


March. 2025 - 267,425 / 2024 - 220,706=(21.2%)



## Transmissions for NC – Mar. 25 vs 24





#### Meeting opened at 9:00 AM.

811 presentation given by Tami Groves.

City of Mooresville – 150 Road widening is very busy. More utility work coming int eh summer. Trenchless. Water line on Center has not gone out for bid yet. Culvert replacement to happen as well. Sanders St is to be done this year. Next week relocating on Kerr Street/Main Street/Locust St. Water line rehabilitation but only about 150'.

NCDOT – they are very busy.

SunState Rentals – they have equipment available and are happy to be of assistance if needed.

Utility Lines Construction Services – Lot of work happening on the 150 project/Charlotte Highway. A number of big projects.

Enbridge – Corrugut/Langtree Campus. T line cross at Transco Road coming to Langtree for the tie-in on Transco Road. Shepherds Farm final review. Close gap on 21 w 4" plastic. Run main down Lookout Drive. Tie-in changes on regulator off Shinville Road. NC3 Brantley subdivision night project. Rhinehart subdivision. Two lines Brawley School Road. Hwy 21 to Rolling Hill. One high pressure line, one lower. Hwy 150 tie-ins then next phase. Quintin just finished Harris Farm. Five projects in Davidson – NCDOT.

Next meeting will either be at the City of Statesville or the Town of Troutman.
