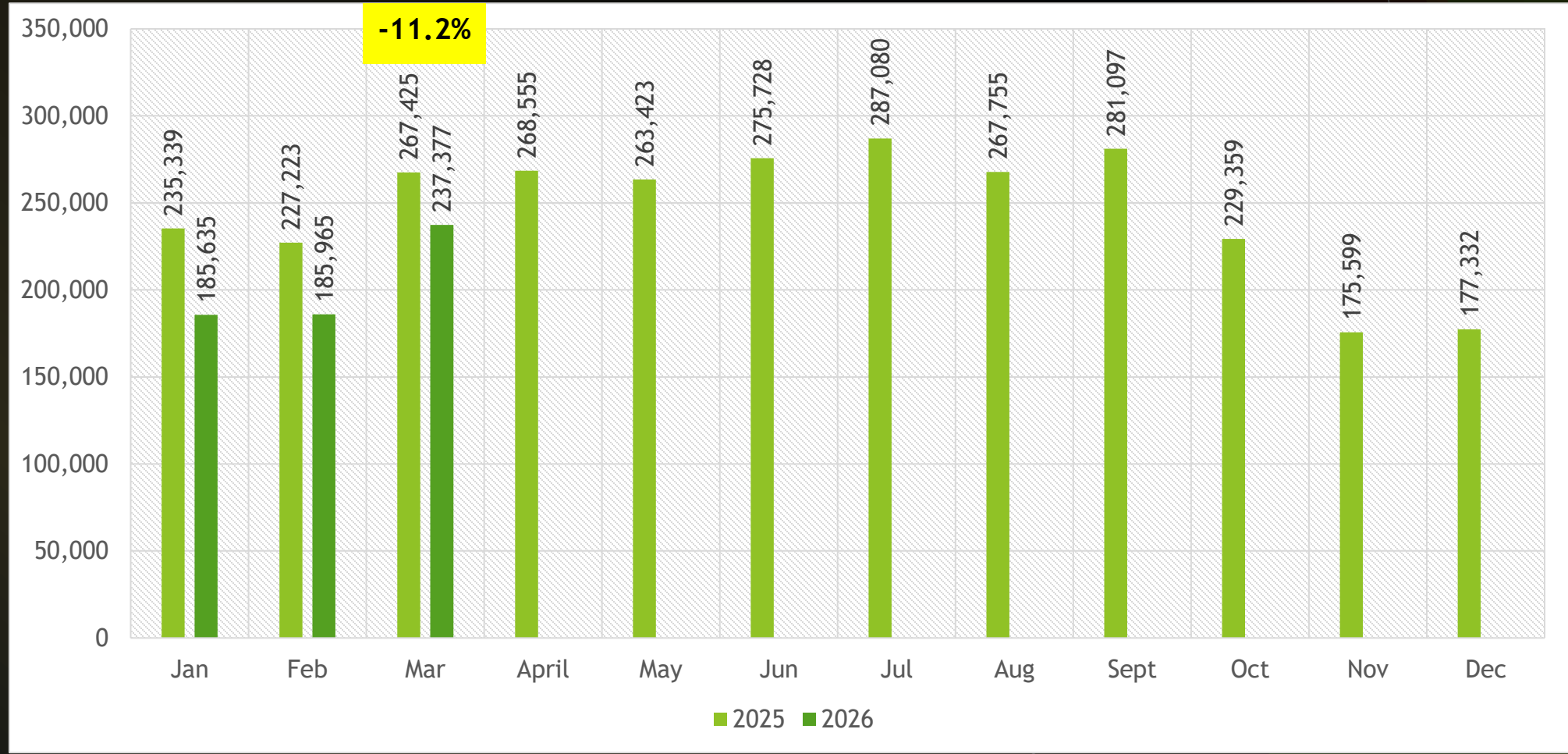

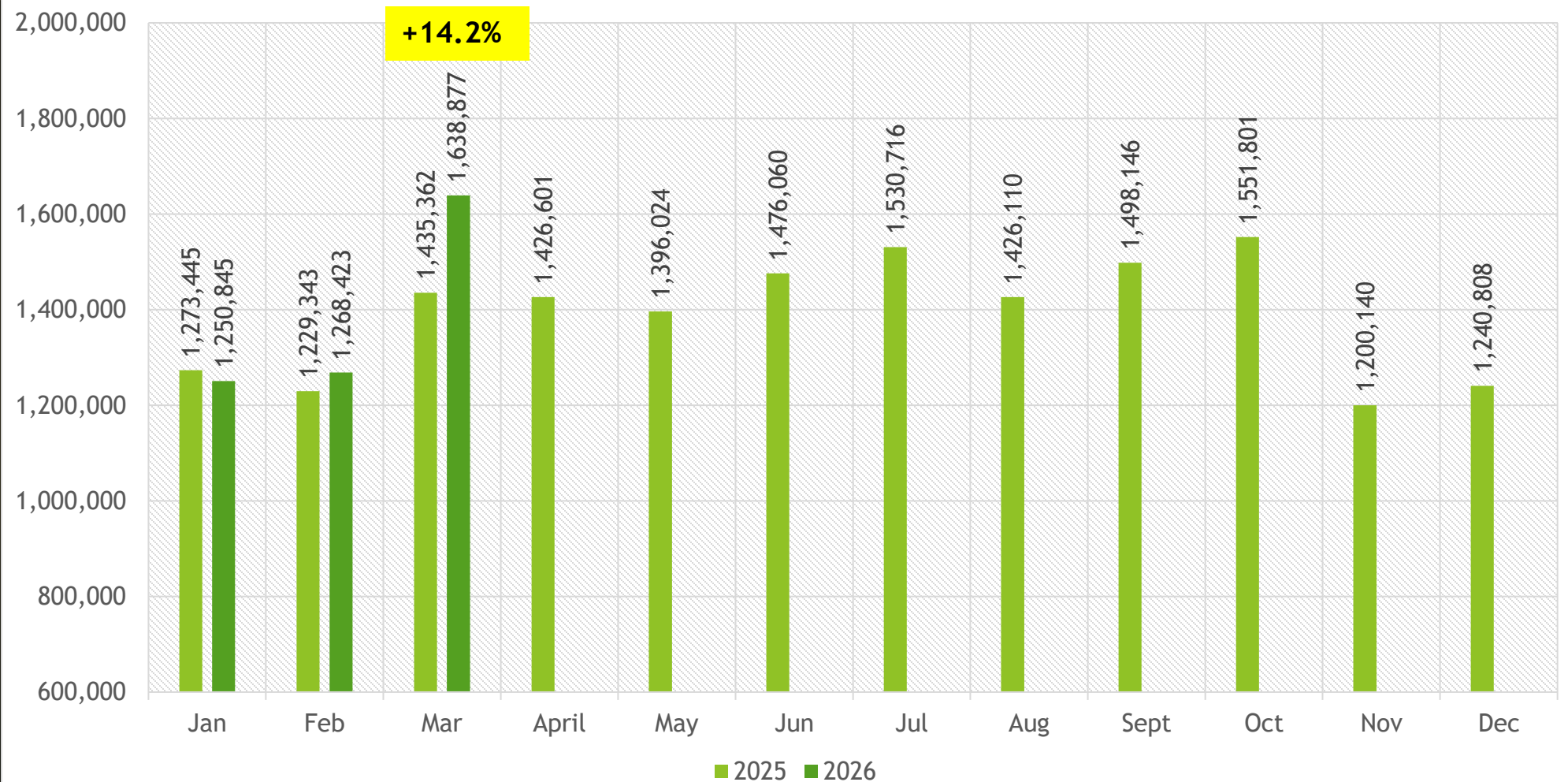
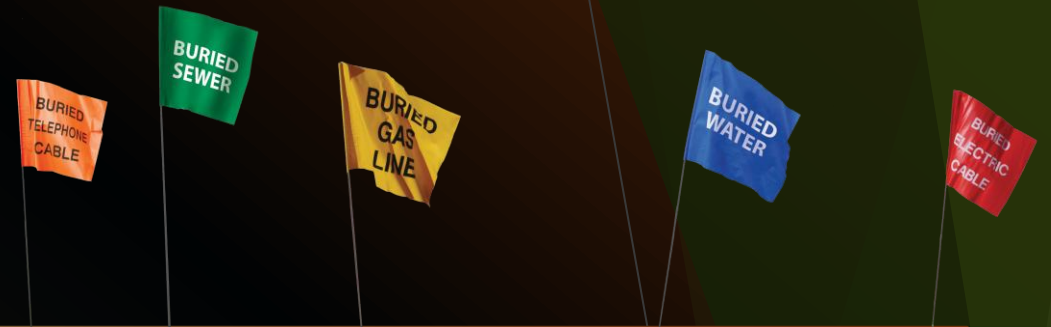
# LOCATE REQUESTS FOR NC 2025 VS 2026

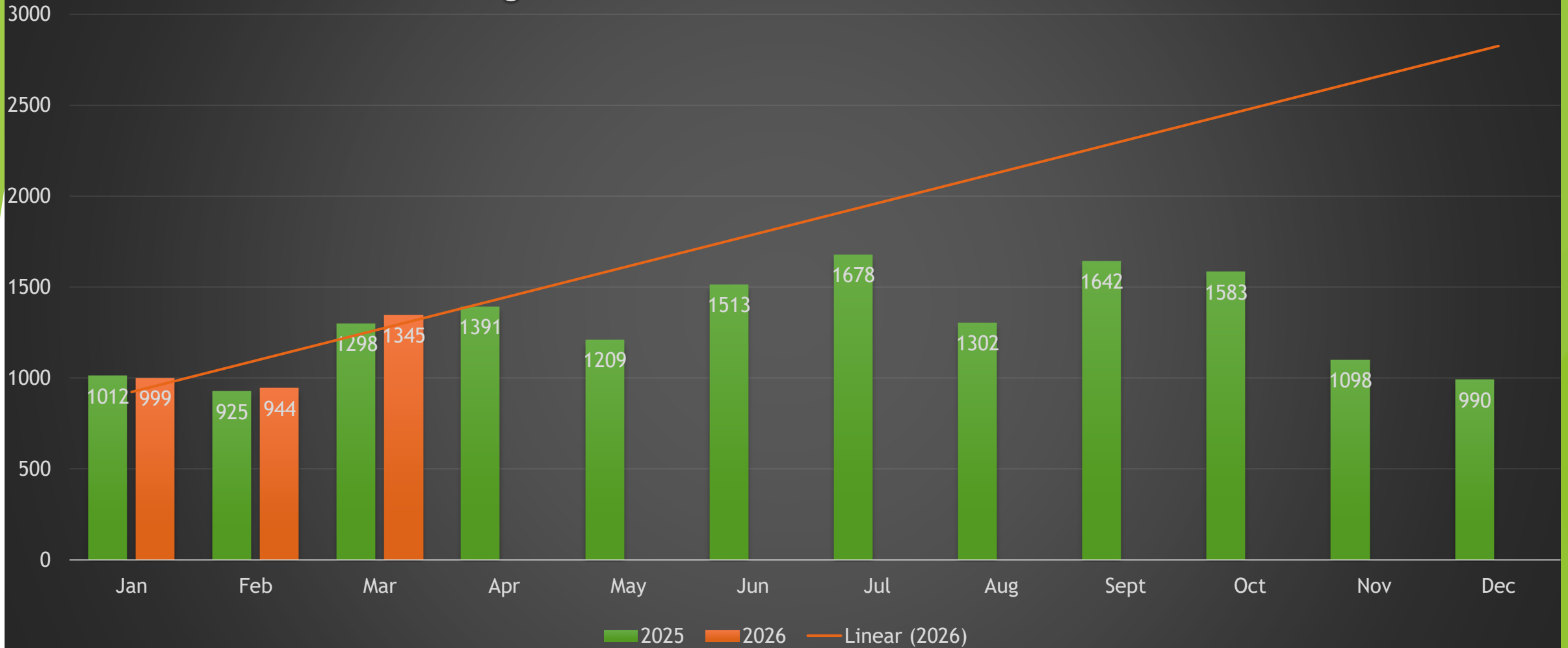

## Minutes April 15, 2026

### A. Call To Order

1. Recognize new attendees & guests.
  - Thomas Johnson- Opened and welcomed everyone to the meeting.
  - Any Rumley “Safety Share” –Be aware of surroundings especially in outfalls and right of ways where grass is tall. Check yourself for tick bites and if working with others please make them aware of any allergies you may have, especially bees and if there is an EpiPen available for treatment.

### B. Review and Approval of Previous Meeting’s Minutes

### C. Old Business/New Business/Projects

1. NCDOT- Jared introduced Byyan Grffin to the group, he’s new to the DOT.

They have bridge replacements at Hogan’s Creek on HWY 158. Also, the bridge is being replaced at the Rockingham-Caswell County line. Verizon is installing fiber on 86,87 and 150. Jacob creek Rd is getting a round-about as well as other road improvements. There is a roundabout at Washington and Boone Road starting next month. A question was asked why it takes a week to tear a bridge on Mayfield but a year and a half to rebuild it.

2. Report – NC811 – Parrish Reddick
  - Parrish gave this month’s UCC.
3. NC811 Parrish Reddick reported #’s was down, and he attributed it to the 28-calendar day ticket life.
4. PNG- Thomas with Piedmont stated the DOT in the area was great to work with as they always contact PNG with questions or issues.
5. PNG spoke about issues with a gas line that was unlocatable and the time frame to have it done so work could start. They have 2 projects, River Run and Freeway Dr those are being installed under a govt grant
