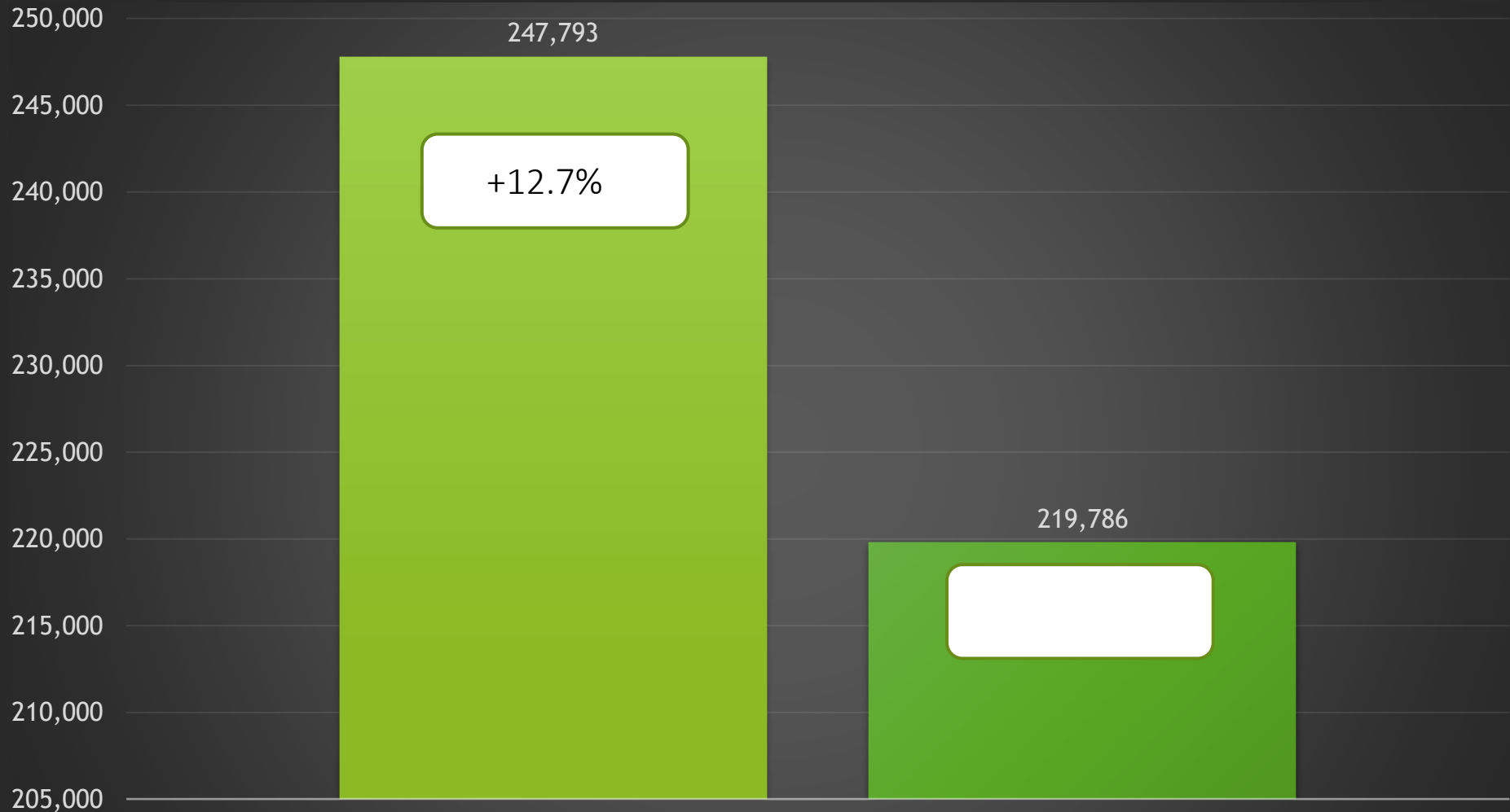

# Locate Requests for NC - July 2024 vs 2023



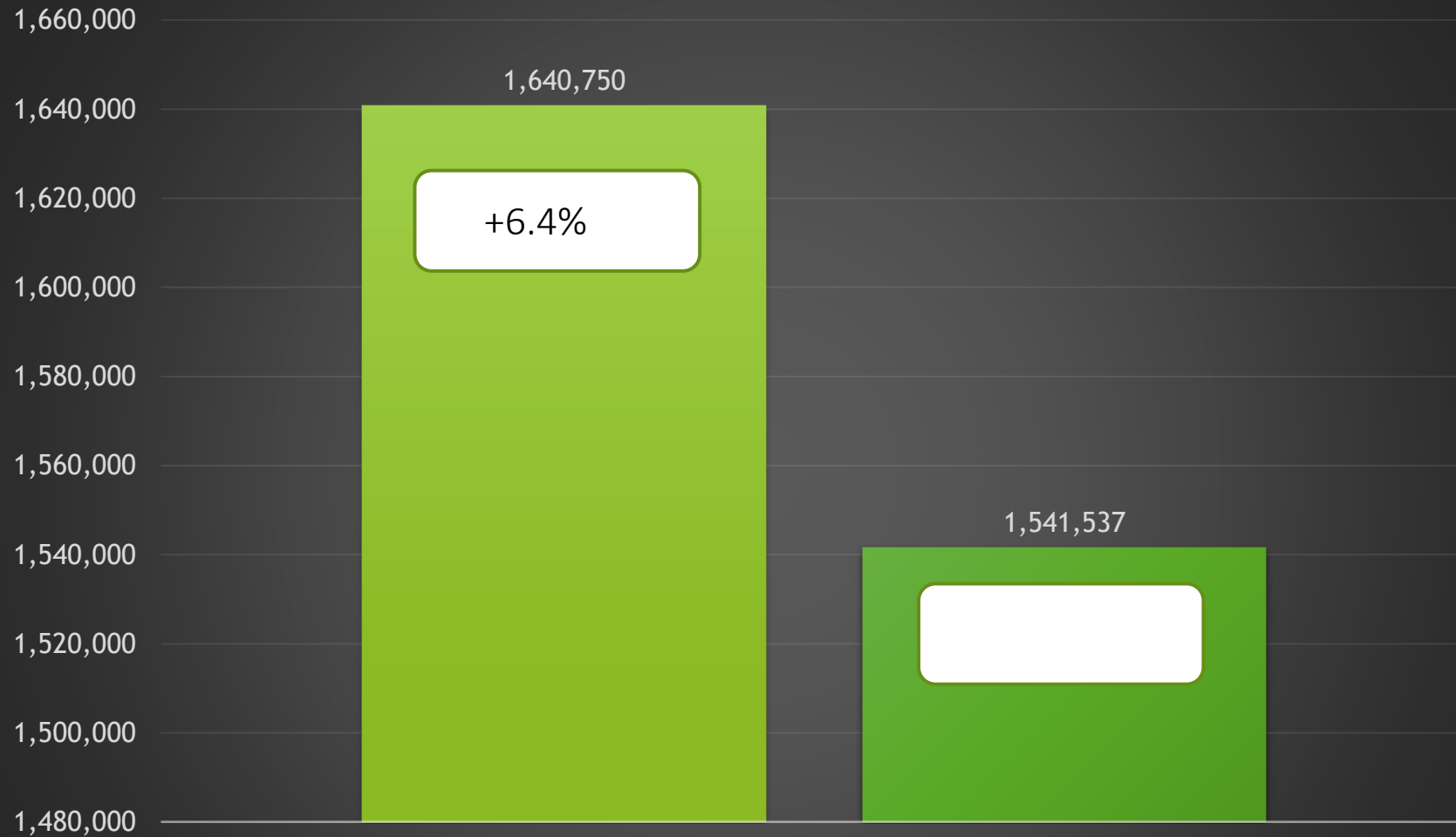
MTD July 2024 - 247,793 / 2023 - 219,786 = (12.7%)

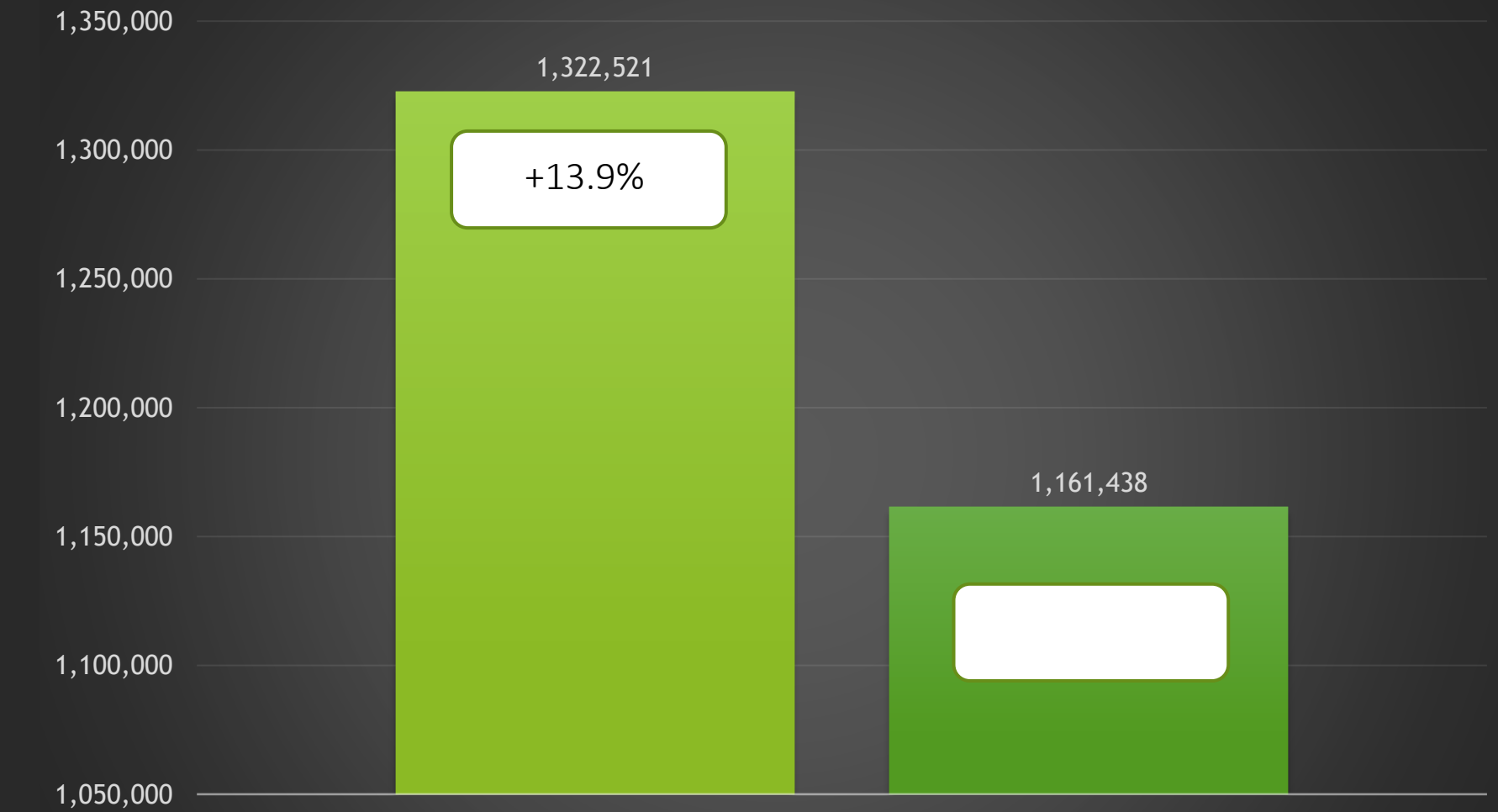

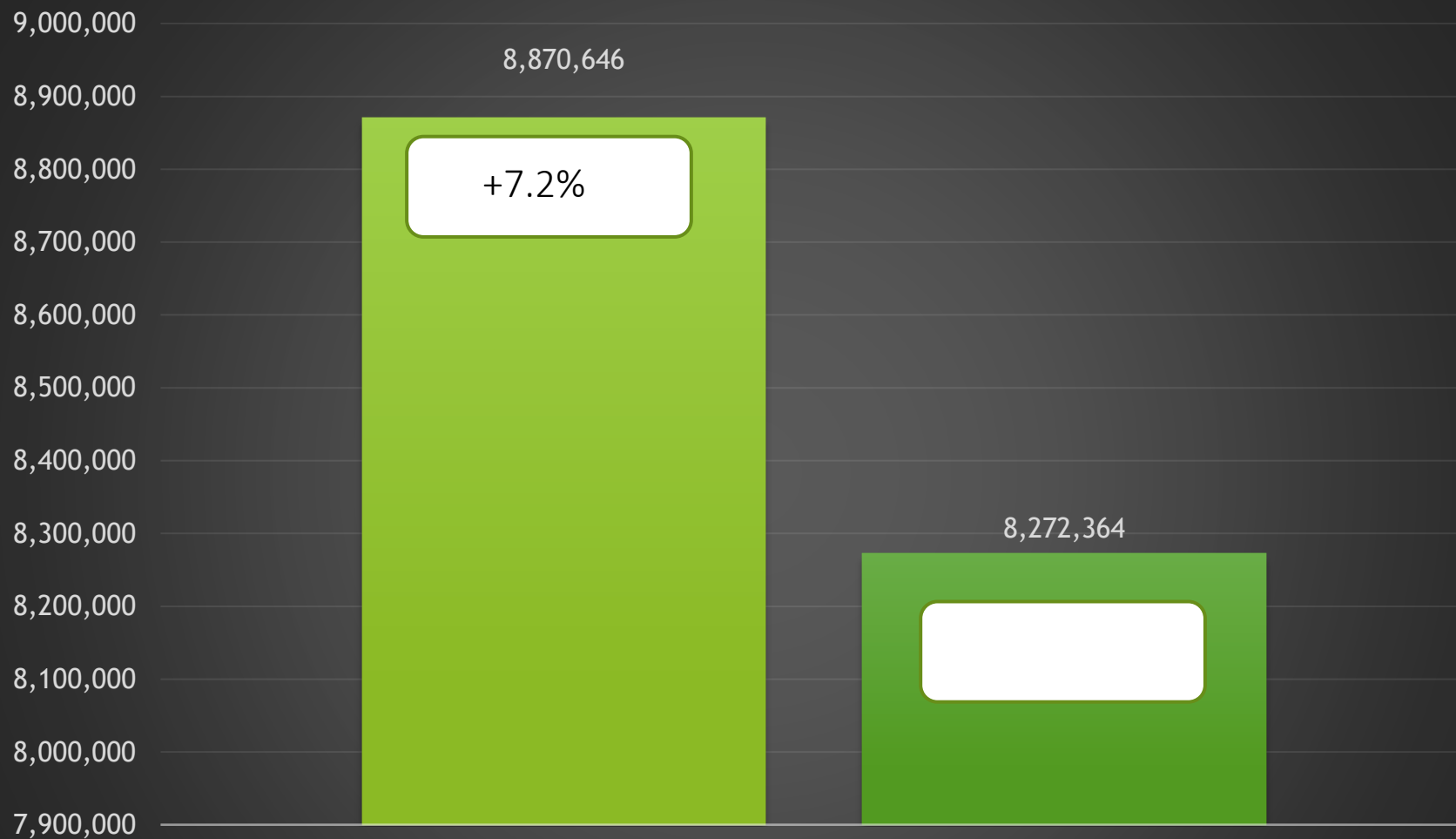

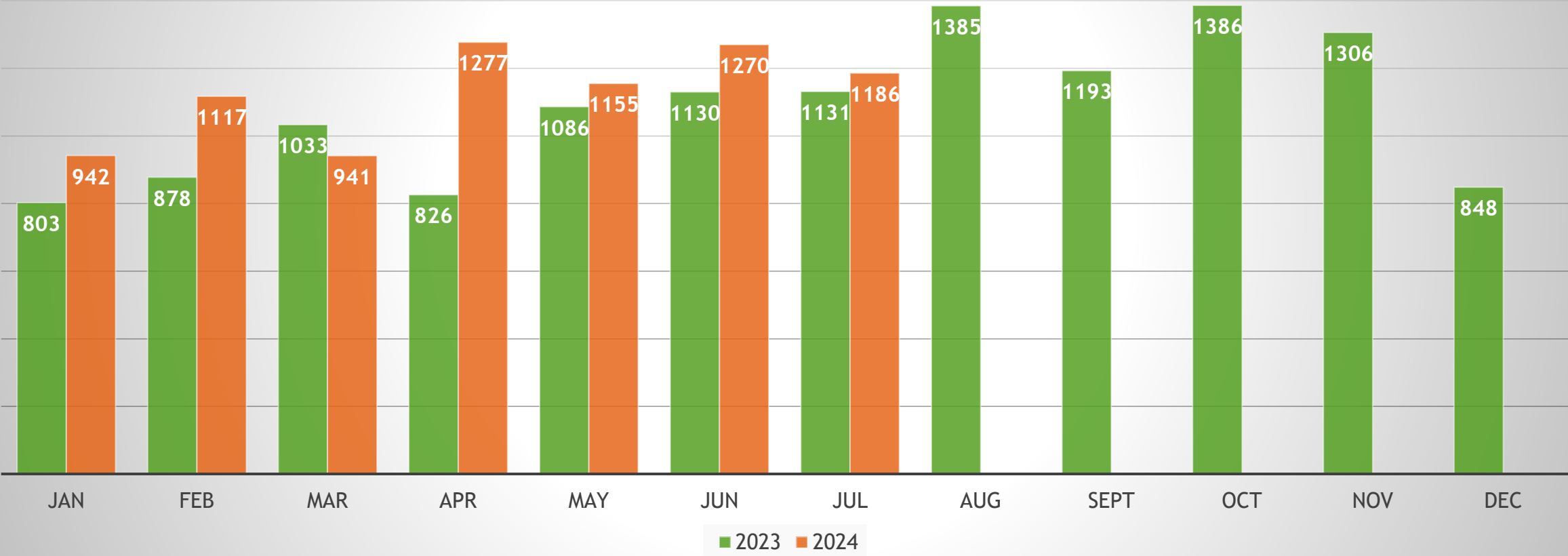
