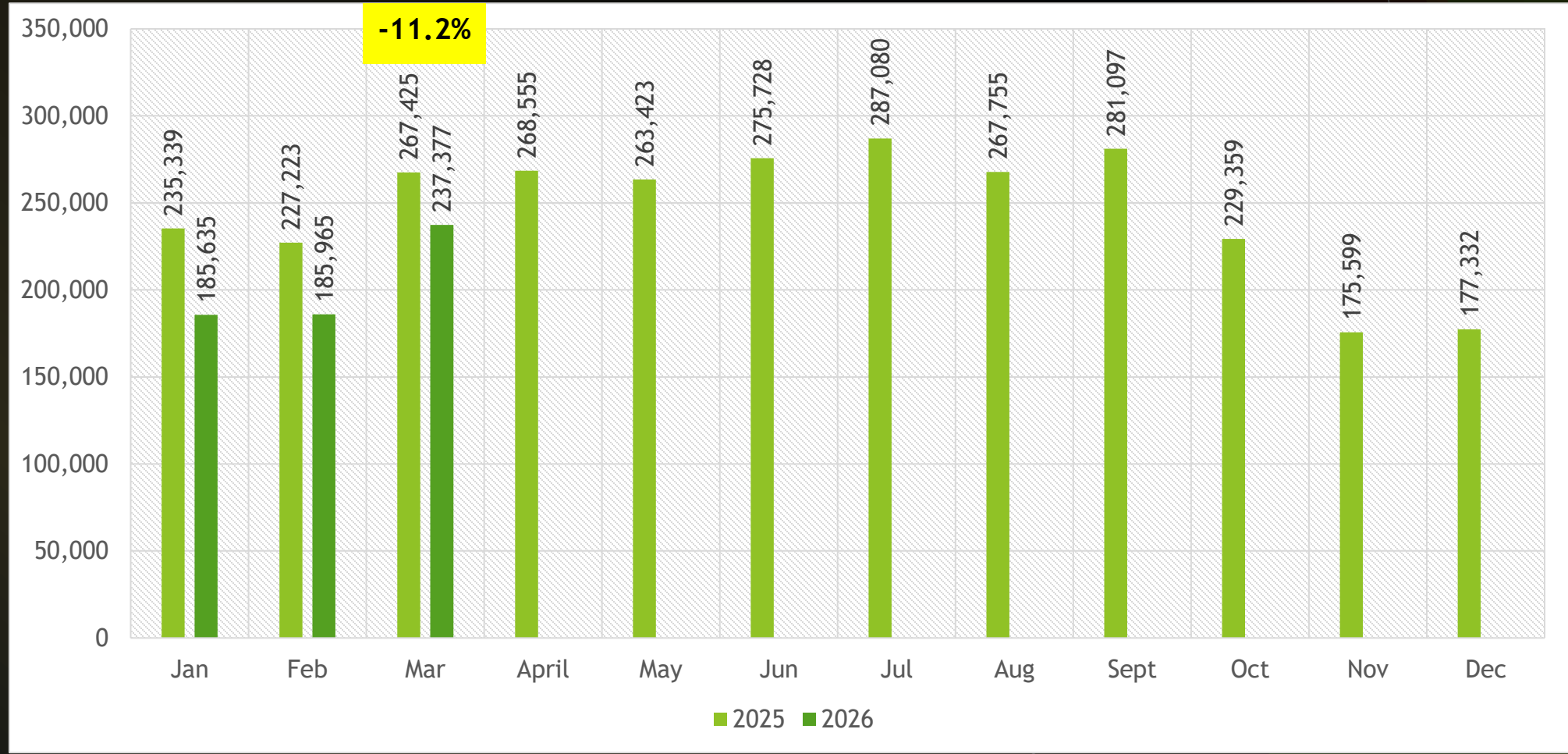

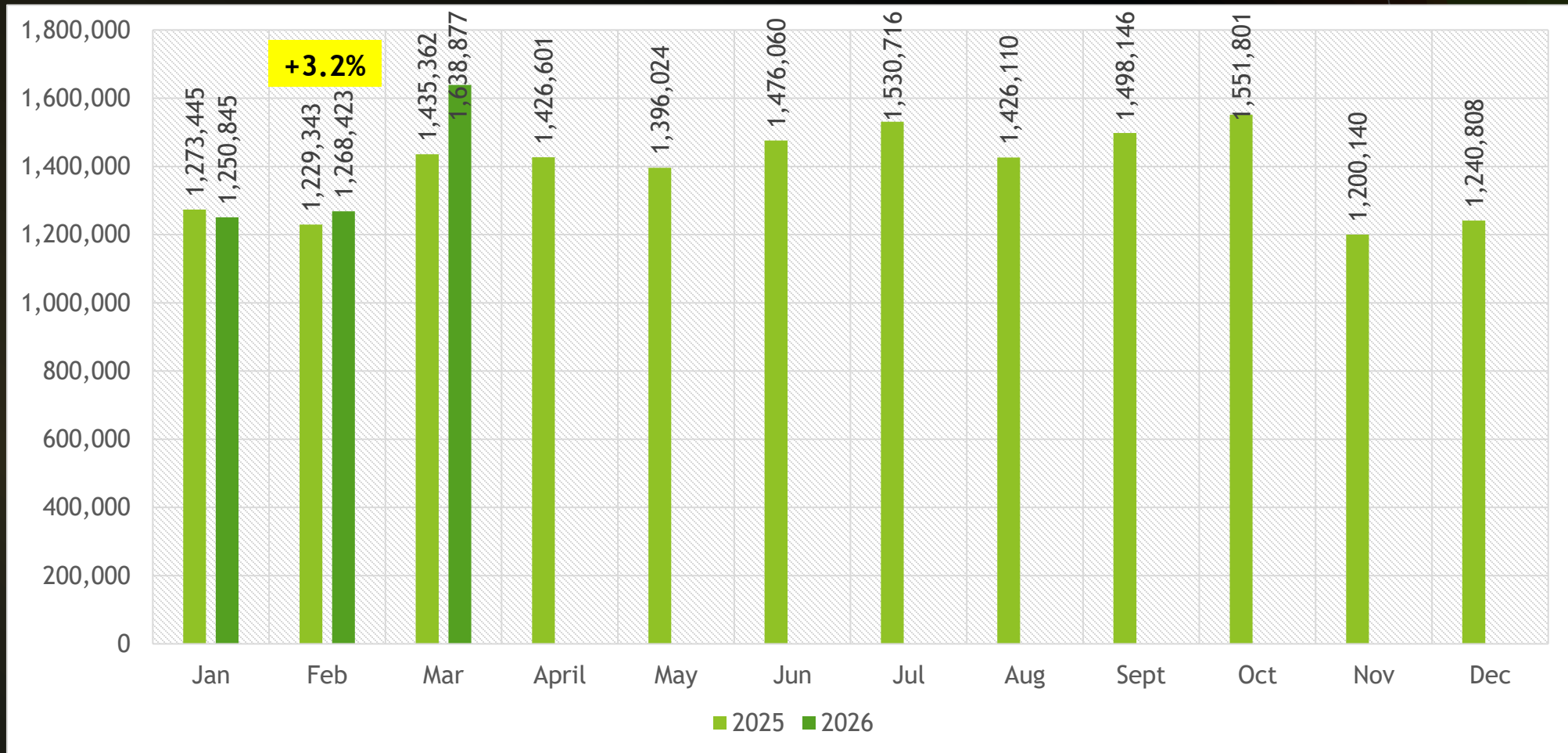
LOCATE REQUESTS FOR NC 2025 VS 2026

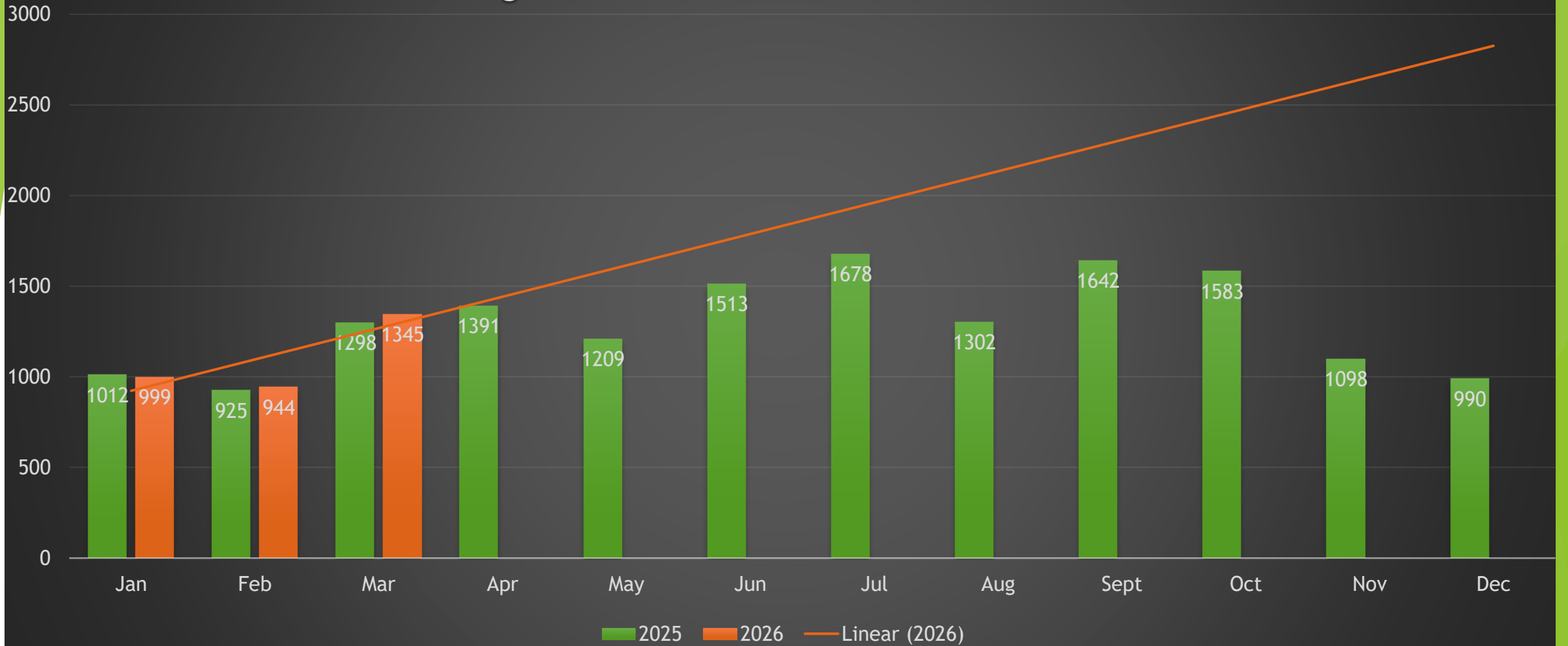
