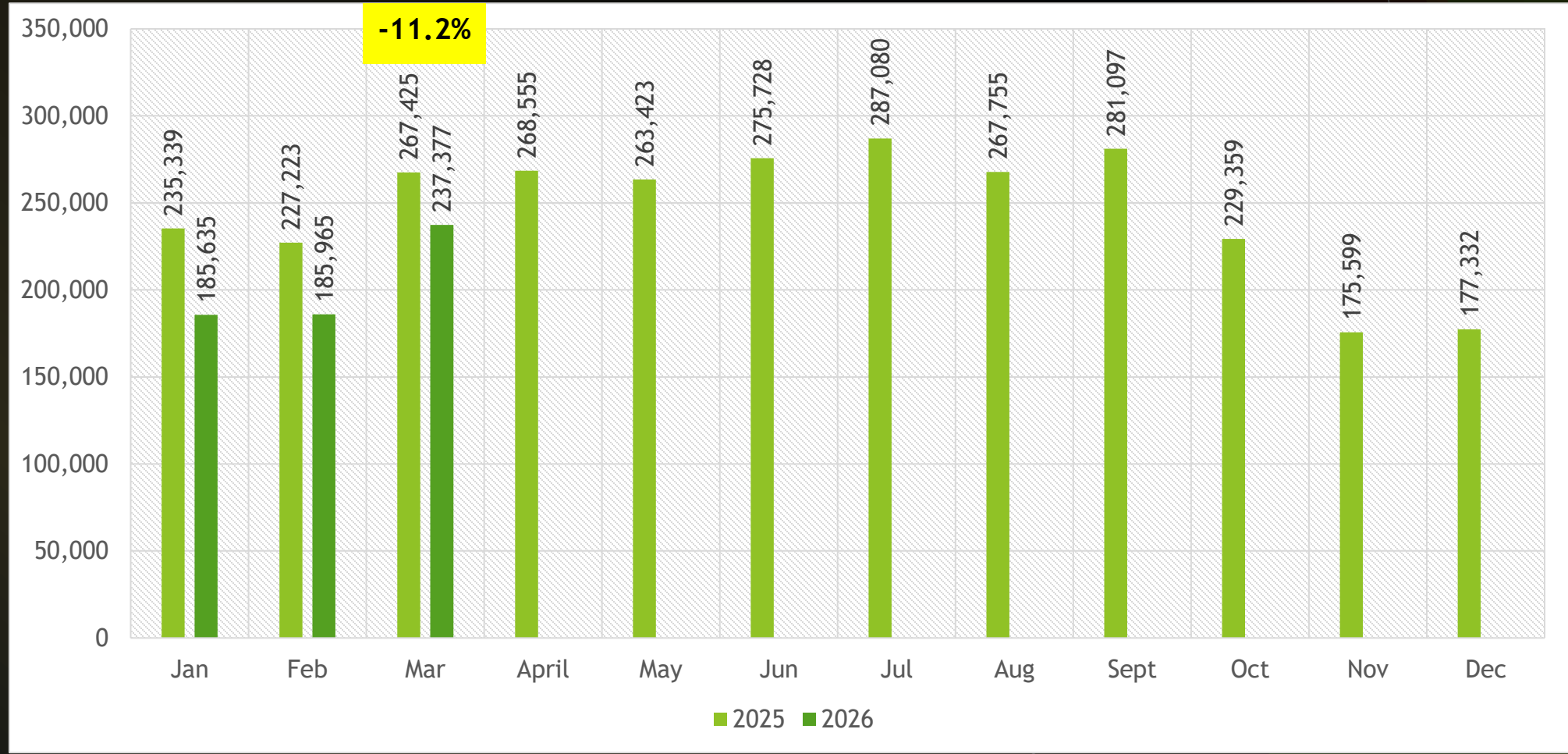

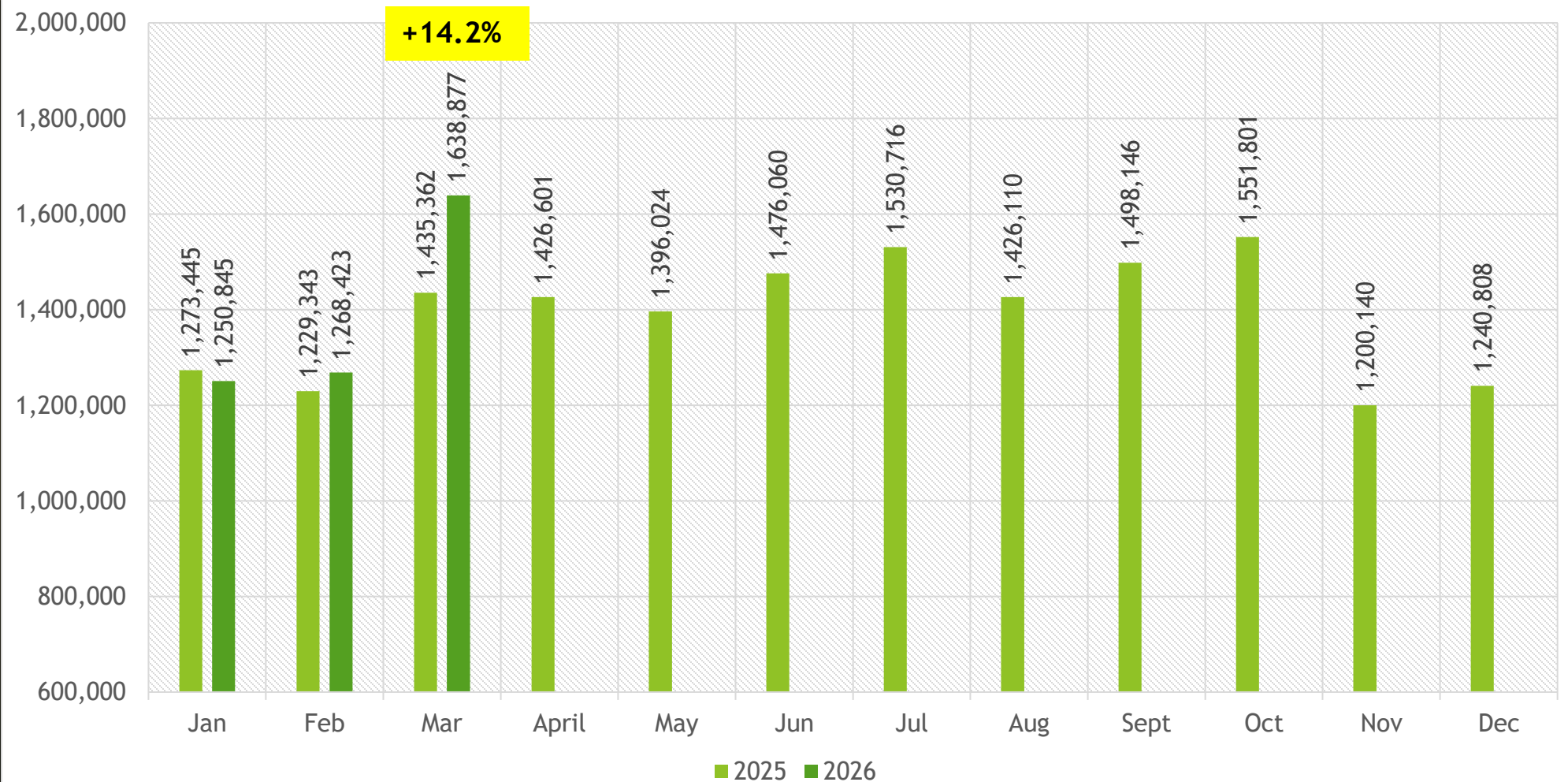
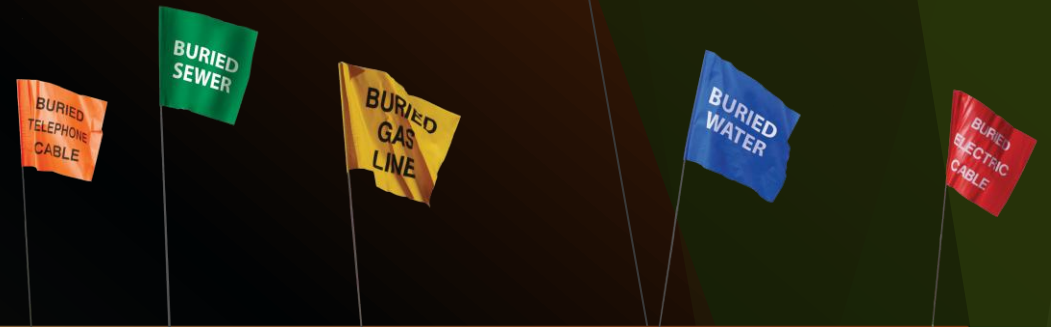
LOCATE REQUESTS FOR NC 2025 VS 2026

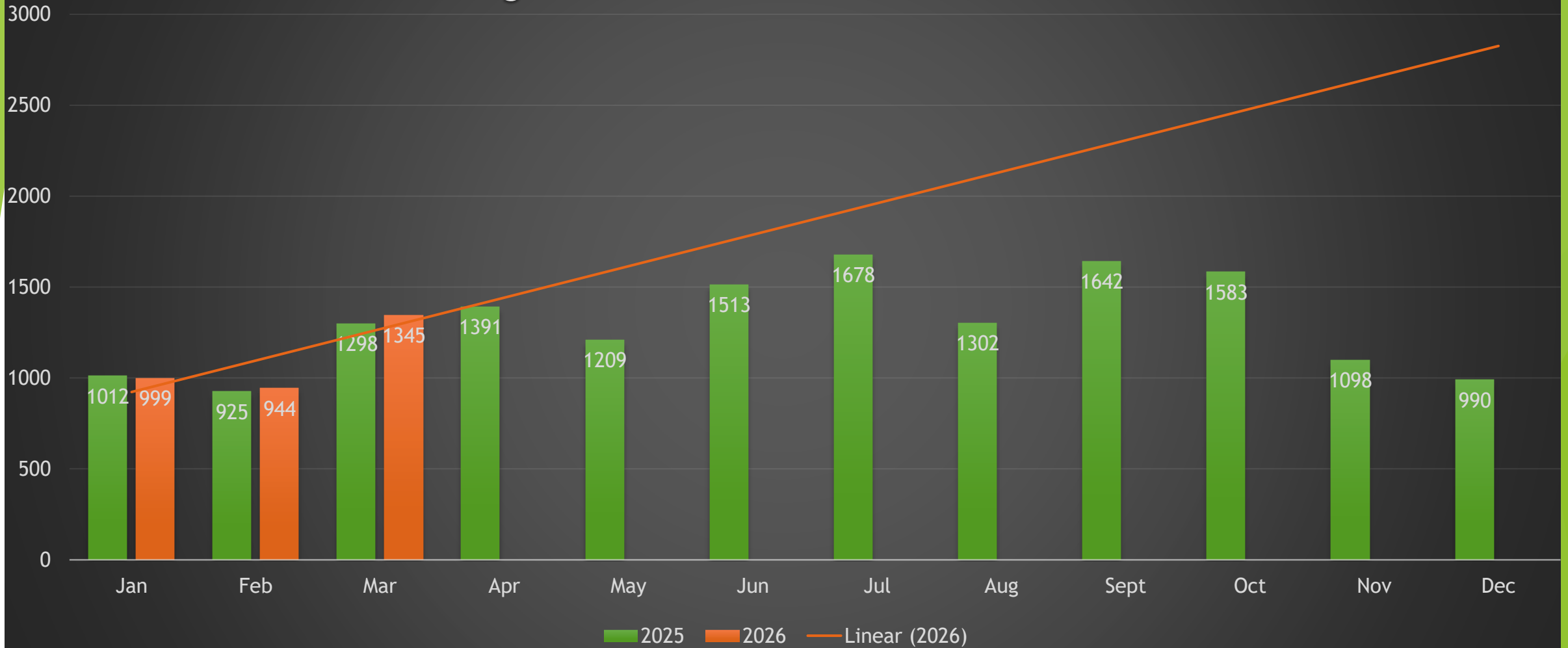

Meeting opened at 8:35 by Chair, Andrew Holquist

Enbridge Gas – No new big projects at this time. Lot of maintenance work ongoing. Watch and protect gearing up to start in May. Ten damage prevention folks to join the crew already in the field. Most of the new staff will be in the Wake County area with the exception of one crew. Damages are down currently 10% from last year. Enbridge has a good relationship with the City of Durham on right of ways. SAM will shut down crews if they are not operating correctly, and the City of Durham will as well. Enbridge would like to extend the program into other areas as well, empowering municipalities to feel more comfortable working right of ways.
