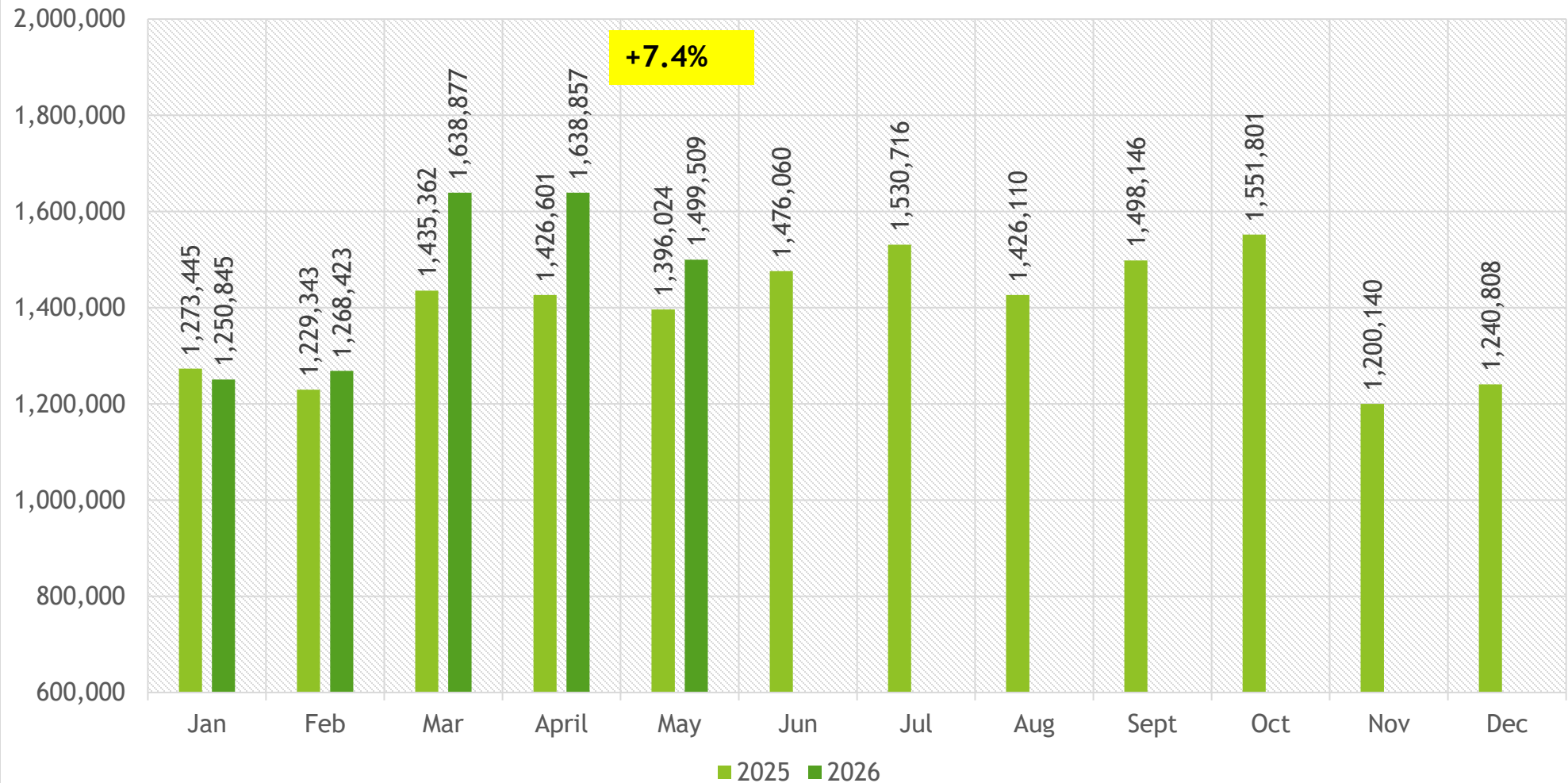
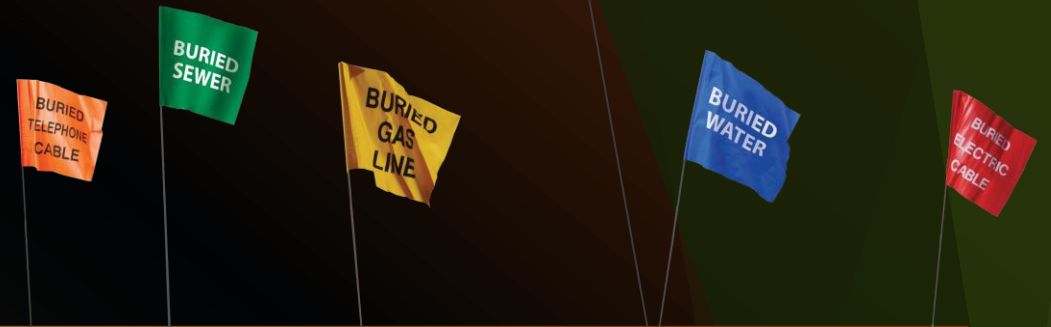
# LOCATE REQUESTS FOR NC 2025 VS 2026

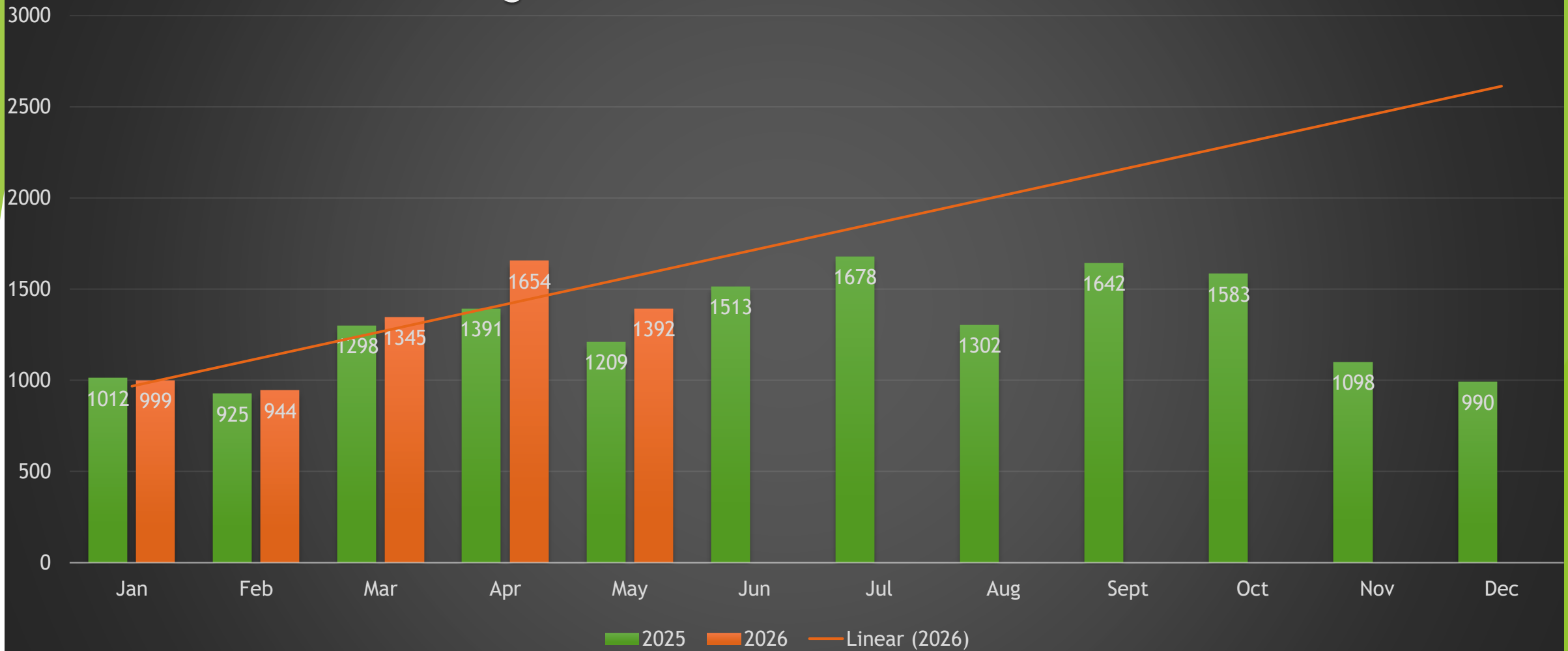

The **Work Date** is the date you *plan* to begin your excavation or demolition work.

This is the timeline you set based on your project schedule, crew availability, and job requirements.

However, just because you've listed a Work Date... **does not automatically mean you're cleared to start digging.**

The **Legal Work Date** is the earliest date you are legally allowed to begin excavation.

By law, your locate request must be submitted at **least three full working days** before excavation begins.

**The three full working days are not optional.**

  - Although a damage may seem small it can become a large damage down the line. A small scratch down the side of a pipe can cause lasting effects and weaken it's integrity.
