


Locate Request, Transmissions,
County ticket volume and distribution




## Locate Requests for NC

### December 2023 vs 2022












### Transmissions for NC

# December 2023 vs 2022






Transmissions MTD 2023 – 998,892 / 2022 – 915,621= +9.1%




