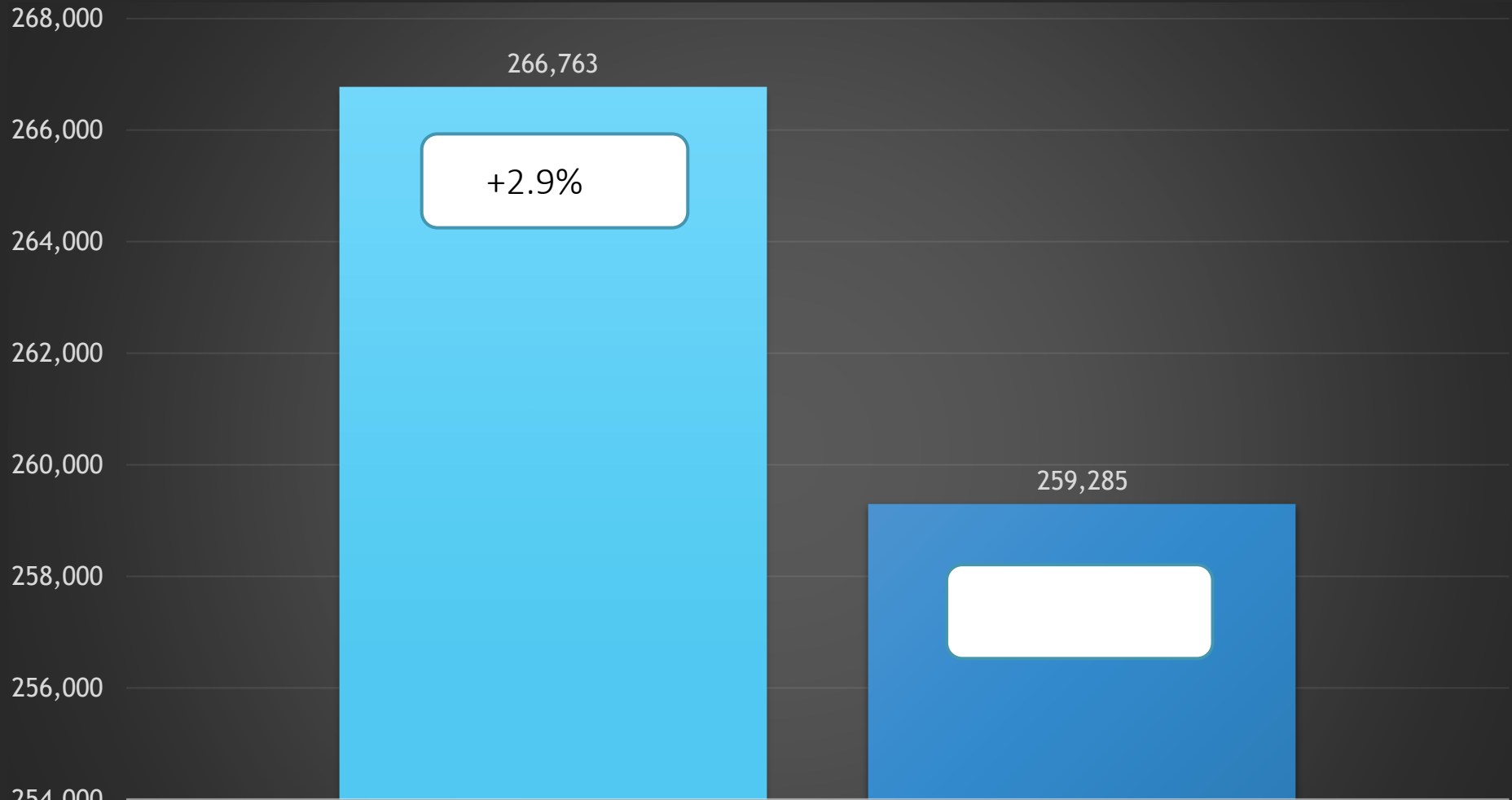

MTD Oct. 2024 - 266,763 / 2023 - 259,285 = (2.9%)

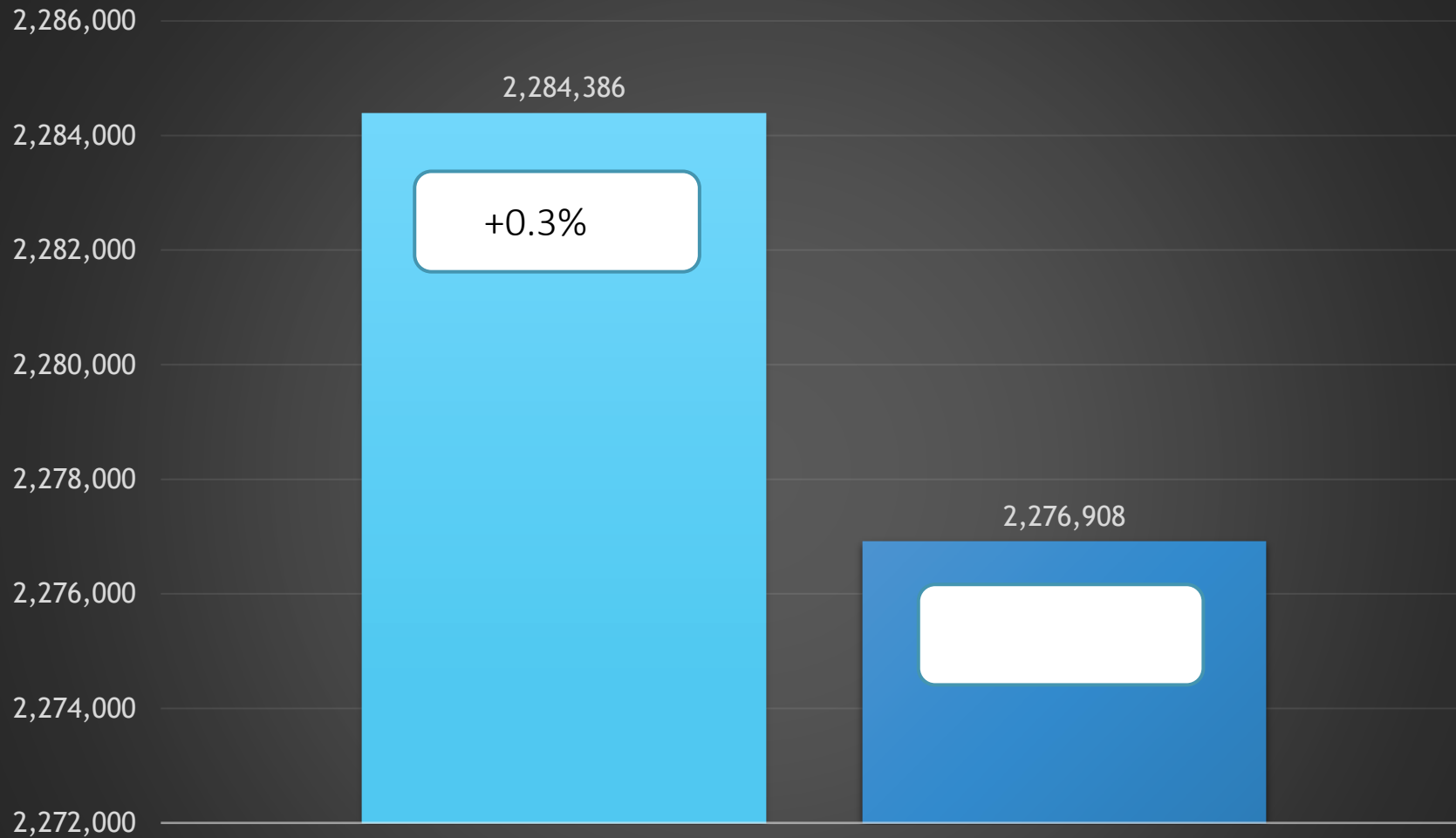
YTD 2024 - 2,284,386 / 2023 - 2,276,908 = +0.3%

Updates for Oct 2024 - (83,245) = 31.2% of volume / Sept 2024 = 31.1% (0.1% Increase from the month before)

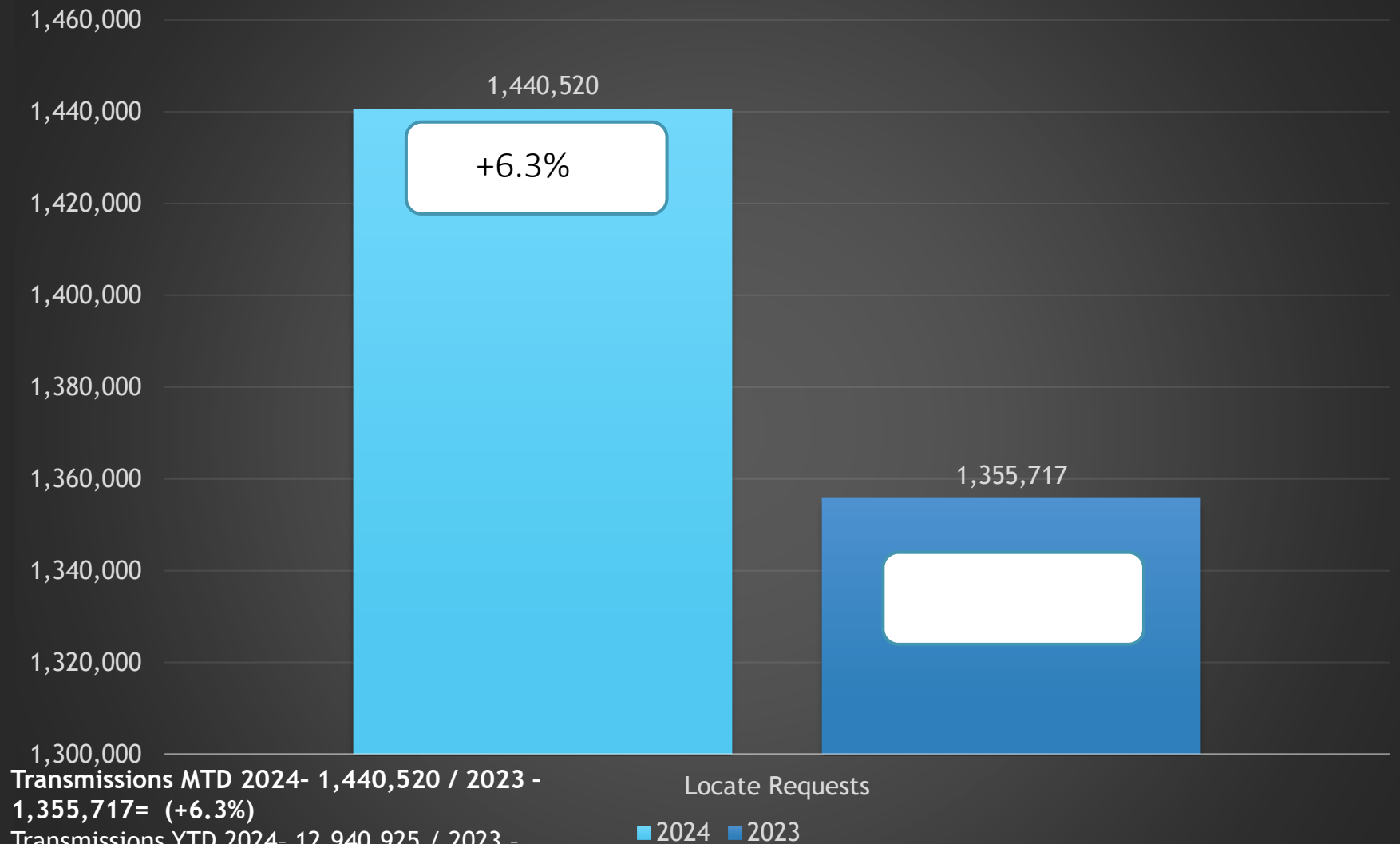
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# Transmissions for NC - Oct 24 vs 23



Transmissions MTD 2024- 1,440,520 / 2023 - 1,355,717= (+6.3%)

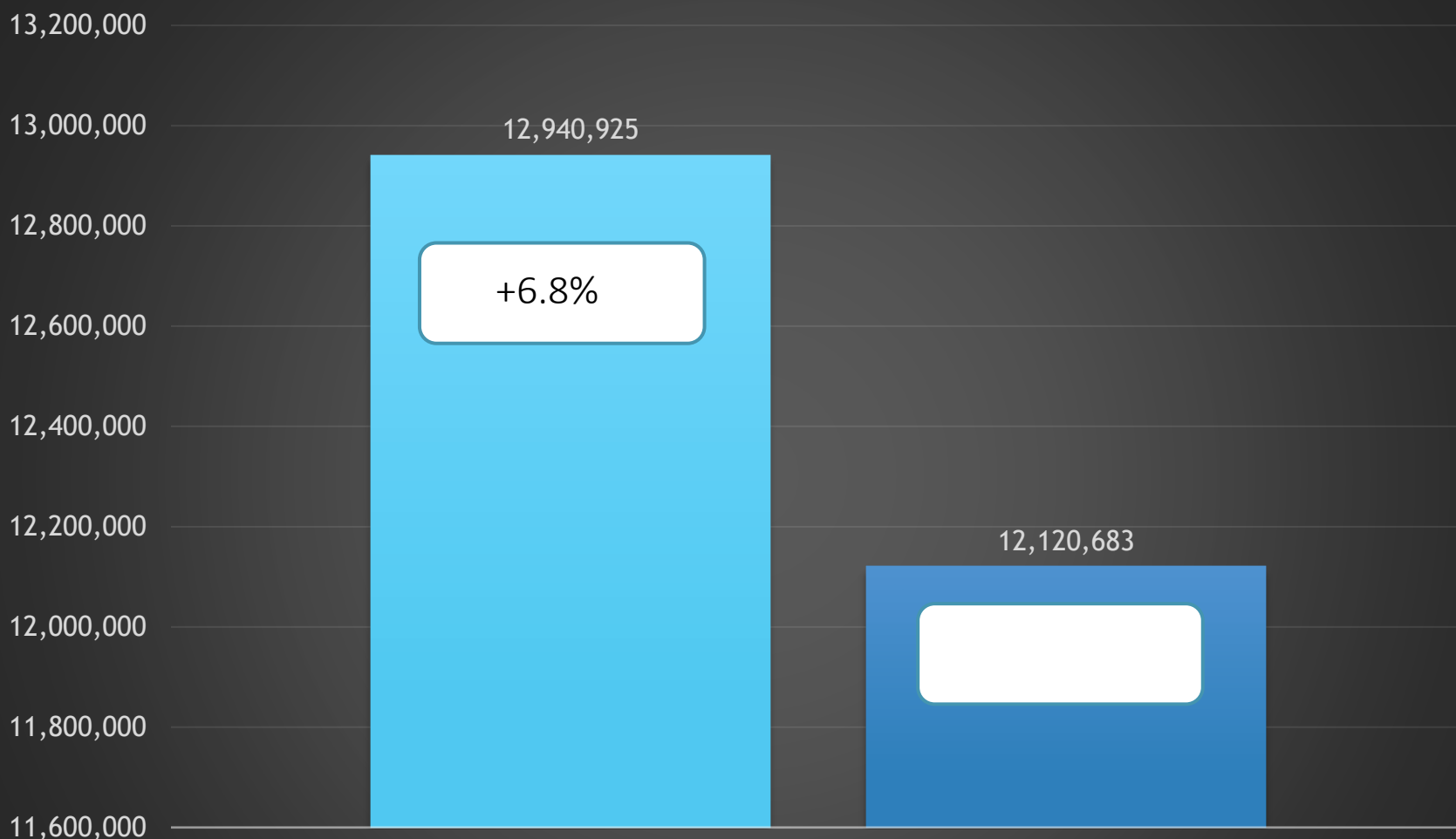
Transmissions YTD 2024- 12,940,925 / 2023 - 12,120,683= +6.8%

# Transmissions for NC - YTD 2024

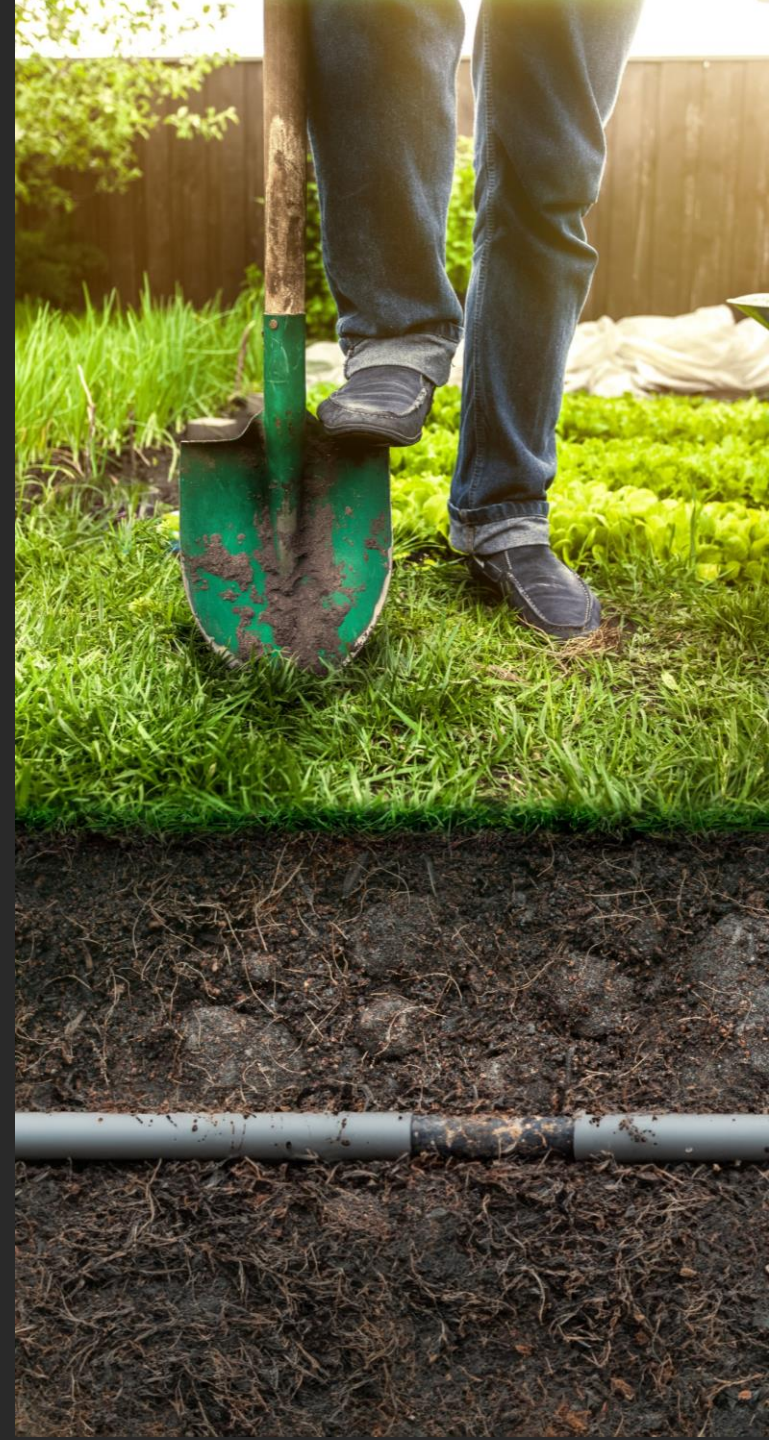

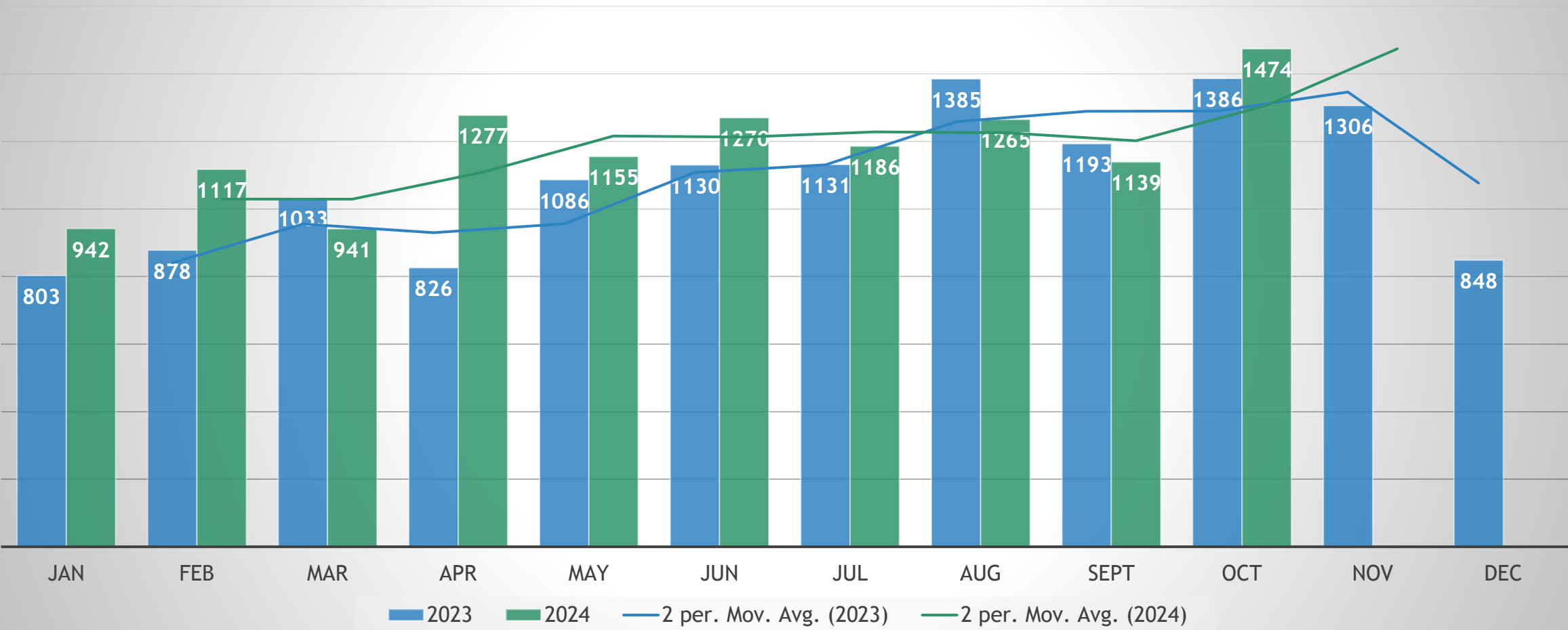
