- Postponed for possible federal earmark. Not progressing. No funding is available.

- Project scope denied. Grant will go toward Dickinson Avenue Betterments.
- Grant deadline December 2026.

St. Andrews Streambank Restoration

- Phase 1 deliverables were submitted to the State.
- Waiting to receive construction funding. Possible new grant funding.

Eppes Community Center Pathway

- Likely will need overhead power and utilities to be relocated on 3rd St by memorial intersection across from Stutz St. Also, will need pole shifted on 4th St.

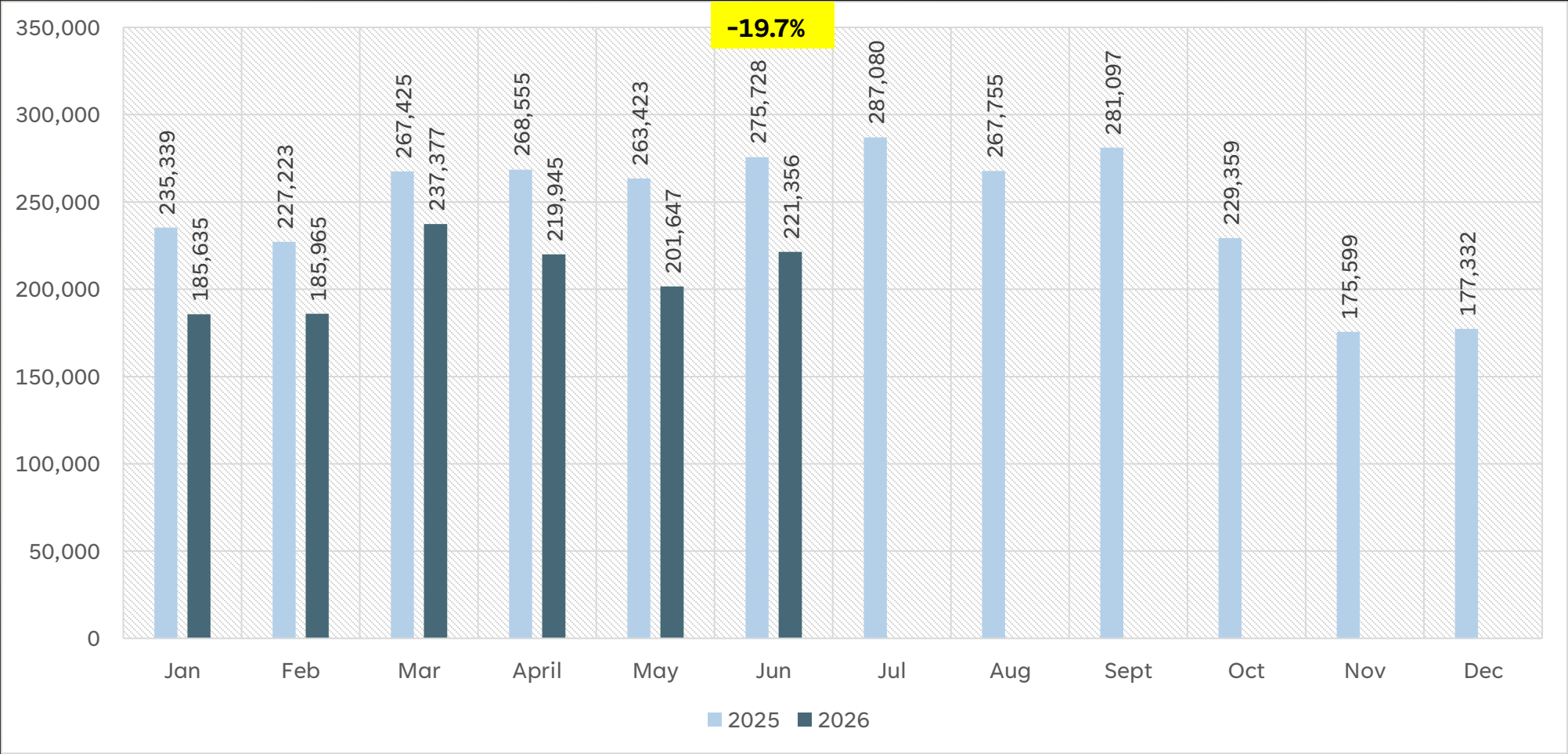

2025 VS 2026

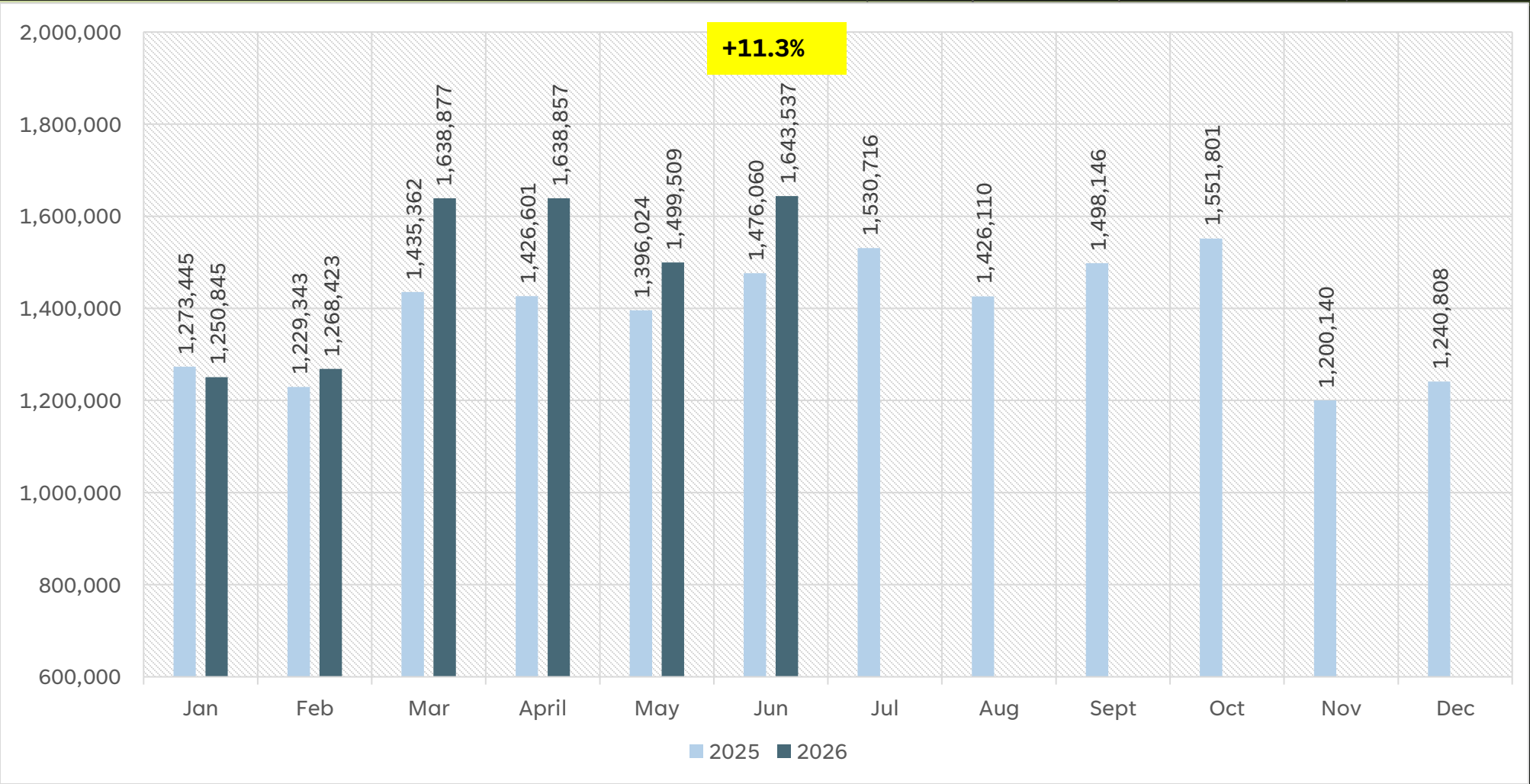

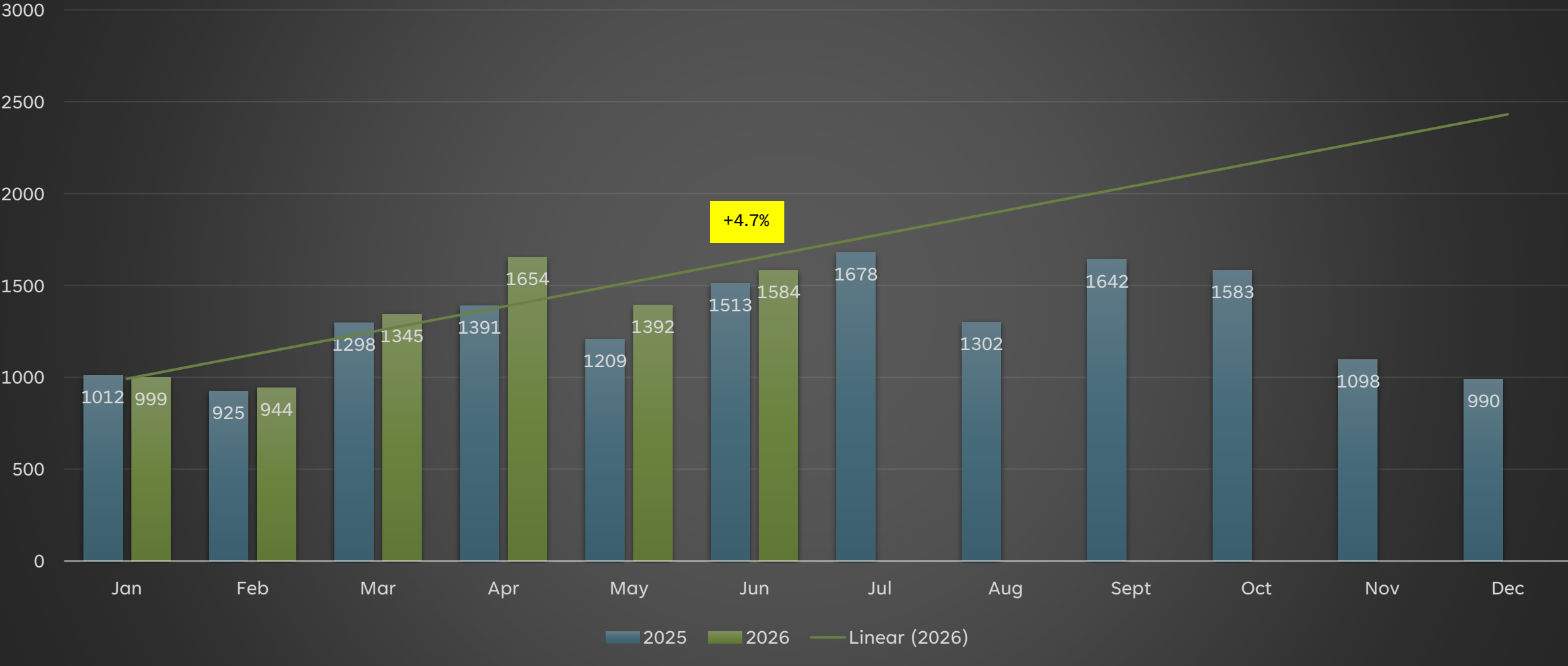
