2024 Street Rehabilitation and Preservation (Annual Contract)

- Project is closed out.

2025 Street Rehabilitation and Preservation (Annual Contract)

- Contracts are out for signature.
- Pre-con will be scheduled for mid to late March.

2023 Stormwater Repairs Contract (Annual Contract)

- Still in the warranty period.

2024 Stormwater Repairs Contract (Annual Contract)

- Currently on John Hopkins. Once finished, GUC to re-install the existing street light.
- Other issued Task Orders: Hooker Road, Woodwind Drive, and Maple Street.

Cedar Ln Stormwater Improvements

- Postponed until further notice.

Oxford Rd. & Rock Springs Bridge Replacement

- Oxford bridge water line to be bored under creek soon.
- Rocksprings still in talks w/ Historical society/DEQ and others.

W. 5th Street Reconstruction, Phase 2-4 (BUILD Grant)

- Project D roundabout work continuing.
 - Need to get with GUC to install electrical panel. Streetlights going up.
 - Paving has begun.
- Project E has started on Cotanche and Greene St
 - GUC putting up streetlights at Cotanche
 - Storm pipe being put in at Greene St.
 - Trader to layout fiber for City Traffic poles.

BUILD Grant Greenways

- Still need to get with GUC electric on lighting install for G and F.
 - (meeting with Jacob Barnes 2pm tomorrow)
- Need to get electric panel set up on project D roundabout.
- Pedestrian Bridge going in on between 1st and 2nd.

Greenbrier Culverts and Stream Restoration

- Estimated to Advertise for Bid Fall/Winter of 2024

Cedar Stream Restoration

- Postponed for possible federal earmark. Not progressing. No funding available at the moment.

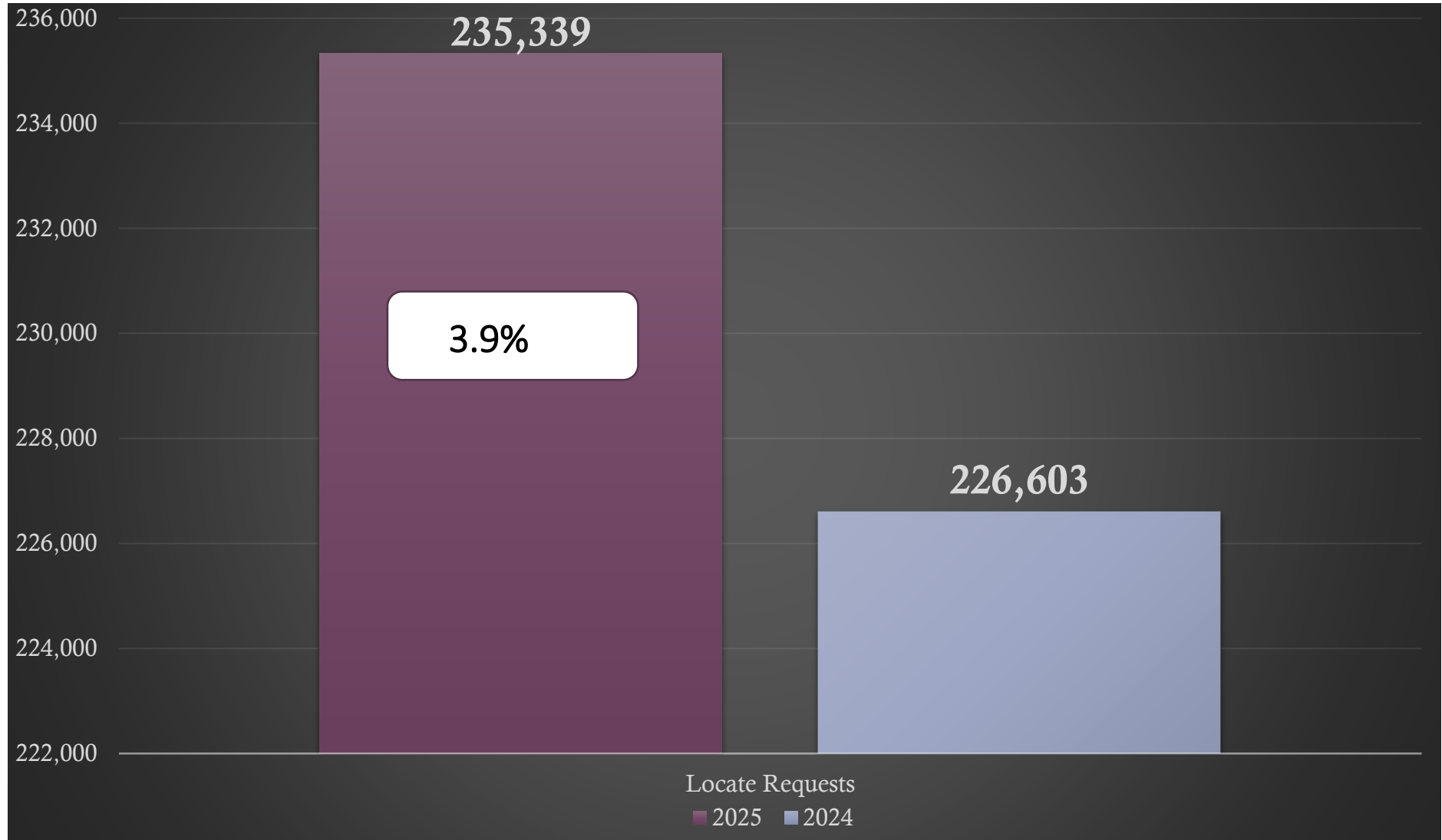

Updates for Jan 2025 - (75,322) = 32.0% of volume / Dec 2024 = 33.8% (1.8% Decrease from the month before)

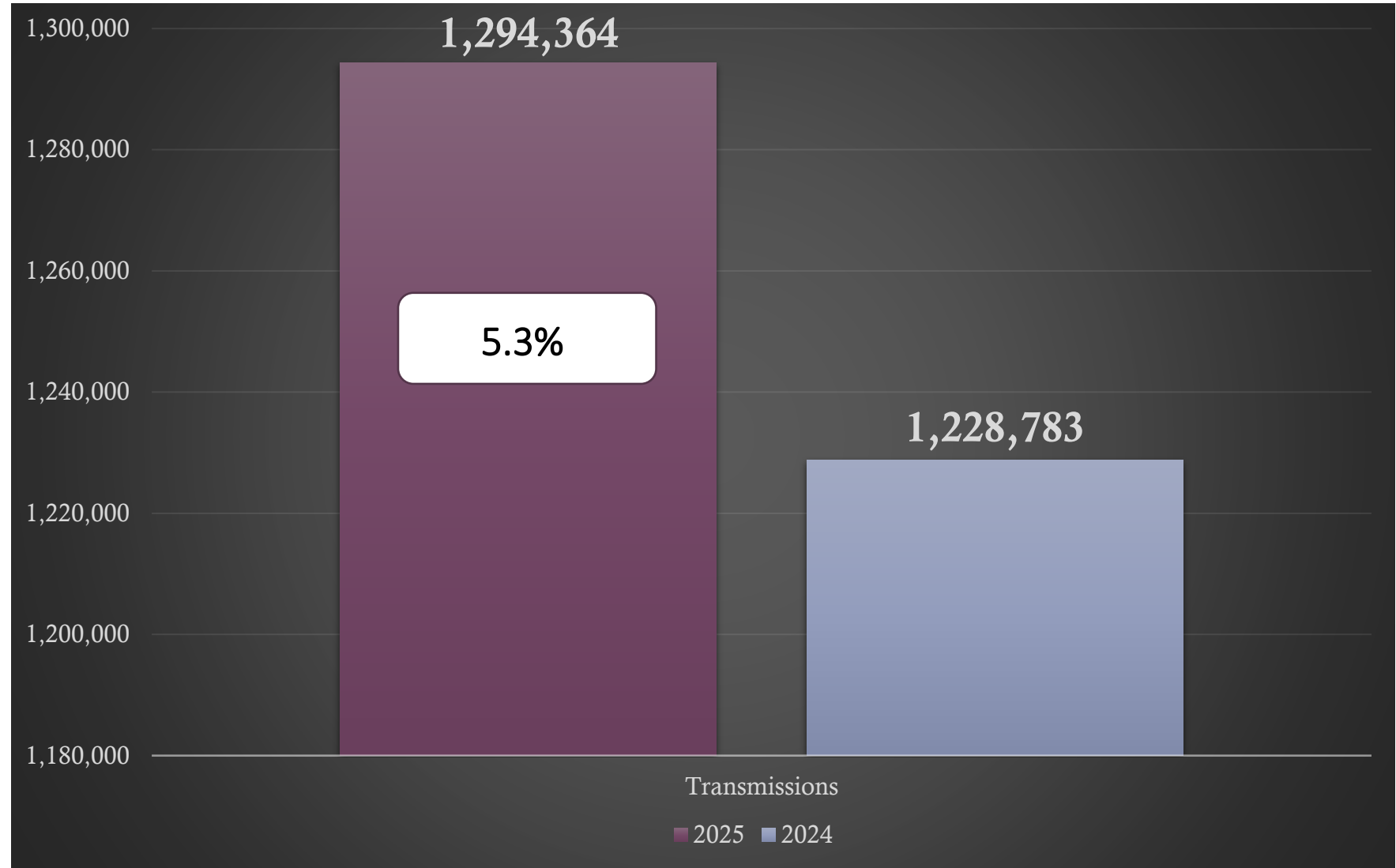


Transmissions for NC – Jan. 25 vs 24



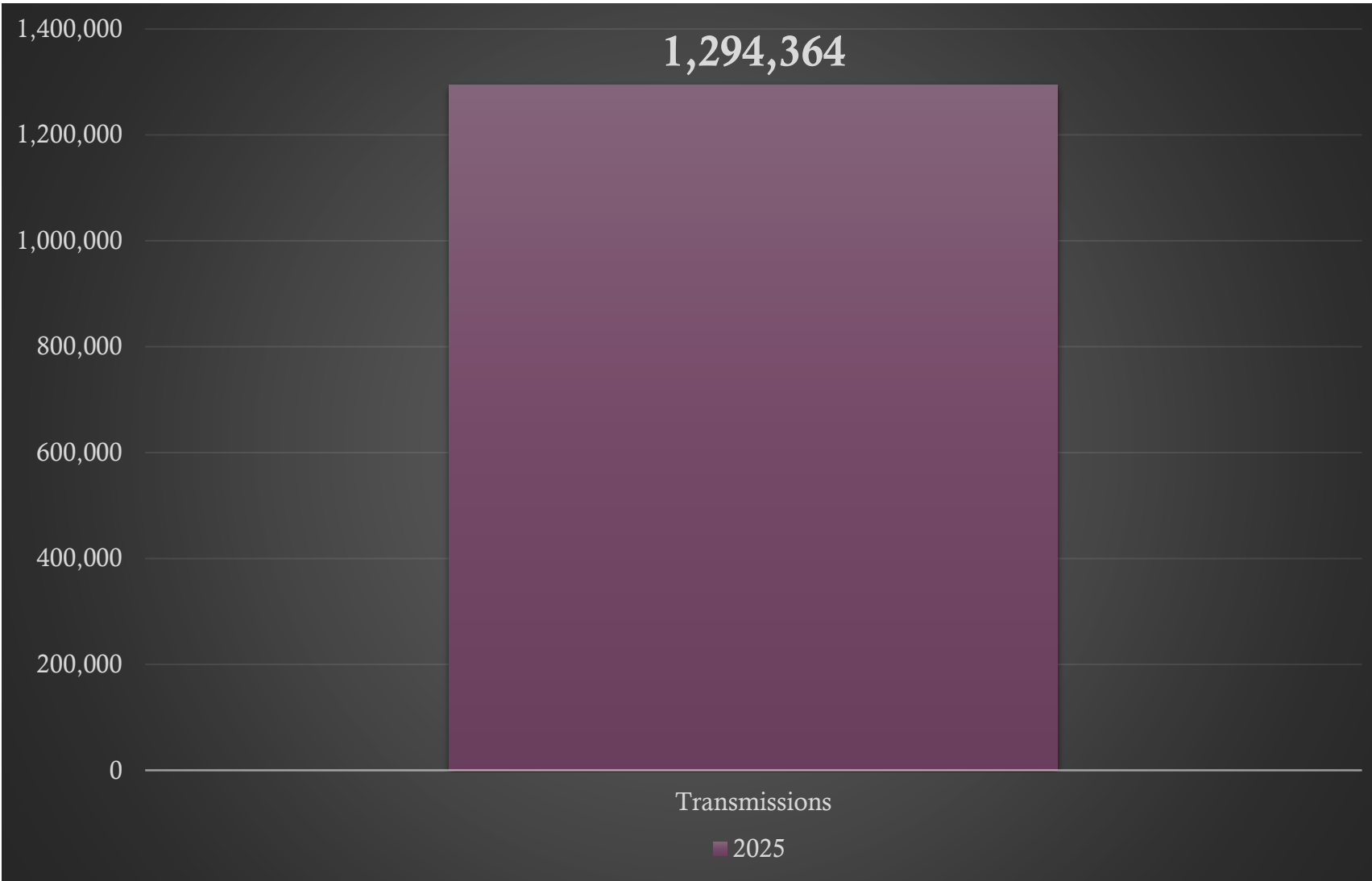

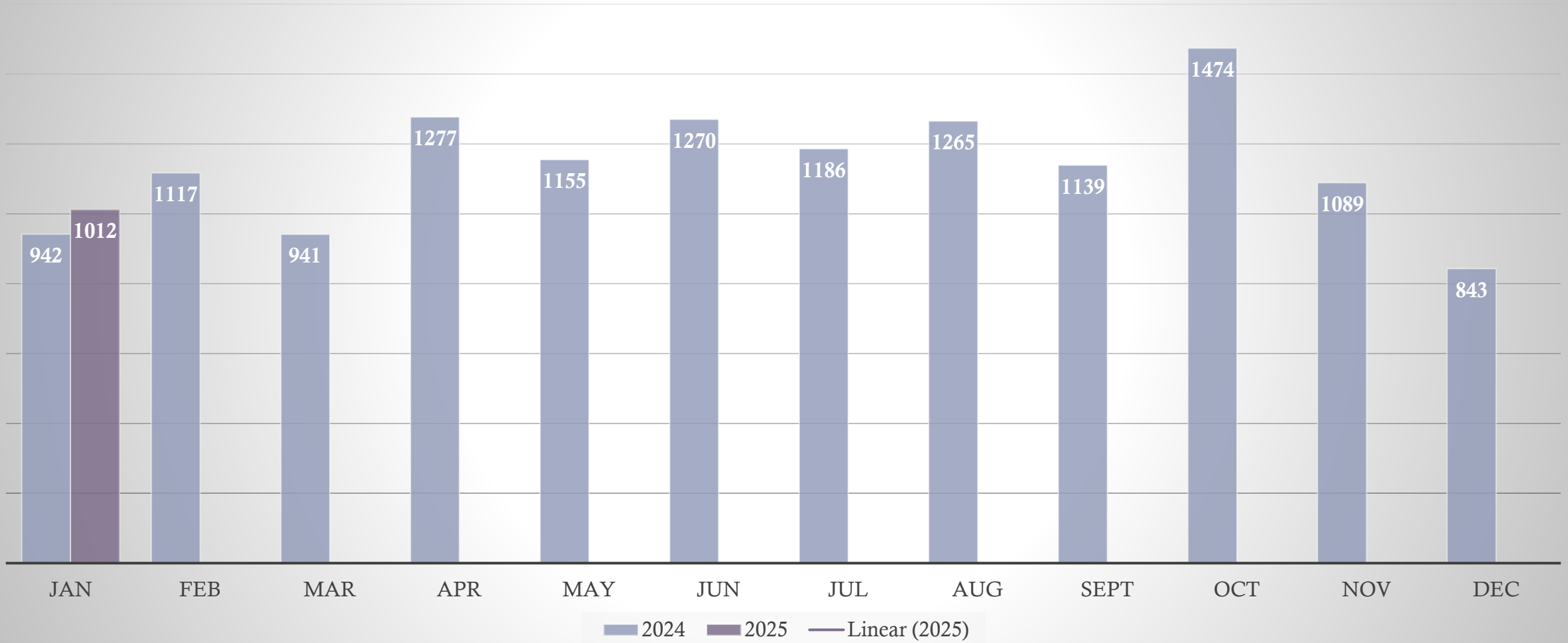
