2025 Street Rehabilitation and Preservation (Annual Contract)

- ADA Ramps Complete. Backfill and seeding remain
- Micro surface on Bayswater Drive, Planters Walk Subdivision, and Arbor Hils Subdivision are still underway.












DAMAGES PER 1,000 TRANSMISSIONS
