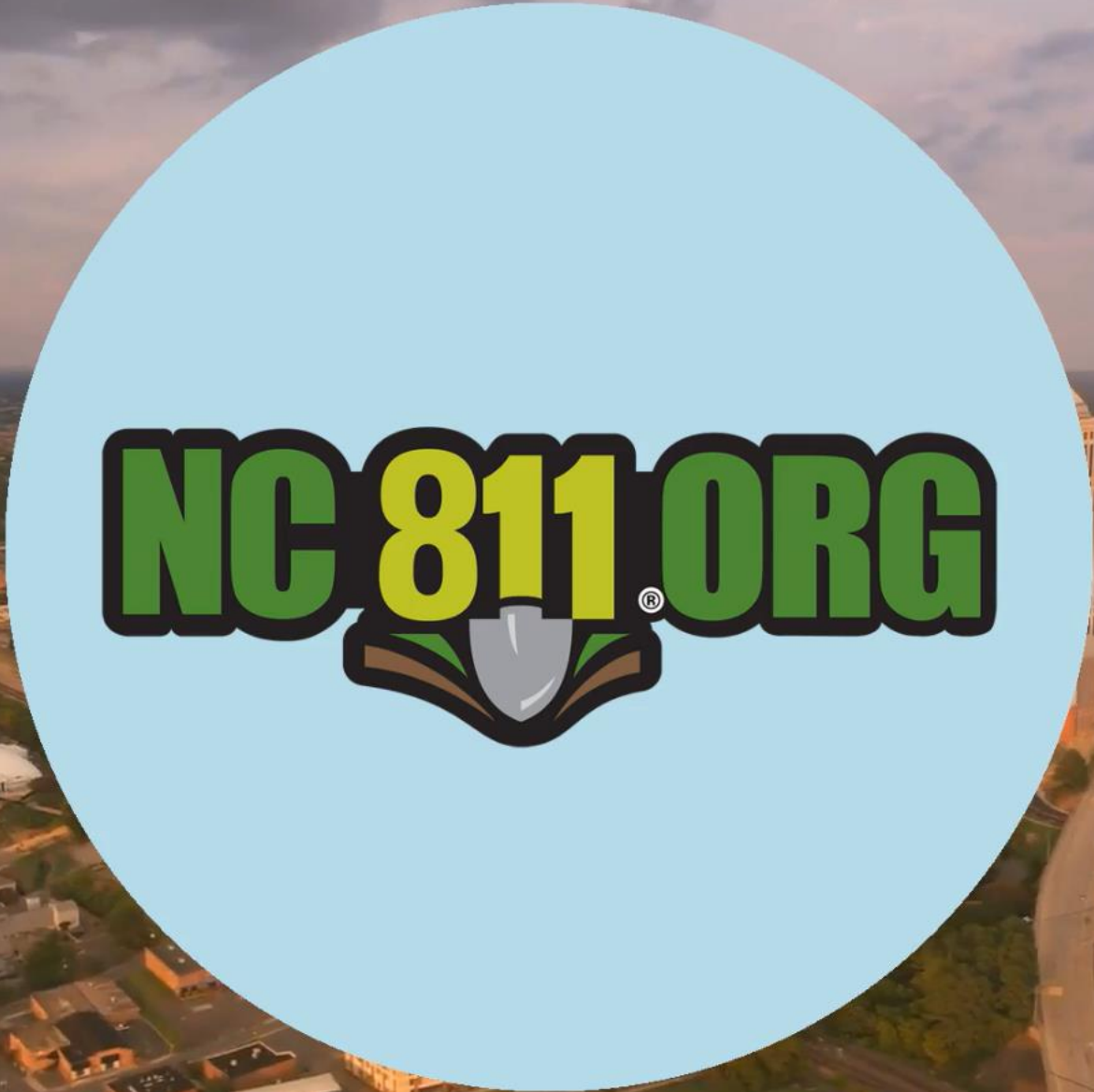

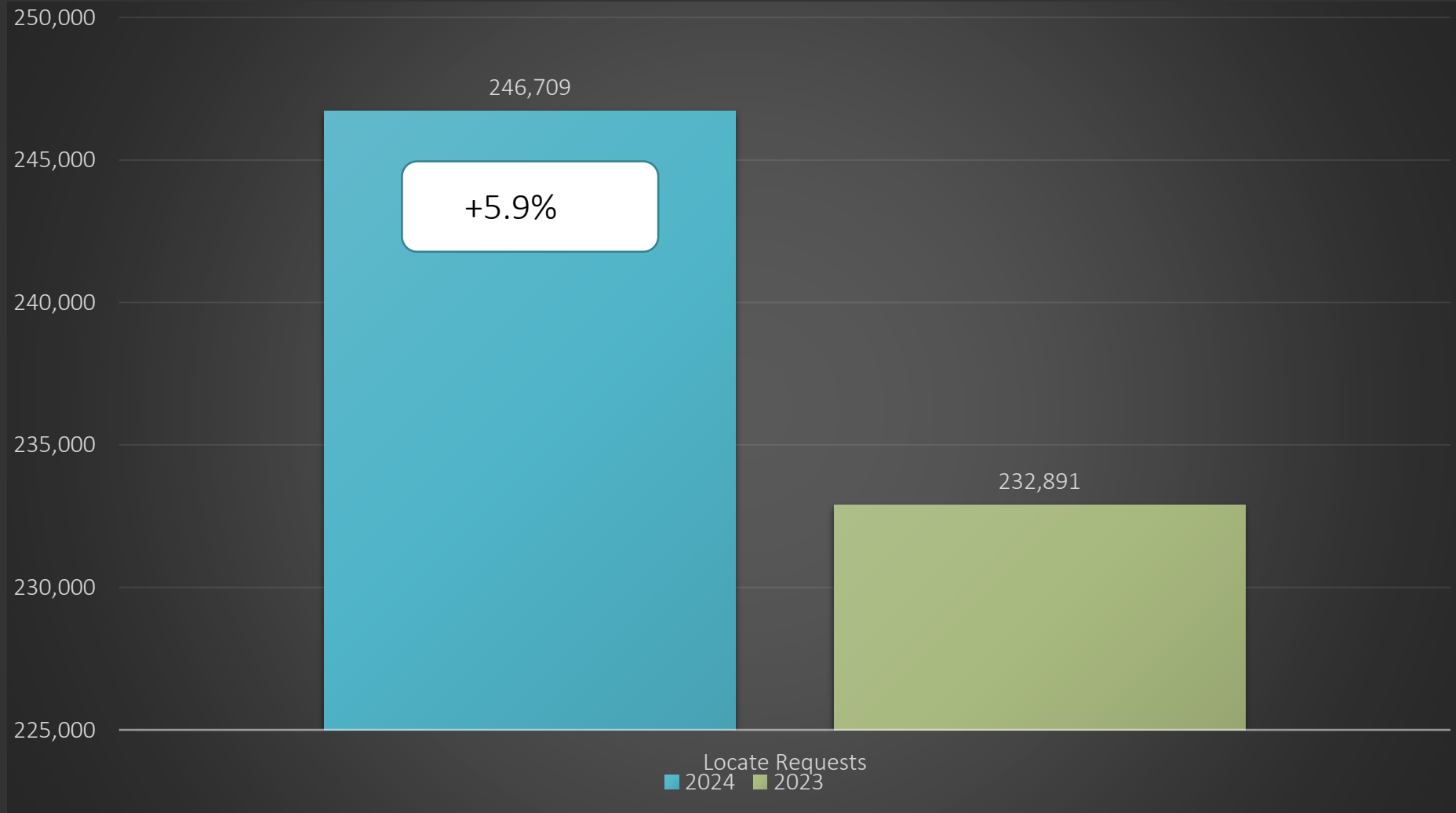

# Locate Requests for NC - May 2024 vs 2023

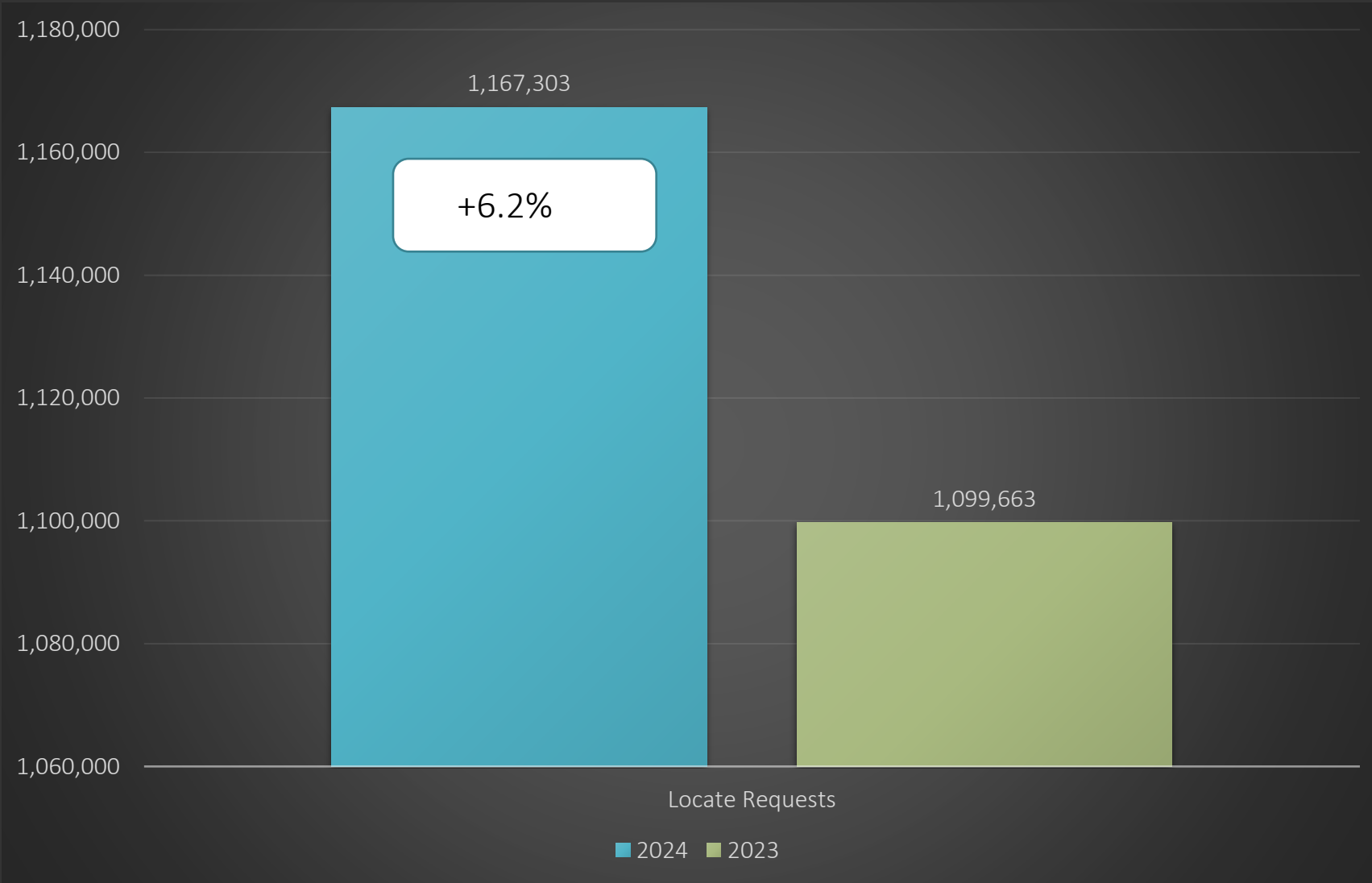


MTD May 2024 – 246,709 / 2023 – 232,891=(5.9%)

Updates for March 2024 – (79,139) = 32.1% of volume / April 31% = -1.1% (Increase the month before)

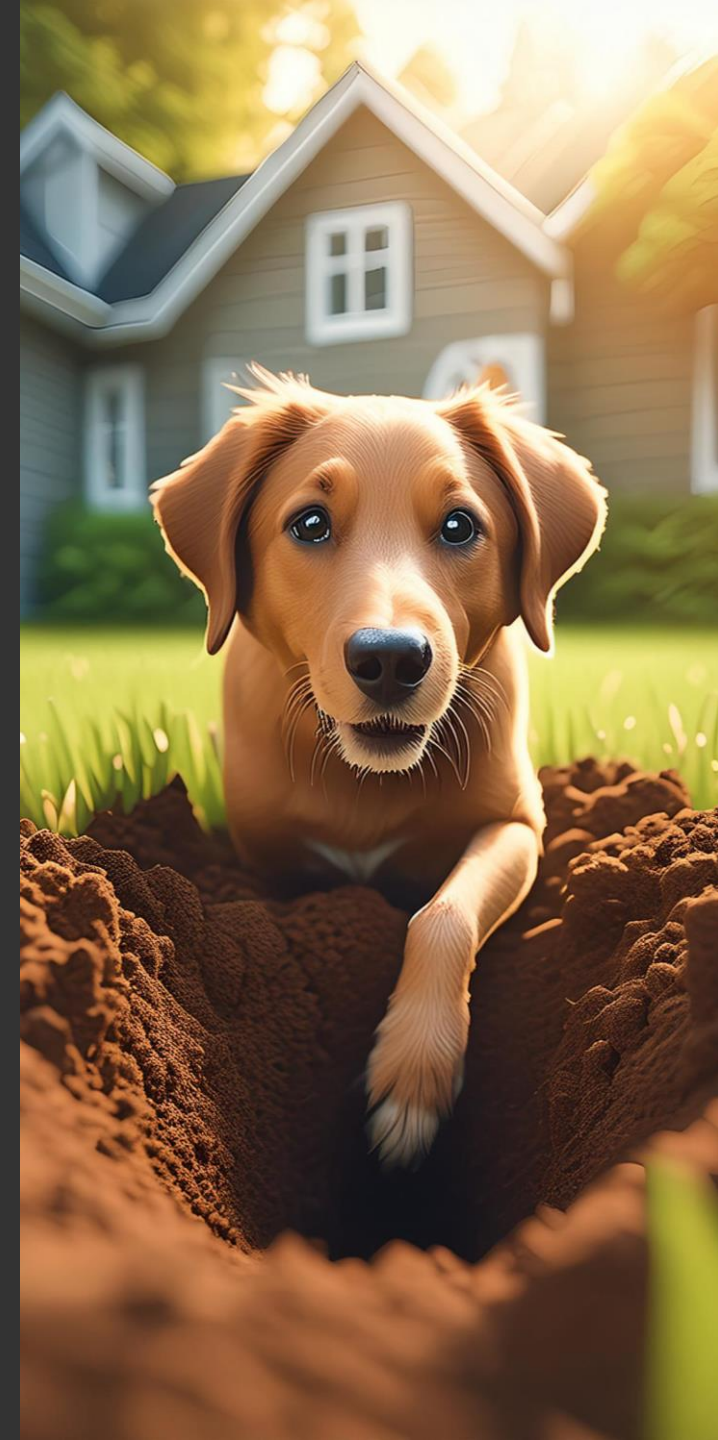
# Locate Requests for NC - YTD



MTD May 2024 – 246,709 / 2023 – 232,891=(5.9%)

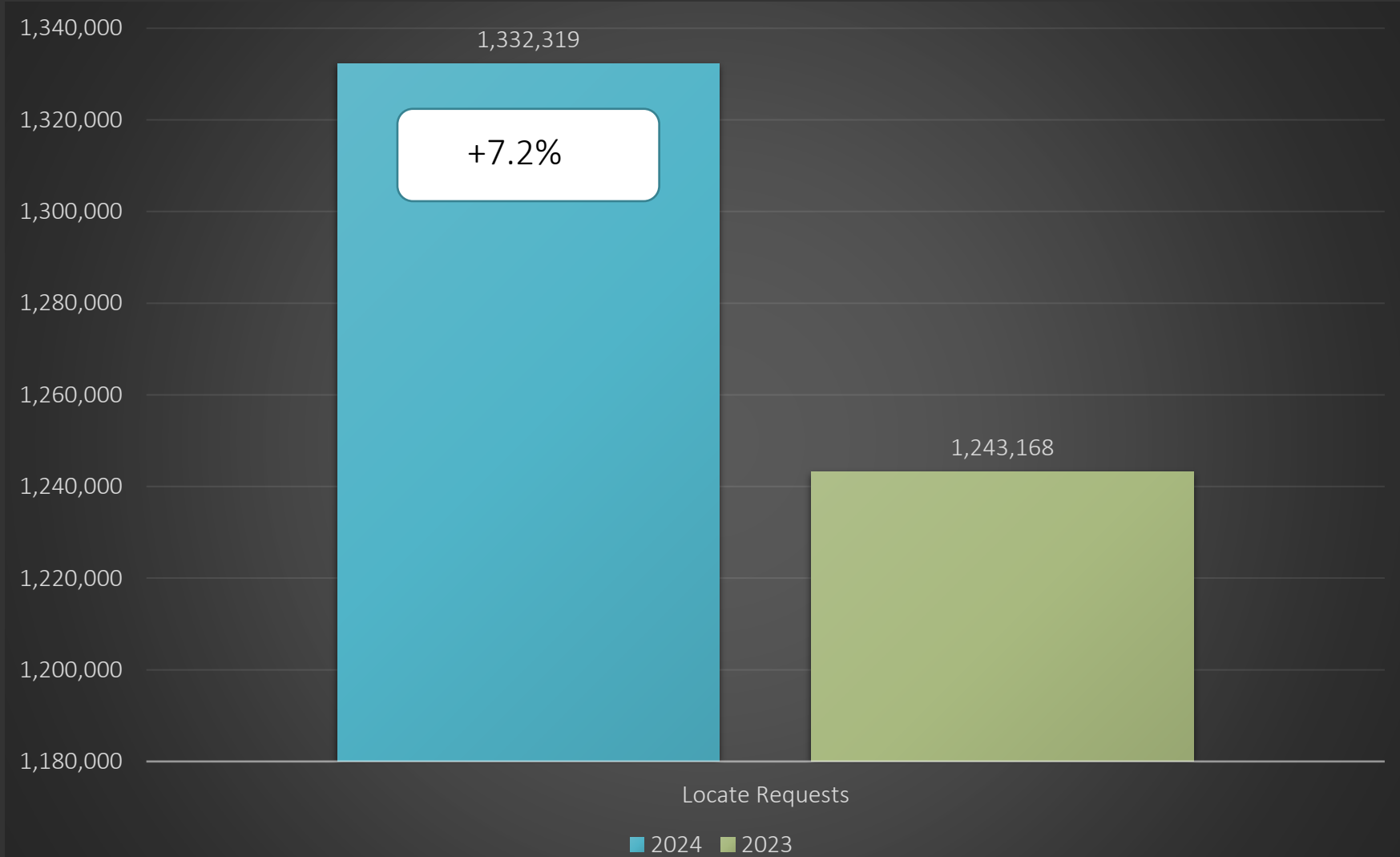
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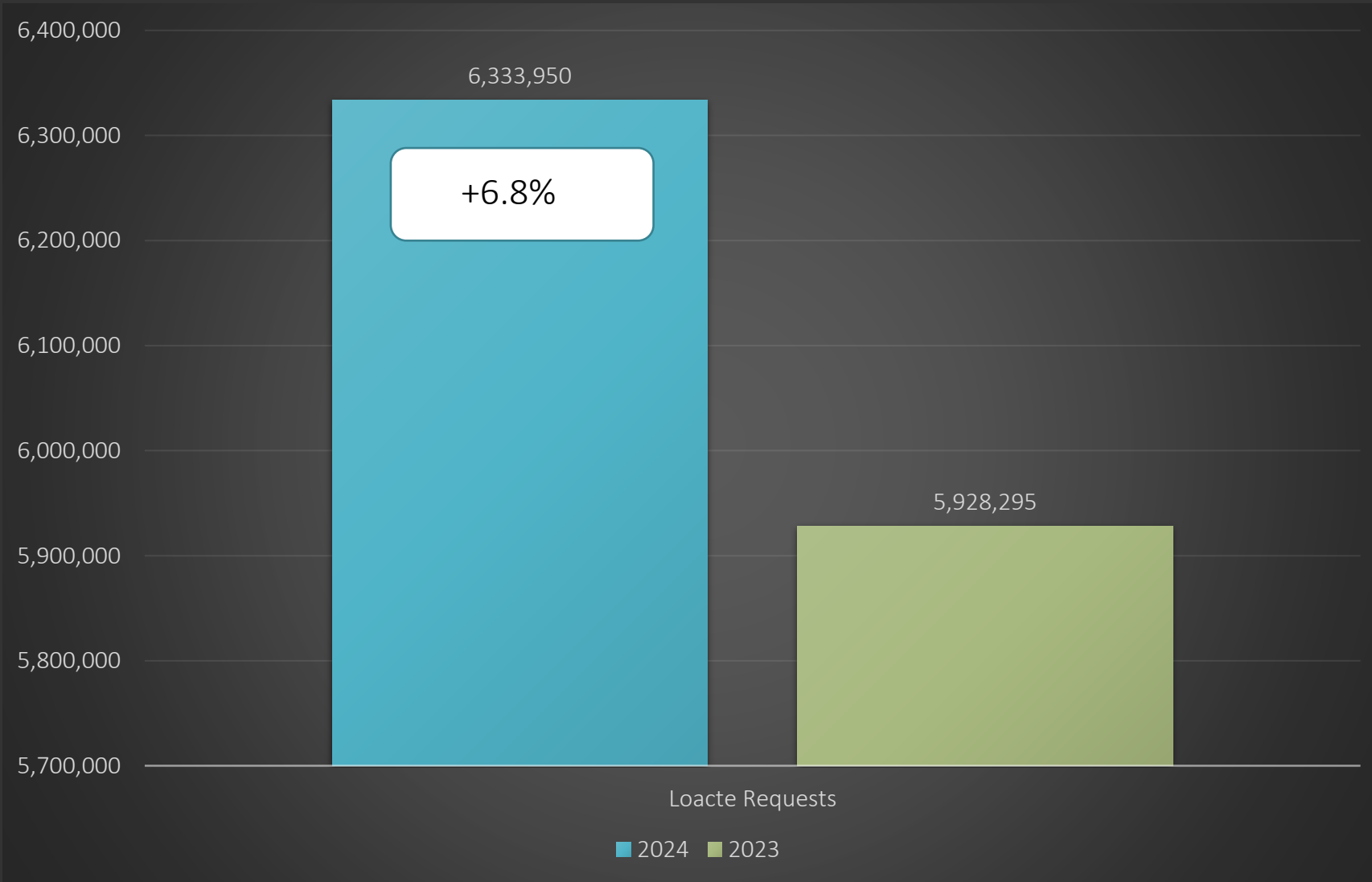


# Transmissions for NC - May 24 vs 23

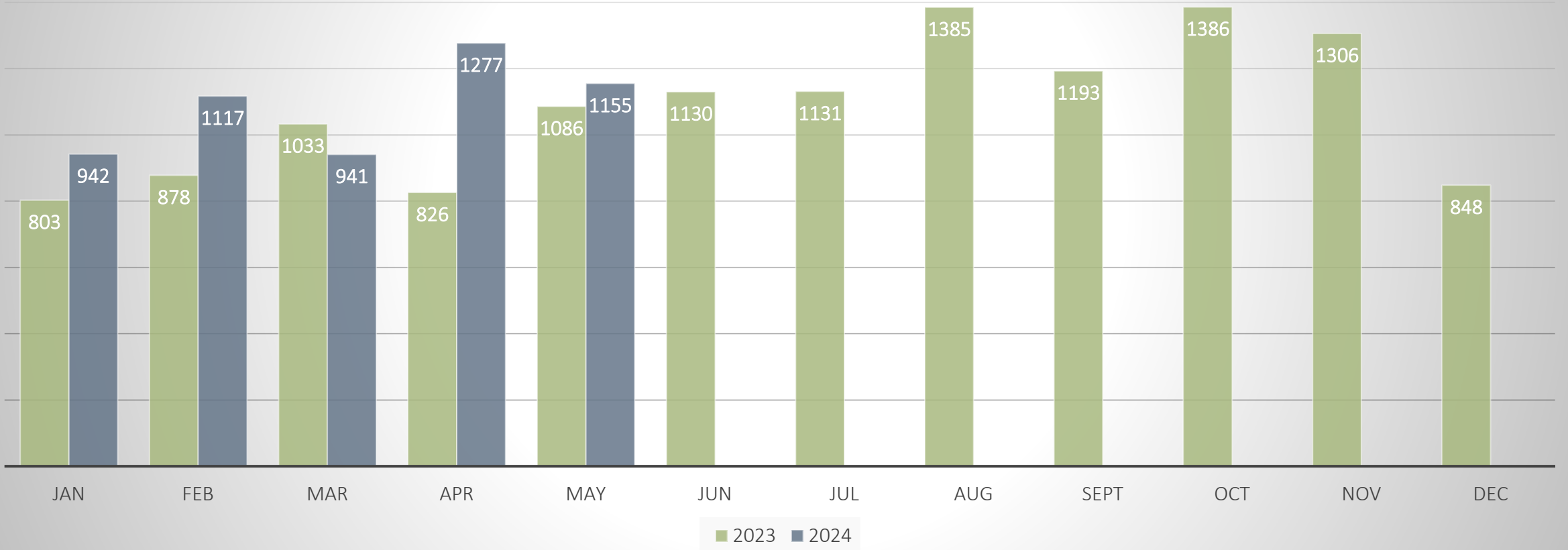

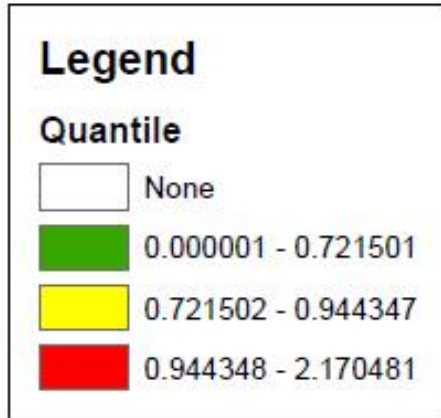
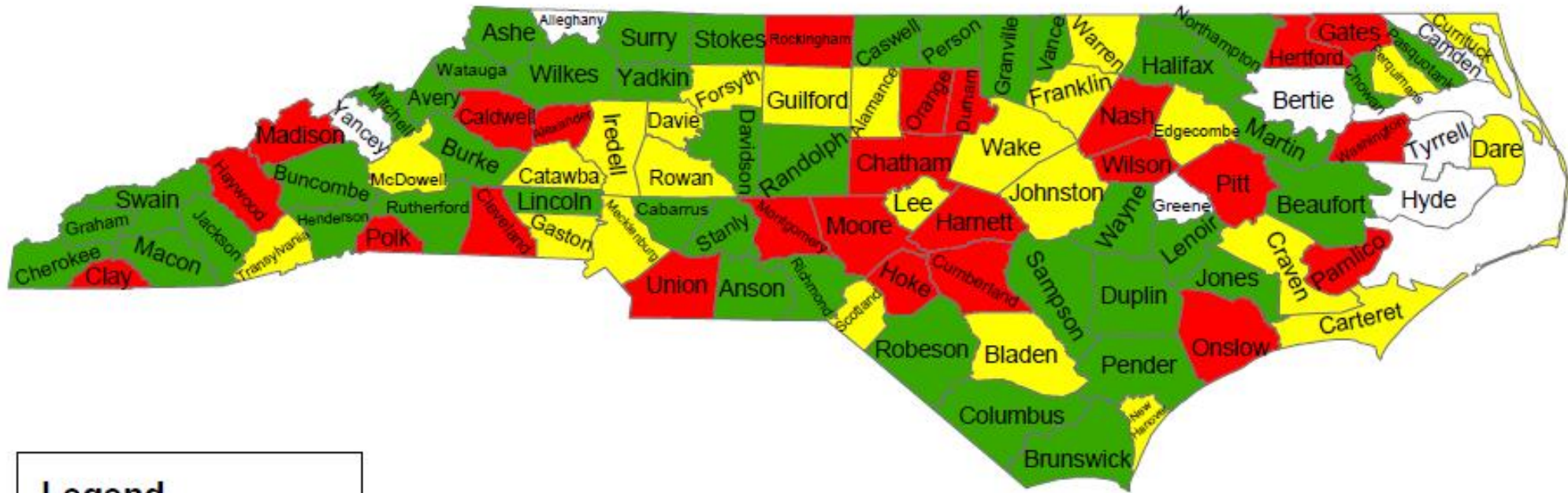
