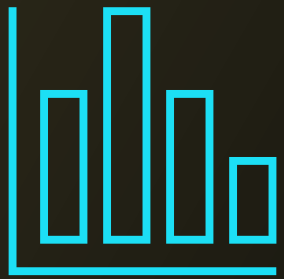

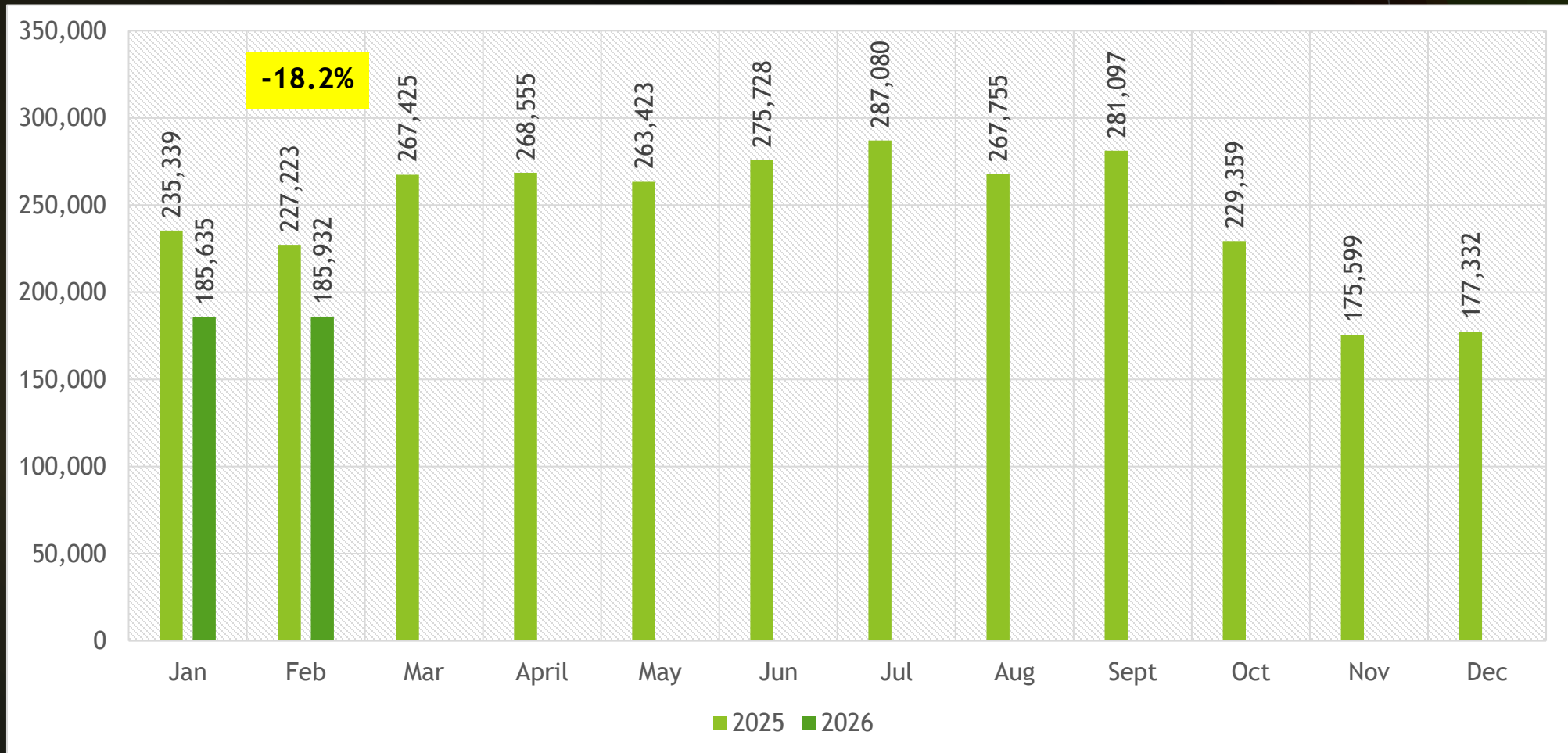

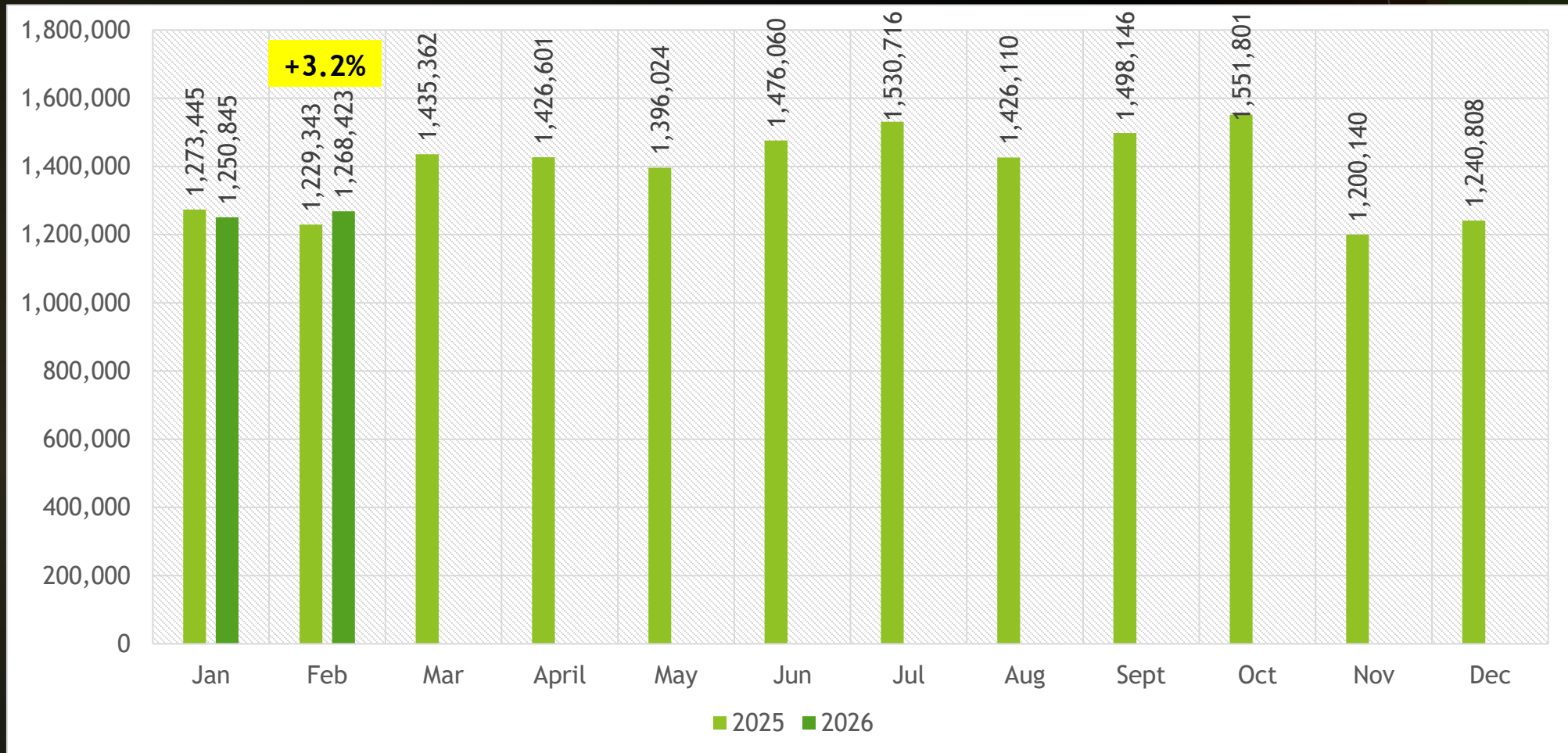

March Buncombe UCC Meeting Minutes

Notes Provided by Rory Phipps: Stand-In Buncombe UCC Secretary

Called to Order By: Rory Phipps

I Call to Order Welcome to the March Buncombe UCC meeting at Galactic Pizza.

Announcements:

I would like to thank everyone who attended the March meeting. Attendance was outstanding, with 27 members present. During the presentation, it was noted that there has been an increase in locates not being completed within the required three business days. NC811 has been made aware that members are receiving letters from a locate company citing an inability to meet the timeframe established by law. Please remember that clear and timely communication is essential when addressing these situations. If members feel this is unacceptable and are unable to delay work, the Underground Damage Prevention Review Board is the appropriate organization to contact to report potential violations, including but not limited to excavating without a valid ticket and failing to report damages which was also mentioned.

NCDOT Update:

NCDOT was not in attendance but let it be known they are planning to replace at least 18 bridges within the Buncombe area.

AT&T Update:

AT&T was also not in attendance; however, based on current observations, approximately 400,000 feet of new fiber is still being installed to replace outdated infrastructure. Please make every effort to communicate effectively with these contractors. Additionally, if any digging or boring activities are observed that do not comply with the North Carolina Excavation Safety Guidelines (i.e., the law), please remember the appropriate avenues for enforcement are available and should be utilized when necessary.

City of Asheville Water Department Update:

Replacing Water Lines from Hill Street to Montford.

Other Members in attendance: Enbridge, GHL Services, Southern Cross, and MB Haynes.

We Close this meeting with a reminder to communicate with each other and remember safety first.
