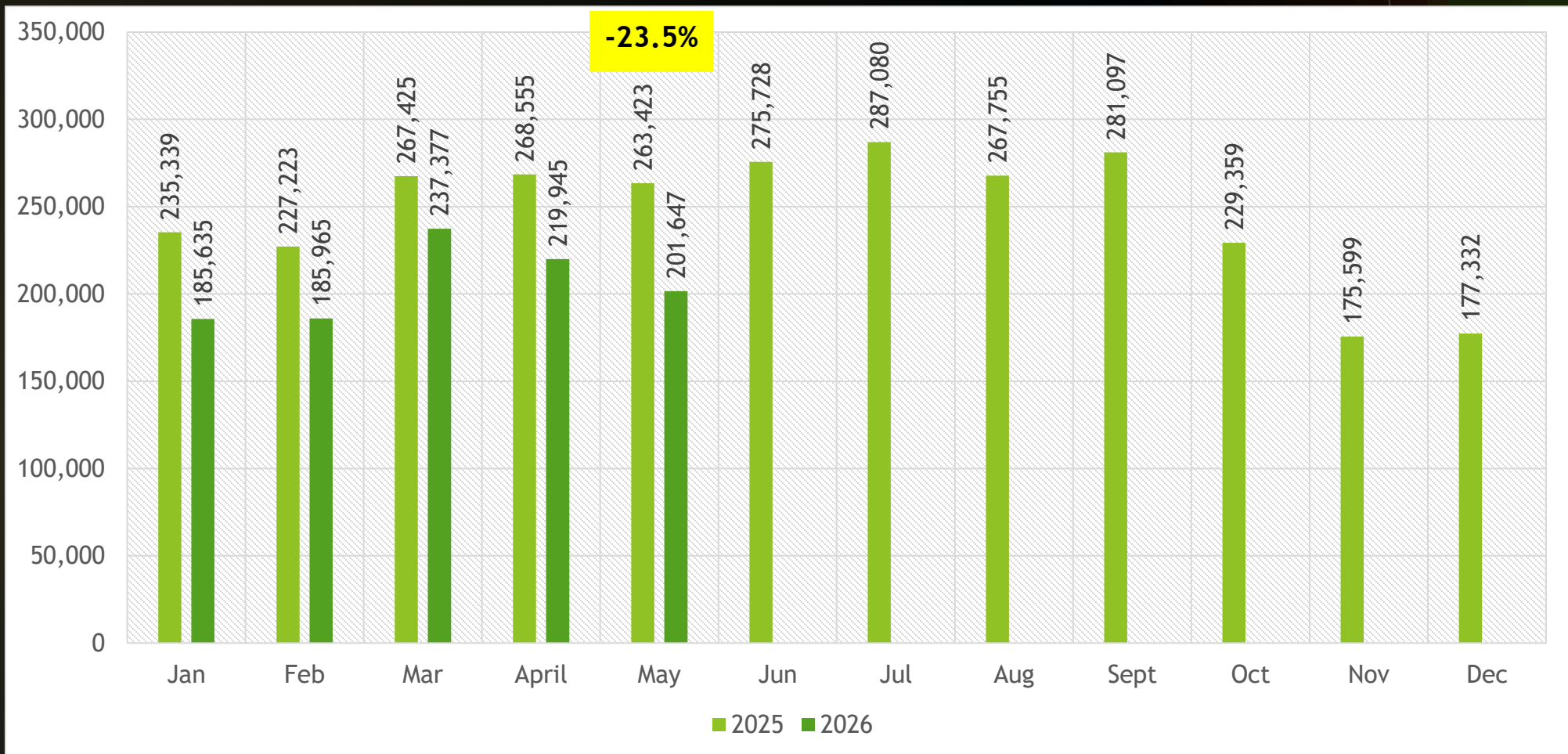

and distribution



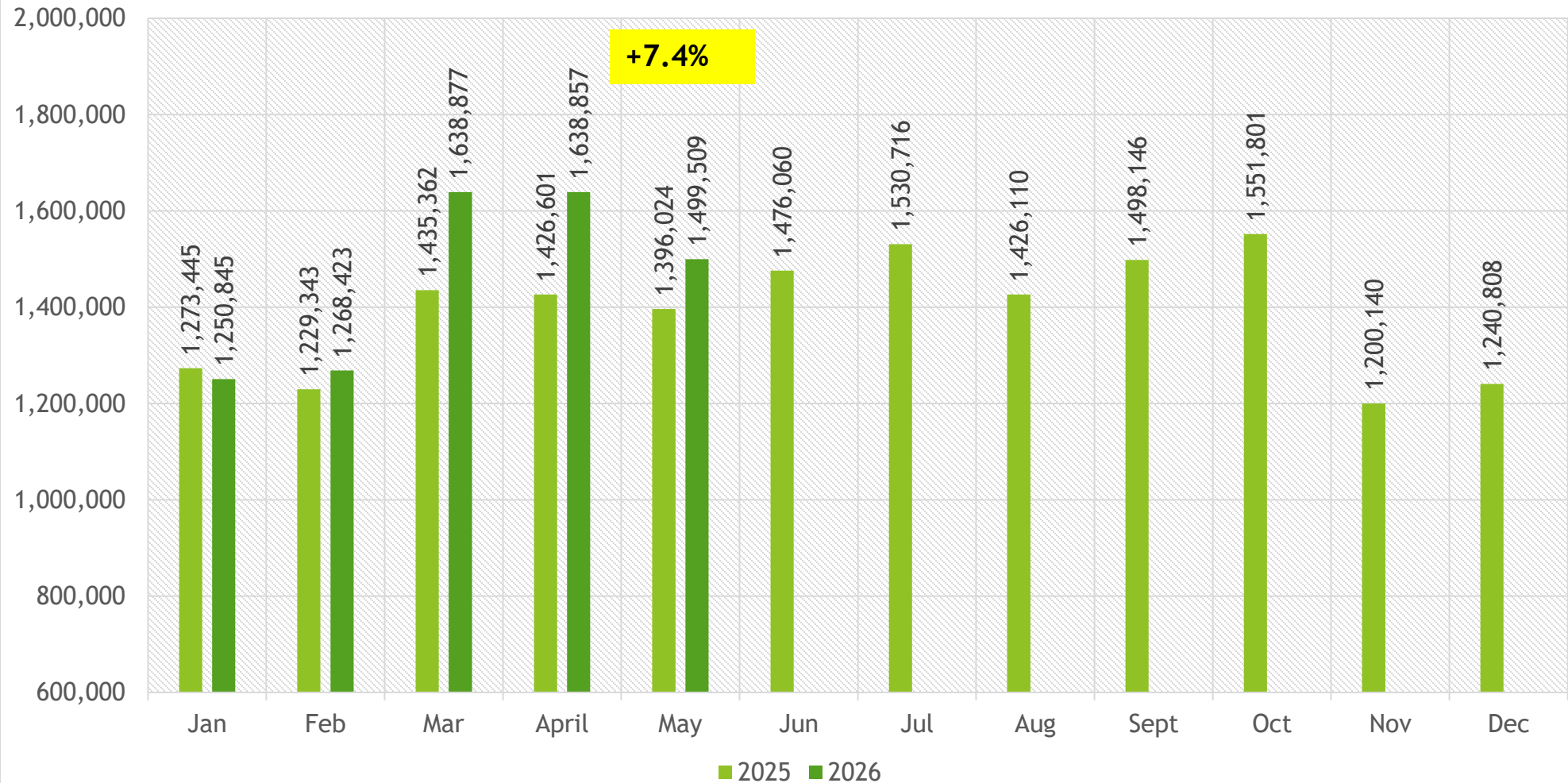
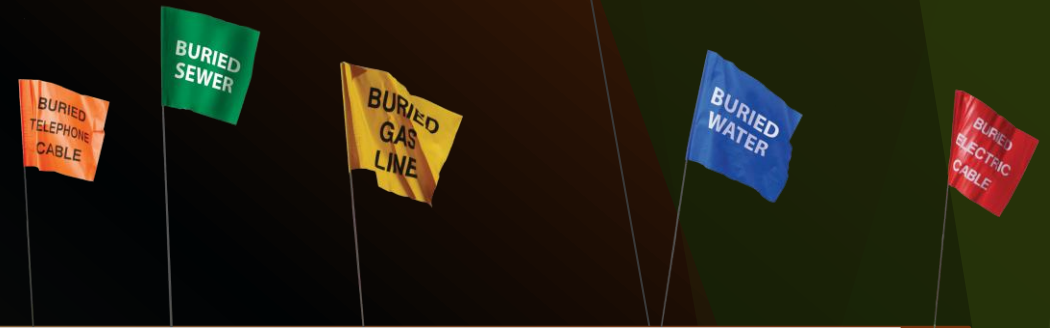

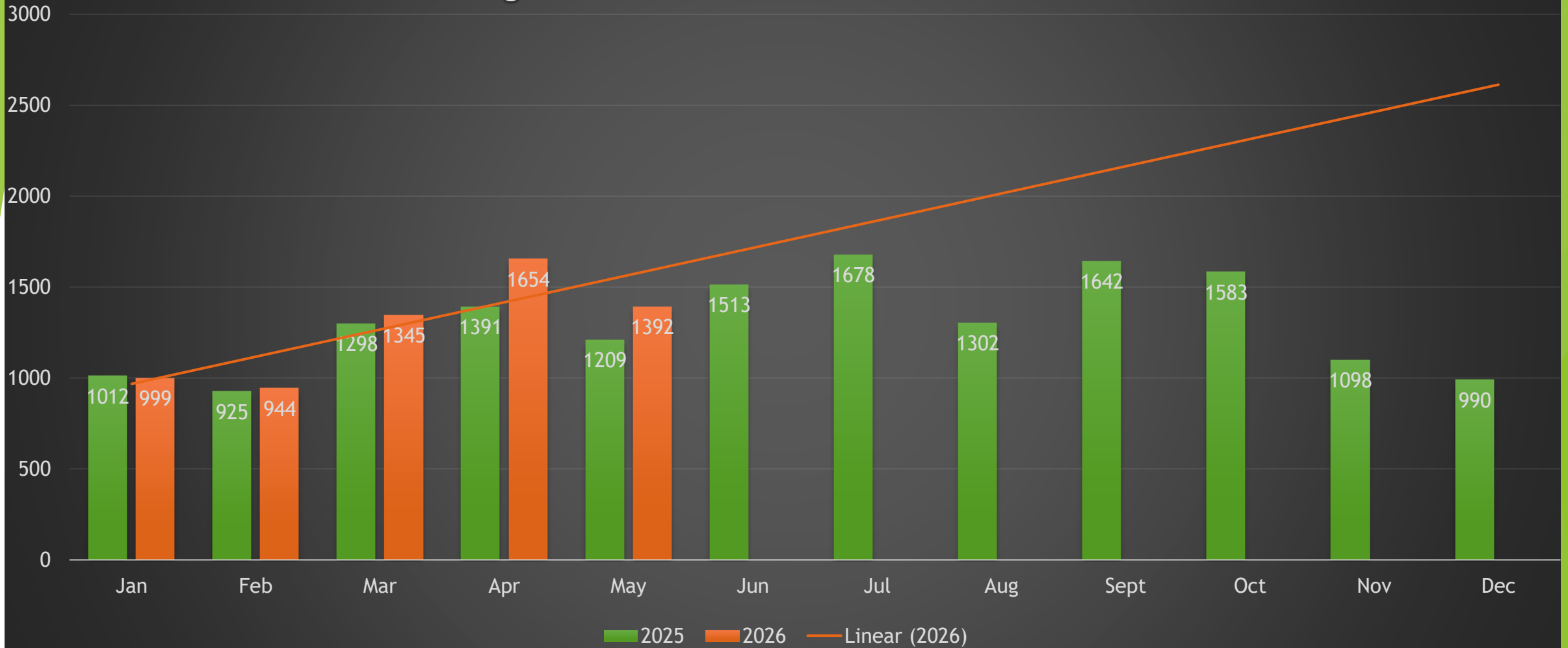

SREMC –New Subdivision on Morgan Rd in Johnston County, Pole changeout project on Overhills Rd in Spring Lake.

Discussion:

NC811 report: Parrish showed a video with the Top 10 safety violations, it is National Safety Month. Parrish presented the meeting dates that are coming up. Overall locate tickets were down 18.3% from last year. Mastec was the top caller for Harnett County in May and National Ondemand was the top caller for Johnston County in May. Harnett County had 21 reported damages and Johnston had 47 reported damages in May. Parrish played a video that explains the work date versus the legal work date; with the new law you have to wait the three days even if all responses have come in.

Issue was discussed where locate instructions are vague and it is unclear what needs locating; a lot of companies are not white lining. It would be really helpful if companies would white line especially if they are not going to put clear locate instructions. Locators are also seeing a lot of tickets that say both sides of the road, this is very time consuming and could be avoided if they know they are only going down one side of the road. South River EMC also said they are seeing a lot of locate tickets with bad addresses.

Everyone was encouraged to attend the monthly meetings and to invite their contractors to the monthly meetings. Please remember to white line or flag the area you need located when calling in locates and give them good contact information.
