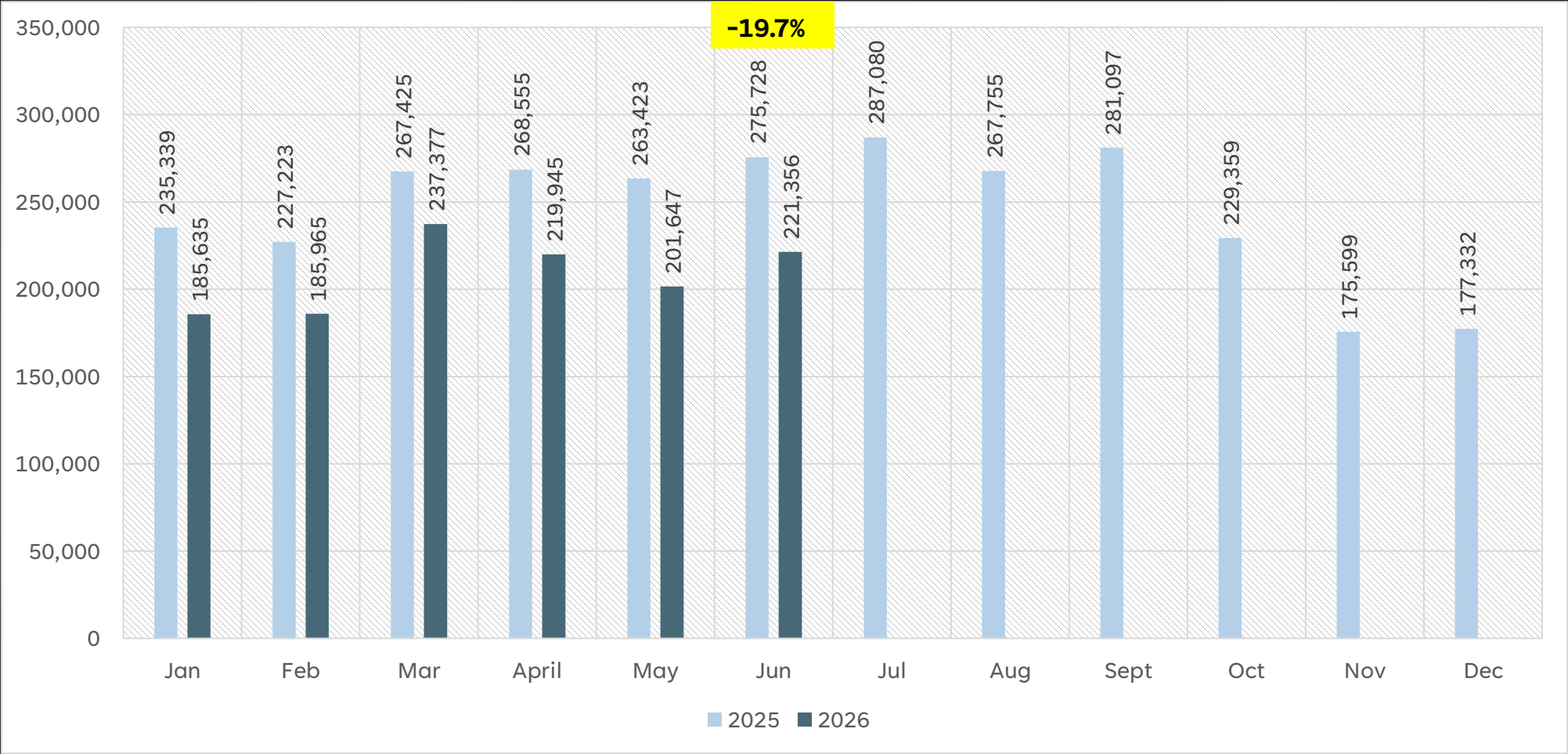
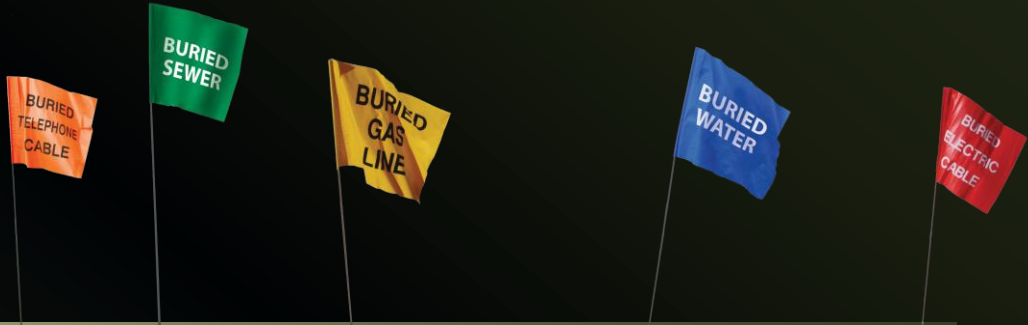

2025 VS 2026

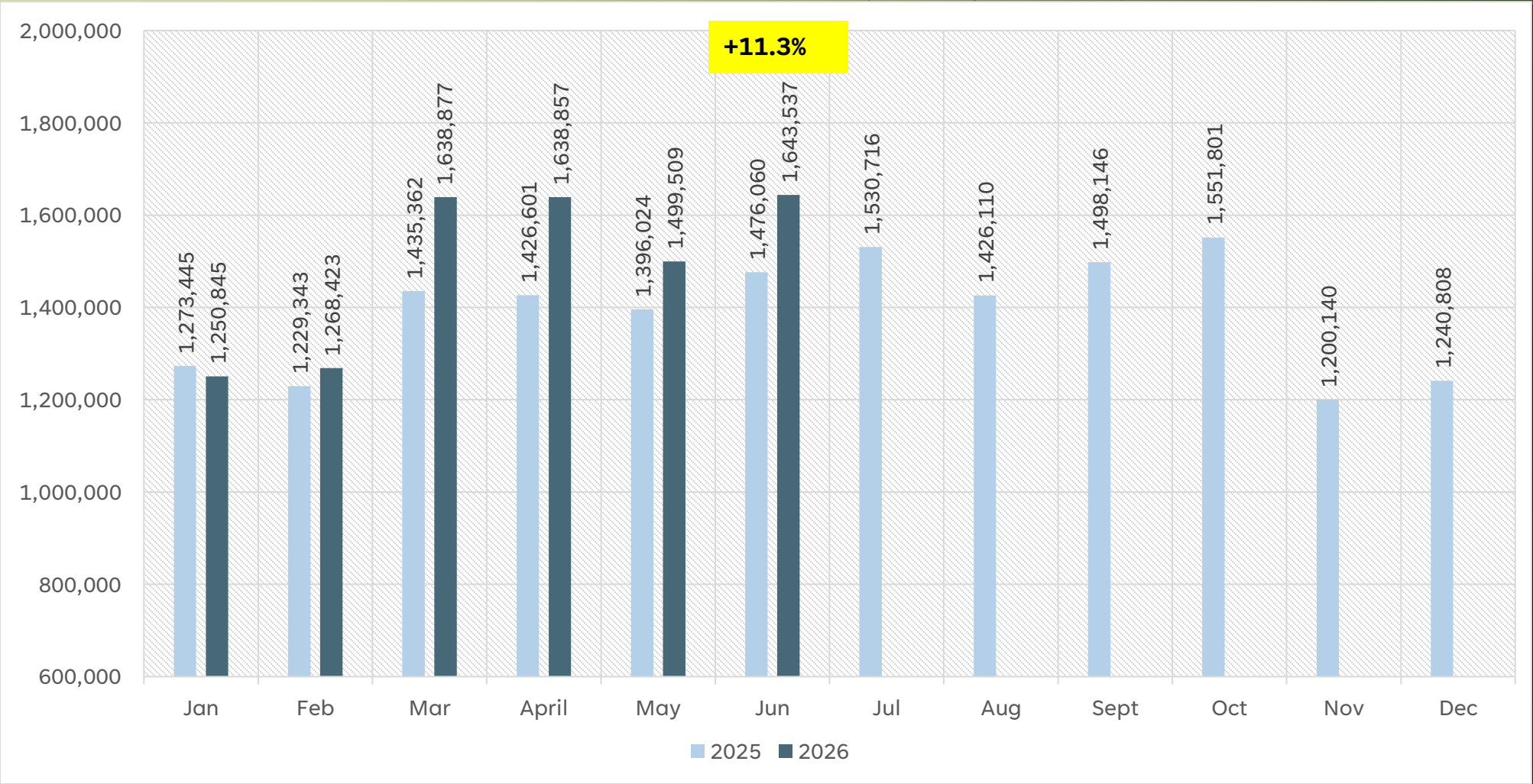
2026 YTD -1,251,925

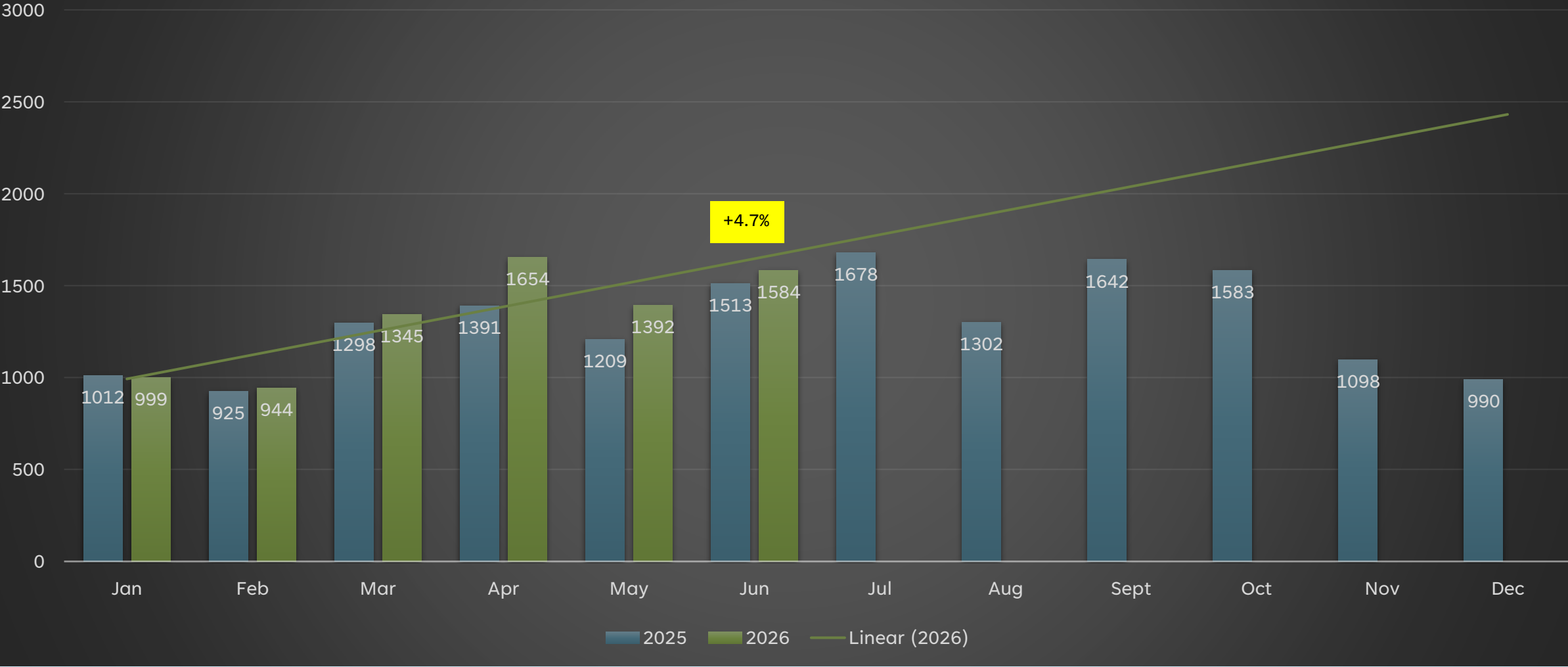

August 11th or 8/11 Day serves as a natural reminder for NC residents to call 811 prior to any digging project to have underground utility lines marked.

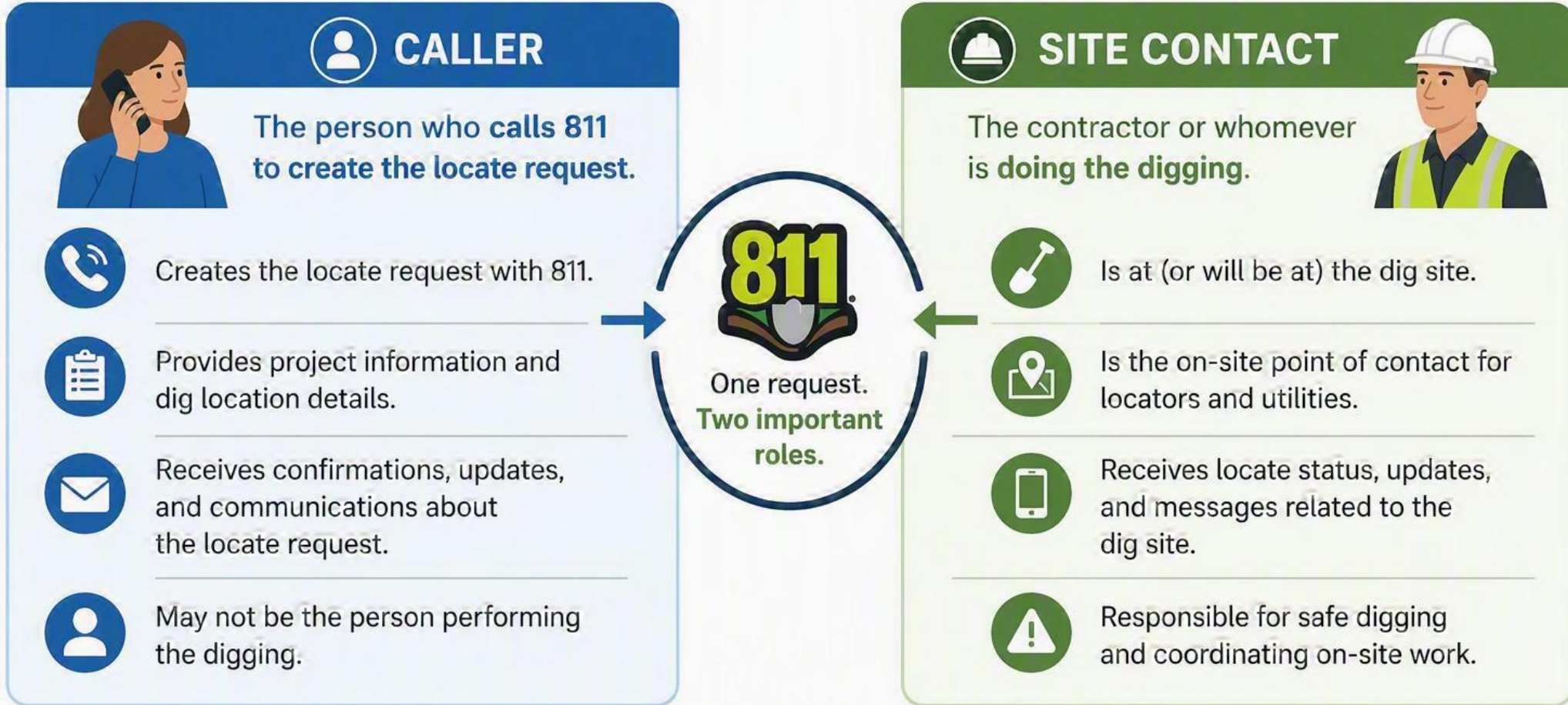
