

CHANGES TO HOUSE BILL 247 SESSION 2025


AN ACT TO UPDATE THE UNDERGROUND UTILITY SAFETY AND DAMAGE PREVENTION ACT.

- Changes to the law will go into effect October 1st, 2025
- The NC811 Education department will be relaying what the changes are and how it will impact our industry.


TRANSMISSIONS FOR NC JUNE 25 VS 24


TRANSMISSIONS FOR NC YEAR TO DATE
















Damages in North Carolina 2025 vs 2024

Call to Order

Welcome to the July Buncombe UCC meeting. The meeting was called to order at Galactic Pizza in Asheville NC.

Announcements

I would like to thank everyone who came to the July meeting. This meeting has been the largest turnout to date, and we had multiple new members.

Recognition of New Attendees and Guests

We were pleased to welcome Kevin Comalander and Mike Kamback from Colliers Engineering. As well as Paul Jordan, and Jasmin Watson from GHL Services INC.

Old Business

MATA Enterprise was mentioned as a possible contractor who needed to be contacted due to ongoing issues with safety concerns.

New Business

The group discussed increasing concern about **locate requests not being completed** in a timely manner. Other major concerns were brought up regarding a Tel-Com contractor operating in an unsavory manner.

 A subcontractor for ITG- Frontier Communications: MATA Enterprise was reported again to be very uncooperative with many members of the meeting. There were mentions of utilities being possibly intentionally damaged after being discovered in the way of their boring efforts. The company was brought to light at the June Buncombe UCC meeting and it seems this has been escalated into a major priority.

Damage Report

Multiple ongoing damages from Mata Enterprises working for ITG-Frontier Communications were reported. I asked for members to please provide pictures, utility information, and locations of any damage to me as soon as possible. Though there have been many claims of damage, nothing has been turned into NC811 at this time.

Round Table Discussion

• Attendees expressed interest in finding a way to documenting any damages caused by excavators intentionally. Due to the issue currently at hand with a contractor possibly damaging utilities off spite, we as a collective spoke about improving communication regarding any damage being 1) Photographed. 2) Documented: Date, Time, Utility Type/Owner, Location, and Ticket Number if possible. 3) Suspected Contractor. All this information needs to be emailed to the Education Liaison rory@nc811.org. Also, if the members feel like it is warranted, they have been informed to contact the Underground Damage Prevention Review Board and file a report of violation.

Project Report

• It was noted that **Brian Jamerson is coordinating with area contractors** and others in neighboring counties as part of Enbridge's **rebranding efforts**, involving updates to old Dominion Gas markers since Enbridge's acquisition.
