 - Gas, power, sewer and water too.

BUILD Grant Greenways

- Project G lights to be installed after ECU locates are in.

Greenbrier Culverts and Stream Restoration

- Currently on Hold.

Cedar Stream Restoration

- Postponed for possible federal earmark. Not progressing. No funding is available.

Arts District Streetscape

- Revised scope has been approved.
- Project Deadline December 2026.

St. Andrews Streambank Restoration

- Currently working on 90% Design and property owner outreach.
- KCI will be reaching out to GUC Departments regarding comments.
- 90% plans are scheduled to be finished by October 2025.

Eppes Community Center Pathway

- Working on procuring PE funds from the state.

Drainage Improvements and East Fire Tower Road Project

- Starting 30% plan review to send back for comments.

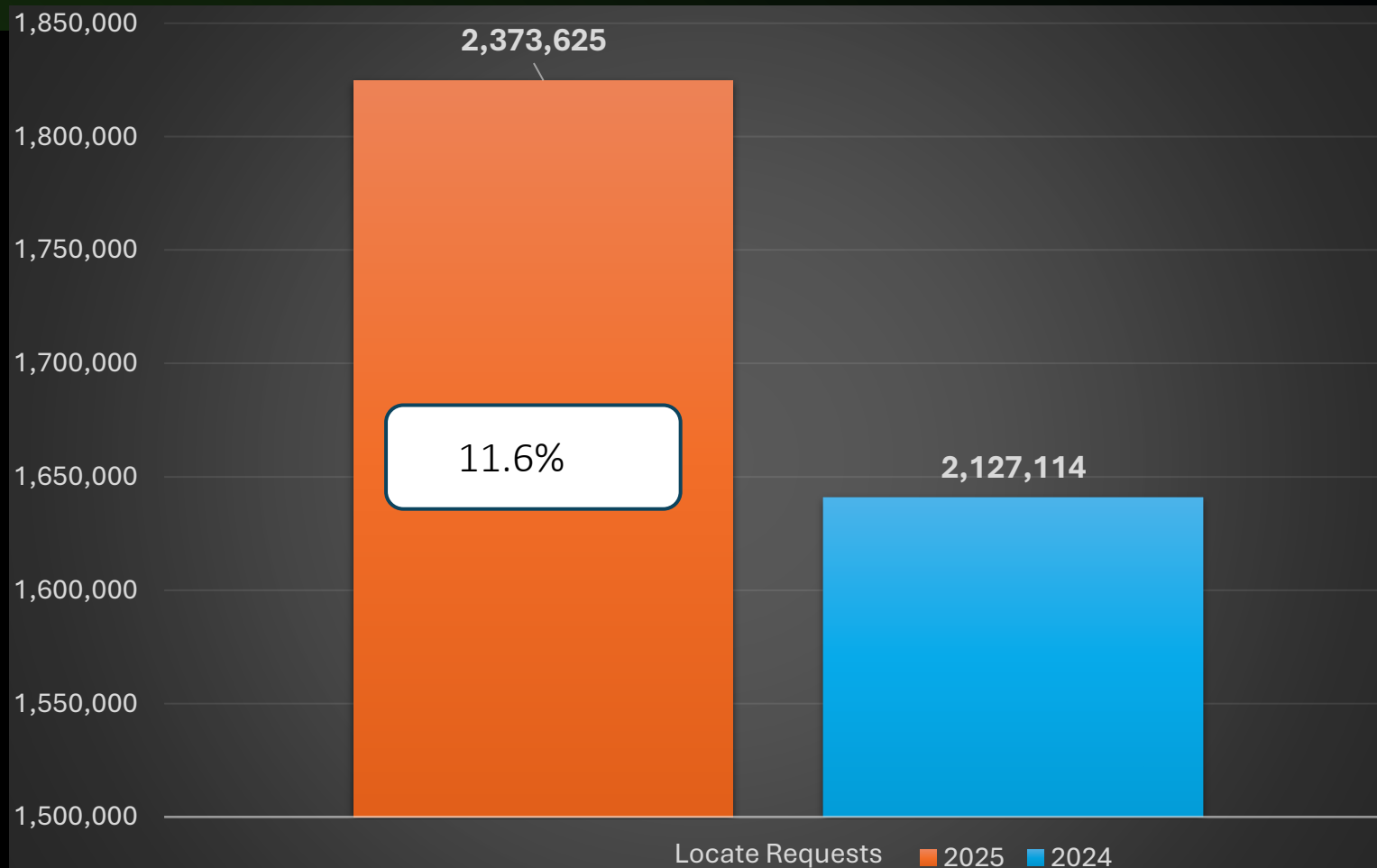

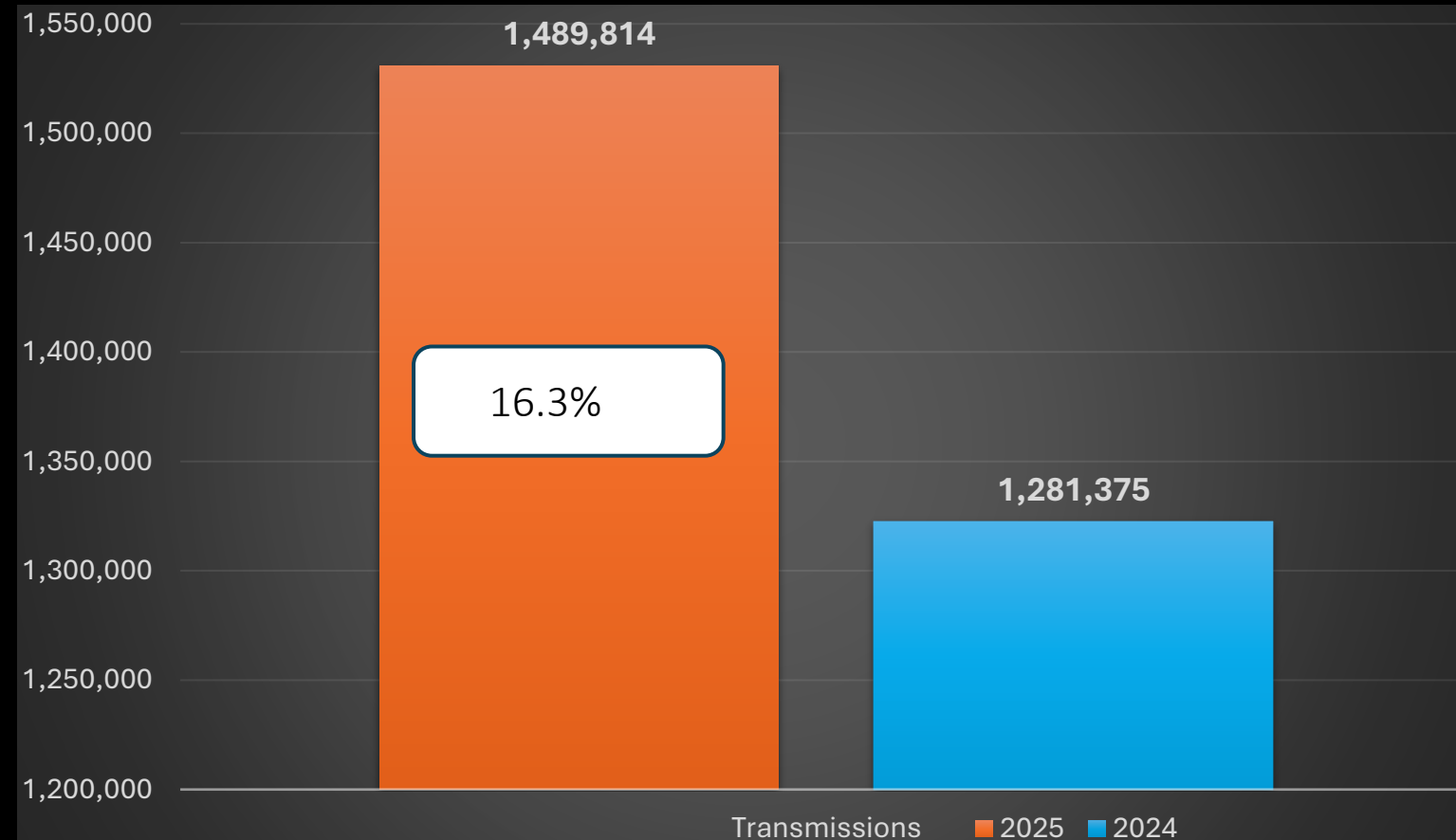

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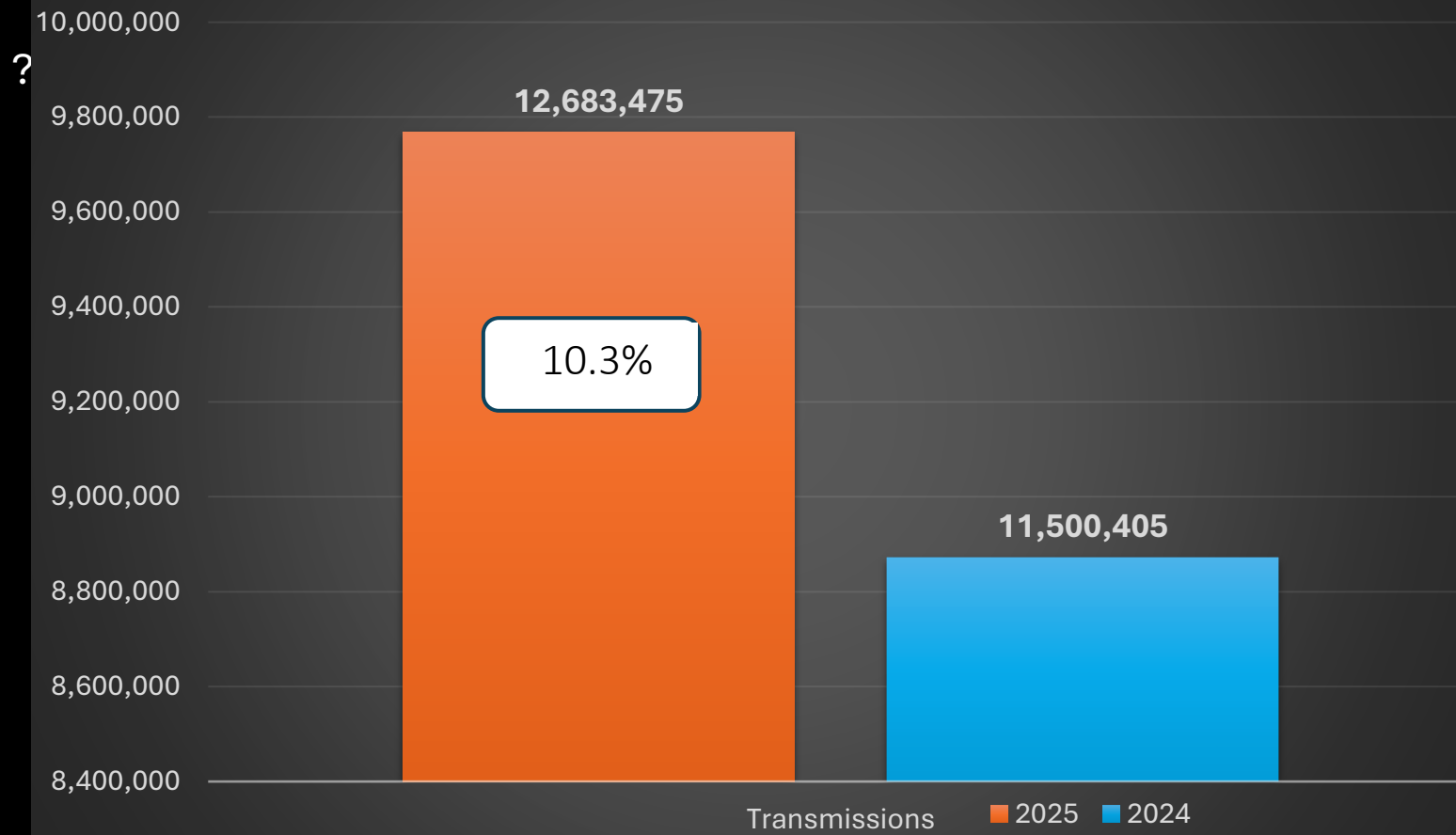
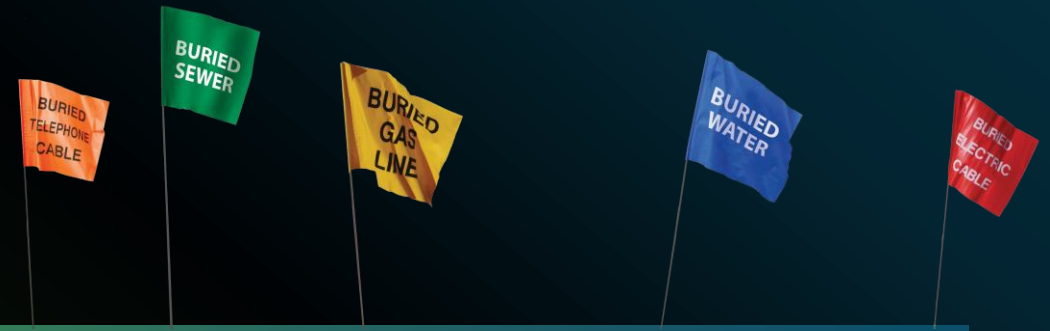

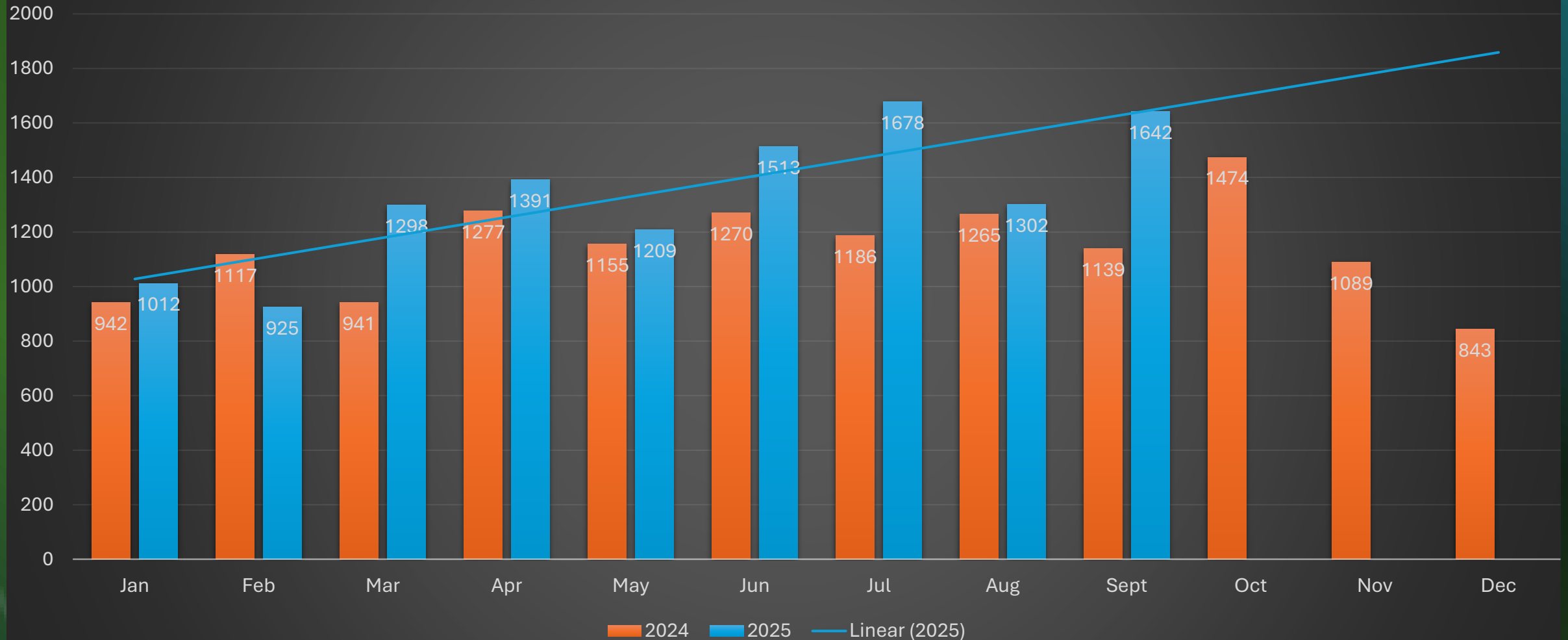


DAMAGES PER 1,000 TRANSMISSIONS
