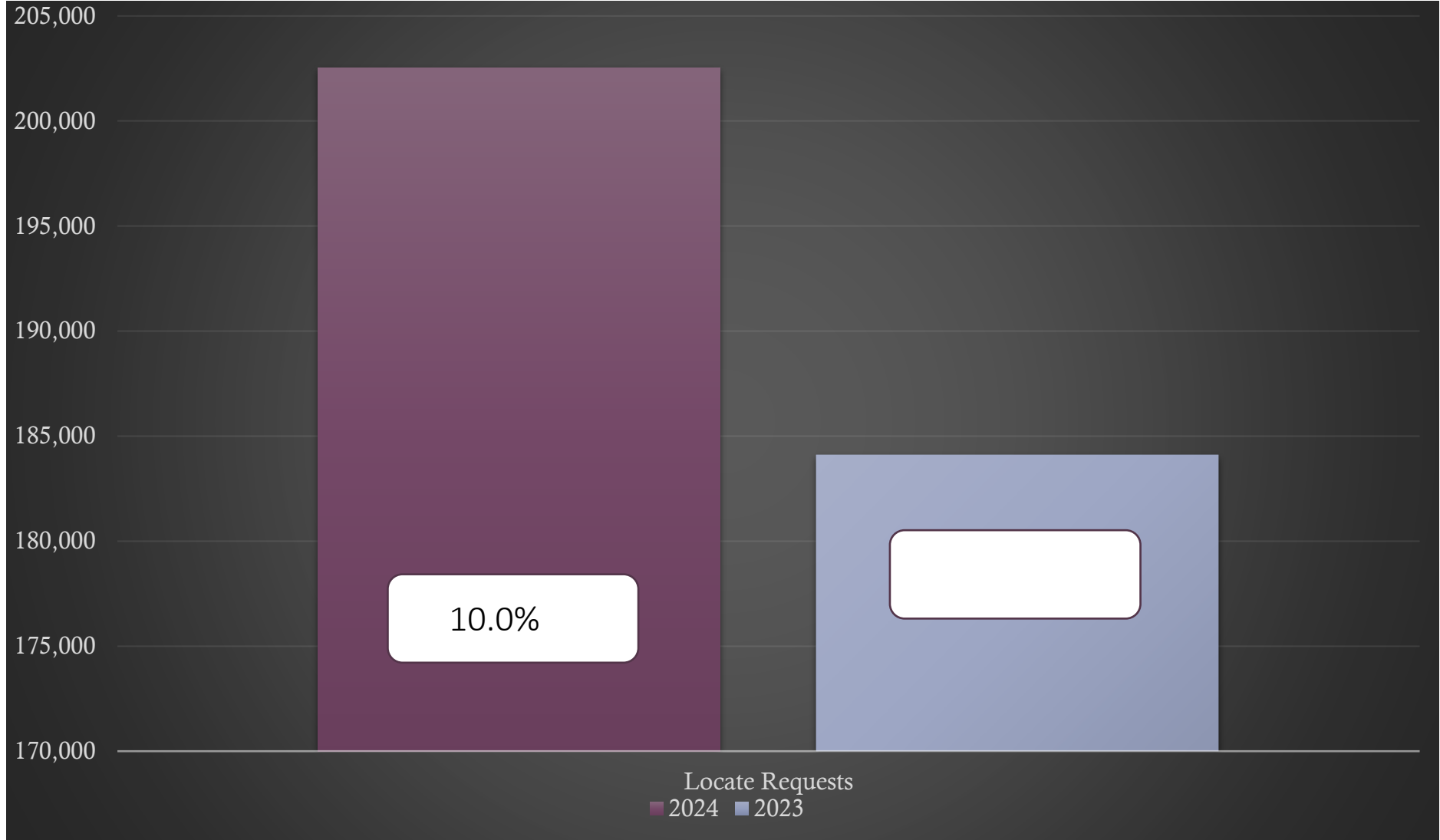




# Locate Requests for NC - Dec 24 vs 23

YTD 2024 - 2,803,579 / 2023 - 2,677,733 = +4.7%

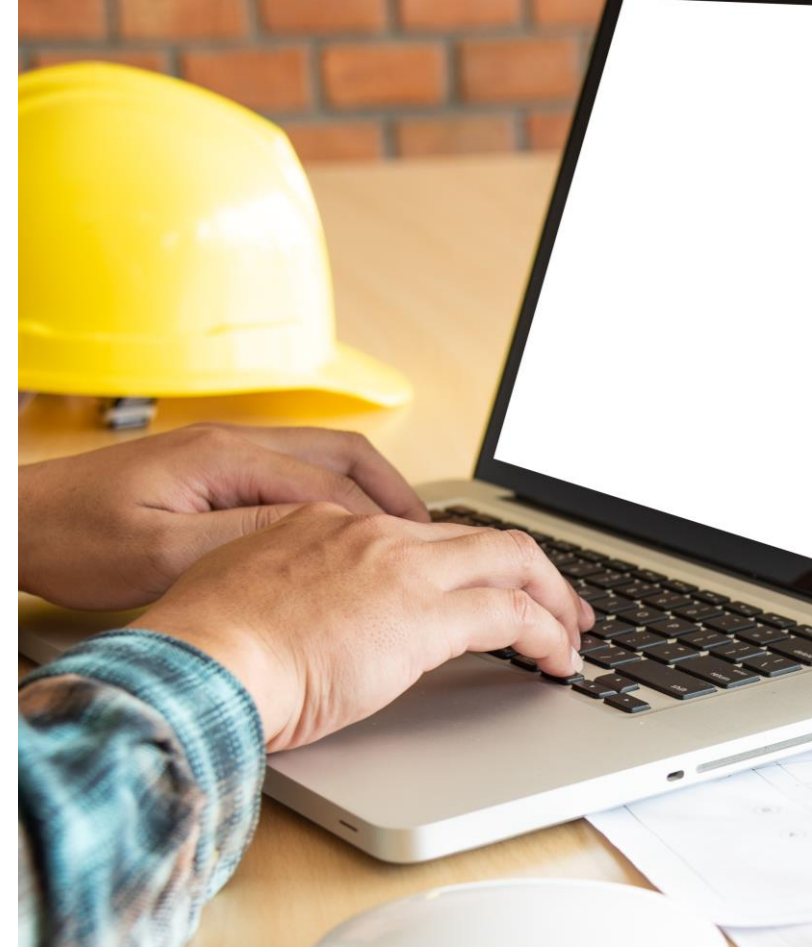
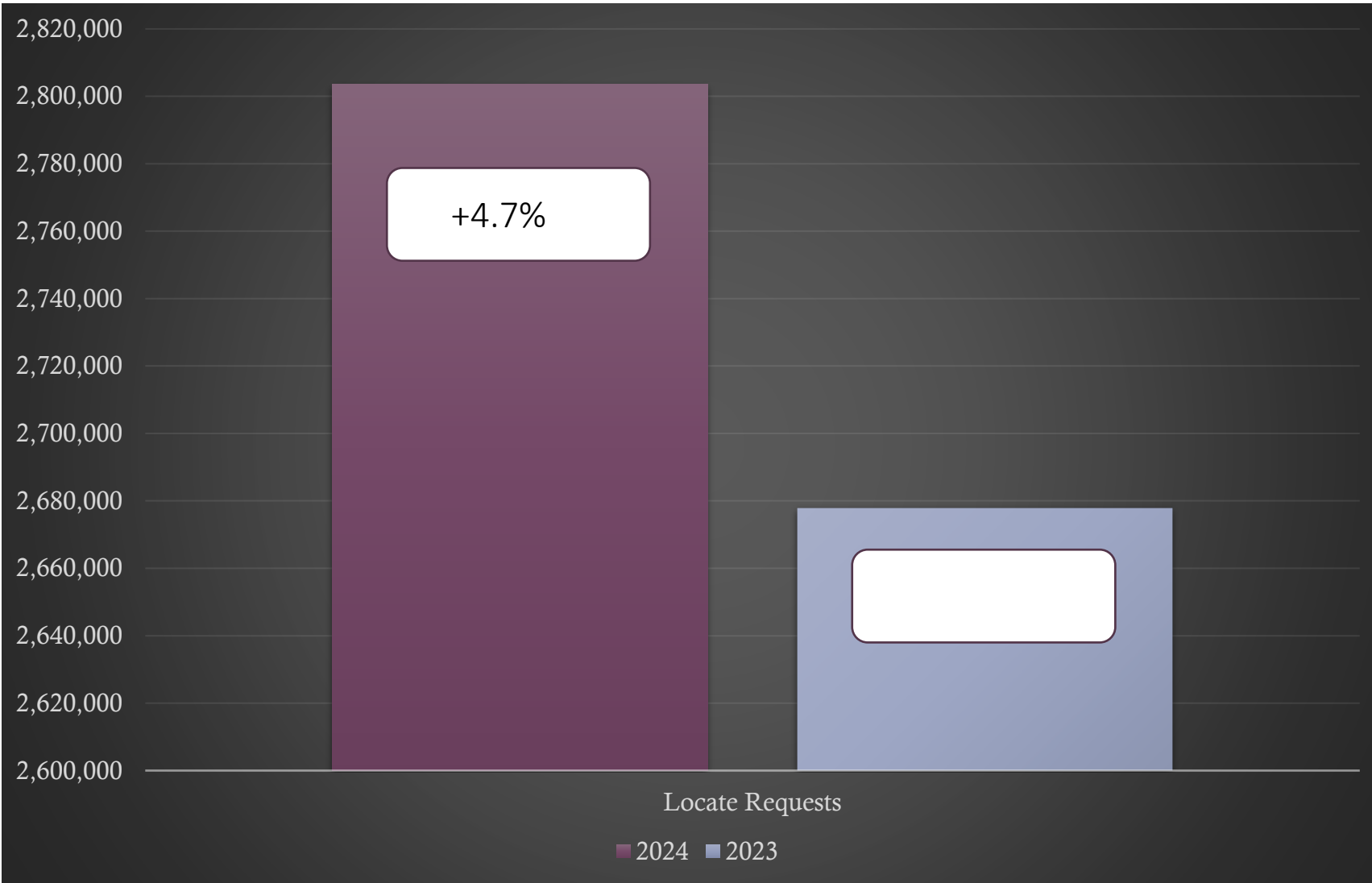

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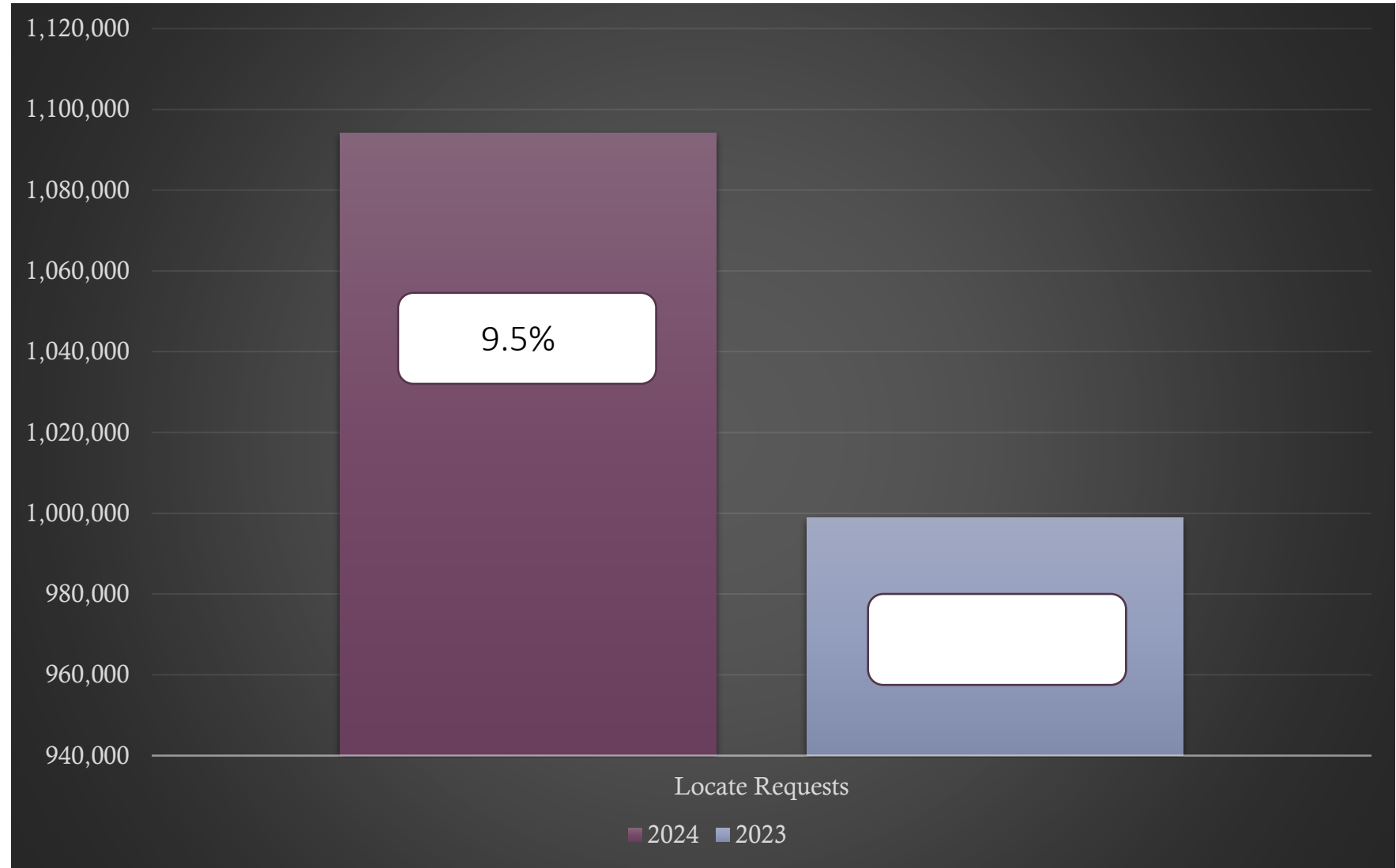
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# Transmissions for NC – Dec 24 vs 23



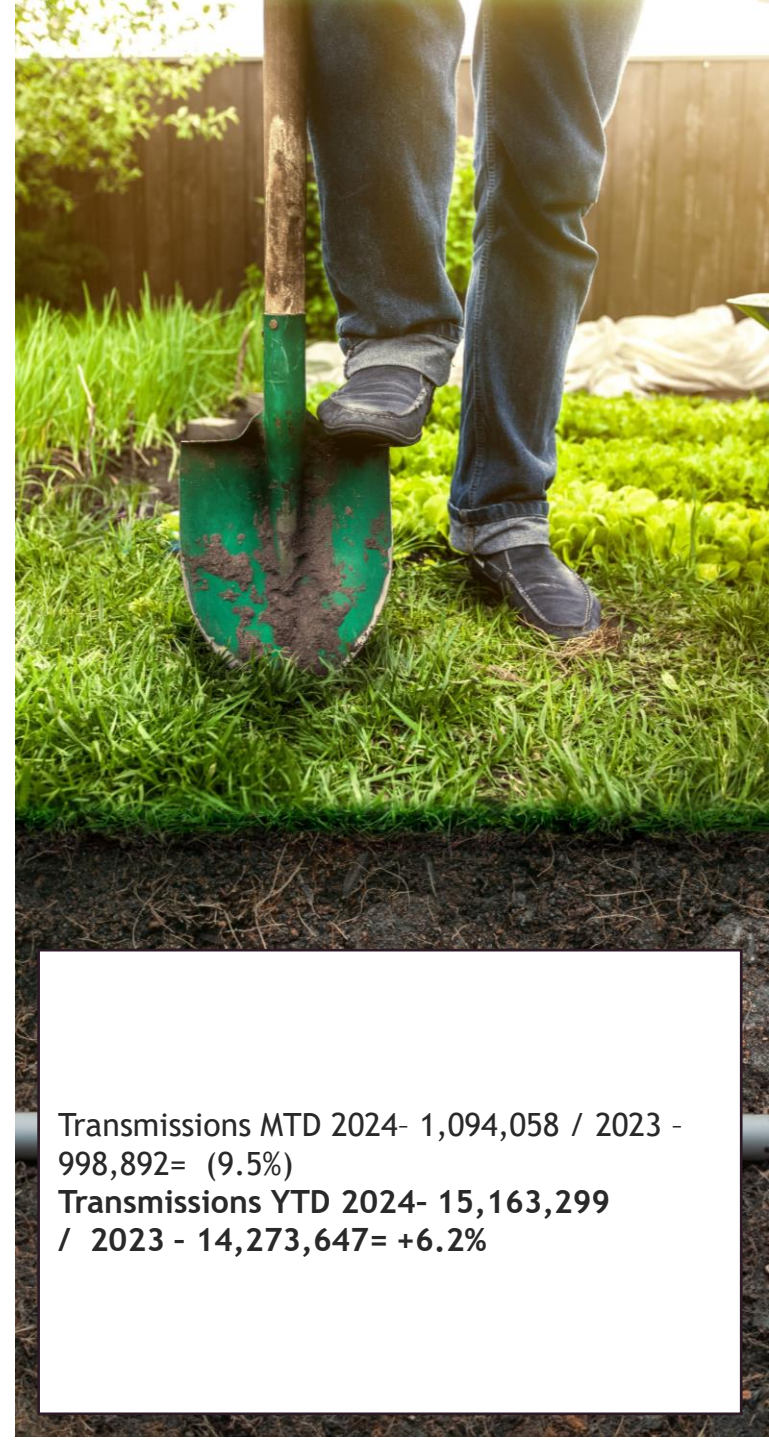
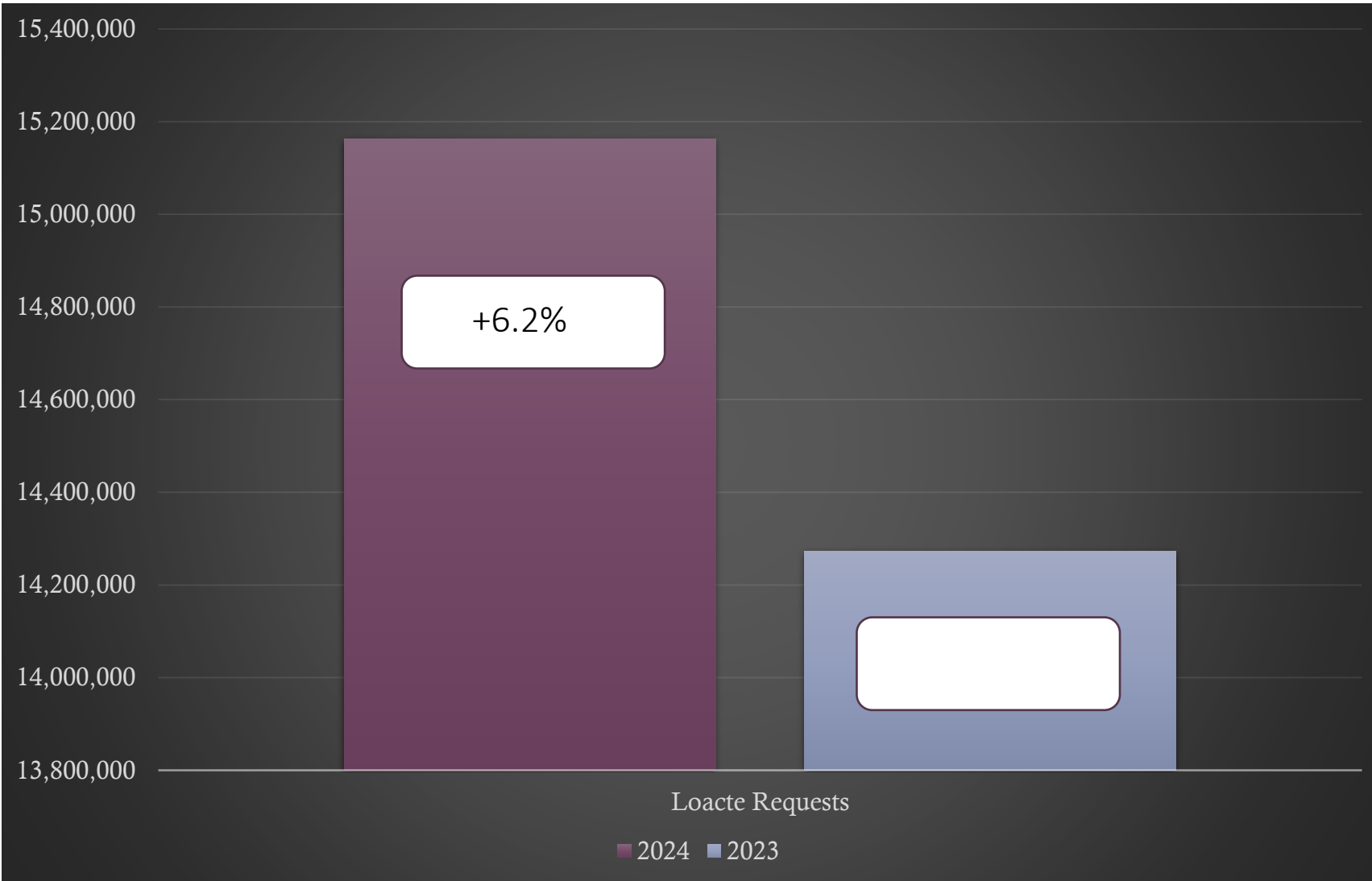

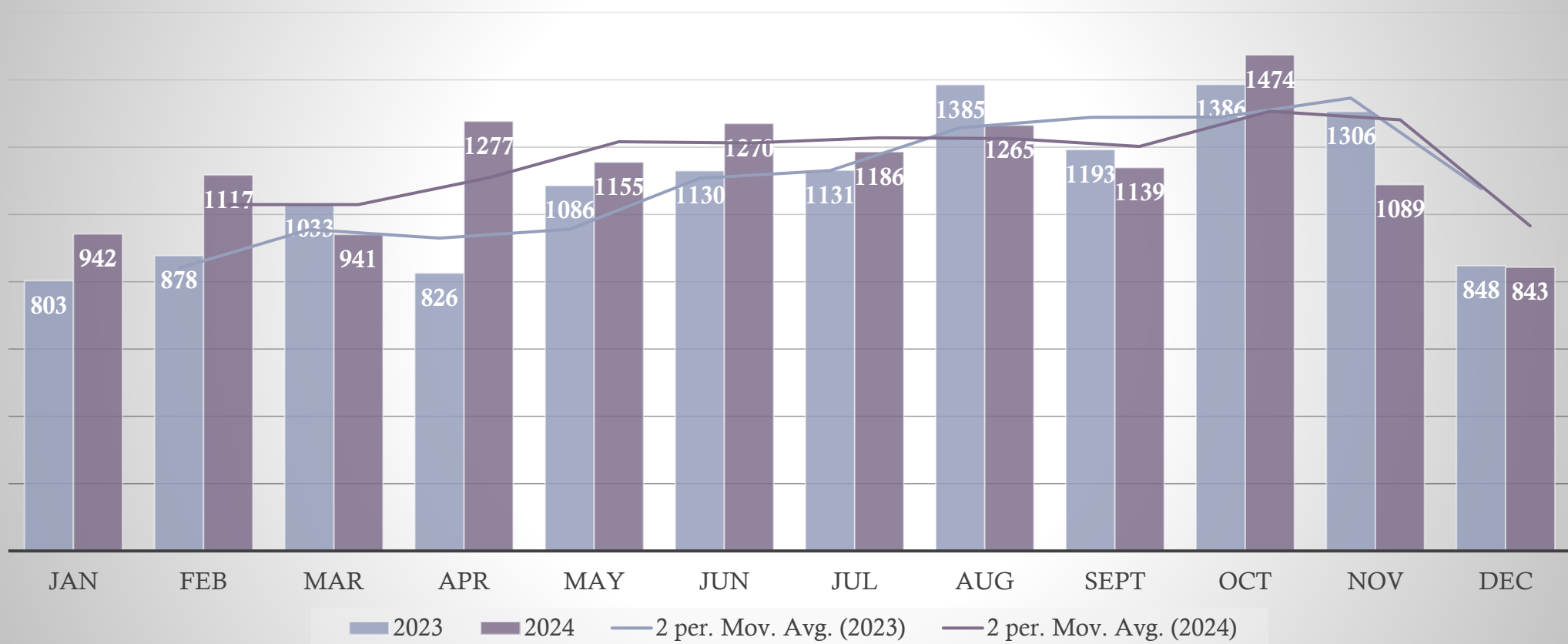
# Damages Per 1,000 Transmissions

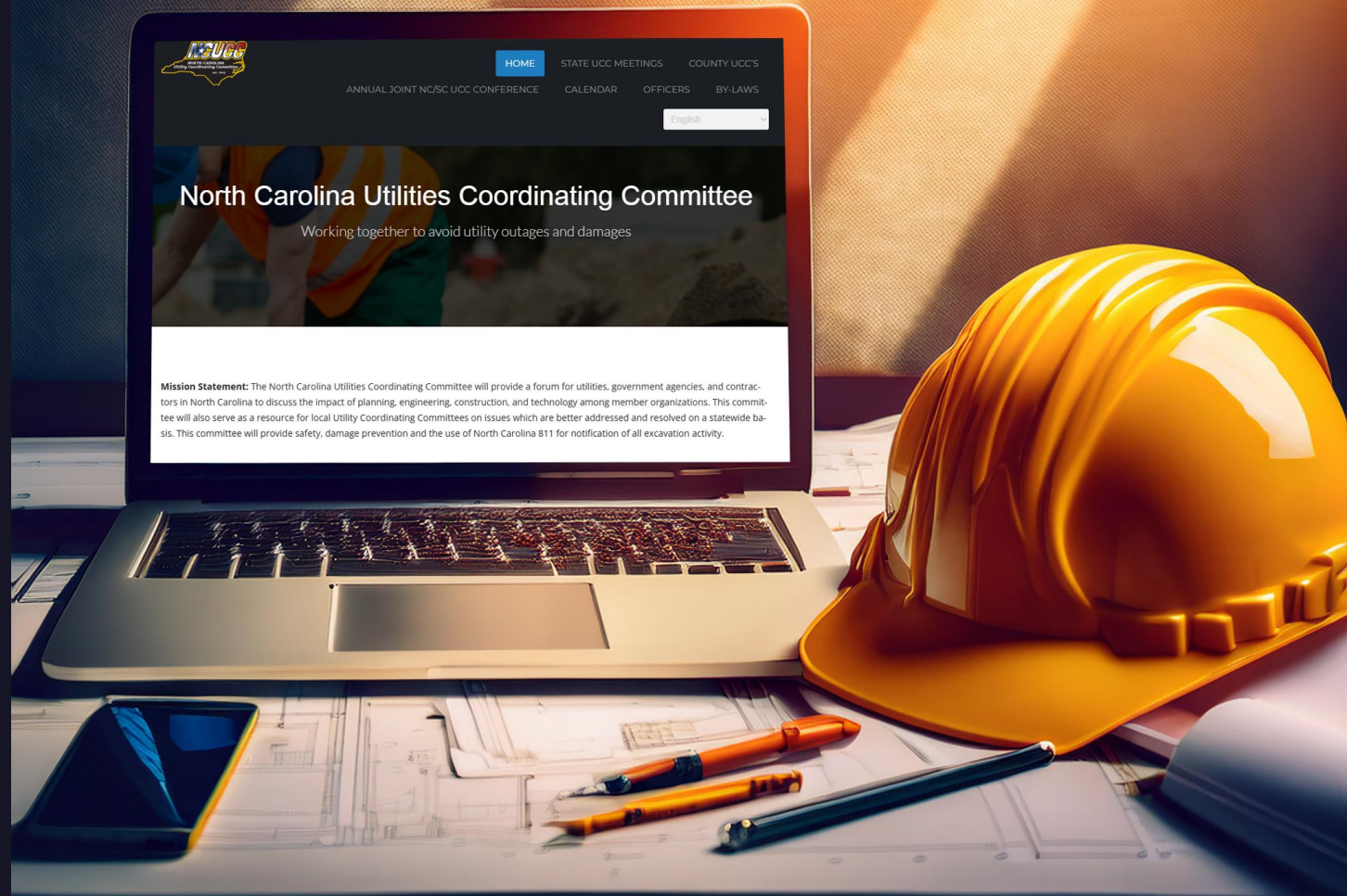
