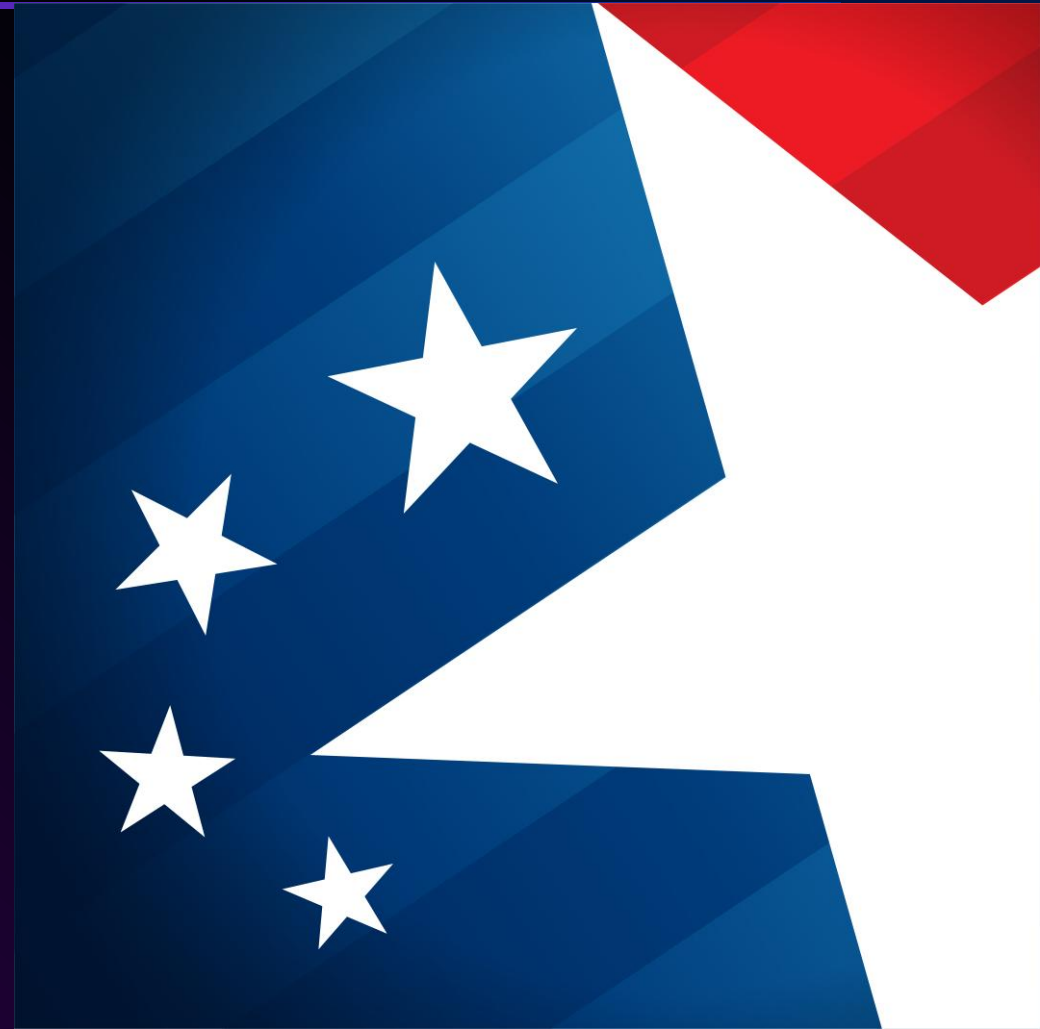

CHANGES TO HOUSE BILL 247

SESSION 2025

AN ACT TO UPDATE THE UNDERGROUND UTILITY SAFETY AND DAMAGE PREVENTION ACT.

- Changes to the law will go into effect October 1st, 2025
- The NC811 Education department will be relaying what the changes are and how it will impact our industry.

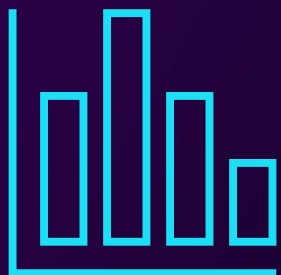

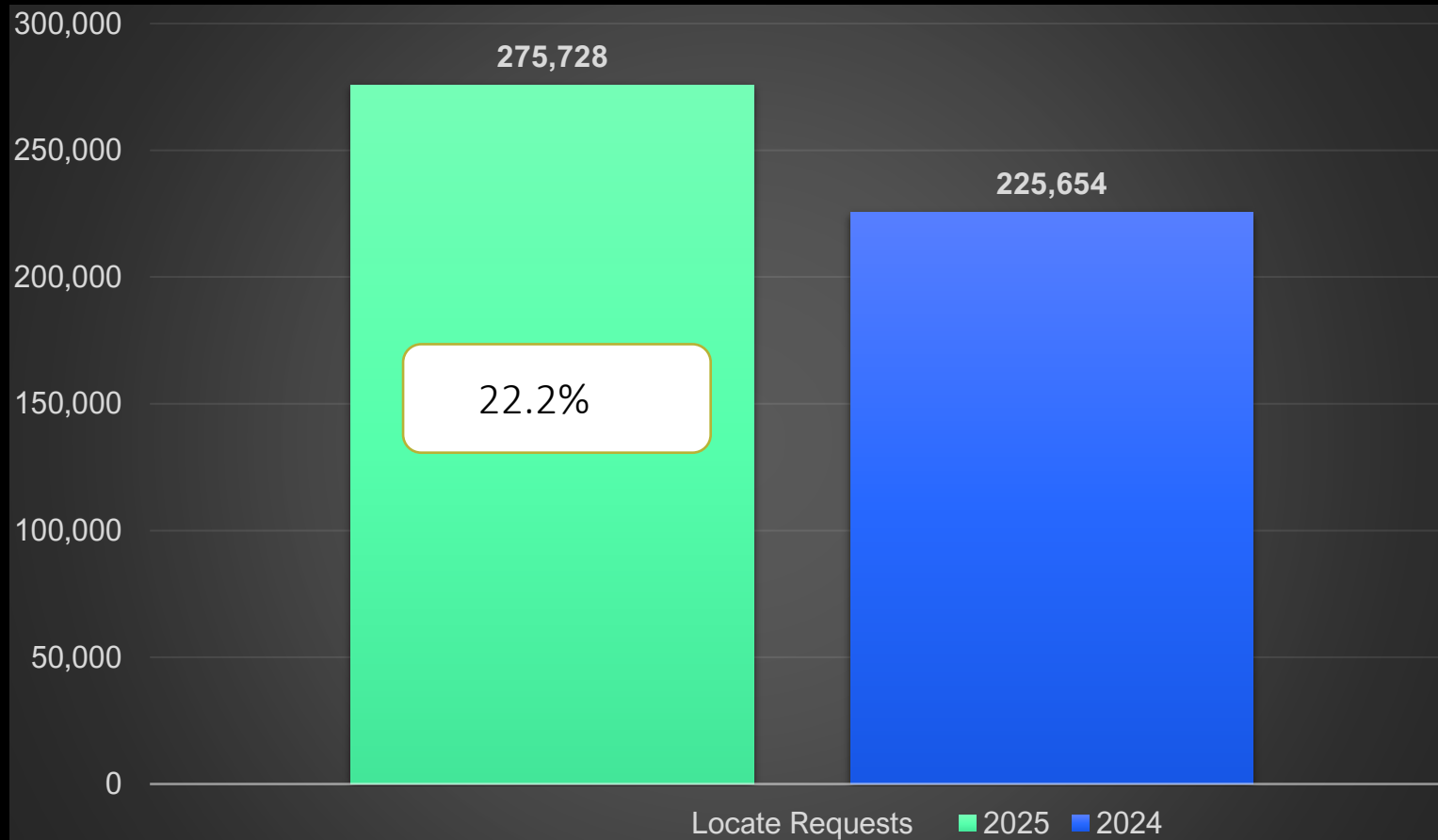

LOCATE REQUESTS FOR NC JUNE 25 VS 24



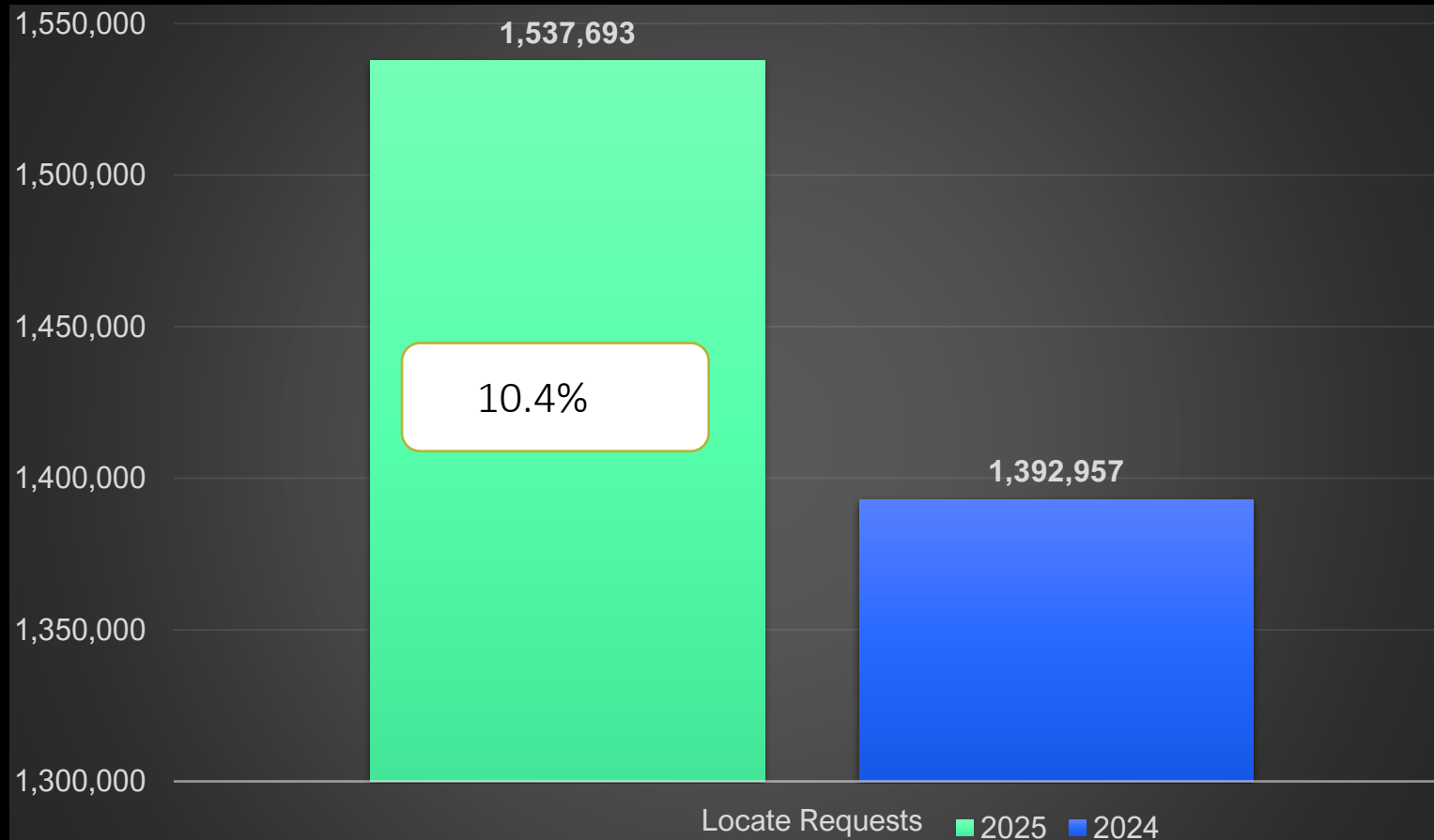
June, 2025 - 275,728 / 2024 - 225,654 = (22.2%)

(.5% Increase from the month before)

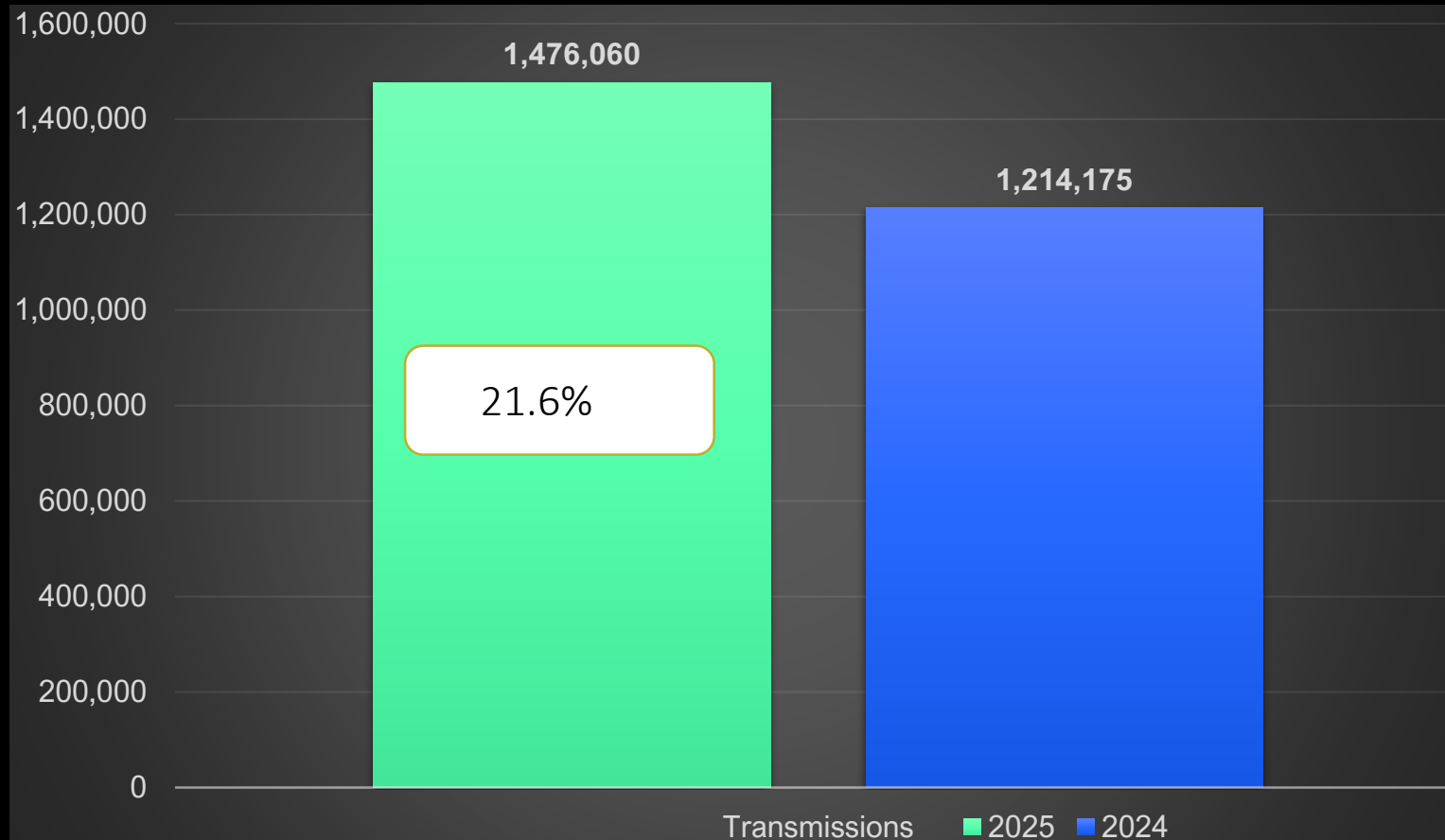
LOCATE REQUESTS FOR NC YEAR TO DATE

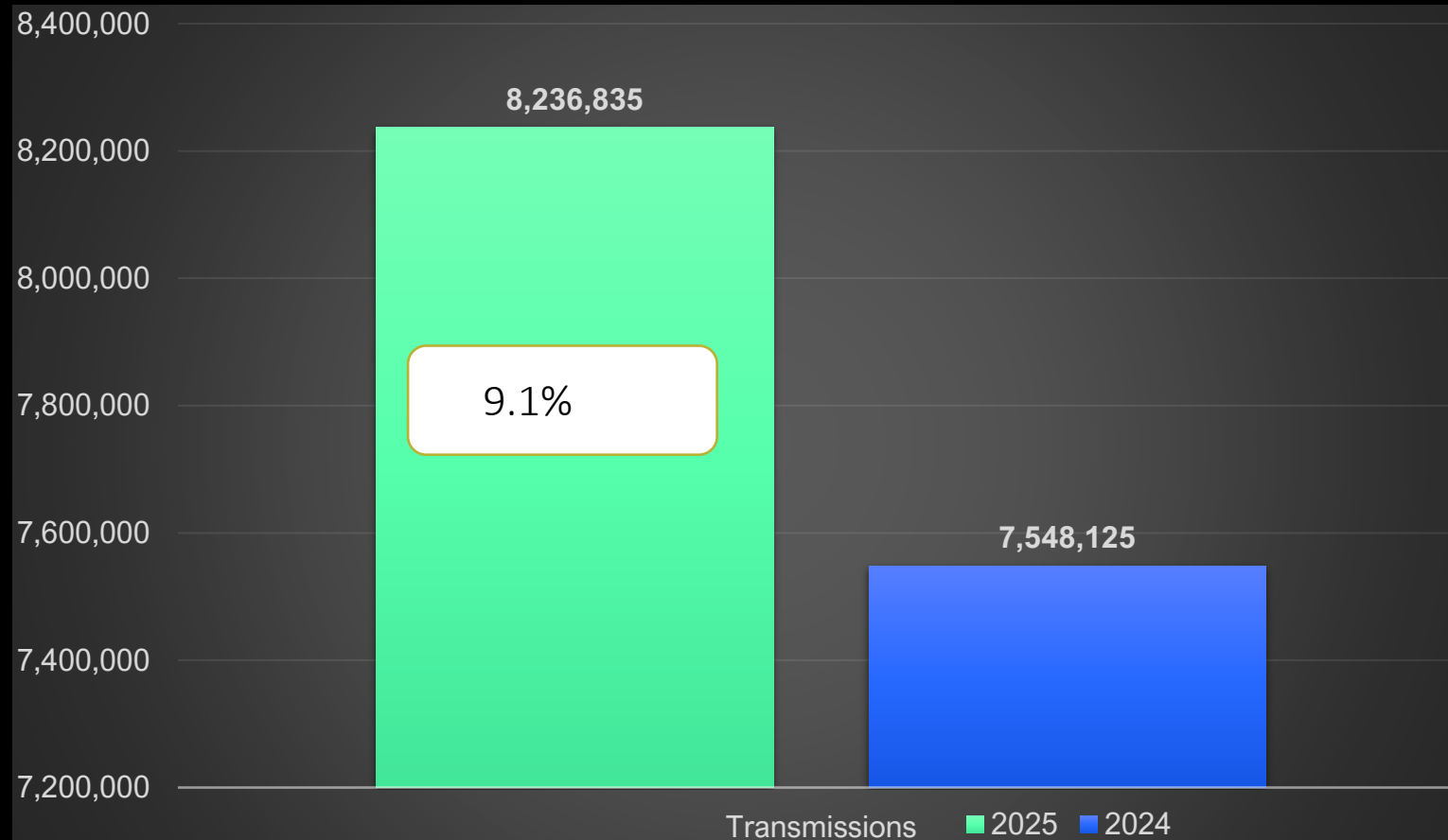

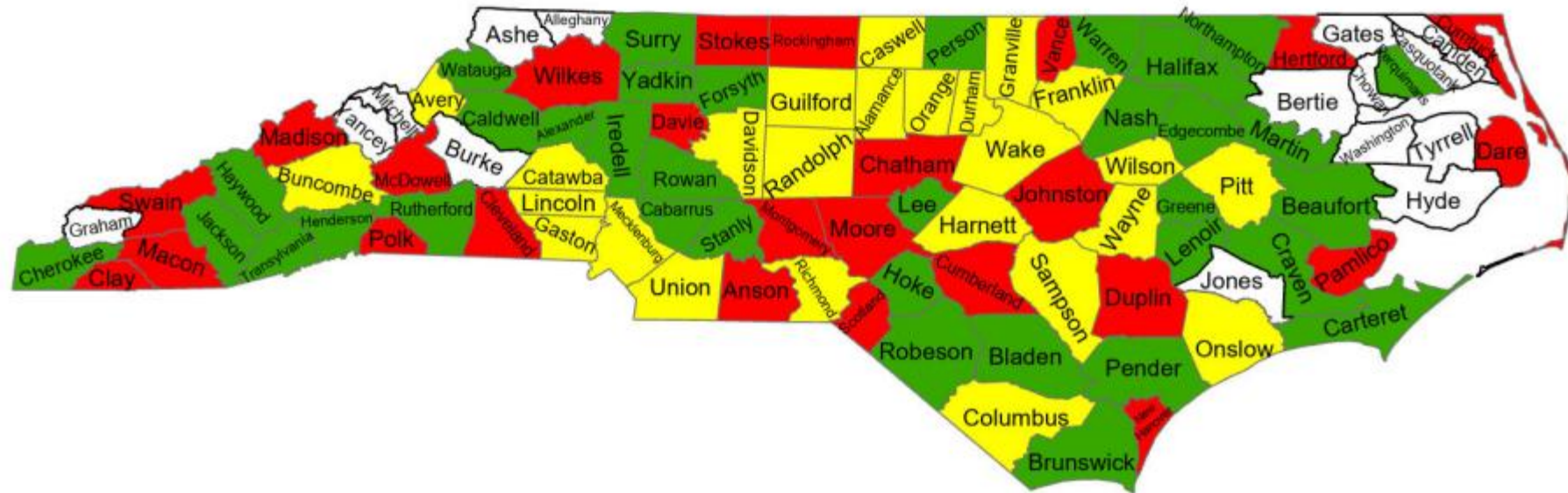

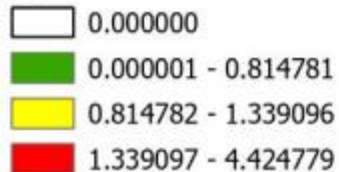
DAMAGES PER 1,000 TRANSMISSIONS

JUNE 2025



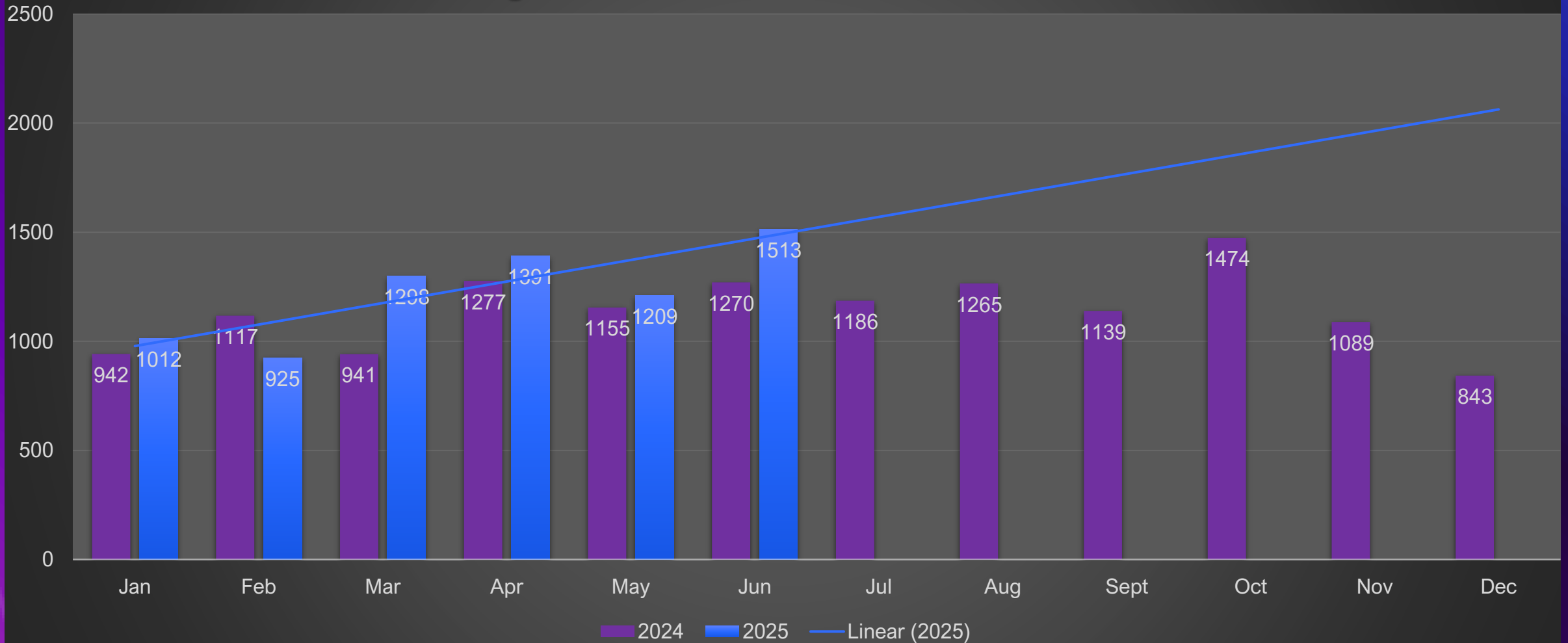
