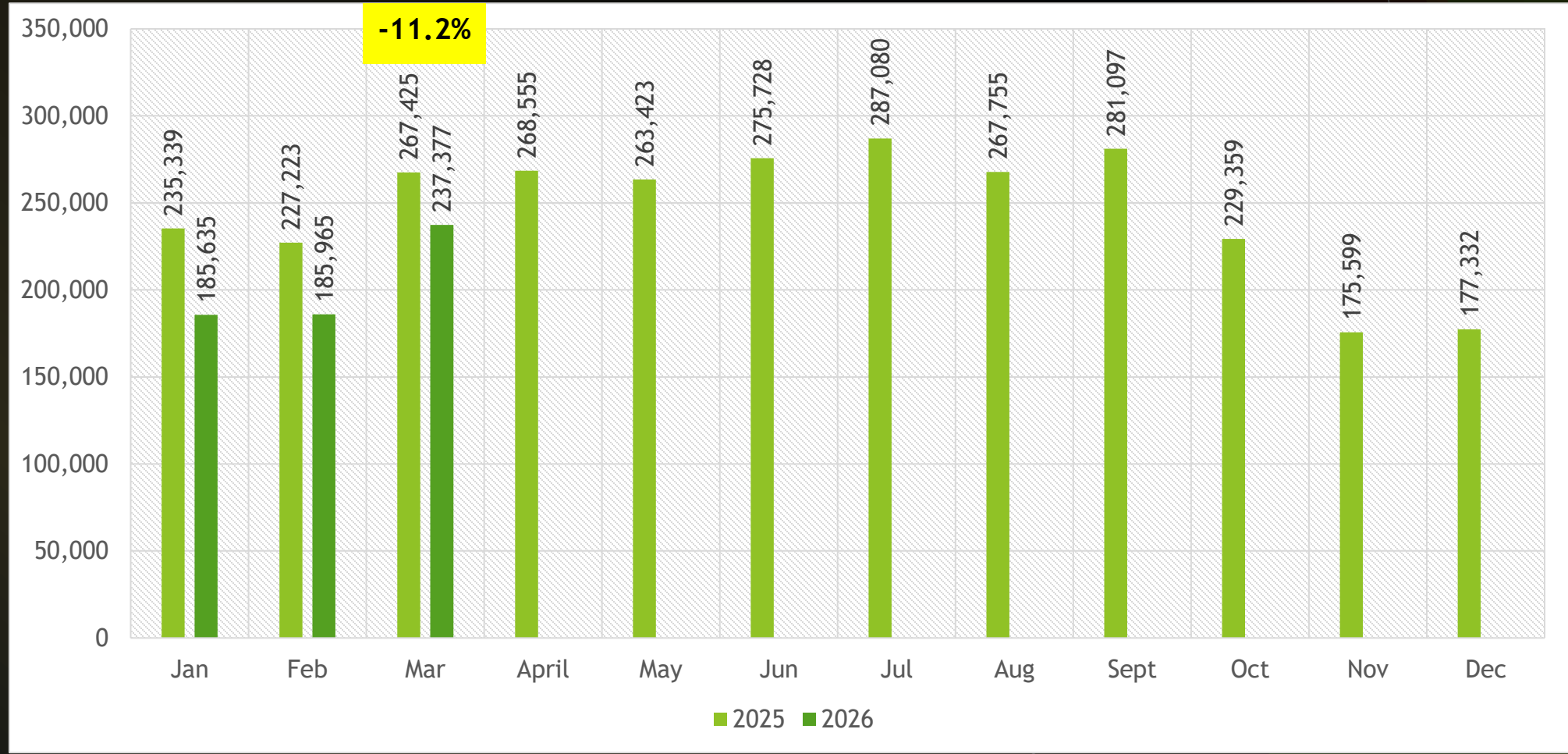

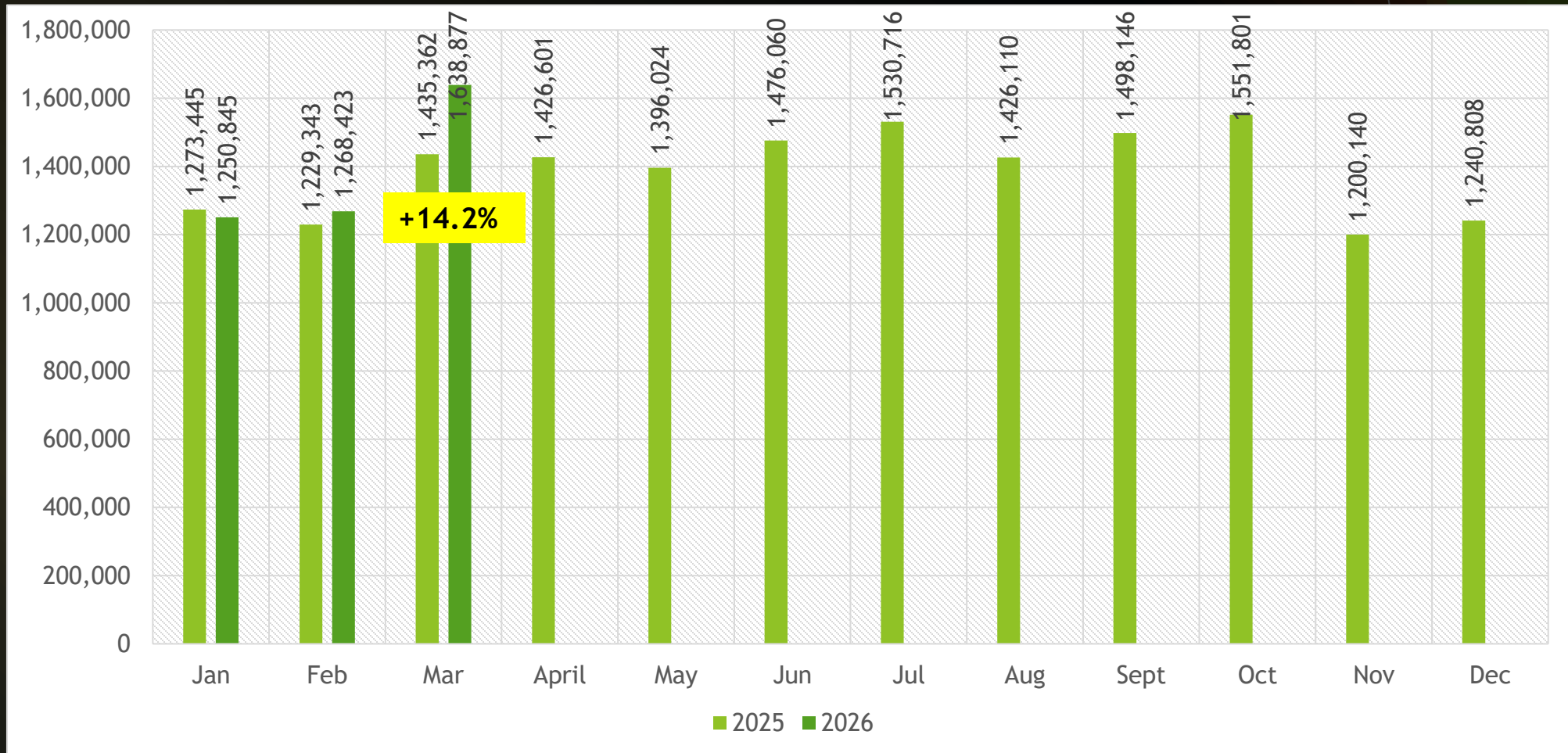
LOCATE REQUESTS FOR NC 2025 VS 2026

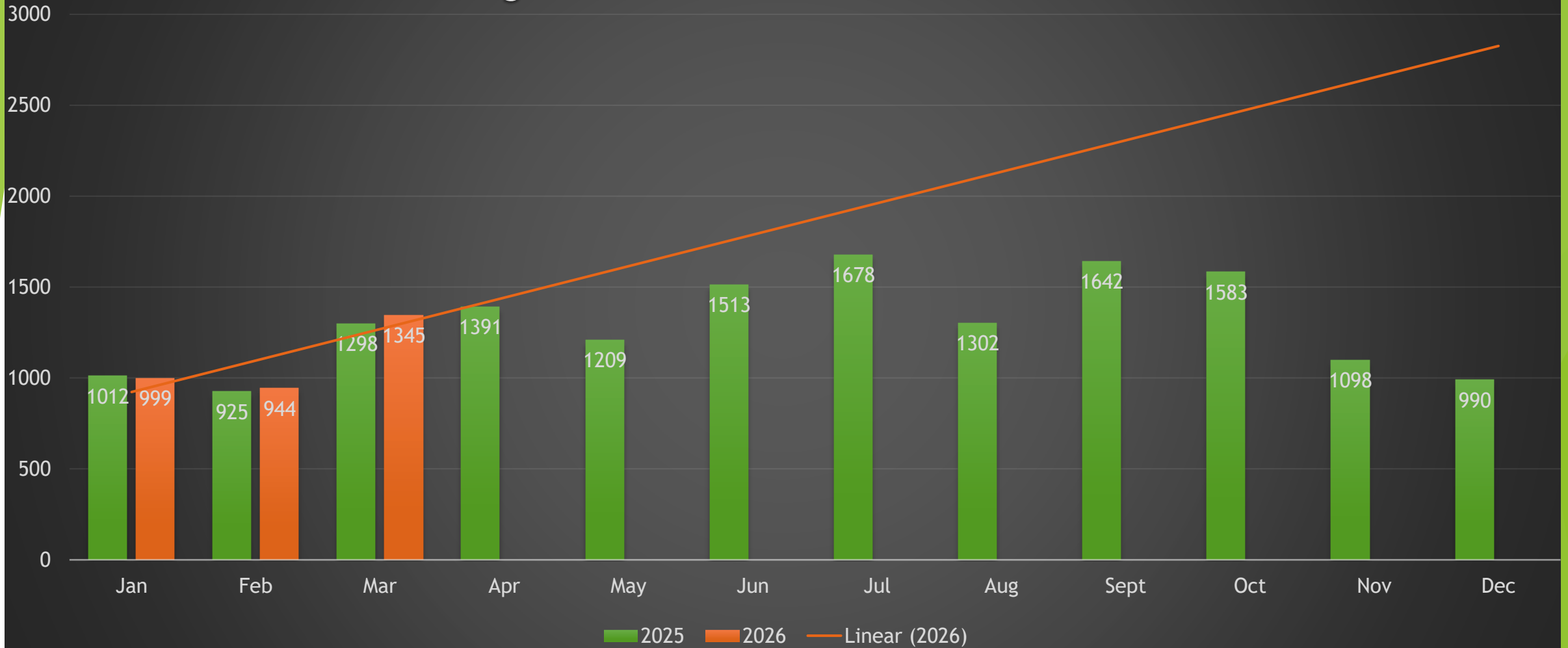

 - Safety Share: Remember warmer weather causes ticks and other stinging insects to become more frequent. Check yourself for ticks and especially be mindful when walking through tall grass of possible nests or snakes that may be in the area.
2. Announcements
 - NC/SC Joint UCC: May 13-15th – Sign-ups are available and payment processing is working adequately.

C. Old Business/New Business/Projects

1. Old business.
 - NCDOT-has 2 US Open projects ongoing that must be completed by 2028 as well as one drain replacement on Hwy 42.
2. Open floor for any new business.
 - PNG (Zac Harris)
 - Hwy 42 & Fayetteville St – Gov. Relocation
 - In Liberty, three new housing developments are underway.
 - NCDOT (Tyler Kimes & Justin Richardson)
 - Increased encroachment activity, especially Montgomery County Brightspeed rural fiber project.
 - Reported issues of improper traffic control, infractions such as:
 - Wrong Signs
 - Incorrect sign locations
 - Not enough signage
 - Signs not being taken down during non-working hours
 - Flaggers not certified
 - GHL Services (Trey Hannig)
 - Pineview Rd, Randleman – 20” Water line (PTRWA)
 - Audobon (David Talbert & Robert Memory)
 - Recently signed contract with Enbridge Natural Gas
 - Office opening in Concord/Charlotte
 - Increased project engineering for both gas and telecom
 - S&N Communication (Brian Morehouse)
 - Contracted to mark for Ripple Fiber which is covering some of Moore County

 - Parrish shared the presentation.
 - Reminder: April is SAFE DIGGING month
