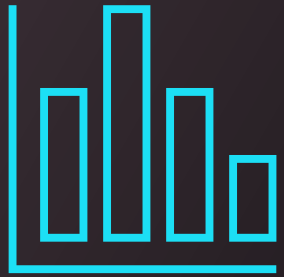

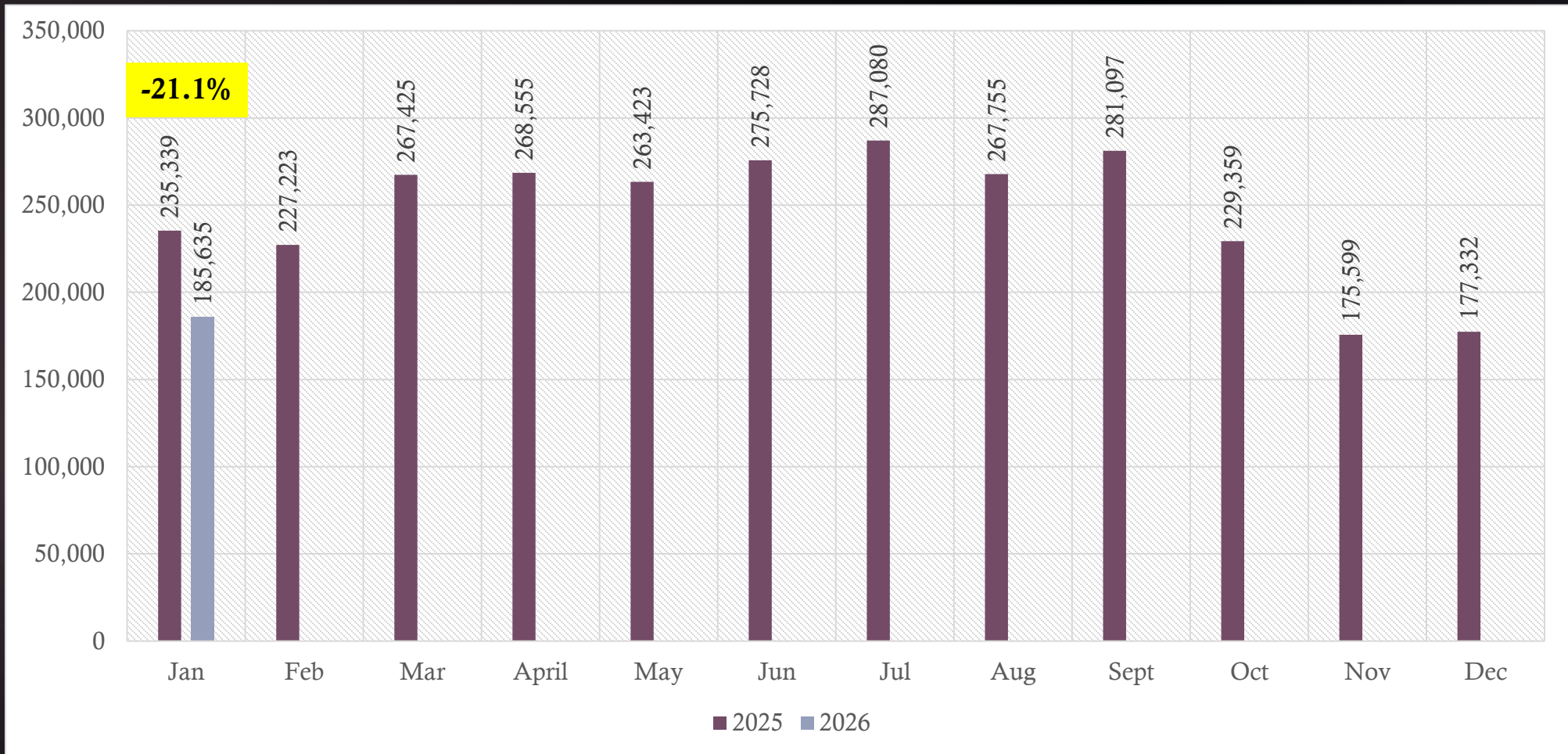

LOCATE REQUESTS FOR NC 2025 VS 2026

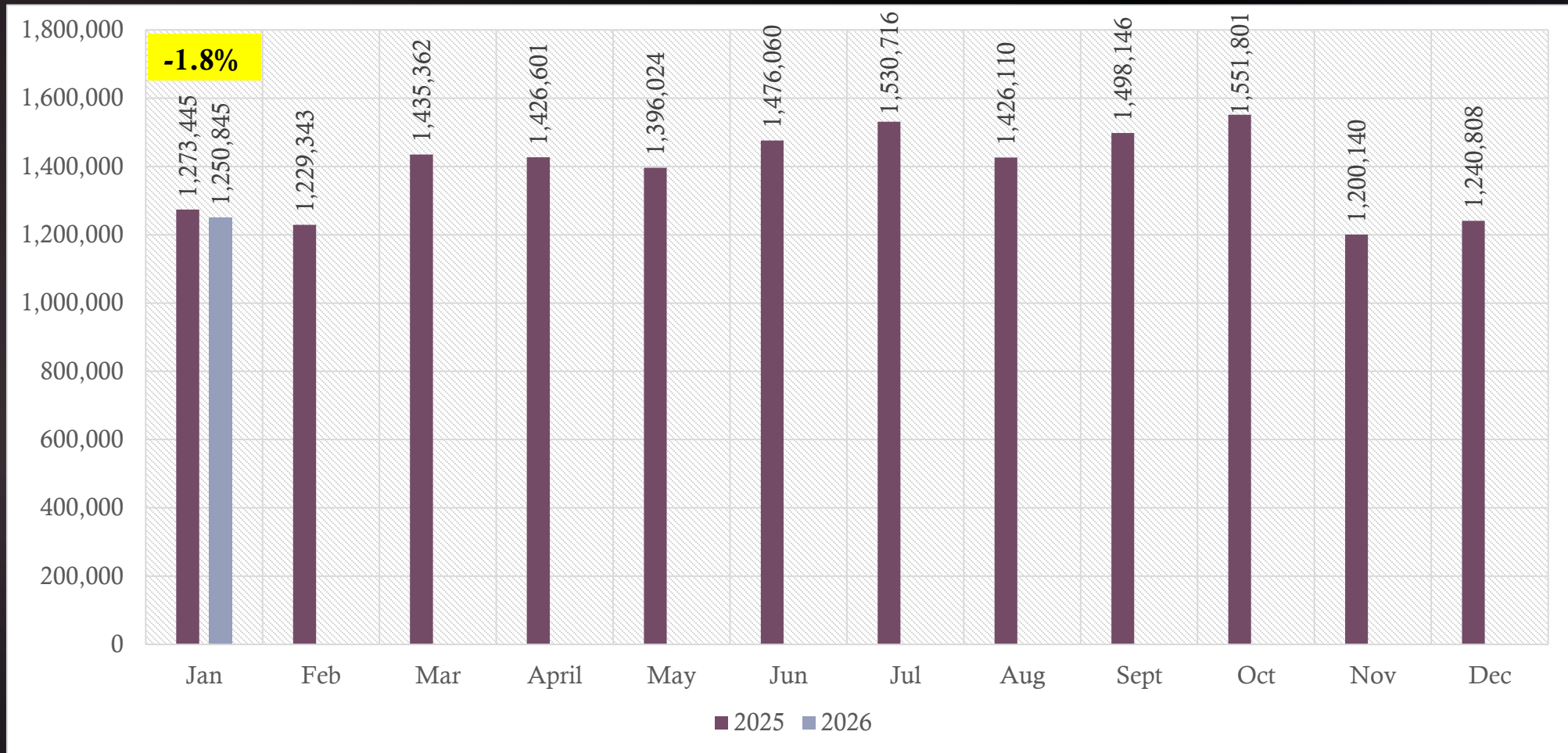

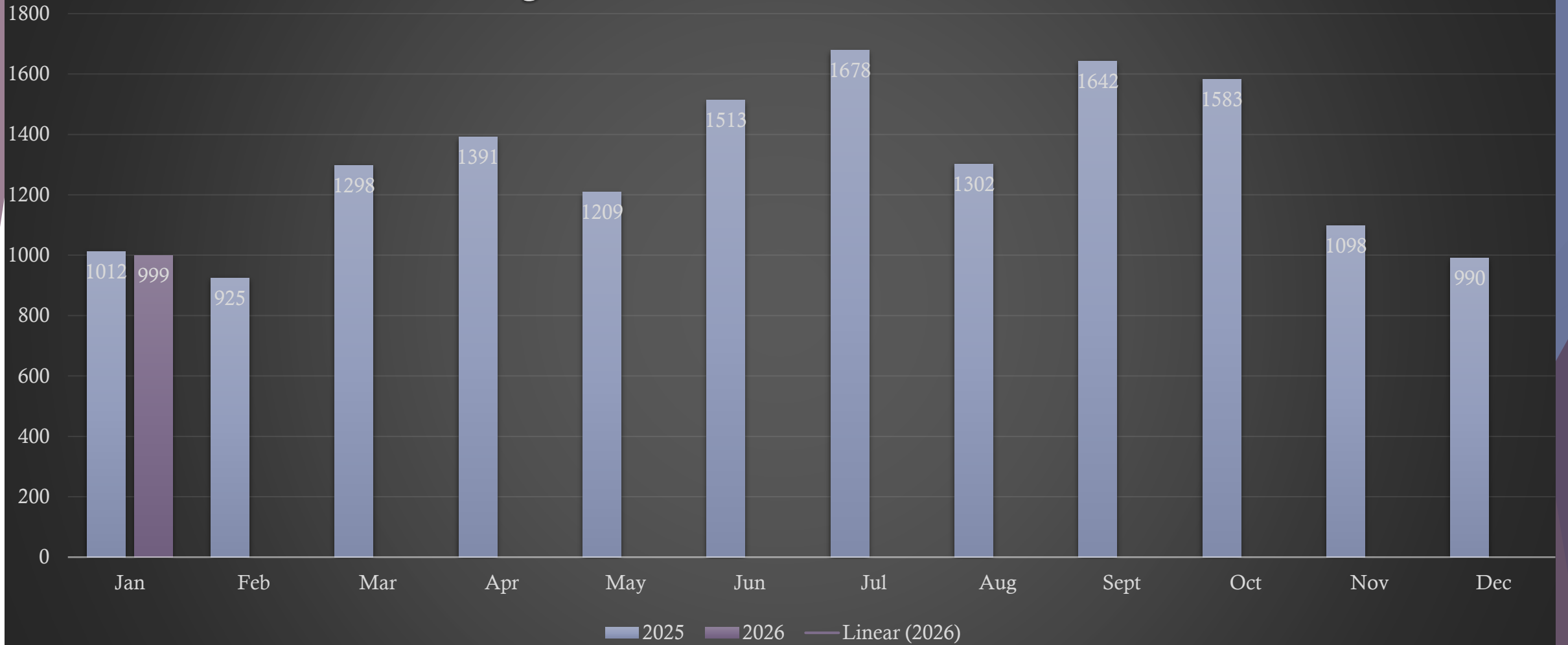

Projects:

SREMC –New subdivisions and replacement projects in Harnett County; new subdivisions in Johnston County. Transmission line out of Benson, 3 or 4 more weeks to go. Transmission project on Hwy 13.

Town of Clayton – routine maintenance, new phase of Carolina Overlook across the street from the current one.

Discussion:

NC811 report: Parrish went over all the upcoming meetings. Overall locate tickets were down 21% from last year. Harnett County had 21 reported damages and Johnston had 49 reported damages in January.

Lynetta with Town of Clayton mentioned issues with locate instructions she is getting, wanting entire property located and no white lines. Greg with SREMC mentioned similar issues with Brightspeed contractors, the locates are wanting both sides of street located even though they are only going down one side. When the utilities call the person calling in the locates for clarification, the contractor is sometimes reacting in an unprofessional manner per PRG. They are also calling in several tickets for the same address, same contractor and same area.

PRG said they are having a lot of issues with people digging without locates. He asked Parrish if he could help, he said all he can do is educate them. PRG also mentioned they are having an issue getting a police report when NCDOT tears down a pole. They asked how everyone is handling labeling their marked lines, SREMC said they are tagging theirs with SRE.

After discussion about locates, it was mentioned that if you call a contractor/utility to ask for clarification of area they want located you need to make sure they give you something in writing (email/text) if it is in conflict with what the ticket says.

Andrew reminded everyone that the Annual Contractor's Awareness/ Damage Prevention Breakfast is coming up in March. PNG will be covering the cost of the meal but we still need door prizes. He also encouraged everyone to attend the monthly meetings and to invite their contractors to the monthly meetings. Please remember to white line or flag the area you need located when calling in locates and give them good contact information.

Andrew thanked everyone for coming and adjourned the meeting.
