### **Projects InProgress**

1. 251 Industrial Blvd. (Metallix): Abandon 2" PE main crossing Industrial Blvd., remove old gas meter, and reconnect 2" PE service from back building.
2. New Hope Road (Pitt County Detention Center): 4" PE main installation along New Hope Road and access road from Industrial Blvd., install 2" PE service lines.
3. E. 3<sup>rd</sup> Street (Cypress Glen): Connect new 4" PE to the existing 2" W/S on E. 3<sup>rd</sup> St.
4. NC 11 North (8" PE Main Extension): Mears Group, Inc is installing 8" PE for the GUC Gas Department along NC 11 North, Staton Mill Road, and NC 903. This work includes 2 J&B under the CSX Railroad crossing Staton Mill and 903 and trenching from Independence Blvd to the by-pass.
5. Build Grant Project: Contractor working at several locations along 5th Street. The Gas Department is performing gas relocations as requested from the contractor.
6. Beddard Road, Grimesland (Laurel Oaks Subdivision): 2" PE service extension
7. MacGregor Downs Rd. (GUC Electric Substation): 4" PE main installation, service is to supply gas to GUC generators.
8. Sugg Parkway (Apple Park: Mr. Beast): 2" PE gas services
9. E. Evans Street (Hilton): Completing service in alley way and renewing gas valve at Cotanche St.
10. GUC LNG Facility- Expansion

and distribution



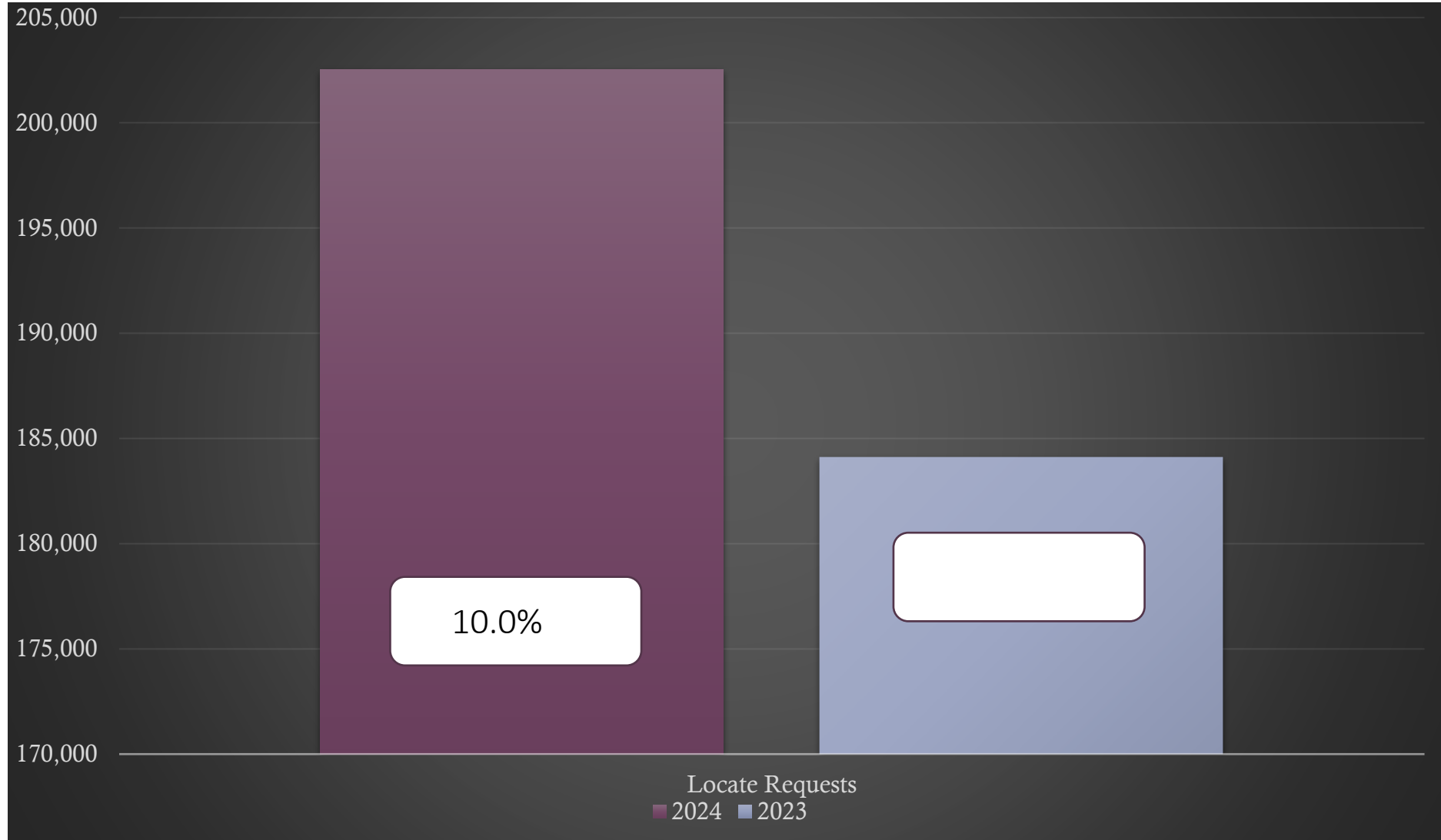


# Locate Requests for NC - Dec 24 vs 23

Dec. 2023 - 184,086 = (10.0%)

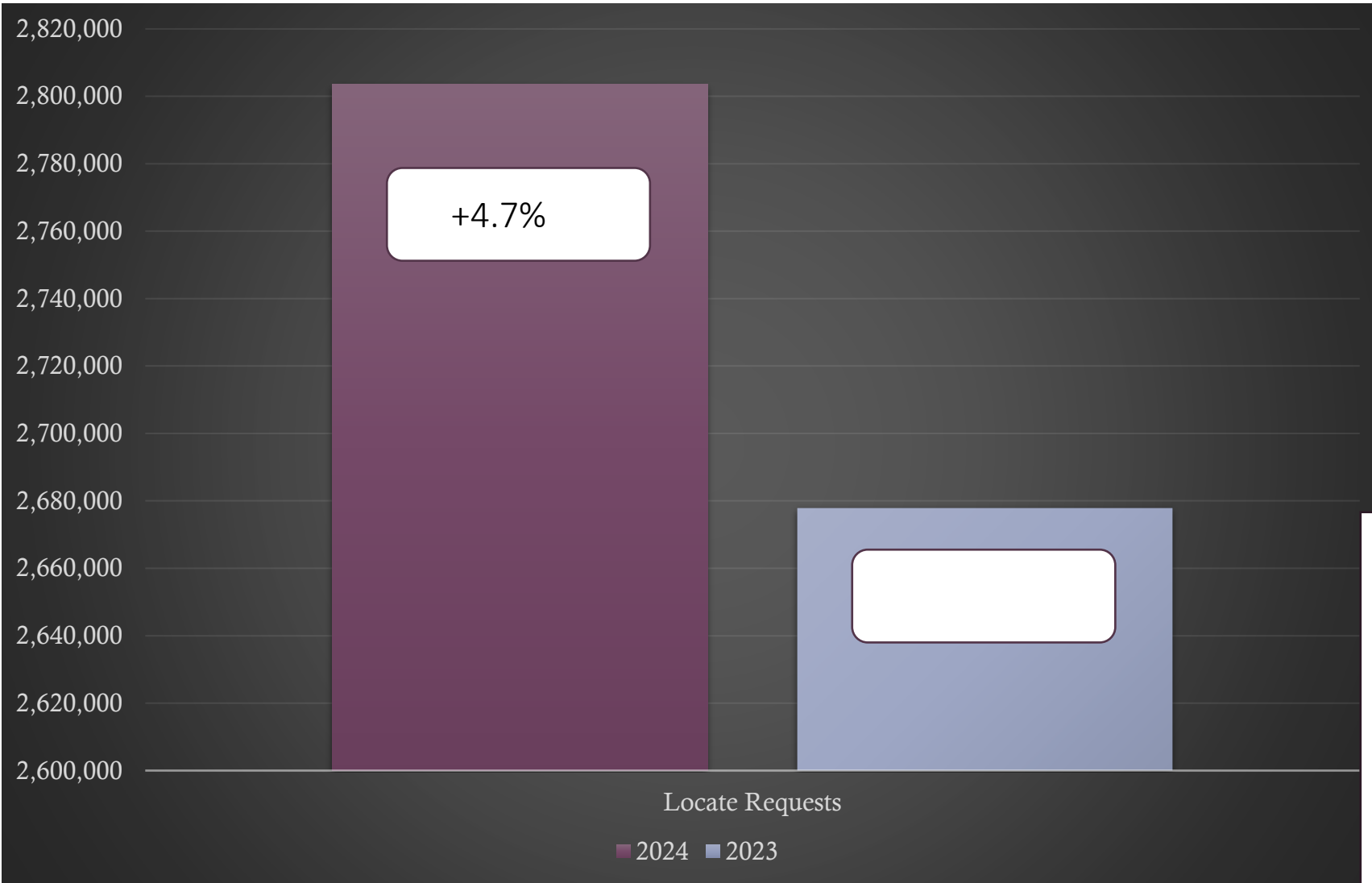
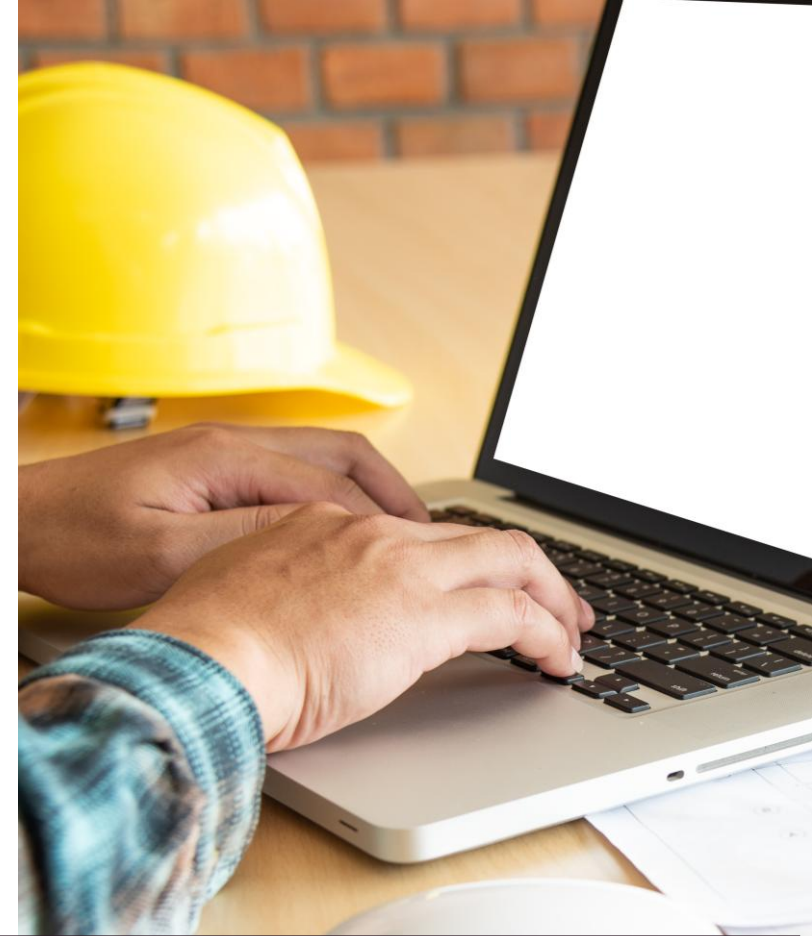

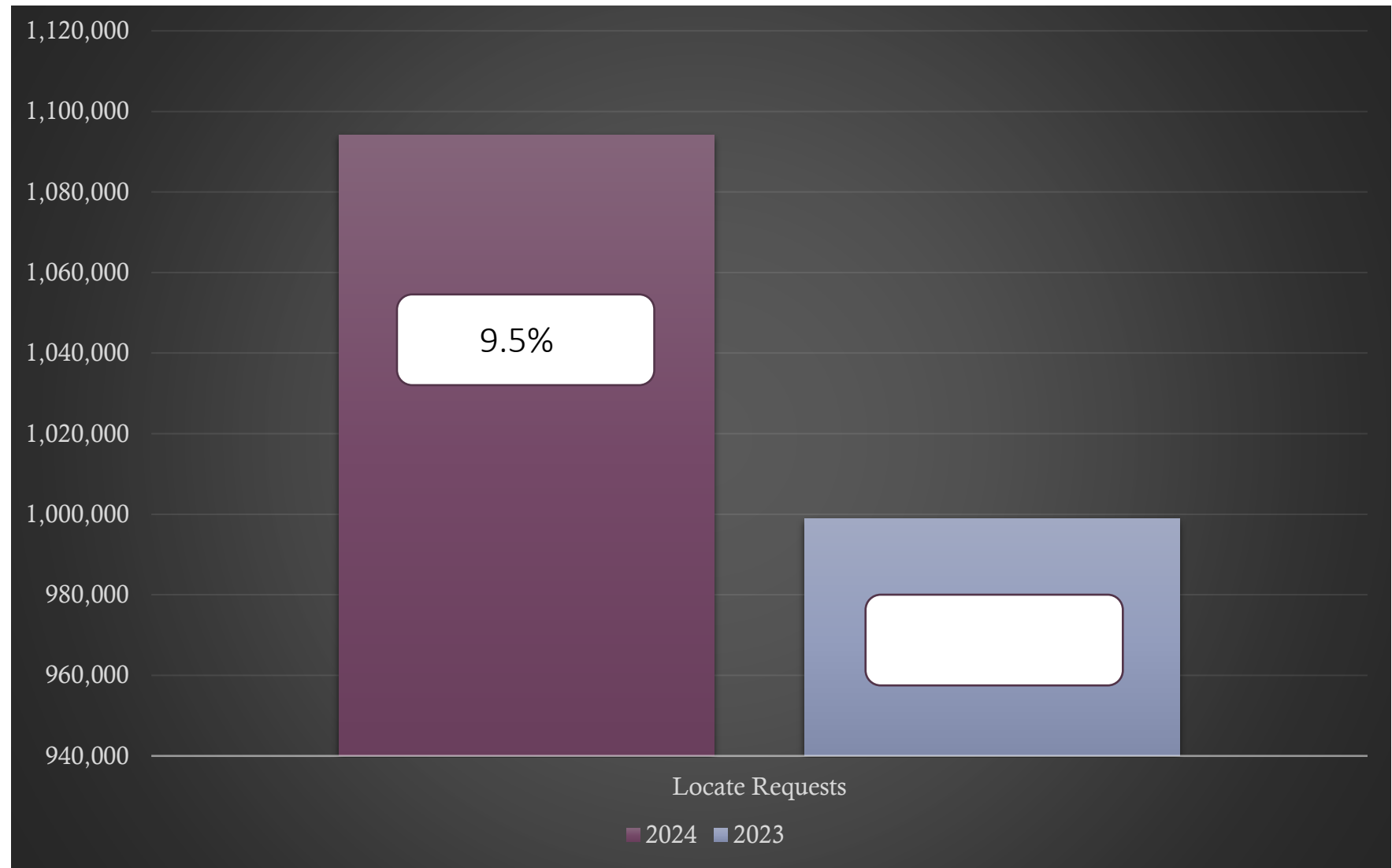

# Transmissions for NC – Dec 24 vs 23

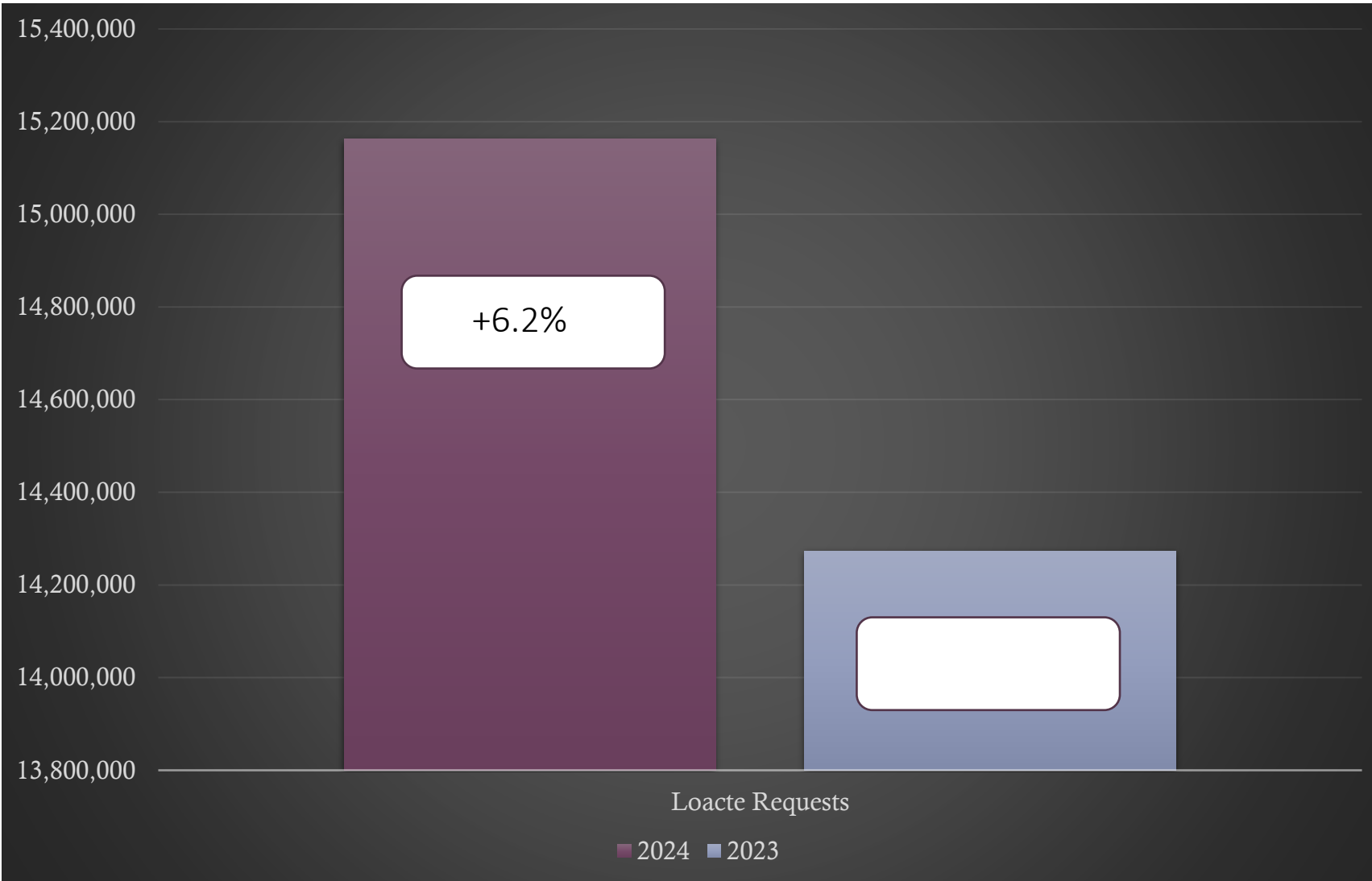


Transmissions MTD

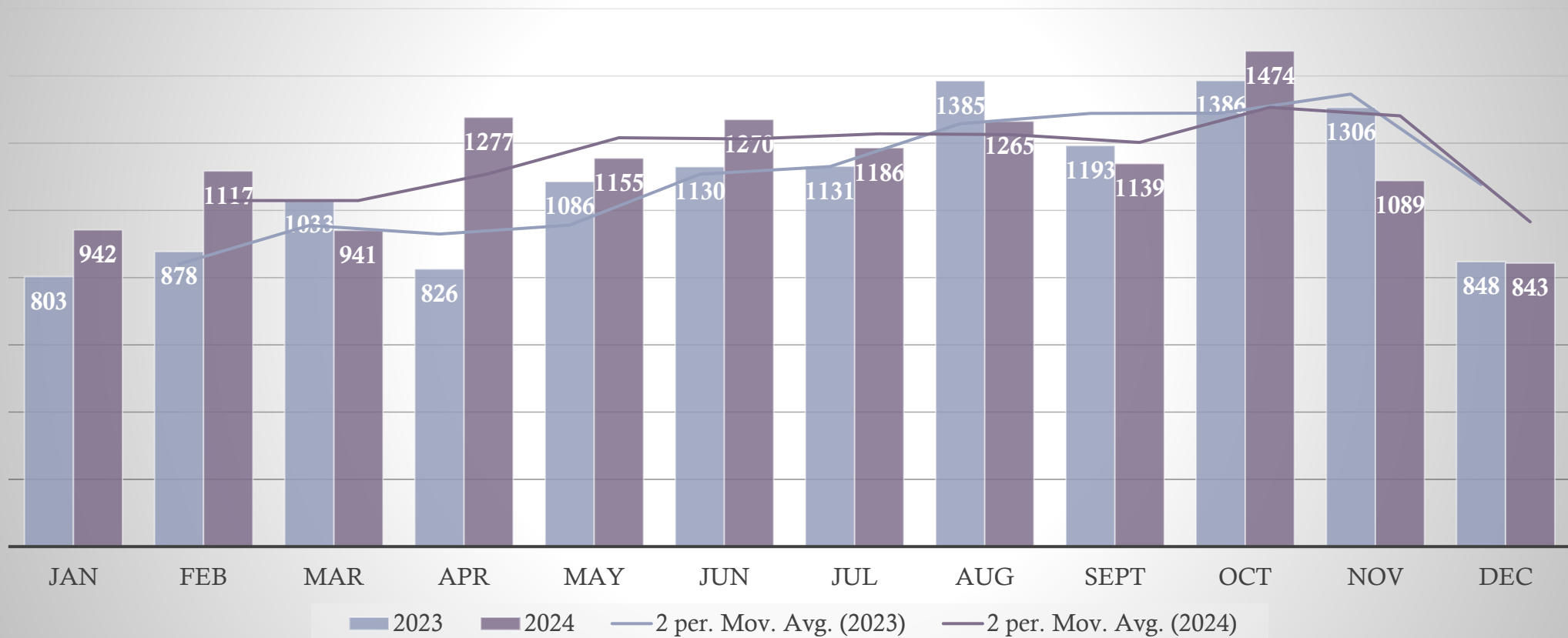
