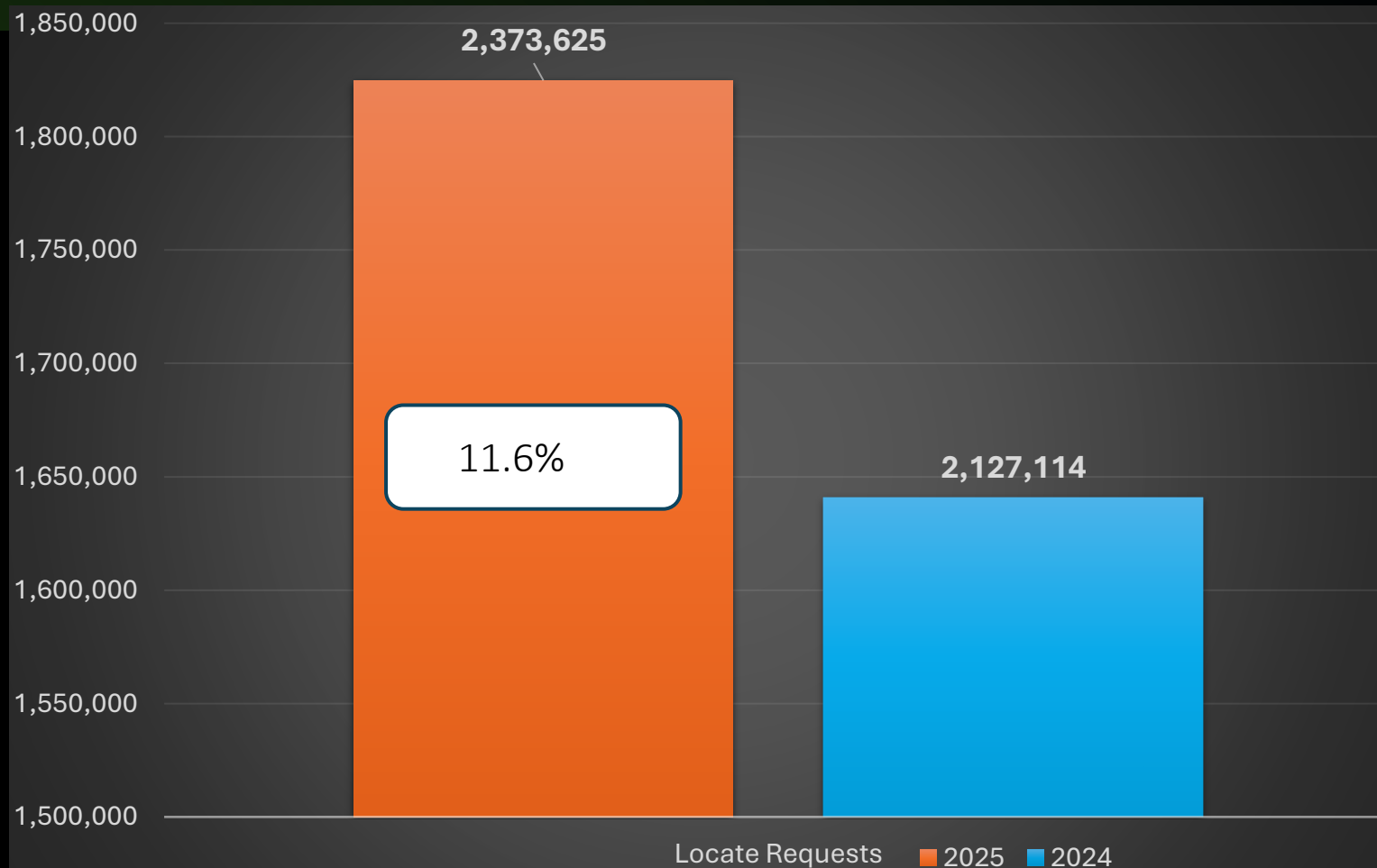
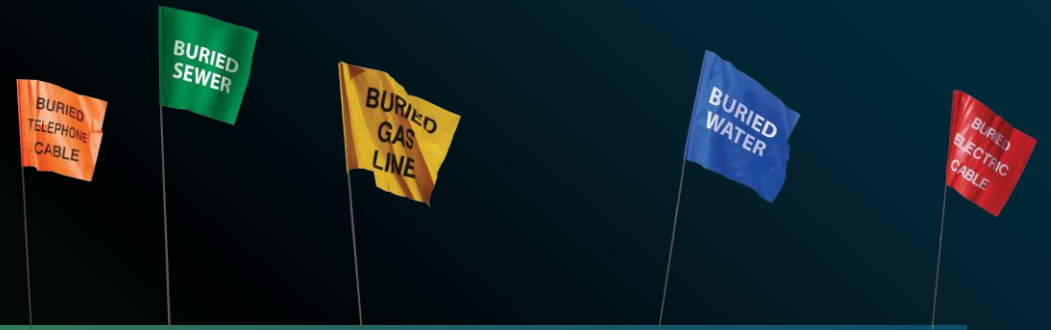
LOCATE REQUESTS FOR NC SEPT 25 VS 24

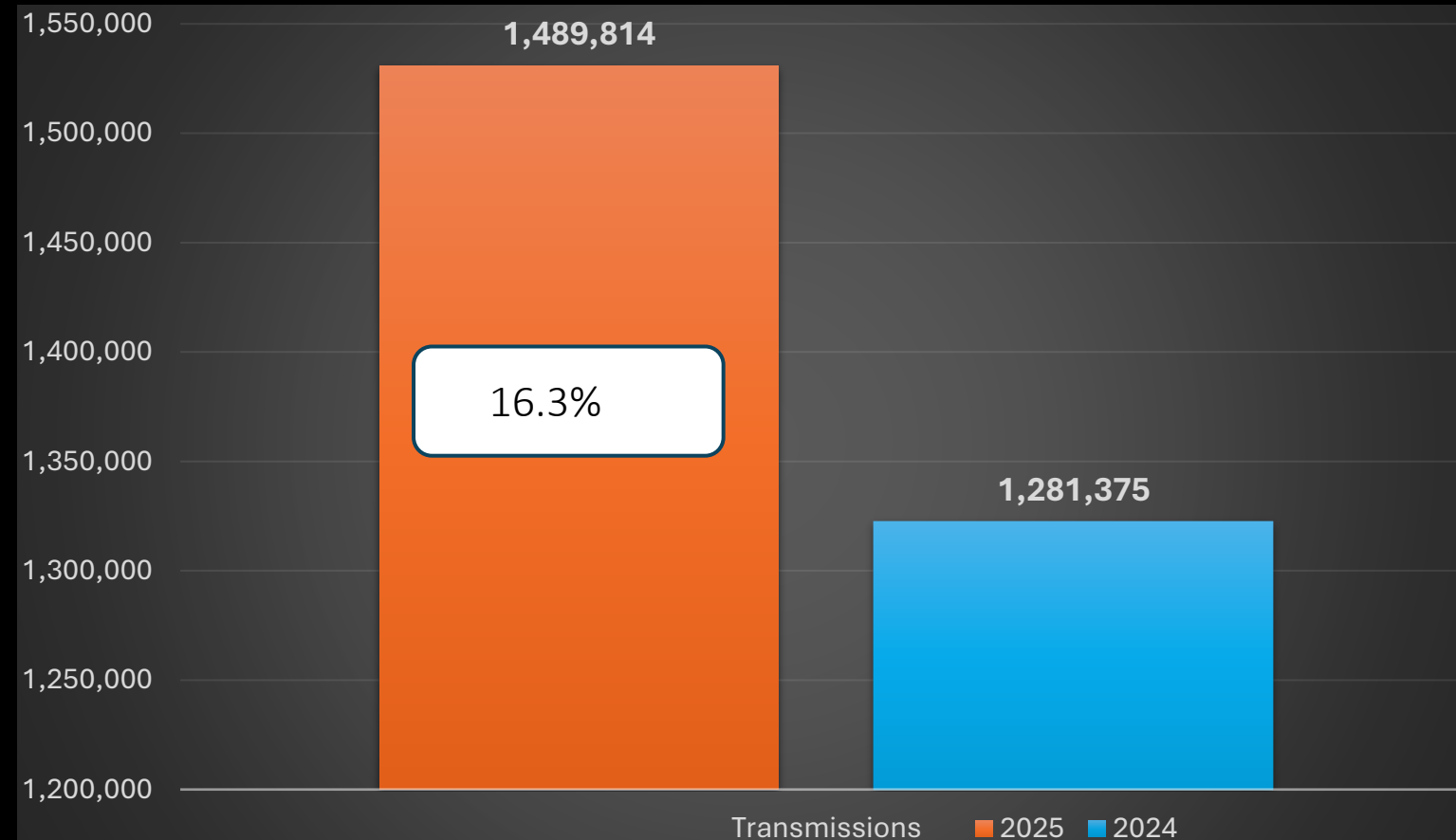
LOCATE REQUESTS FOR NC YEAR TO DATE

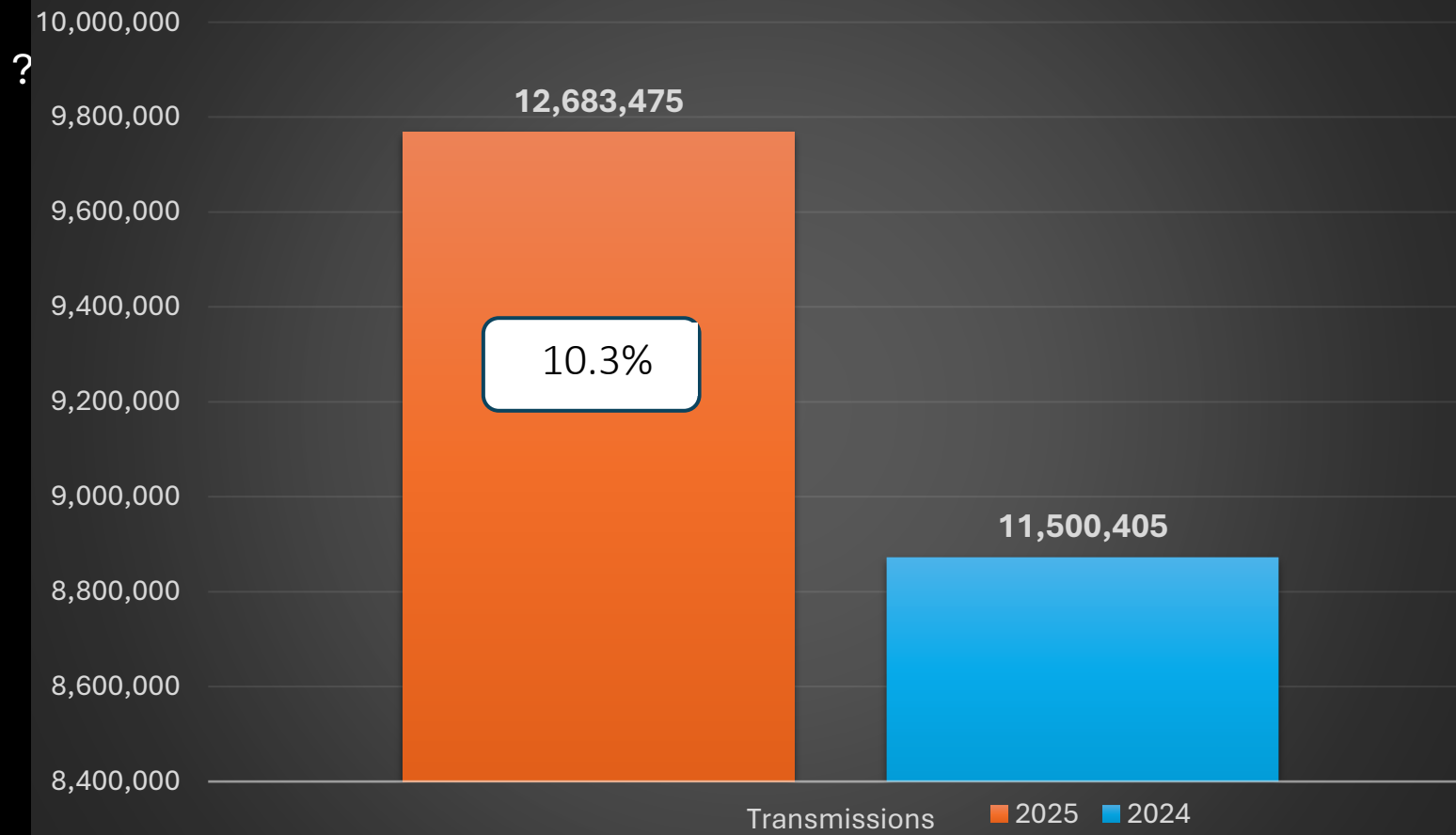
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TRANSMISSIONS FOR NC SEPT 25 VS 24

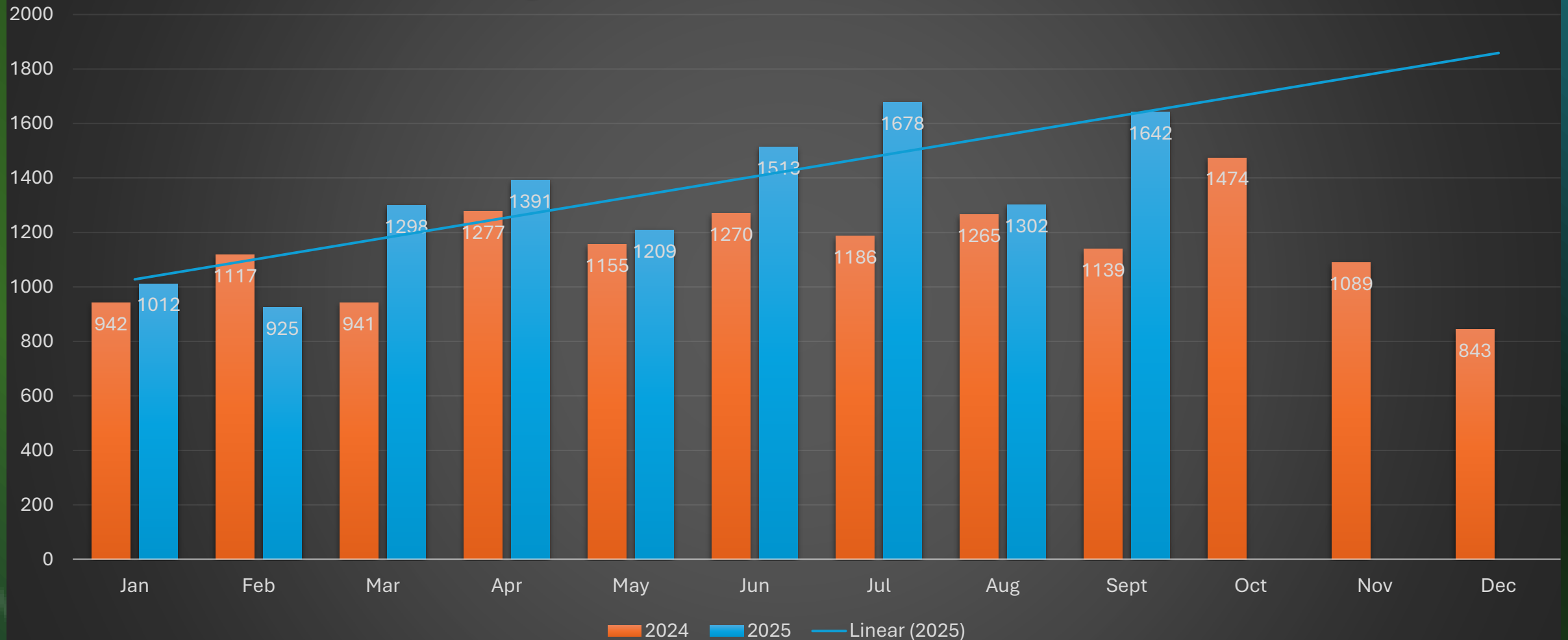
