

# CHANGES TO HOUSE BILL 247 SESSION 2025


AN ACT TO UPDATE THE UNDERGROUND UTILITY SAFETY AND DAMAGE PREVENTION ACT.


# TRANSMISSIONS FOR NC JUNE 25 VS 24


# TRANSMISSIONS FOR NC YEAR TO DATE














#### Damages in North Carolina 2025 vs 2024
