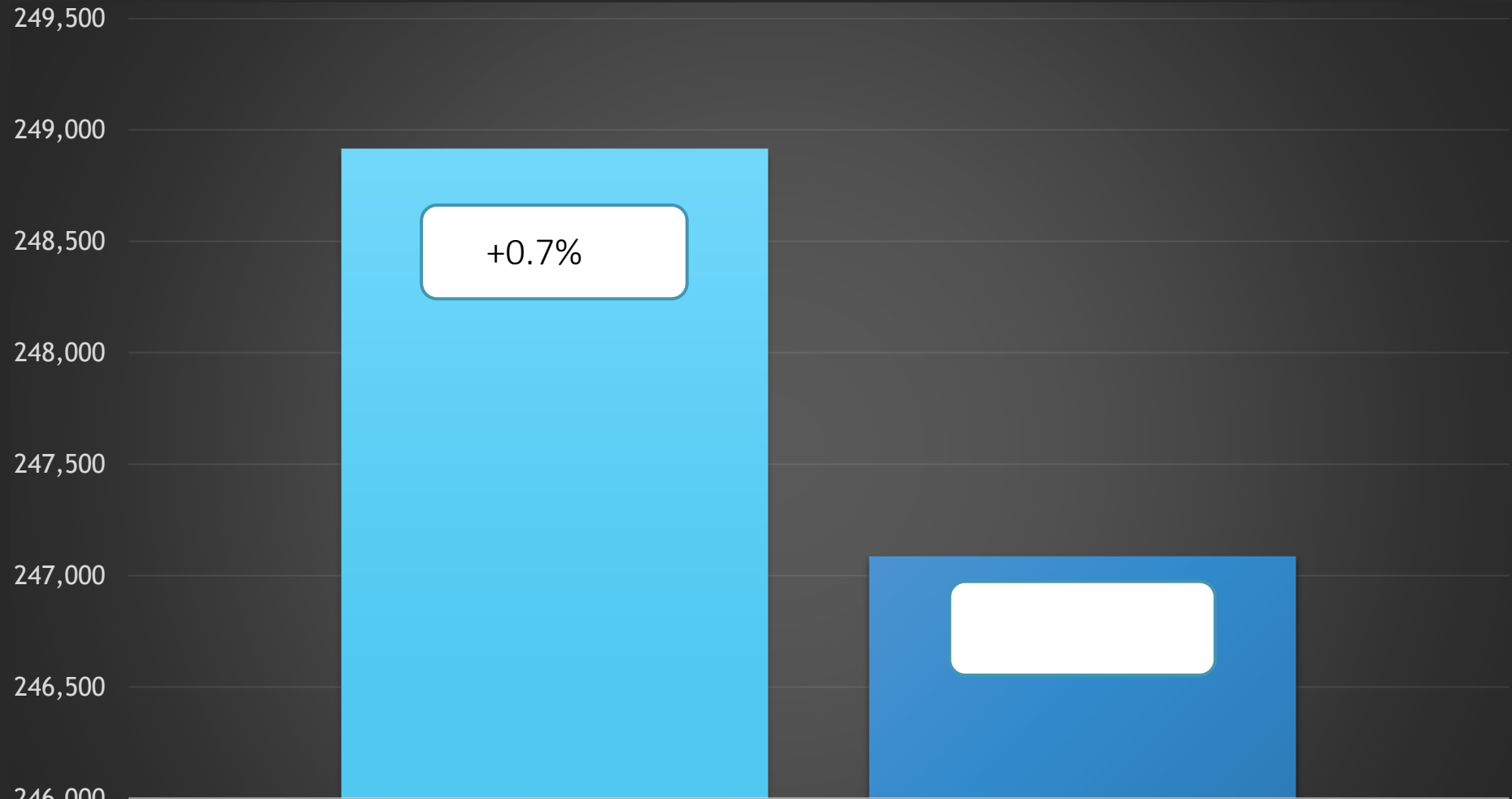


County ticket volume

MTD Aug 2024 - 248,916 / 2023 - 247,083 = (0.7%)

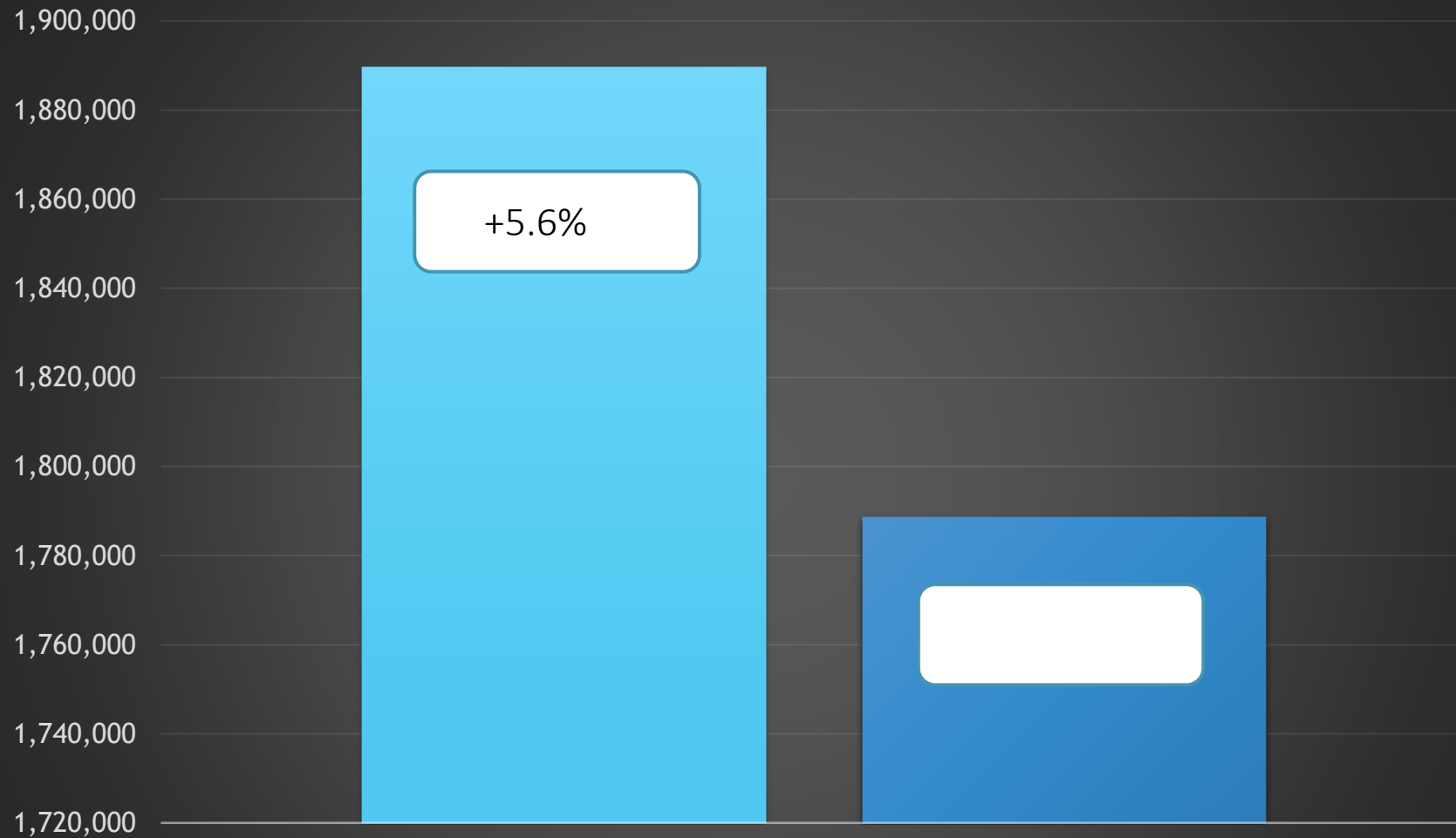
YTD 2024 - 1,889,666 / 2023 - 1,788.620 = +5.6 %

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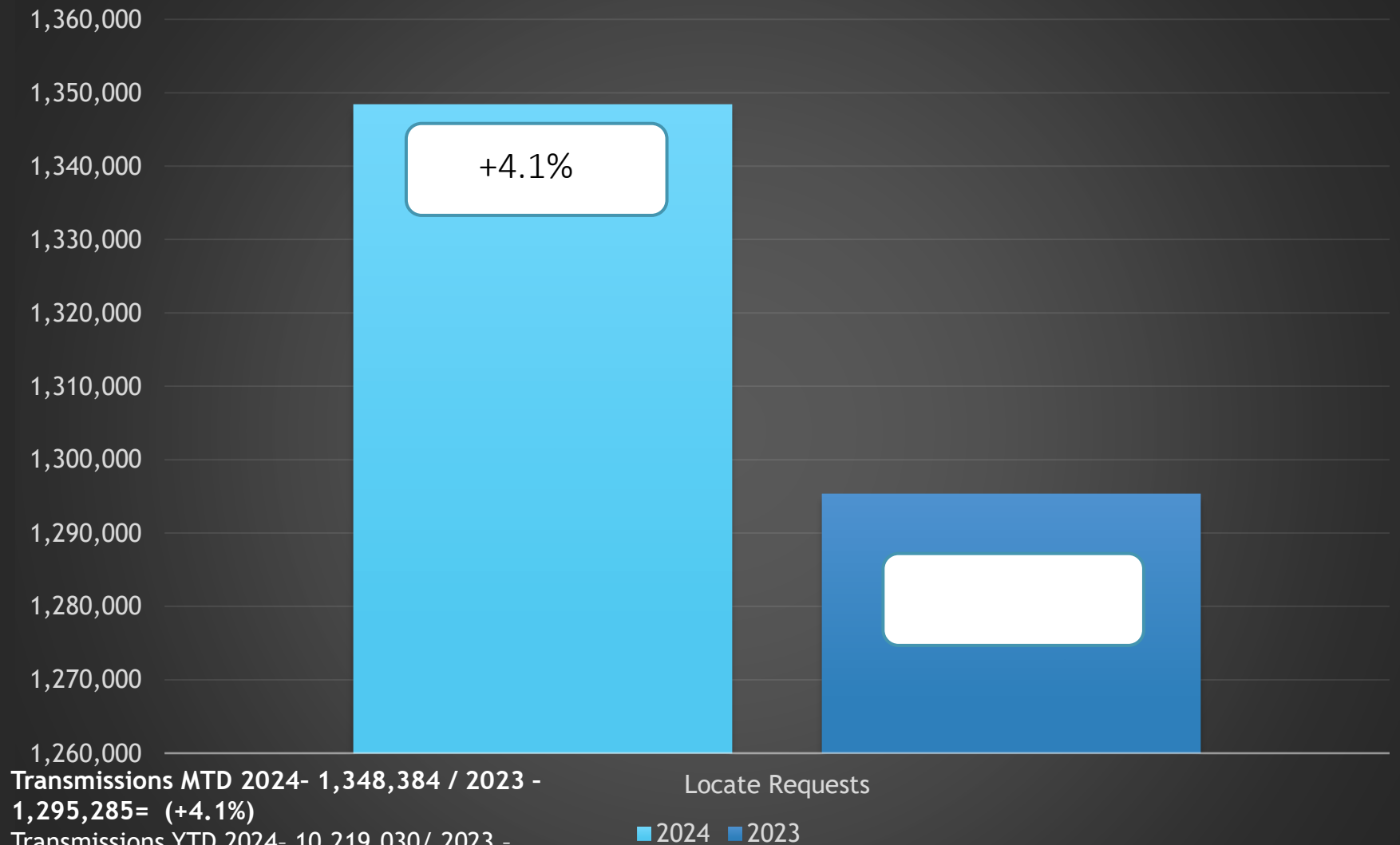

Transmissions for NC - Aug. 24 vs 23



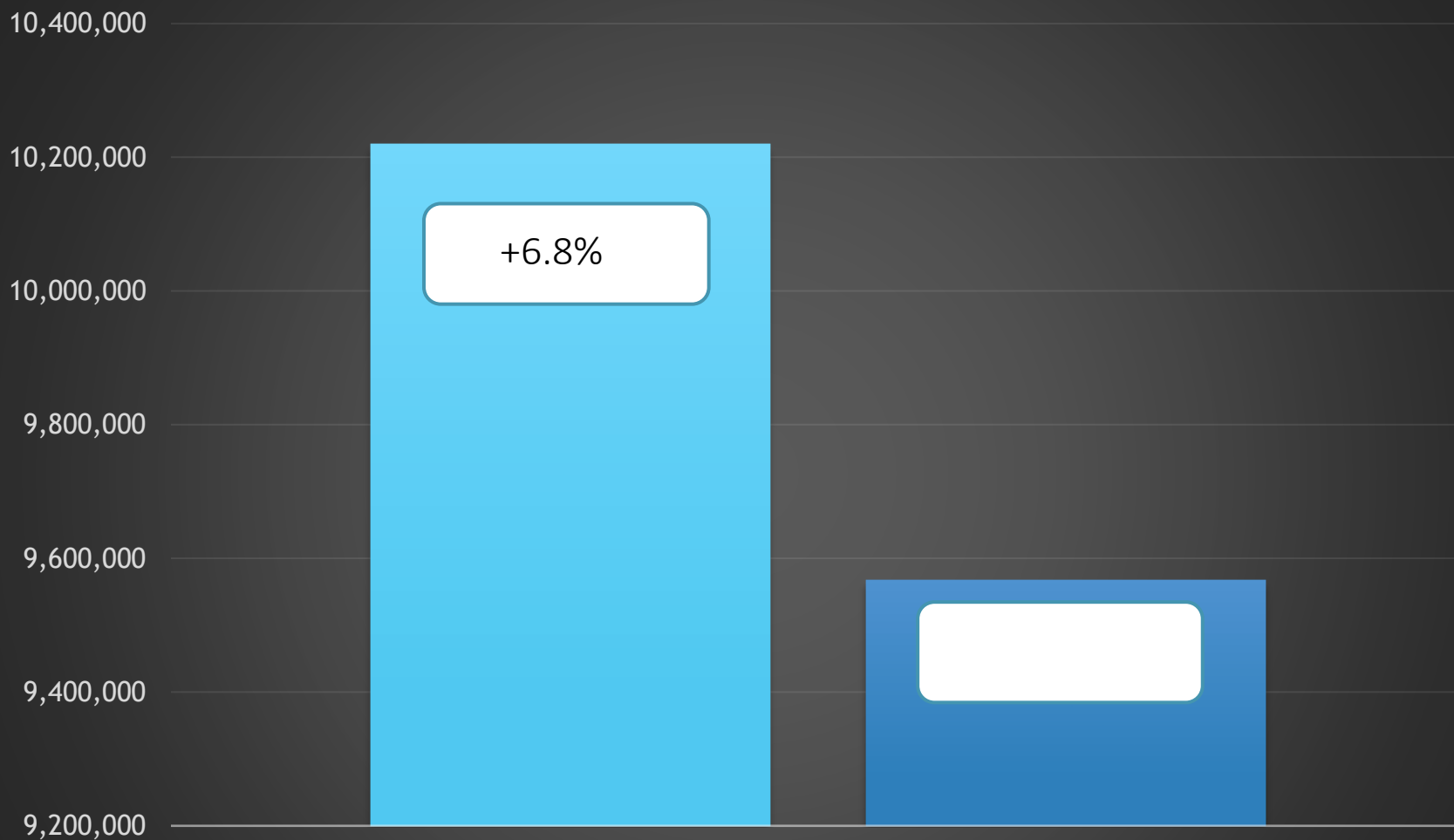
Transmissions MTD 2024- 1,348,384 / 2023 - 1,295,285= (+4.1%)

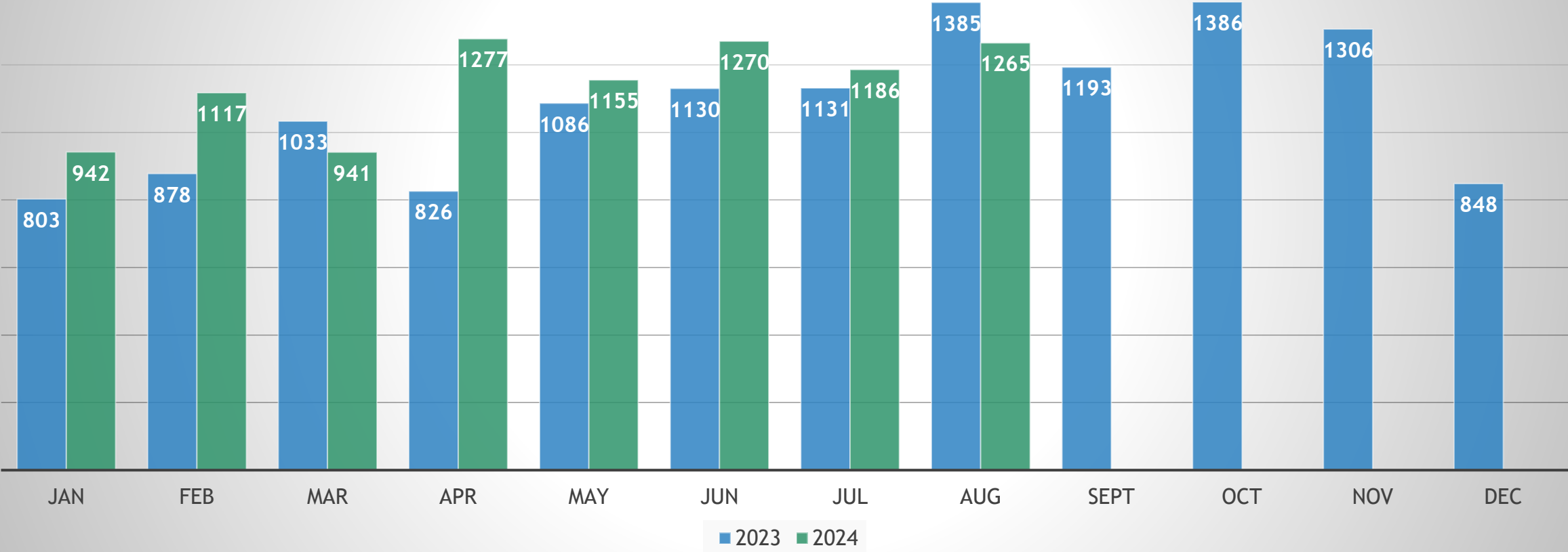
