







County ticket volume and distribution



Locate Requests for NC - Oct 24 vs 23











Transmissions for NC - Oct 24 vs 23



Transmissions for NC - YTD 2024









County ticket Volume 2024 vs 2023






County ticket Volume YTD VS PREVIOUS YEAR






