The **Work Date** is the date you *plan* to begin your excavation or demolition work.

This is the timeline you set based on your project schedule, crew availability, and job requirements.

However, just because you've listed a Work Date... **does not automatically mean you're cleared to start digging.**

The **Legal Work Date** is the earliest date you are legally allowed to begin excavation.

By law, your locate request must be submitted at least **three full working days** before excavation begins.

The three full working days are not optional.
