


Locate Requests for NC - Dec 24 vs 23







Locate Requests for NC - YTD







Transmissions for NC – Dec 24 vs 23




Transmissions MTD 2024- 1,094,058 / 2023 - 998,892= (9.5%)






Damages Per 1,000 Transmissions
