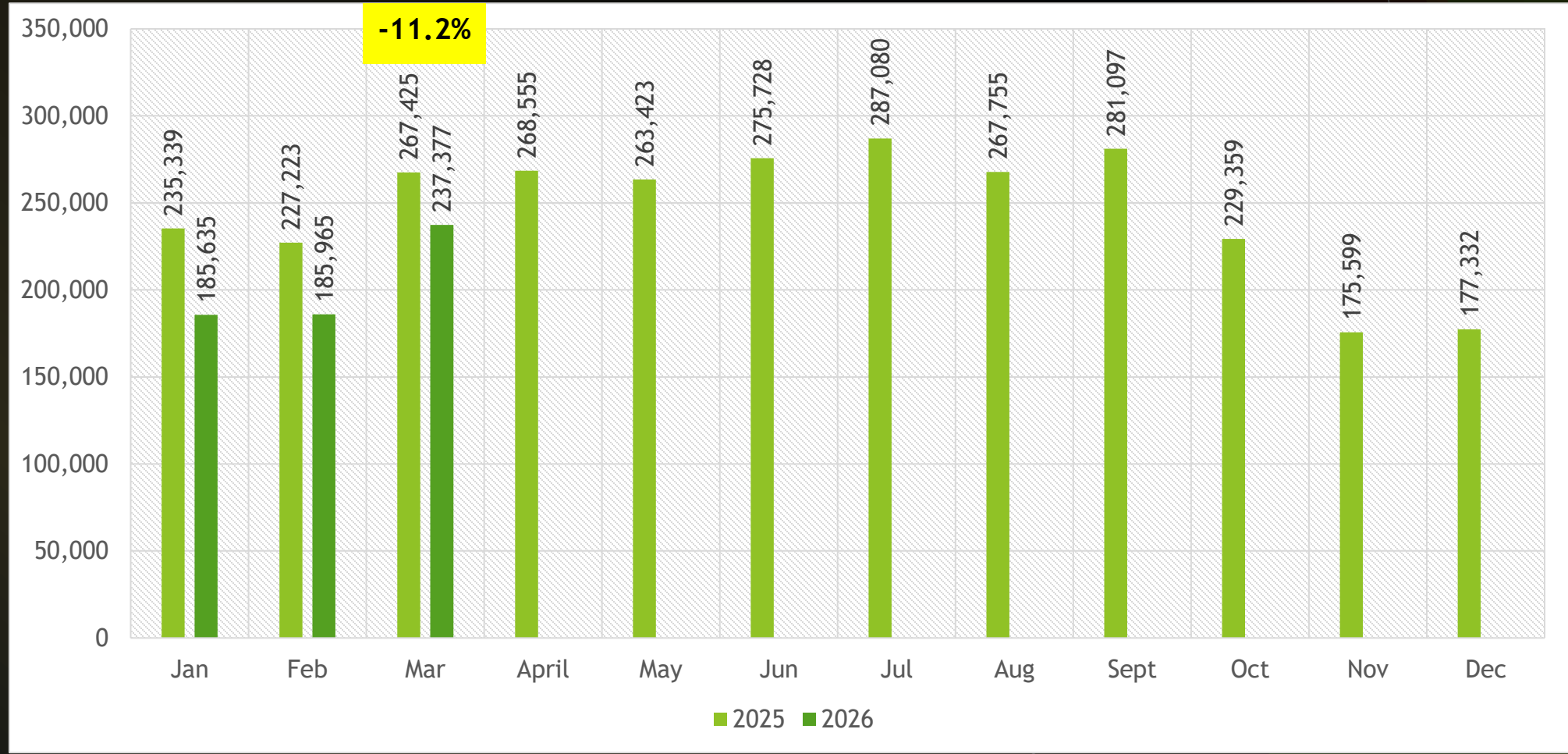

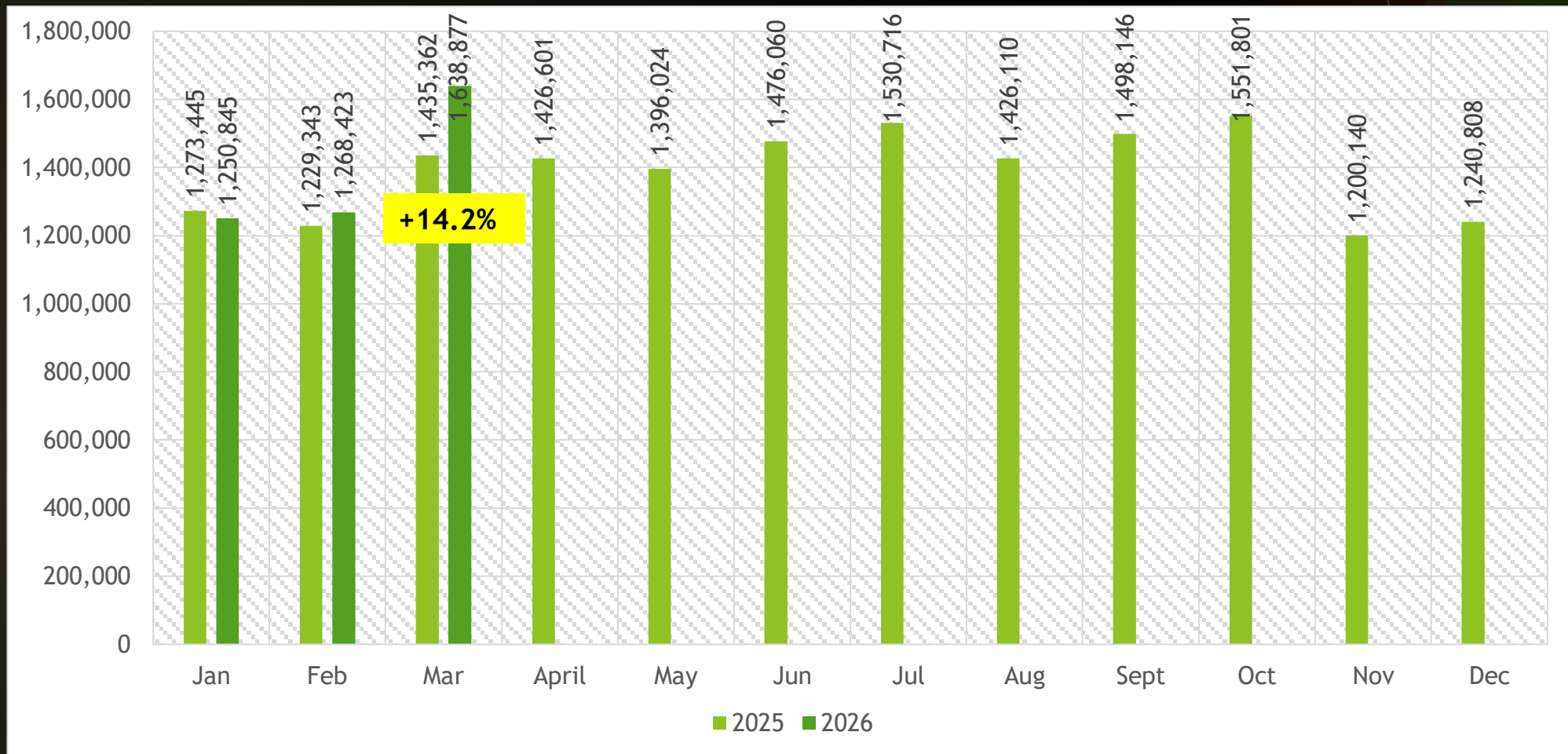
# LOCATE REQUESTS FOR NC 2025 VS 2026

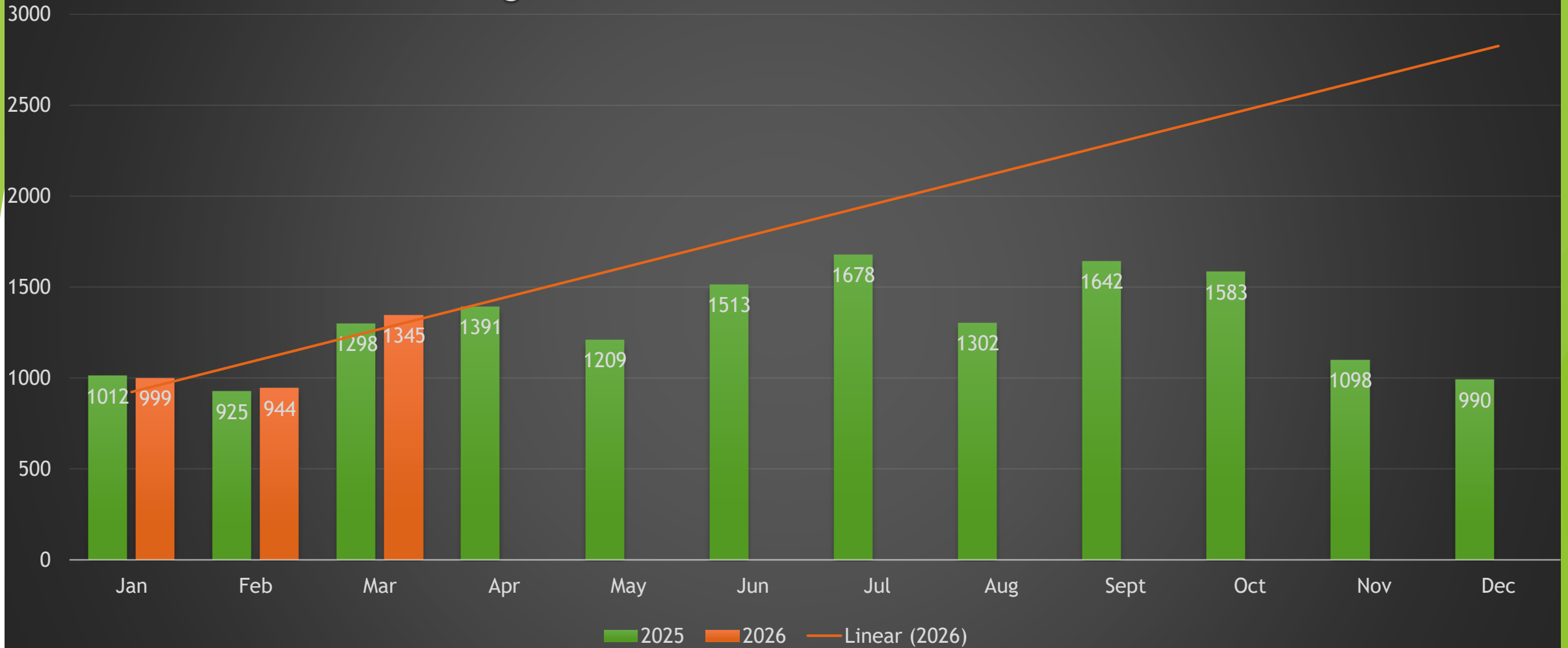

Meeting opened by Chair, Bryan Mills at 10:00 AM

NC811 presentation given by Tami Groves

Enbridge -Google project currently on hold. They need to resubmit a form. Keeping an eye on plumbing contractors entering emergency tickets for non-emergencies. (I've been reaching out to the contractor) In some cases, there is no emergency, in others def emergencies. Also, Windstream/Uniti hitting them. We need ticket numbers so we can reach out.

Duke Energy – Nothing specific. Electrical still continuing updates. For the LRPC – Senator Lazaro would like to get the law group together to discuss the law changes in Oct. For utilities screening their tickets – if you get an IMMEDIATE response two minutes after entering a locate request that there is no utility in conflict, and you know there is a utility, you can enter a three-hour ticket even though the three days are not up. This is geared toward utilities that are screening. Next LRPC meeting is May 20<sup>th</sup>. Everyone is welcome to attend.

TRC – If you are seeing a response to a ticket that says someone has approved an extension, please know that USIC is attempting to fix this automated response with their IT inhouse. This is the response that comes to the excavator that says, “the utility and the excavator agreed to an extension.”

Piedmont Natural Gas – currently doing work as normal. No new large projects.

City of Salisbury – they are seeing emails from a company called AMDocs. The email said Mobile NC – mobile NC permits. This is a new AI company. Unknown if they are a legit company or if they are phishing. They are NOT opening the emails and treating them as though they are phishing.

Next meeting May 14<sup>th</sup> in Salisbury
