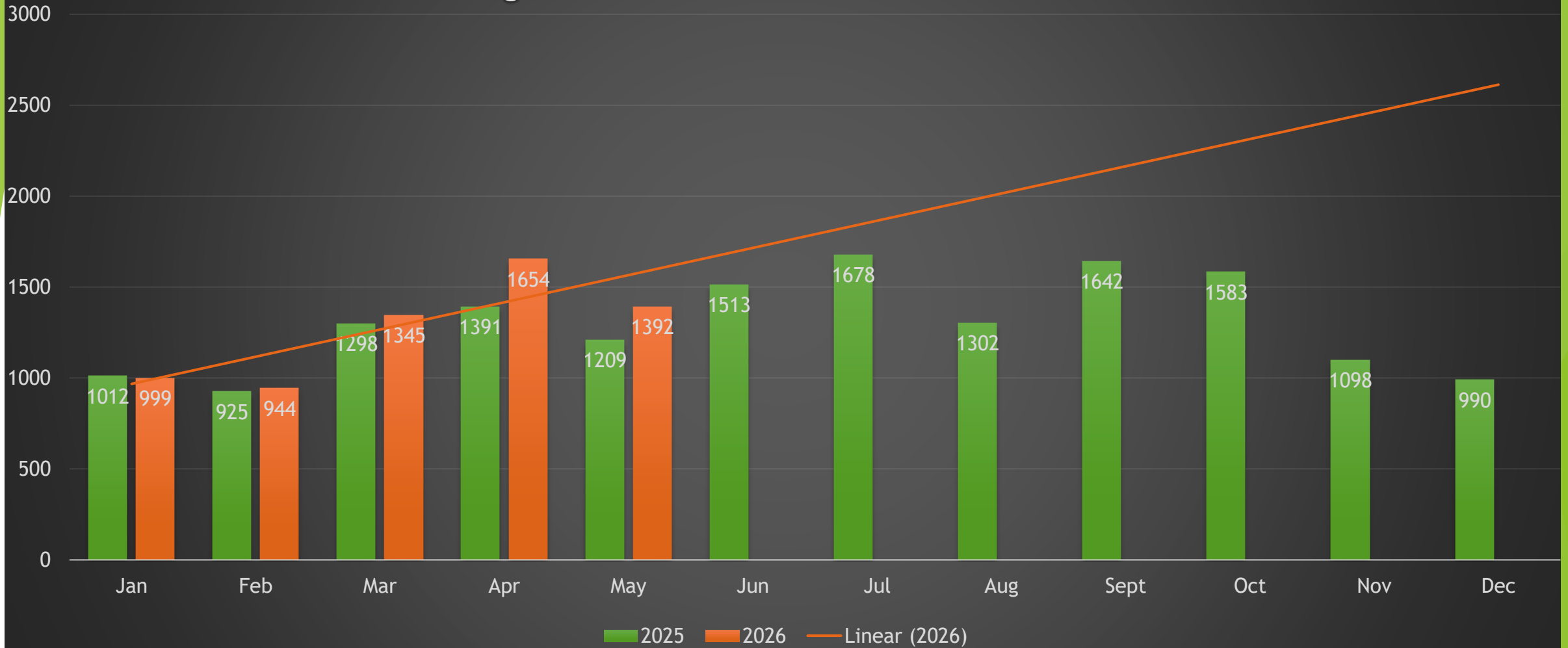

The **Work Date** is the date you *plan* to begin your excavation or demolition work.

This is the timeline you set based on your project schedule, crew availability, and job requirements.

However, just because you've listed a Work Date... **does not automatically mean you're cleared to start digging.**

The **Legal Work Date** is the earliest date you are legally allowed to begin excavation.

By law, your locate request must be submitted at least **three full working days** before excavation begins.

The three full working days are not optional.

1. Old business.
 - NCDOT- there are two US Open projects ongoing that must be completed by 2028.
2. Open floor for any new business.
 - NCDOT (Jared McCaskill & Justin Richardson)
 - Increased encroachment activity in Division 8, primarily telecom.
 - GHL Services (Paul Jordan)
 - Pineview Rd, Randleman – 20” Water line (PTRWA) & Ace Avant
 - Hwy 73 Mount Gilead, Montgomery Co. – 8” and 12” distribution PNG & SEC
 - Audobon (Robert Memory & David Talbert)
 - Telecom designs have increased dramatically in the recent months and Audobon is focusing on joining alongside other gas providers besides Enbridge to expand their design capabilities.
 - Further discussion around the use of multisystem duct banks in relocation projects. It simplifies the constructability and reduces damages.
