

LOCATE REQUESTS FOR NC 2024 VS 2025





Discussion:

NC811 report: NC811 needs everyone to update their maps to stay as current as possible. NC811 will be at the Wake Forest basketball game and some other games vending. Overall locate tickets were down 12.5% from last year. Harnett County had 28 reported damages and Johnston had 51 reported damages in December. Dunn had the most reported damages in Harnett County.

Randy Johnson with Vermeer mentioned that if you see someone running one of their machines incorrectly, please call him and he will do a safety meeting with them.

Andrew reminded everyone that the Annual Contractor's Awareness/ Damage Prevention Breakfast is coming up in March. PNG will be covering the cost of the meal but we still need door prizes and speakers. He also encouraged everyone to attend the monthly meetings and to invite their contractors to the monthly meetings. Please remember to white line or flag the area you need located when calling in locates and give them good contact information.

David Larson with SREMC asked if white lining would become mandatory soon, Parrish said the law won't be discussed for a while. Linetta asked when a 3 hour ticket should be called in and Parrish said you can do a 3 hour ticket if you do not get a Positive Response, you must do a 3 hour ticket if you see evidence of an unlocated utility.

Randy Johnson with Vermeer sponsored the meal today. Andrew thanked everyone for coming and adjourned the meeting.
