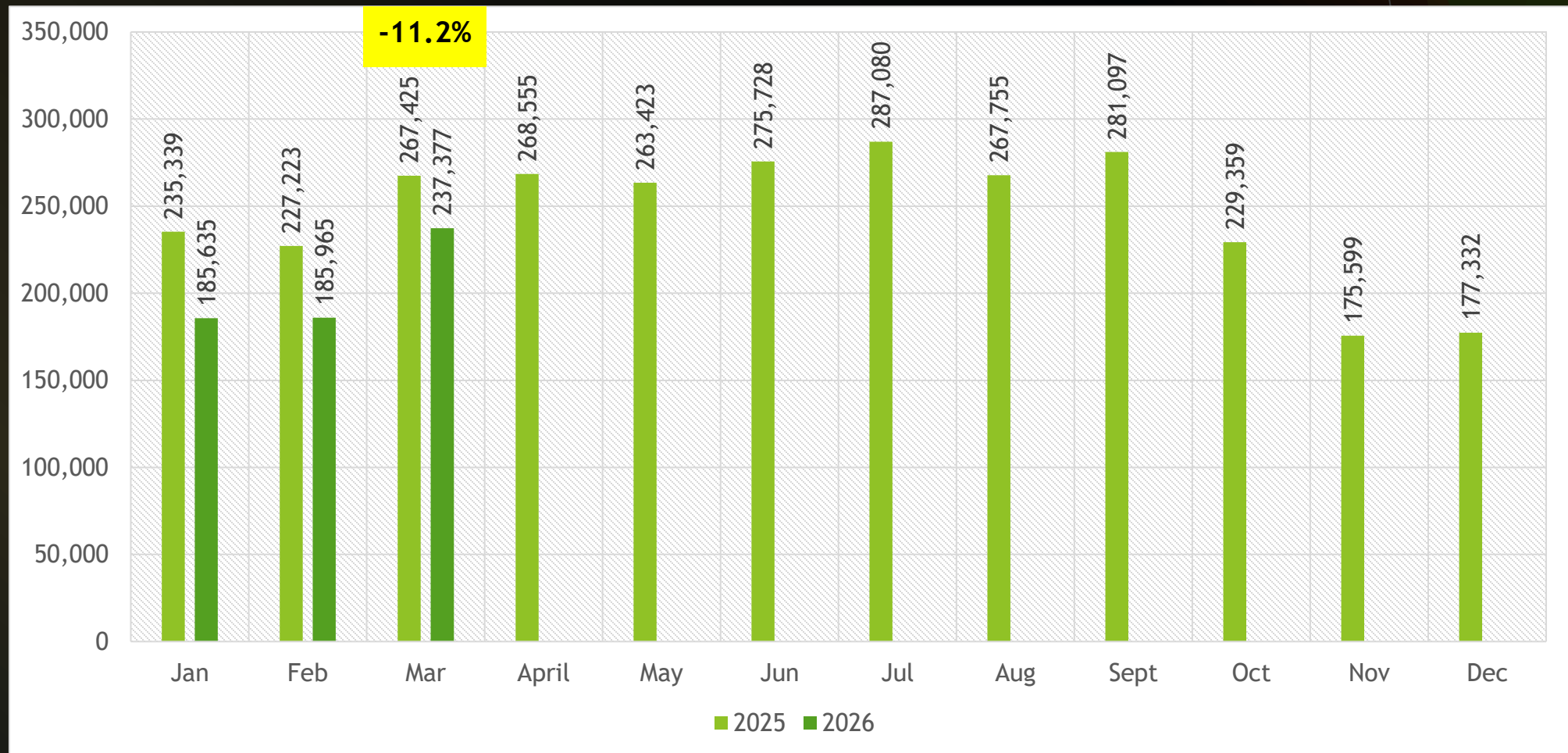

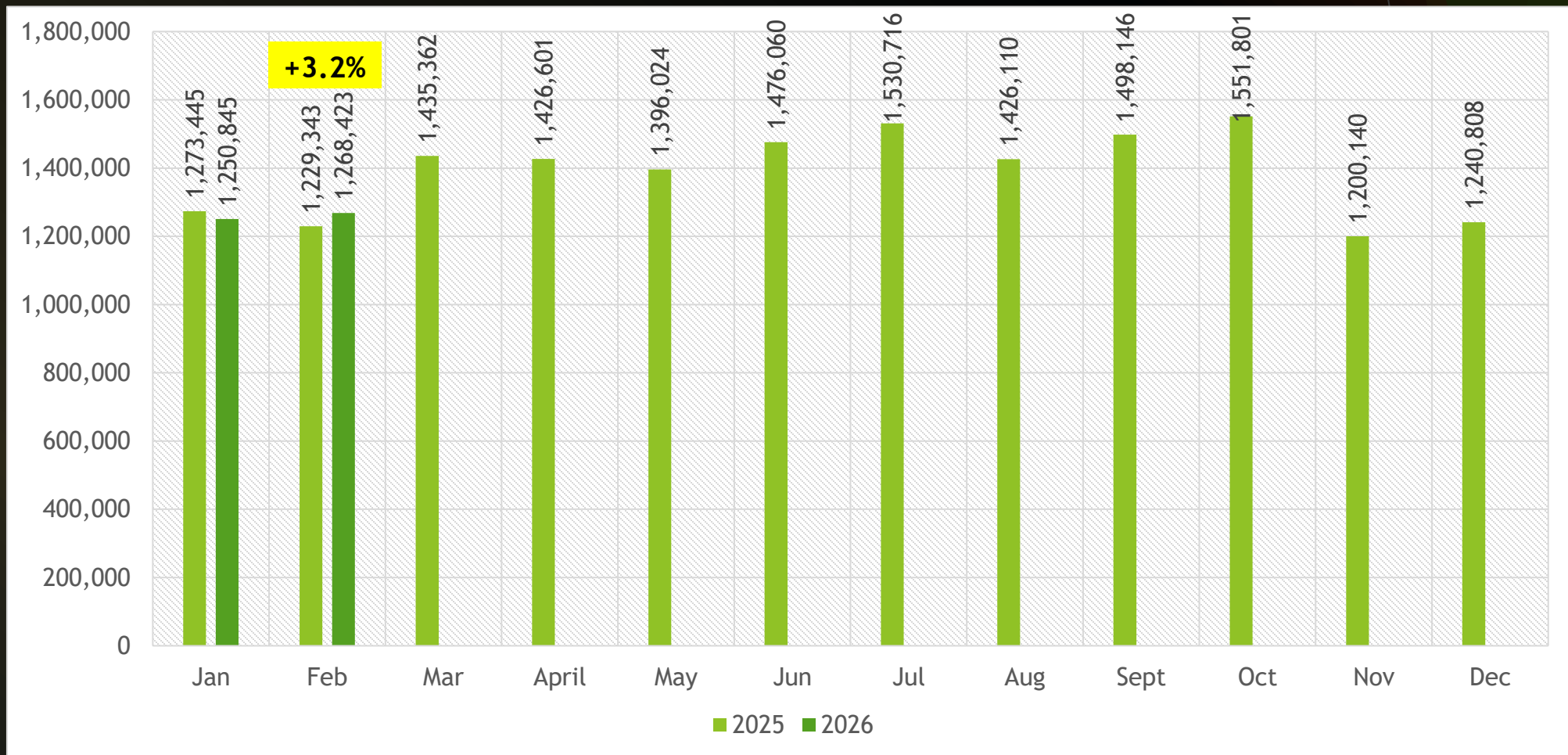
LOCATE REQUESTS FOR NC 2025 VS 2026

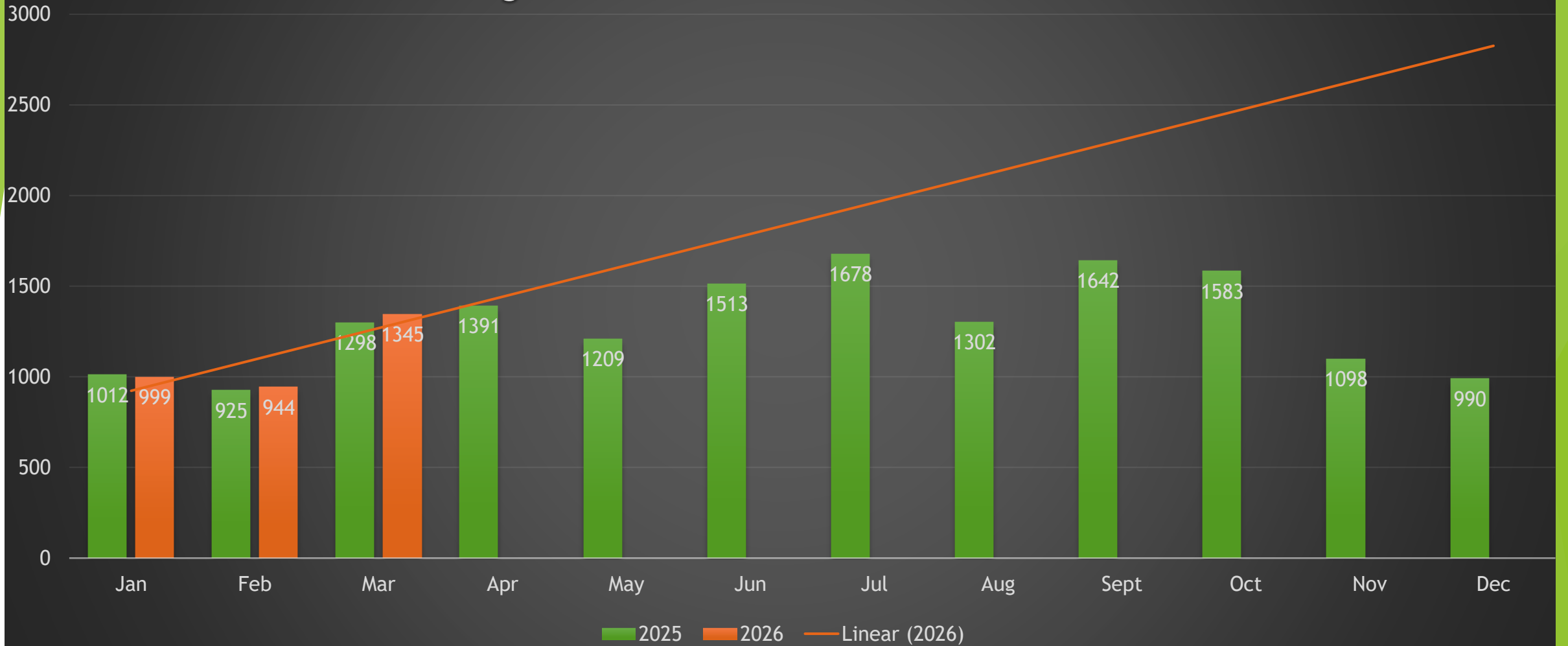

Piedmont Natural Gas – New locator has been hired. Tim Nickens retired. New gentleman is Carlton Foley. Currently in Charlotte doing training. He's been in the locate business for 30+ years. Duke is building next to PNG. Moving the office from Wild Grass over to Enterprise. 12" plastic main in Mt Gilead. Lake Tillery is GROWING. Businesses and residential coming. Fayetteville, Brunswick Co, and Indian Trail very busy.

PeeDee EMC – Shell building that had been in construction collapsed. Possibly a piece of material had been forgotten. They are in the process of rebuilding. Windstream is in the county replacing poles. Mineral Springs Ch Rd doing work. Pole replacements on Ledbetter.

NCDOT – Windstream doing a lot of arial work. Frontier headed to Richmond Co. They have had some concerns with Frontier. Trying to make sure they operate correctly.
